

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- **At Nhava Sheva port around 270 containers pulses landed on 22.12.2016.** Out of total containers 27.04 % were Chickpeas imported from Australia and Russia. Lentils share were higher at 31.85 % and were imported from Uganda and Canada. Mung Bean share was 26 %. Pigeon Pea share was 9 % and has been imported from Malawi and Mozambique. Import flow is likely to continue and its impact is being felt on domestic price.
- **Cash pulses markets traded mixed on good Rabi production prospects,** import flow and restricted demand from retail end. Trading activities remained sluggish ahead Christmas celebration and holidays. Money crunch would continue to impact normal course of trading at least for two to three months in domestic market.
- **Pulses Rabi sowing has crossed 94% of normal area of 140.67lakh ha so far** and is running ahead by 12.60 % to 131.8 lakh ha from last year as on 16.12.2016. Chana, the main Rabi pulses, area coverage has been registered at 86.9 lakh ha, higher by 12.93 percent from last year till date. Its normal area is 88.37 lakh ha.
- **Weather remains favorable and sowing is expected to be over by December end.** Chana area may exceed normal as prices continue to rule higher. Higher MSP of Rs 4000 per qtl., including bonus, has encouraged farmers to grow more Chana this year. Large calibre (10mm) kabuli chickpeas are currently seeing prices top out at 70 cents per pound in Western Canada, according to Prairie Ag Hotwire data. Those are the highest prices of the crop-year-to-date.
- **Forward deals for Australian Chana for Jan end delivery has been** reported at \$750/755 per tonne. Import flow is higher and deals for around 1000 containers have been struck from Australia for Jan end. Besides, new crop will hit Indian market from end February and it would pressurize domestic market. Chana market is expected to decrease continuously and may stay around Rs 5500/6000 with arrival of new crop in India.
- **Tur lemon in Mumbai is being traded at Rs 4900 per qtl.** Steady to slightly weak tone may prevail in coming days as arrival pressure is building up from new crop. Urad quote too decreased from Rs 7000 to Rs 6200/6300 per qtl. and may continue to trade down. Lower demand at higher level and easing supply side amid availability of other cheap pulses may restrict any up momentum in Urad. Australian Chana in Mumbai is being traded at Rs 9400/9500. At Mundra port it is being quoted at Rs 9500/9600 per qtl. Tanzanian and Ethiopian Chana are being traded at Rs 9200 and Rs 8300 per qtl. respectively. Downward pressure continues as large volume of import is expected in Dec. and Jan.
- **Masur is being quoted at Rs 4500/4600 while Canadian peas is being** quoted at Rs 2281 per qtl in Mumbai. Russian peas are being offered at Rs 2251 per qtl. Green peas are being offered at Rs 3100 per qtl. In domestic market there is weak demand and buyers are engaged in only need based buying as sentiments remain weak. After bumper kharif crop, prospects for Rabi are very good. Supply side would increase with continuous flow of import from Russia, Canada and Australia.
- **Around 17500 tonne Australian Chick Peas is expected to land at Mundra port on 25th Dec.** while 19950 tonne is expected to land at Mumbai on 28.12.2016 from same destination. Besides, 27277 tonne is likely to land Mundra port on 5th Jan-2017. All these imports are expected in bulk.
- **Pulses Rabi sowing has crossed 94% of normal area of 140.67lakh ha so far** and is running ahead by 12.60 % to 131.8 lakh ha from last year as on 16.12.2016. Chana, the main Rabi pulses, area coverage has been registered at 86.9 lakh ha, higher by 12.93 percent from last year till date. Its normal area is 88.37 lakh ha. Weather remains favorable and sowing is expected to be over by December end. Chana area may exceed normal as prices are ruling still higher. Higher MSP of Rs 4000 per qtl., including bonus, too has encouraged farmers to grow more Chana this year.
- **Tur is likely to witness bearish sentiments** due to low demand, increase in arrival of the new crop and adequate availability of imported stocks. On Wednesday, tur lemon was quoted at Rs 5100/quintal in Indore whereas tur was quoted at Rs 4200/quintal in Madhya Pradesh. Overall pulses are likely to notice range bound to weak movement.
- **India imported 283426 tonne pulses during 21st to 26th Nov-2016, higher by 16.14 %** from previous week. It had imported 244024 tonne pulses during week ended 20th Nov-2016. The highest quantity was of yellow peas out of total import during the week. India imported 193883 tonne yellow peas, 32699 tonne Tur, 7043

