

### Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- **According to Union Minister of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution govt.** would continue to procure pulses till 22nd April-2017 instead 15th April. All involve agencies would buy pulses directly from farmers on MSP. Total procurement by govt.'s agencies have gone up to 14.10 lakh tonne for central pool stock. If we add import of 4 lakh tonne total stock in central pool goes up to 18.10 lakh tonne against the set target of 20 lakh tonne. As pulses, especially Tur, is abundantly available total procurement may exceed 20 lakh tonne.
- **India imported around 296 containers of pulses at Krishnapatnam and Chennai port** during 28th March to 03rd April-2017 compared to 345 during 22nd to 27th March at the same ports. Of the total 296 containers share of Black mape was recorded at 158 containers. The second and third largest quantities were chickpeas and Toor Whole (44 & 36 containers). The rest were other pulses like Green Moong, yellow peas, lentils etc.
- **State procurement agencies in M.P., Karnataka and Maharashtra are selling Tur** and Urad procured in kharif Season 2015-16. In MP (Narsinghpur, Chhatarpur CWC warehouses) 33451.32 qtl tur and 11292.69 qtl. Urad are available for sale through bidding process. In Karnataka (Sedam Kalaburgi CWC) 2026 qtl Tur for sale is available. In Maharashtra (Ausa, Latur, Dhamongaon, Wardha, Yavatmal and Osmanabad) 11404 Qtl Tur is available for sale. Bidding is going on weekly basis (Wednesday). Interested parties may participate in bidding.
- **Mumbai Tur Lemon(old) opened at Rs 4150 and Rs 4250 (new) per qtl. and traded weak** from previous close. Downward trend is unlikely to continue this week. Urad FAQ traded up at Rs 5900 and SQ at Rs 6875/6900. Imported Chana in Mumbai traded up by Rs 100 to Rs 5850/5900. Uptrend is likely to continue as buyers are active. Trading range of Chana may be Rs 5800 to Rs 6200 in Mumbai. It is being offered at Rs 5800 at Mundra Port. Canadian Masur is being offered at Rs 4300 per qtl. and Australian Lentils are being offered at Rs 4400 per Qtl. Steady to slightly firm tone may be seen during March-2017.
- **Chana market is likely to trade up once again as Australian forward quotes are up.** Tur harvesting start in UP after MP and Jharkhand. More dip is unlikely as buyers remain active. Moong is unlikely to dip from current level. Import is costly and sowing in Bihar and UP is yet to begin. Demand from UP is good and stock is lower. Higher quotes in Burma and limited arrival from Pakistan and Uzbekistan would continue to support Moong market. Masur may trade firm now as arrival is decreasing and demand at lower level begins.
- **Pulses quotes in forward deals continued to increase and it hints domestic market to trade steady to firm** in the near to medium term. Ukraine yellow peas May shipment CnF quote was heard at \$345 for Tuticorin/Nhava Sheva. It was \$ 355 for Kolkata. Broken Red Lentils of Canadian origin was quoted at \$555 for Nhava Sheva in 25kg PP bags.
- **Australian Desi Chickpeas was quoted at \$920 for May delivery,** June \$930 and July \$960 per T. Australian green Moong was quoted at \$955 for April/May delivery. Australian Red Whole Lentils was quoted at \$665 per T for May delivery. Myanmar origin Urad was quoted at \$ 917 for FAQ and \$1118 for SQ variety for Chennai and Nhava Sheva port.
- **Indian govt. recent decisions regarding pulses are likely to benefit exporting** countries as well as domestic farmers. Import duty (10%) on Tur helped domestic market to move up from Rs 4200 to Rs 4350/4400 per qtl. in last three -four days. Besides, extension on agri fumigation policy for another three months till June -2017 has ensured exporting countries to continue export and find out the option for the same till June-2017. Govt has not brought other pulses in import net.
- **India relaxed the fumigation regulation for import of agriculture commodities** for another three months to June -2017. Circulation regarding this has been issued yesterday. Govt has decided that all imported agriculture commodities whose date of bill of lading in the country of export is 30<sup>th</sup> June -2017 or before.
- **Despite expectation of import duty on major pulses. Govt. finally imposed 10 % duty only on Tur** from immediate effect. It would help Tur price to recover from current level. Besides, govt. has decided to continue procurement of Tur beyond 15<sup>th</sup> April. Now procurement would continue till 30 April-2017
- **Lentils production this year is expected to increase by 14 to 15 % to around 12 lakh tonne** this year. Higher area coverage (16.50 lakh ha) supported by good weather condition so far, have increased prospects for bigger crop size. Crop condition is very good so far.

