

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- **Maharashtra Agriculture Department has released its 3rd Adv estimate for 2016-17.** According to latest update Maharashtra has produced 20.35 lakh tonne Tur, 17.77 lakh tonne Chana, 3 lakh tonne Moong and 2.5 lakh tonne Urad. It had produced 4.4 lakh tonne Tur, 7.76 lakh tonne Chana, 69,300 tonne Moong and 61,200 tonne Urad last year. Agriculture department has increased Tur production estimate from 11.71 lakh T (2nd Adv estimate) to 20.35 lakh t in third adv. estimate.
- **Production estimate of Chana in the MP has been pegged at 43.37 lakh tonne** against 33.64 lakh tonne last year in the 3rd adv. estimate. Lentils production has been pegged at 6.66 lakh tonne against 6.15 lakh tonne last year. Tur production pegged 64 % higher than last year to 10.45 lakh tonne. Urad production has been increased from 5.15 lakh to 10.75 lakh tonne. Moong production has been increased from 70,000 t to 1.4 lakh tonne.
- **Pulses import in last MY(2016-17) was recorded at 57 lakh tonne. It is lower by only 1 lakh tonne** imported during 2015-16. Peas import increased unexpectedly last year to 29,30,987 tonne. Chana import registered at 8,81,372 tonne from April 2016 to March-2017. Masur, Tur and Urad import too increased to 5,97,449, 4,47,876 and 2,79,923 tonne respectively. The rest quantity was for Moong, Hari Matar and green Lentils. As availability is higher, import flow is bound to decrease in coming months.
- **Sudan Origin Chickpeas CnF Quote At Nhava Sheva port was reported at \$1130 per T.** Ethiopian origin kabuli Chickpeas CnF Nhava Sheva port was quoted at \$1280 per T. Ukraine is offering yellow peas at \$345 CnF at Nhava Sheva port for May shipment. Australian Chickpeas Oct/Nov shipment is being offered at \$845 per tonne. Australian Green moong beans May shipment is being offered at \$1000 per tonne. Australian Red whole Lentils May shipment is being offered at \$655 per T June delivery. Australian pure Chana dal is being offered at \$1280 per tonne July-Aug delivery. Broken red Lentils from Turkey is being offered at \$560 per T at Nhava Sheva port.
- **Rajasthan Govt. published its third Advance estimate for pulses in the third week of April.** It has estimated 13.82 lakh tonne Chana production for 2016-17 crop year. Yield has been estimated at 930 KG per ha. Lentils production has been estimated at 57,856 tonne. Tur production has been estimated at 19,426 tonne. Urad production has been at 3,05,460 T. Moth production has been estimated at 4.34 lakh tonne. Good yield encouraged Rajasthan govt. to increase production estimate.
- **India imported around 296 containers of pulses at Krishnapatnam and Chennai port** during 28th March to 03rd April-2017 compared to 345 during 22nd to 27th March at the same ports. Of the total 296 containers share of Black mape was recorded at 158 containers. The second and third largest quantities were chickpeas and Toor Whole (44 & 36 containers). The rest were other pulses like Green Moong, yellow peas, lentils etc.
- **Pulses quotes in forward deals continued to increase and it hints domestic market to trade steady to firm** in the near to medium term. Ukraine yellow peas May shipment CnF quote was heard at \$345 for Tuticorin/Nhava Sheva. It was \$ 355 for Kolkata. Broken Red Lentils of Canadian origin was quoted at \$555 for Nhava Sheva in 25kg PP bags.
- **Indian govt. recent decisions regarding pulses are likely to benefit exporting countries** as well as domestic farmers. Import duty (10%) on Tur helped domestic market to move up from Rs 4200 to Rs 4350/4400 per qtl. in last three -four days. Besides, extension on agri fumigation policy for another three months till June -2017 has ensured exporting countries to continue export and find out the option for the same till June-2017. Govt has not brought other pulses in import net.
- **India relaxed the fumigation regulation for import of agriculture commodities** for another three months to June -2017. Circulation regarding this has been issued yesterday. Govt has decided that all imported agriculture commodities whose date of bill of lading in the country of export is 30th June -2017 or before.
- **Despite expectation of import duty on major pulses. Govt. finally imposed 10 % duty only on Tur** from immediate effect. It would help Tur price to recover from current level. Besides, govt. has decided to continue procurement of Tur beyond 15th April. Now procurement would continue till 30 April-2017.
- **Lentils production this year is expected to increase by 14 to 15 % to around 12 lakh tonne** this year. Higher area coverage (16.50 lakh ha) supported by good weather condition so far, have increased prospects for bigger crop size. Crop condition is very good so far.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- **Experts differ on Canadian pulses acreage for the crop year 2017-18.** Notably, Canada had produced record Peas and Lentils last year on the back of record area coverage. Survey based estimates of statistics Canada see Lentils area may vary from 3.9 to 6.1 million acres against 5.9 million acres covered last year. In case of Peas area estimate varies from 3.6 to 4.8 million acres against last year coverage of 4.2 Million acres. The main reason behind a wide gap in acreage estimate is mainly attributed to uncertainty over Indian demand and quality issues seen in Canadian crop last year. These factors go in favour of lower acreage. However, good return per acre and low inputs cost go in favour of higher area coverage. Govt.'s estimate is yet to come. Lower price factor too may impact final size of the acreage.