tonne Urad and 11358 tonne Chana during this period. Besides, 32206 T Lentils has been imported. The rest were other pulses including kidney beans.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- **Matar production in Canada has been estimated at 48.35 lakh tonne for 2016-17.** It had produced 32.01 lakh tonne in 2015-16. The season started with 1.76 lakh tonne as opening stock while it was 6.84 lakh tonne in 2015-16. Import too have increased from 16 to 29 thousand tonne in 2016-17. Thus total supply has been pegged at 50.40 lakh tonne against 39.01 lakh tonne last year. Total demand for this year has been pegged at 41.60 lakh tonne against 37.24 lakh tonne last year. The season may end with 8.8 lakh tonne peas that hints ample supply to continue throughout the year. Prices are ruling at \$260 to 290 per tonne, depending on quality.
- **Lentils production in Canada has been estimated at 32.48 lakh tonne for 2016-17.** It had produced 25.41 lakh tonne in 2015-16. The season started with 0.73 lakh tonne as opening stock while it was 3.65 lakh tonne in 2015-16. Import too have increased from 16 to 75 thousand tonne in 2016-17. Thus total supply has been pegged at 33.96 lakh tonne against 29.21 lakh tonne last year. Total demand for this year has been pegged at 27.96 lakh tonne against 28.49 lakh tonne last year. The season may end with 6 lakh tonne peas that hints ample supply to continue through out the year. Prices are ruling at \$585 to 615 per tonne, depending on quality. Last year its average was \$965 per tonne.
- **As per latest update, record lentil harvest has been confirmed in Canada and Australia** although it has a little impact on markets during the past week. Statistics Canada has pegged harvest at 3.25 MMT compared to 2.54 MMT last year, whereas the Australian harvest is expected to be around 0.45 MMT compared to 0.258 MMT last year. Exporters and processors are focused on fulfilling their commitments made for export sales before new year's holiday season.
- **As per the latest survey data issued (6th Dec) by Statistics Canada hints** record pea and Lentils production in 2016-17. The agency have pegged 4.8 MMT pea production, higher by 1 MMT from record of 2013. Similarly Lentils crop has been pegged at 3.2 MMT against 2.5 MMT produced last year. Traders see these figures as per their previous expectation. Number 2 Laird lentils are currently topping out at about 63 cents per pound in Western Canada, while red lentils are bid up to 32.5 cents per pound. Large calibre (10mm) kabuli chickpeas are currently seeing prices top out at 65 cents per pound.
- **Laird 1 Lentils in Western Canada continued to inched up to 66 cents per pound,** almost 5 cents up from a fortnight ago. Light Kidney beans dropped a little bit and its average bid comes to 43.5 cents per pound. Despite bad weather farmers in Australia expects 2 T per ha yield this year. The main problems for them were ascochyta blight and water-logging issues. Delayed harvesting would delay shipment and New Indian crop would hit the market by end feb. This means they have two and a half months to ship their crop at higher prevailing price. India would not buy Chana from March. It is clear due to bumper production prospect this year. For Australia it would be very difficult to ship maximum marketable surplus in two months. So pressure on global domestic Chick peas market looms large.
- **Australia is exporting lentils to India at \$680/85 per tonne while Canada is offering lentils at \$750 per tonne.** Cheaper supply from Australia has put pressure on Canadian lentils quote. According to the Prairie Ag Hotwire, 1 Red Lentils in Western Canada decreased by one cent per pound last week. Bids ranged from 27 cents per pound at the lows to 34 cents at the highs. Green pea is being offered in the range of C\$7.50 to as high as C\$9.00 per bushel in Western Canada. Pressure would continue as supply side has eased and buyers are in bargaining seat now.
- **Despite current uptrend Lentils price in Canada is unlikely to move northward in coming weeks.** Currently it is being traded at 66 cents (CND) per pound. Laird 1 lentils are being quoted in the range of 61 to 66 cents per pound. Kabuli Chana is being traded at 64 to 65 cents per pound. In Indian market there is a pressure on Lentils and Chana markets it may trade lower due to lower demand in local markets. Consumers are turning to green vegetables.
- **Chickpeas import from US In India is increasing fast. India imported 20607 MT Chickpeas in Sept** and Volume is expected to be higher in Oct. Data is awaited. Surprisingly, it is 73 % of total Chickpeas export from US in a month. Turkey and Spain brought the rest volume. The reason behind higher import from US is said to be crop loss around 70 % in Canada due to wet condition.

- **Lentils import volume from US too increased to 19326 T, around 30.9 % of total lentil export in a month.** India imported 74526 tonne drypeas from US too, 75.4 % of total drypeas export in a month. India imported 1.14 lakh tonne pulses from US out of total export of 1.9 lakh tonne. Higher import volume is likely to continue as prices in India still rules higher despite decreased price.
- **Pulses prices in Canada have moved up in recent weeks. Lentils local quotes for Number 2 Laird varieties** are currently hovering in the range of 48 to 61 cents per pound in Western Canada. Green pea prices range from C\$7.50 to as high as C\$9.00 per bushel.
- **Farmers in Australia have been taking advantage of higher chickpea price. Drought** affected crop and tight supply side have temporarily lent support to chickpea price from AU\$800 per tonne to AU\$1,000 per tonne. However, firmness would not sustain in the medium term once Indian crop starts hitting the market in Feb this year.
- **According to the latest update by market viewers in Australia, Lentil crop in some pacts of western Australia** has been affected by severe outbreaks of botrytis grey mould. Experts say that South Australia and Victoria alone have planted 2.5 lakh ha Lentil this year and out of this 50 % is said to be affected by this botrytis grey mould. Quality and yield is expected to be affected badly and it would reduce the final size of the crop.