**Pulses International Fundamental:**

- **Canada has revised its average price estimates for pulses for crop year 2016-17.** Canadian Govt agency has revised average price for Chickpeas, Peas and Lentils upto C\$ 910-930 per T, 290-310 & 610-615 per T. This shows strong demand in Canadian market continues. In Jan average prices estimate for the year were C\$900-930 for Chana, C\$280-310 for peas and C\$605 -635 for Lentils.
- **During 2016-17 crop year Canada is expected to produce 48.36 lakh tone peas, 32.48 lakh T Lentils and 82,000 T Chana.** Against this in 2017-18 production of chickpeas, peas and Lentils is likely to increase to 1.45, 42.50 and 35 lakh tonne. Peas production would decrease due to lower prevailing price and weekend demand from India. If demand continues average price estimate may be revised further up.
- **Australian Chickpeas farmers are expected to cover higher area under this crop in 2017** due to conducive weather and strong demand from India. Chickpeas prices in Australia jumped around \$125 to \$135 per tonne to \$915 in last one month. Demand for Chickpeas continues from India, Pakistan and B, desh. Exporters are trying to meet Indian growing demand. India has brought around 1MMT Chickpeas from last year crop. As per ABS export data India imported 9.5 lakh tonne Chana from October to february-2017. Pakistan and B, desh have brought 325000 and 60,000 tonne Chickpeas in same period. Ample rainfalls in March-2017 have provided the ideal start for another huge planting of chickpeas. Farmers in Queensland had planted 4.74 lakh ha last year. Higher price would encourage farmers to increase 20 to 25 % area under Chickpeas.
- **Peas & Lentils exporters from Canada are worried a lot over crop fumigation policy in India.** Canada is currently enjoying exemption and exporters are allowed to fumigate pulses at destined port with methyl bromide, an insect-killing gas. Now it will expire on 31st March-2017. However, importers in India seems to have assurance from concerned minister for extension for three month upto June-2017. Actually govt has agreed to extend it for next three months to allow exporter/importers to find a substitute for it. Notification regarding this is awaited.
- **According to the Ukrainian Ag Ministry forecast Peas area coverage in Ukraine would increase by 15.5 % to 2.76 Lakh ha in 2017 from 2.39 lakh ha in 2016.** farmers have decided to increase the proportion of crop rotation. Farmers had planted 31 % higher area from govt estimate of 1.82 lakh ha in 2016. Planting pace is higher by 32 % this year so far. Farmers in Odesa, Mykolaiv, Kherson, Zaporizhia regions too have palnted 5 to 10 % higher area so far. This year total planted area may hit 7 yearshigh.
- **Canada exported 87900 tonnes of peas and only 100 tonnes of lentil in the week ending 12th March'17.** The total pea and lentil exports are about 2.36 MMT and 607200 tonnes till date. Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada has forecasted that pea and lentil ending stocks are likely to increase to 1.1 MMT and 925000 tonnes in 2017/18.
- **As per latest update By Canadian Market experts Chickpeas production in Canada in MY 2017-18 may increase from 82,000 MT to 1.45 lakh tonne in 2017-18.** Area coverage under Chickpeas too is likely to increase from 68,000 ha to 75,000 ha. This season Canada may end up with 1.15 lakh tonne export while export volume for 2017-18 has been trimmed to 90,000 MT. Domestic use may increase to 63,000 MT in coming MY. In the first week of March around 2000 MT export has been reported, lower 1600 MT from corresponding time. Chickpeas traded mixed in local market as Kabuli types get firmer. Desi type traded weak due to weak demand from India. However, Australian Chickpeas export for India remains strong. Australia has shipped 3.03 lakh tonne Chickpeas so far. Out of this 90 % shipped to Indian subcontinent.
- **Canada Agriculture & Agro Foods has estimated 42.5 lakh tonne peas production for 2017-18,** lower by around 6 lakh to 48.36 lakh tonne in 2016-17. However, production estimates for Chana and Lentils has been revised up to 14.50 lakh tonne and 35 lakh tonne respectively. In 2016-17 Canada has produced 32.48 lakh tonne Lentils
- **Matar production in Canada has been estimated at 48.35 lakh tonne for 2016-17.** It had produced 32.01 lakh tonne in 2015-16. the season started with 1.76 lakh tonne as opening stock while it was 6.84 lakh tone in 2015-16. Import too have increased from 16 to 29 thousand tonne in 2016-17. Thus total supply has been pegged at 50.40 lakh tonne against 39.01 lakh tonne last year. Total demand for this year has been pegged at 41.60 lakh tonne against 37.24 lakh tonne last year. The season may end with 8.8 lakh tonne peas that hints ample supply to continue throughout the year. Prices are ruling at \$260 to 290 per tonne, depending on quality.
