

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- **Govt. hints That production of kharif pulses like Tur and Urad may decline this year** in comparison to last year due to lower price realization by farmers. Agriculture ministry has revised down production estimate for Tur and Urad for 2017-18. It has been revised down to 42.5 lakh T(Tur) and 26 lakh tonne for Urad including rabi(7.5 lakh tonne) too. Total kharif pulses production estimate has been pegged at 87 lakh tonne. Production in 2016-17 was 46 and 29.30 lakh tonne respectively for Tur and Urad..
- **Parle is planing to enter in pulses sector now under business development strategy.**It may start selling Toor, Moong, Urad, Channa and Masoor dals through retail outlets,self service outlets and local retail chains and will cover more than five lakh cities. The decision is under consideration on the back of rollout on July 1 post.It would reduce pulses prices. Parle Products category head expects that pulses category can contribute around 7 to 8 % of its total business in two-three years.
- **Lower offer by Australia put further pressure on Chana price.**Australia offers Desi Chickpeas at \$900 per tonne for June delivery,for July shipment it is \$910 per tonne. New crop shipment for October/Nov is being offered at \$765 per tonne.Dun peas is being offered at \$345 per T. Nugget type whole lentils FD bulk for June delivery is being offered at \$600 per tonne.green Moong variety crytal variety new crop is being offered at \$900 for May/June delivery.
- **Burma offers Lemon Tur at \$565 per tonne on CiF basis.Urad FAQ is being offered** at \$738 and SQ at \$9427per tonne, Moong Pedisheva is being offered at \$910 per tonne While Pakaois at \$705 per tonne. CnF quotes in Burma may stay steady in coming weeks. Demand from India may decrease due to higher availability in domestic market.
- **India imported 452 containers pulses at JNPT port as on 25th May-2017.Out of total major share was of chickpea.** Around 123 containers of chickpea landed at JNPT. Black Mapte contribution was registered at 75 containers. Besides this pigeon pea, Lentils, Red kidney beans and green pea contribution was registered at 102, 82, 32 and 28 containers respectively. There was no import of yellow peas.
- **Nafed continues to buy Chana at market price in Rajasthan, especially in Bikaner,Shri Ganganagar and Hanumangarh region.**Till 21st,may it has procured 30410 tonne Chana. Besides, around 4805 tonne Chana has been purchased from M.P. The rest has been procured from Lalitpur and Jhhasi region of U.P. Total 36013 tonne Chana has been purchased so far. Procurement would continue in coming weeks too.
- **MSP might be revised up for kharif pulses. Tur MSP may be hiked from Rs 5050 to Rs 5450 Inc. Rs 200 bonus.** Moong MSP may be hiked from Rs 5225 to Rs 5575 inc.Rs 200 bonus.Urad MSP may be hiked From Rs 5000 to Rs 5400 per qtl. with a bonus of Rs 200. It remains to be seen whether govt would able to procure next kharif crop at MSP specially when stock are ample and Tur and Moong are available below MSP.
- **New Moong started hitting in MP and from UP it is expected by mid-June. However,** crop area is almost 45/50 percent lower. Pressure on price is due to old stock selling. Stockiest are sellers of old stock. It hampers firmness in Moong market. Demand for dal dhoya and chilka has started improving and supply from Rajasthan has decreased. So any major dip from current level is unlikely. Moong may trade range bound to slightly firm in the near term.
- **Ministry has proposed to increased import duty on Tur from 10 % to 20 percent** to curb import flow into the country and arrest decreasing prices in domestic markets. Situation remains grim as it is considered as a delayed decision. Almost all pulses prices have declined in last one month and pressure continues. The number of sellers is more than buyers as availability is higher.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- **Peas planting in Ontario is getting delayed due to excess rains in key producing belts of this state.** Wet weather is likely to continue and it may further hamper smooth sowing activities. However, prices of peas in local market remain steady. Green peas at Prairies are hovering in the range of C\$7.80 to C\$8.50 per bushel. Demand from India for Canadian pulses has weakened. So firmness in Canadian peas market is unlikely in the short term. Ukraine is offering yellow peas at Kolkata at \$330 per tonne. Australian Dun Peas are offered at \$378 June/July delivery.
- **Pulses season (crop year) in Canada starts in August. Before starting the season.** Canada has revised down lentils production estimate from 31 lakh tonne to 28 lakh tonne now for 2017-18 season. According to the latest update by AAFC Canada has produced 32.48 lakh tonne Lentils in 2016-17. As production was at higher side, its export figure in current MY is expected to touch at 23 lakh tonne. India as usual emerged as major buyer for Canadian Lentils.
- **AAFC (Canada) has revised down peas production estimated from 42.50 to 41.50 lakh tonne for 2017-18.** In last one month production estimate has been revised down by 1.50 lakh tonne for next season crop due to lower prevailing price and weak demand from India and Pakistan. Canada had produced 48.36 lakh tonne peas in 2016-17. Local farmers may opt for other lucrative crops if prices continue to hover at lower level.
- **As per the latest Canadian Grain Commission Report Canada exported** around 59,400 tonne peas in the second Week of May, till 14 May-2017. Total peas export during the crop year to 14 May-2017 was registered at 31.4 lakh tonne, almost 10 lakh tonne higher than previous year till date.
- **Lentils weekly export trend too has been on higher side. It has exported around 21000 tonne** in the second week of May-2017. Thus total Lentils export reached around 7.27 lakh tonne till 14 May-2017. It is almost higher by 1.25 lakh tonne from previous season till mid May. Premium quality large green Lentils are being traded firm in Western Canada, with number 2 Lairds currently topping out at about 48 cents per pound. New crop bids, range from about 31 to 39 cents per pound. Red lentil bids range from about 23 to 27 cents per pound.
- **Global Chickpeas markets trades firm due to export demand and shipping position** for the new crop. Market experts say that tight supply side in Kabuli Chana market may continue as arrival from Mexico crop would not be available in 2017. In Canada delayed sowing has increased the concern of market participants. There is no report regarding seeding so far. As Canada is not a major player in Kabuli Chana, seeding development would not affect global market much.
- **Export of Lentils and Peas from Canada continued to perform well during the last week of April.** Canada exported 76,200 tonnes peas and 12,300 tonnes Lentils during the review period. With this volume total peas export from Canada till April was recorded at 30.3 lakh tonne. It is almost higher by 10 lakh tonne during the same period last year. In case of Lentils total export was recorded at 700,600 tonne, higher by 1.1 lakh tonne till date.
- **Experts differ on Canadian pulses acreage for the crop year 2017-18. Notably, Canada had produced record Peas and Lentils last year on the back of record area coverage.** Survey based estimates of statistics Canada see Lentils area may vary from 3.9 to 6.1 million acres against 5.9 million acres covered last year. In case of Peas area estimate varies from 3.6 to 4.8 million acres against last year coverage of 4.2 Million acres. The main reason behind a wide gap in acreage estimate is mainly attributed to uncertainty over Indian demand and quality issues seen in Canadian crop last year. These factors go in favour of lower acreage. However, good return per acre and low inputs cost go in favour of higher area coverage. Govt.'s estimate is yet to come. Lower price factor too may impact final size of the acreage.
- **Peas import from Ukraine to India is bound to increase over 50 % to 6.5 lakh tonne** in 2017-18 as bumper production seems very much on the card. Ukraine produced 7.45 lakh tonne peas last year. Area coverage has increased from 2.39 lakh ha to 2.9 lakh ha and with expected 3.16 tonne per ha yield production may touch 9 lakh tonne this year. It has exported around 3 lakh tonne peas in first eight months of 2016-17. Higher acreage would compensate likely acreage loss in Canada.
- **Canada has revised its average price estimates for pulses for crop year 2016-17.** Canadian Govt agency has revised average price for Chickpeas, Peas and Lentils upto C\$ 910-930 per T, 290-310 & 610-

