### Pulses Domestic Fundamentals

- India imported around 1415 containers of pulses at Krishnapatnam and Chennai port during 16th -31st May'17 compared to 855 during 03rd-15th May'17 at the same ports. Of the total 1415 containers share of Black mapte was recorded at 784 containers, chick peas at 149 containers, Toor whole at 164 containers and lentils at 130 containers. The rest were other pulses like Green Moong, yellow moong, green peas etc. Share of black mapte, chick pea, toor whole and lentils during 16th -31st May'17 was greater by 345, 26, 21 and 101 containers respectively compared to 03rd-15th May'17.
- **Pulses markets would continue to reel under pressure until demand emerges from** retail and wholesale end. There is a common perception in market that demand for pulses would come by the end of this month. Buyers remain hesitant to buy due weak market sentiments. Forecast for good rainfall in monsoon season may help to attain higher yield. So fear of lower area coverage may be negated by higher yield.
- Australian Chana in Mumbai was quoted up by Rs 150 to Rs 5600 per qtl.lt was quoted Rs 5650 at Mundra port. Australian Chana from new crop was quoted at Rs 5000 per qtl. for Nov/ Dec delivery. Lemon Tur stayed steady at Rs3650 and 3625 per qtl from old and new crop respectively. Urad FAQ was quotedRs4800 and SQ was quoted at Rs 5800 per qtl. Matar Canada was quoted at Rs 2171 in Mumbai and Rs2211 at Mundra port. Masur(Canadian) was quoted at Rs3500 to 3750 depending on quality of the crop. Green Matar at Mumbai was quoted at Rs2700/2800 per qtl. Australian Masur was quoted at Rs 3700/3850 per qtl.
- Australia offers DesiChana at \$900 per Tonne on CnF basis for June to Sept delivery. It offers Chana for Oct/ Nov delivery from new crop at \$760 and Nov/Dec delivery at \$740 per tonne. Buyers and sellers for Russian Chickpeas showed their interests at \$900 and \$925 respectively for ready to deliver stock. As stock is ample and new planting in Australia is on,the forward quotes may adjust with new crop quotes, i.e. in months ahead it will come down.
- Burma offers Lemon Tur at \$539 per tonne on CiF basis.Urad FAQ is being offered at \$738 and SQ at \$918per tonne, MoongPedisheva is being offered at \$885 per tonne While Pakakois at \$695 per tonne. CnF quotes in Burma may stay steady in coming weeks. Demand from India may decrease due to higher availability in domestic market.
- Maharashtra Govt. has lifted stock limit on pulses after intensified protest by local farmers due to lower price realization. However, stock limit on Chana continues as there is short supply of Chana and it is still ruling above MSP. Maharashtra had imposed stock limit on pulses till September 30, 2017. Export option for Tur remains open if prices continues to hover below MSP level.
- Govt. hints that production of kharif pulses like Tur and Urad may decline this year in comparison to last year due to lower price realization by farmers. Agriculture ministry has revised down production estimate for Tur and Urad for 2017-18. It has been revised down to 42.5 lakh T(Tur) and 26 lakh tonne for Urad including rabi(7.5 lakh tonne) too. Total kharif pulses production estimate has been pegged at 87 lakh tonne. Production in 2016-17 was 46 and 29.30 lakh tonne respectively for Tur and Urad.
- **MSP might be revised up for kharifpulses. Tur MSP may be hiked from Rs 5050** to Rs 5450 Inc. Rs 200 bonus. Moong MSP may be hiked from Rs 5225 to Rs 5575 inc.Rs 200 bonus. Urad MSP may be hiked From Rs 5000 to Rs 5400 per qtl. with a bonus of Rs 200. It remains to be seen whether govt would able to procure next kharif crop at MSP specially when stock are ample and Tur and Moong are available below MSP.
- New Moong started hitting in MP and from UP it is expected by mid-June. However, crop area is almost 45/50 percent lower. Pressure on price is due to old stock selling. Stockiest are sellers of old stock. It hampers firmness in Moong market. Demand for dal dhoya and chilka has started improving and supply from Rajasthan has decreased. So any major dip from current level is unlikely. Moong may trade range bound to slightly firm in the near term.