- **Peas import from Ukraine to India is bound to increase over 50 % to 6.5 lakh tonne** in 2017-18 as bumper production seems very much on the card. Ukraine produced 7.45 lakh tonne peas last year. Area coverage has increased from 2.39 lakh ha to 2.9 lakh ha and with expected 3.16 tonne per ha yield production may touch 9 lakh tonne this year. It has exported around 3 lakh tonne peas in first eight months of 2016-17. Higher acreage would compensate likely acreage loss in Canada.
- **Driven by strong demand production of pulses in Black Sea region is bound to increase.** Around 18 to 20 % area increase against 2015 coverage in Russian and Ukraine is expected this year. Domestic demand of peas in both countries has been almost constant. However, demand from India, Pakistan and other Asian countries, Europe is continuously increasing. This has promoted farmers of Russia and Ukraine to plant more area under peas in 2017-18. Increasing demand of peas world over and higher planting intensity would enable Black Sea Region as top suppliers of peas next season, replacing Canada at second position. Russian and Ukraine origin peas are comparatively cheaper from Canada.
- **Turkey has abolished 19.3 % import duty on Chickpeas with immediate effect and it** would continue till 1st of July-2017 for taming the inflation. Turkey produces 4 to 5 lakh tonne Chickpeas per year against consumption of 5 to 5.5 lakh tonne annually. It exports small quantity around 15/20 thousand tonne too. Lower production, weak local currency and higher prices in global market encouraged local chickpeas price by 100 % in a year.
- **Canada has revised its average price estimates for pulses for crop year 2016-17.** Canadian Govt agency has revised average price for Chickpeas, Peas and Lentils upto C\$ 910-930 per T, 290-310 & 610-615 per T. This shows strong demand in Canadian market continues. In Jan average prices estimate for the year were C\$900-930 for Chana, C\$280-310 for peas and C\$605 -635 for Lentils.
- **During 2016-17 crop year Canada is expected to produce 48.36 lakh tonne peas, 32.48 lakh T Lentils and 82,000 T Chana.** Against this in 2017-18 production of chickpeas, peas and Lentils is likely to increase to 1.45, 42.50 and 35 lakh tonne. Peas production would decrease due to lower prevailing price and weak demand from India. If demand continues average price estimate may be revised further up.
- **Australian Chickpeas farmers are expected to cover higher area under this crop in 2017** due to conducive weather and strong demand from India. Chickpeas prices in Australia jumped around \$125 to \$135 per tonne to \$915 in last one month. Demand for Chickpeas continues from India, Pakistan and B, desh. Exporters are trying to meet Indian growing demand. India has brought around 1MMT Chickpeas from last year crop. As per ABS export data India imported 9.5 lakh tonne Chana from October to February-2017. Pakistan and B, desh have brought 325000 and 60,000 tonne Chickpeas in same period. Ample rainfalls in March-2017 have provided the ideal start for another huge planting of chickpeas. Farmers in Queensland had planted 4.74 lakh ha last year. Higher price would encourage farmers to increase 20 to 25 % area under Chickpeas.
- **As per latest update By Canadian Market experts Chickpeas production in Canada** in MY 2017-18 may increase from 82,000 MT to 1.45 lakh tonne in 2017-18. Area coverage under Chickpeas too is likely to increase from 68,000 ha to 75,000 ha. This season Canada may end up with 1.15 lakh tonne export while export volume for 2017-18 has been trimmed to 90,000 MT. Domestic use may increase to 63,000 MT in coming MY. In the first week of March around 2000 MT export has been reported, lower 1600 MT from corresponding time. Chickpeas traded mixed in local market as Kabuli types get firmer. Desi type traded weak due to weak demand from India. However, Australian Chickpeas export for India remains strong. Australia has shipped 3.03 lakh tonne Chickpeas so far. Out of this 90 % shipped to Indian subcontinent.
- **Matar production in Canada has been estimated at 48.35 lakh tonne for 2016-17.** It had produced 32.01 lakh tonne in 2015-16. The season started with 1.76 lakh tonne as opening stock while it was 6.84 lakh tonne in

2015-16.Import too have increased from 16 to 29 thousand tonne in 2016-17.Thus total supply has been pegged at 50.40 lakh tonne against 39.01 lakh tonne last year.Total demand for this year has been pegged at 41.60 lakh tonne against 37.24 lakh tonne last year. The season may end with 8.8 lakh tonne peas that hints ample supply to continue throughout the year.Prices are ruling at \$260 to 290 per tonne, depending on quality.