615 per T. This shows strong demand in Canadian market continues. In Jan average prices estimate for the year were C\$900-930 for Chana, C\$280-310 for peas and C\$605 -635 for Lentils.

- **As per latest update By Canadian Market experts Chickpeas production in Canada** in MY 2017-18 may increase from 82,000 MT to 1.45 lakh tonne in 2017-18. Area coverage under Chickpeas too is likely to increase from 68,000 ha to 75,000 ha. This season Canada may end up with 1.15 lakh tonne export while export volume for 2017-18 has been trimmed to 90,000 MT. Domestic use may increase to 63,000 MT in coming MY. In the first week of March around 2000 MT export has been reported, lower 1600 MT from corresponding time. Chickpeas traded mixed in local market as Kabuli types get firmer. Desi type traded weak due to weak demand from India. However, Australian Chickpeas export for India remains strong. Australia has shipped 3.03 lakh tonne Chickpeas so far. Out of this 90 % shipped to Indian subcontinent.
- **Matar production in Canada has been estimated at 48.35 lakh tonne for 2016-17.** It had produced 32.01 lakh tonne in 2015-16. The season started with 1.76 lakh tonne as opening stock while it was 6.84 lakh tonne in 2015-16. Import too have increased from 16 to 29 thousand tonne in 2016-17. Thus total supply has been pegged at 50.40 lakh tonne against 39.01 lakh tonne last year. Total demand for this year has been pegged at 41.60 lakh tonne against 37.24 lakh tonne last year. The season may end with 8.8 lakh tonne peas that hints ample supply to continue throughout the year. Prices are ruling at \$260 to 290 per tonne, depending on quality.
