

### Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- **As per market sources government may impose 15% import duty on Chana, Tur, Mung and 20% import duty on pea.** Chana harvesting in Maharashtra and Madhya Pradesh is in full swing whereas harvesting in Rajasthan and Uttar Pradesh is in its initial stages. As per government, India has produced 221 lakh tonnes of pulses of which 91 lakh tonnes is Chana. Notification is likely to come within two weeks and import duty will provide support to prices in domestic market.
- **As per market sources, NAFED has procured more than 5.6 lakh tonnes of tur until 18th march'17.** NAFED has purchased 2.07 lakh tonnes from Maharashtra, 1.27 lakh tonnes from Telangana, 1.17 lakh tonnes from Karnataka, 0.66 lakh tonnes from Gujarat, 0.43 lakh tonnes from Madhya Pradesh and 54 tonnes from Andhra Pradesh. NAFED will continue its procurement of tur until 15th April'17. Prices of tur fell below MSP, therefore in order to keep the farmers motivated government agencies are procuring tur at MSP.
- **India imported around 406 containers of pulses** at Krishnapatnam and Chennai port during 03rd to 10th March-2017. During 26th February– 02nd March a total of 440 containers were imported at the same ports. Of the total 406 containers share of Black Mapte was recorded at 188 containers. The second and third largest quantities were Toor Whole and chickpeas (26 & 149 containers). The rest were other pulses like Green Moong, yellow peas, lentils etc.
- **Mumbai Tur Lemon opened at Rs 4200/4250per qtl. and traded firm** from previous close. Uptrend is likely to continue based on hope for imposition of duty by the end of this month.. Urad FAQ traded up at Rs 5950/6000 and SQ at Rs 6900/6950. Imported Chana in Mumbai traded up by Rs 100 to Rs 5075/5100. Uptrend is likely to continue as buyers are active amid report of minor damage to the crop and slower release by farmers. Trading range of Chana may be Rs 4900 to Rs 5300 in Mumbai. It is being offered at Rs5100 at Mundra Port. Tanzanian Chana is being quoted at Rs 5050/5150 per qtl. Canadian Masur is being offered at Rs 4100/4150 per qtl. and Australian Lentils are being offered at Rs4200/4250 per Qtl. Steady to slightly weak tone may be seen during March-2017.
- **Burma offers Lemon Tur at \$620 per tonne on CiF basis, up by \$5 from previous week.** Urad FAQ is being offered at \$790 and SQ at \$940 per tonne, Moong Pedisheva is being offered at \$980/90 per tonne While Pakakois at \$740 per tonne. Tur and Urad CNF offer has been increased. But demand at higher level has decreased. CnF quotes in Burma may stay steady to firm in coming weeks. Demand from India may decrease due to higher availability in domestic market.
- **Govt has procured around 14.66 lakh tonne pulses from domestic market and import** so far(till 8th March-2017) for creating approved buffer stock of 20 lakh tonne. Out of total14.66 lakh tonne purchase through import has been reported at 4.06 lakh tonne. The government has approved engaging a professional Buffer Stock Management Agency for efficient management of procurement, storage, maintenance and liquidation of the stock as per directives of the govt. Govt may start selling pulses through tendering process. Pulses production is likely to touch at record 22.14 million tonnes in the 2016-17 crop year as against about 16.5 million tonnes in the previous year. Pulses annual demand in India is 240/245 lakh tonne.
- **Urad FAQ traded Rs 100 up to Rs 5950/6000 and SQ at Rs 6900 in Mumbai market.** Farmers have retained stock and higher quotes in forward deal at \$785 for FAQ variety and \$920/25 for SQ varieties supported Urad price in domestic market. Likely Imposition of duty on import is under consideration and it may support price in the short term.
- **Imported Chana in Mumbai traded up by Rs 100 to Rs 5150. Current firmness** is based on increasing fear of lower crop size and recent loss due to hail storm. Market expects Chana production not more than 82/83 lakh tonne against govt.'s estimate of 90 lakh tonne. Millers and stockiest are active to fulfill their immediate demand and it is supporting market. Rajasthan Chana in Delhi traded up by Rs 100 to Rs 5300 per qtl. while MP Chana quoted at Rs 5350 per qtl. Downward correction is expected this week as bulk buyers are unwilling to buy at this level.
- **Burma offers Lemon Tur at \$605 per tonne on CiF basis, up by \$20 from previous week.** Urad FAQ is being offered at \$780 and SQ at \$920 per tonne, Moong Pedisheva is being offered at \$970 per tonne While Pakakois at \$720 per tonne. Tur and Urad CNF offer has been increased. But demand at higher level has decreased. CnF quotes in Burma may stay steady in coming weeks. Lower demand from India may restrict Burmese quotes to move further up.