### Pulses International Fundamental:

- Despite dry condition farmers in Australia have positive view over Chickpeas crop. They say that Chickpeas have been planted deep into sub-soils and dryness would not impact it much if it persists further. However, there is a fear and some signs of Ascochyta blight and it may affect crop size. Export demand continues for Chickpeas. Old crop Chickpeas is being traded at \$1030 a tonneand for new crop it is being quotes at \$850 per tonne for Nov/Dec delivery.
- Peas planting in Ontario is getting delayed due to excess rains in key producing belts of this state. Wet weather is likely to continue and it may further hamper smooth sowing activities. However, prices of peas in local market remain steady. Green peas at Prairies are hovering in the range of C\$7.80 to C\$8.50 per bushel. Demand from India for Canadian pulses has weakened. So firmness in Canadian peas market is unlikely in the short term. Ukraine is offering yellow peas at Kolkata at \$330 per tonne. Australian Dun Peas are offered at \$378 June/July delivery.
- Pulses season (crop year) in Canada starts in August. Before starting the season. Canada has revised down lentils production estimate from 31 lakh tonne to 28 lakh tonne now for 2017-18 season. According to the latest update by AAFC Canada has produced 32.48 lakh tonne Lentils in 2016-17. As production was at higher side, it export figure in current MY is expected to touch at 23 lakh tonne. India as usual emerged as major buyer for Canadian Lentils.
- AAFC (Canada) has revised down peas production estimated from 42.50 to 41.50 lakh tonne for 2017-18. In last one month production estimate has been revised down by 1.50 lakh tonne for next season crop due to lower prevailing price and weak demand from India and Pakistan.Canada had produced 48.36 lakh tonne peas in 2016-17. localfarmers may opt for other lucrative crops if prices continue to hover at lower level.
- As per the latest Canadian Grain Commission Report Canada exported around 59,400 tonne peas in the second Week of May,till 14 May-2017.Total peas export during the crop year to 14 may-2017 was registered at31.4 lakh tonne,almost 10 lakh tonne higher than previous year till date.
- Export of Lentils and Peas from Canada continued to perform well during the last week of April.Canada exported76,200tonnes peas and 12,300 tonnes Lentils during the review period.With this volume total peas export from Canada till April was recorded at 30.3 lakh tonne.It is almost higher by 10 lakh tonne during the same period last year.In case of Lentils total export was recorded at 700,600 tonne,higher by 1.1 lakh tonne till date.
- Experts differ on Canadian pulses acreage for the crop year 2017-18.Notably,Canada had produced record Peas and Lentils last year on the back od record area coverage. Survey based estimates of statistics Canada see Lentils area may vary from 3.9 to 6.1 million acres against 5.9 million acres covered last year. In case of Peas area estimate varies from 3.6 to 4.8 million acres against last year coverage of 4.2 Million acres.
- Peas import from Ukraine to India is bound to increase over 50 % to6.5 lakh tonne in 2017-18 as buper production seems very much on the card.Ukraine produced 7.45 lakh tonne peas last year.Area coverage has increased from 2.39 lakh ha to 2.9 lakh ha and with expected 3.16 tonne per ha yield production may touch 9 lakh tonne this year.It has exported around 3 lakh tonne peas in first eight months of 2016-17. Higher acreage would compensate likely acreage loss in Canada.
- As per latest update By Canadian Market experts Chickpeas production in Canada in MY 2017-18 may increase from 82,000 MT to 1.45 lakh tonne in 2017-18. Area coverage under Chickpeas too is likely to increase from 68,000 ha to 75,000 ha.
- Matar production in Canada has been estimated at 48.35 lakh tonne for 2016-17. It had produced 32.01 lakh tonne in 2015-16. It has been started with 1.76 lakh tonne as opening stock while it was 6.84 lakh tone in 2015-16. Import too have increased from 16 to 29 thousand tonne in 2016-17. Thus total supply has been pegged at 50.40 lakh tonne against 39.01 lakh tonne last year. Total demand for this year has been pegged at41.60 lakh tonne against37.24 lakh tonne last year. The season may end with8.8 lakh tonne peas that hints ample supply to continue throughout the year. Prices are ruling at\$260 to 290 per tonne, depending on quality.
