

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- The Centre has instructed state govts. to end stock limit on traders without any delay . It will support pulses farmers who are unable to get MSP for the crop. The stock limit on pulses was in practice, when required, prior to 2015. However states were empowered to implement it strictly towards the end of 2015 when dal prices increased to Rs 200/kg to contain hoarding and price rise. India Pulses and Grain Association Chairman Pravin Dongre has welcomed this move and termed it as a right step on right time. The Union Consumer Affairs Ministry has withdrawn powers given to states under the Essential Commodities Act to impose stock limits on pulses traders.
- Govt. has procured 55% more pulses than target. Official says that higher procurement than target was just to save farmers from distress sale in this year of bumper production of 24 MMT. According to FCI official govt had fixed procurement target of 9.50 lakh tonne from kharif season for Tur. Moong and Masur. Against this govt. procured 14.75 lakh tonne pulses. Out of this 11.66 lakh tonne Tur has been procured while 2.20 lakh tonne Moong and 88582 tonne Urad have been procured.
- Ethiopia Kabuli Chickpeas is being offered at \$1230 and Desi Chickpeas at \$960 per tonne.Green Moong bean of same origin is being offered at \$990 per tonne at Nhava Sheva port . Australian Chick peas is being offered at \$940 June and \$950 for July delivery. Ukraine offers yellow peas at \$335 per T CiF Nhava Sheva and \$340 at Kolkata for May delivery. Turkey offers split red Lentils at \$525 CnF at Nhava Sheva for immediate delivery. Canada offers broken red Lentils at \$550 per T CnF Nhava Sheva for May delivery. Tanzania Moong offered at \$690 per tonne, and Mozambique at 640 per tonne.
- Burma offers Lemon Tur at \$560 per tonne on CiF basis. Urad FAQ is being offered at \$780 and SQ at \$950 per tonne, Moong Pedisheva is being offered at \$940 per tonne While Pakakois at \$720 per tonne. CnF quotes in Burma may stay steady in coming weeks. Demand from India may decrease due to higher availability in domestic market.
- Stock limit of Pulses in Maharashtra extended for 4 months to Sept-2017. According to notification stock limit for wholesale traders in municipal councils area would be 1050 tonne. The limit for wholesale traders operating in Municipal Councils would be 750 tonne. Traders can stock450 tonne in smaller municipal councils. Retailers can hold only 60 tonne and 45 tonne operating from bigger and smaller council area.
- India imported around 57 lakh tonne pulses including peas in last financial year. Bumper production
 and higher import flow has affected the price adversely and all pulses except Chana and Urad are ruling
 below MSP. As availability in domestic market is higher (with 22.4 MMT production & 5.7 MMT Import),
 recovery will take time. against 24MMT yearly consumption availability of pulses is 28.1MMT. This means
 import would decrease by 15 to 20 percent this year to negate the impact of additional availability. It may
 come down to 45 /46 lakh tonne this year.
- Import flow continues despite decreasing prices in domestic market. Importers in Mumbai imported 563 containers pulses at Nhava Shewa port on 9th May -2017.Out of total Lentils contribution was registered at 191 containers, followed by Chickpeas- 127 containers. Pegion peas contributed 111 containers, Black Mapte contribution was recorded at 34 containers. The rest were other pulses.
- Govt has increased pulses output in 3rd Adv. Estimate released on 9th May,2017. Total pulses production has been pegged at 22.40 MMT in 2016-17. Before this in 2013-14 India had produced 19.2 MMT pulses. Tur output has been projected at record high of 4.60 million tonnes in 2016-17 crop year as against 2.56 MT last year, while urad output is 2.93 MT compared to 1.95 MT in the said period.
- Ministry has proposed to increased import duty on Tur from 10 % to 20 percent to curb import flow into the country and arrest decreasing prices in domestic markets. Situation remains grim as it is considered as a delayed decision. Almost all pulses prices have declined in last one month and pressure continues. The no. of sellers are more than buyers as availability is higher.
- The season of Tur sowing would start from July and if prices remain at current level, area under Tur is bound to decline by 20 to 25 % this year. Farmers may opt to switch to other crops. Before this 10 % import duty was imposed on Tur/Tur dal on 28th March-2017. Right now price have decreased drastically to Rs 3800/4000 per qtl.



Pulses International Fundamental:

- Laird No-1 Lentils in Western Canada Trades steady in range of 48 to 52 cents per pound. Green Peas hovers in the range of C\$7.65 to C\$8.50 per bushel. According to latest update production of Faba Beans may increase in North Dakota this year as weather is expected to be favorable for the crop. New varieties may be planted in southern region too. Improvement in Lentils price is unlikely as demand has weakened against higher supply side.
- According to Prairie Ag Hotwire Lentils on the Prairies rose half a cent and traded in a range of 23 to 27 cents per pound. Kabuli chickpeas (9mm) dipped two cents in the last few days and are now priced at 64 to 66 cents per pound. Yellow peas lost 10 cents per pound and are now in a range of C\$7.77 to C\$9.60 per bushel. Pressure on price may continue as demand from India decreased.
- **Pea exports from France dropped in March, according to a report on statpub.com**. Export shipments during the month totaled 10,405 tonnes, which compares 40,655 tonnes shipped the previous month. Belgium was the main destination for the shipments.
- Global Chickpeas markets trades firm due to export demand and shipping position for the new crop. Market experts say that tight supply side in Kabuli Chana market may continue as arrival from Mexico crop would not be available in 2017. In Canada delayed sowing has increased the corncern of market participants. There is no report regarding seeding so far. As Canada is not a major player in Kabuli Chana, seeding development would not affect global market much.
- Export of Lentils and Peas from Canada continued to perform well during the last week of April.Canada exported76,200 tonnes peas and 12,300 tonnes Lentils during the review period.With this volume total peas export from Canada till April was recorded at 30.3 lakh tonne.It is almost higher by 10 lakh tonne during the same period last year.In case of Lentils total export was recorded at 700,600 tonne,higher by 1.1 lakh tonne till date.
- Experts differ on Canadian pulses acreage for the crop year 2017-18.Notably,Canada had produced record Peas and Lentils last year on the back od record area coverage. Survey based estimates of statistics Canada see Lentils area may vary from 3.9 to 6.1 million acres against 5.9 million acres covered last year. In case of Peas area estimate varies from3.6 to 4.8 million acres against last year coverage of 4.2 Million acres. The main reason behind a wide gap in acreage estimate is mainly attributed to uncertainty over Indian demand and quality issues seen in Canadian crop last year. These factors go in favour of lower acerage. However, good return per acre and low inputs cost go in favour of higher area coverage. Govt.'s estiamte is yet to come. Lower price factor too may impact final size of the acreage.
- Peas import from Ukraine to India is bound to increase over 50 % to6.5 lakh tonne in 2017-18 as buper production seems very much on the card. Ukraine produced 7.45 lakh tonne peas last year. Area coverage has increased from2.39 lakh ha to 2.9 lakh ha and with expected 3.16 tonne per ha yield production may touch9 lakh tonne this year. It has exported around 3 lakh tonne peas in first eight months of 2016-17. Higher acreage would compensate likely acreage loss in Canada.
- Turkey has abolished 19.3 % import duty on Chikpeas with immediate effect and it would continue till1st of July-2017 for taming the inflation. Turkey produces4 to 5 lakh tonne Chickpeas per year again consumption of 5 to 5.5 lakh tonne annually. It export small quantity around 15/20 thousand tonne too. Lower production, weak local currency and higher prices in global market encouraged local chickpeas price by 100 % in a year.
- Canada has revised its average price estimates for pulses for crop year 2016-17. Canadian Govt agency has revised average price for Chickpeas, Peas and Lentils upto C\$ 910-930 per T,290-310 & 610-615 per T. This shows strong demand in Canadian market continues. In Jan average prices estimate for the year were C\$900-930 for Chana, C\$280-310 for peas and C\$605 -635 for Lentils.
- Australian Chickpeas farmers are expected to cover higher area under this crop in 2017 due to conducive weather and strong demand from India.Chickpeas prices in Australia jumped around \$125 to \$135 per tonne to \$915 in last one month.Demand for Chickpeas continues from India,Pakistan and B,desh.Exporters are trying to meet Indian growing demand.India has brought around 1MMT Chickpeas from last year crop.As per ABS export data India imported 9.5 lakh tonne Chana from October to february-2017.Pakistan and B,desh have brought 325000 and 60,000 tonne Chickpeas in same period.Ample rainfalls in March-2017 have provided the ideal start for another huge planting of chickpeas.Farmers in



Queensland had planted 4.74 lakh ha last year. Higher price would encourage farmers to increase 20 to 25 % area under Chickpeas.

- As per latest update By Canadian Market experts Chickpeas production in Canada in MY 2017-18 may increase from 82,000 MT to 1.45 lakh tonne in 2017-18.Area coverage under Chickpeas too is likely to increase from68,000 ha to 75,000 ha. This season Canada may end up with 1.15 lakh tonne export while export volume for 2017-18 has been trimmed to 90,000 MT.Domestic use may increase to 63,000 MT in coming MY.In the first week of March around 2000 MT export has been reported,lower 1600 MT from corresponding time. Chickpeas traded mixed in local market as Kabuli types get firmer.Desi type traded weak due to weak demand from India.However,Australian Chickpeas export for India remains strong. Australia has shipped3.03 lakh tonne Chickpeas so far. Out of this 90 % shipped to Indian subcontinent.
- Matar production in Canada has been estimated at 48.35 lakh tonne for 2016-17.1t had produced 32.01 lakh tonne in 2015-16.the season started with 1.76 lakh tonne as opening stock while it was 6.84 lakh tone in 2015-16.Import too have increased from 16 to 29 thousand tonne in 2016-17.Thus total supply has been pegged at 50.40 lakh tonne against 39.01 lakh tonne last year.Total demand for this year has been pegged at41.60 lakh tonne against37.24 lakh tonne last year. The season may end with8.8 lakh tonne peas that hints ample supply to continue throughout the year.Prices are ruling at\$260 to 290 per tonne, depending on quality.