**Pulses International Fundamental:**

- **Canada exported 87900 tonnes of peas and only 100 tonnes of lentil** in the week ending 12th March'17. The total pea and lentil exports are about 2.36 MMT and 607200 tonnes till date. Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada has forecasted that pea and lentil ending stocks are likely to increase to 1.1 MMT and 925000 tonnes in 2017/18.
- **As per latest update By Canadian Market experts Chickpeas production in Canada** in MY 2017-18 may increase from 82,000 MT to 1.45 lakh tonne in 2017-18. Area coverage under Chickpeas too is likely to increase from 68,000 ha to 75,000 ha. This season Canada may end up with 1.15 lakh tonne export while export volume for 2017-18 has been trimmed to 90,000 MT. Domestic use may increase to 63,000 MT in coming MY. In the first week of March around 2000 MT export has been reported, lower 1600 MT from corresponding time. Chickpeas traded mixed in local market as Kabuli types get firmer. Desi type traded weak due to weak demand from India. However, Australian Chickpeas export for India remains strong. Australia has shipped 3.03 lakh tonne Chickpeas so far. Out of this 90 % shipped to Indian subcontinent.
- **Pressure on Canadian Lentils Market continues due to slackening fresh export** demand from bulk buyers like Pakistan and India. Exporters are engaged only to fulfill their old export obligation. However, green Lentils market stayed steady to slightly firm due to quality and grades. Large green Laird (15/64) plant delivery average price is being quoted at 54 cents per pound, Laird one is being traded at 49.43 cent per pound while Laird -2 is being traded at 42 cent per pound in western Canada. Medium green (Richlea) is being traded at 38.50 to 39.60 cent per pound. Small green (estone variety) is being traded at 44.07 cent per pound. Small red is being traded at 22/23 cent per pound. Pressure is likely to continue despite acreage for new planting is likely to reduce by 33 percent this year.
- **As per latest Canadian Grain Commission data Canada has exported** around 43000 T peas during week ended 26th February-2017 and total figure for the year so far has reached at 21.9 lakh tonne, higher by 4.4 lakh tonne from last year till date. Farmers have supplied 28.5 lakh tonne so far against 20.6 lakh tonne last year. Number 2 Laird lentils currently top out at about 56 cents per pound in Western Canada, with new crop bids as high as 36 cents per pound. Red lentils are bid up to 25 cents per pound in the spot market and as high as 23 cents per pound for new crop. Large calibre (10mm) kabuli chickpeas are currently hovering around 47 cents per pound in Western Canada.
- **Canada has just revised up adv. estimates of average pulses prices for 2016-17** despite some downward correction in prices in recent days. Agriculture and Agro Food Canada (Govt. agency, AAFC). AAFC has estimated price for peas in between C\$290/310 per tonne while Lentils average price may hover C\$ 615 to 630 per tonne. Chana may hinge in between C\$910/ 930 per T. AAFC had estimated matar price to hover in between C\$ 280/310 per T. Chana and Lentils price projections were C4900/930 and 605/635 per tonne.
- **Canada Agriculture & Agro Foods has estimated 42.5 lakh tonne peas production** for 2017-18, lower by around 6 lakh to 48.36 lakh tonne in 2016-17. However, production estimates for Chana and Lentils has been revised up to 14.50 lakh tonne and 35 lakh tonne respectively. In 2016-17 Canada has produced 32.48 lakh tonne Lentils
- **The US latest report reveals that Chickpeas production in 2016 in US jumped** from 115350 tonne (2015) to 247,047 tonne. The reason behind higher production is said to be higher area coverage and above normal yield. Production of larger Chickpeas (8mm) increased from 72896 to 159,167 tonne. Smaller Chickpeas production too increased from 42457 to 87907 tonne. As production size has gone up, export volume too has gone up by 15 to 16 % this year.
- **Matar production in Canada has been estimated at 48.35 lakh tonne for 2016-17.** It had produced 32.01 lakh tonne in 2015-16. The season started with 1.76 lakh tonne as opening stock while it was 6.84 lakh tonne in 2015-16. Import too have increased from 16 to 29 thousand tonne in 2016-17. Thus total supply has been pegged at 50.40 lakh tonne against 39.01 lakh tonne last year. Total demand for this year has been pegged at 41.60 lakh tonne against 37.24 lakh tonne last year. The season may end with 8.8 lakh tonne peas that hints ample supply to continue throughout the year. Prices are ruling at \$260 to 290 per tonne, depending on quality.
