Pulses Domestic Fundamentals

- Major pulses markets remained closed due to protest over GST issues. Trading volumes were seen lower in other markets. Buyers remained sidelined. Actually trades communities are confused over rules and regulations regarding GST. The major trading activities are on hold. Mostly traders have incurred heavy loss in declining markets and have no directional clue for price trend. Money crunch also hampers trading activities. Market remains still under bearish phase.
- Indian importers imported 1336 containers of pulses at JNPT port on13th June-2017. With 439 containers Chickpeas contributed the highest quantity, followed by Lentils(308 containers), Pigeon peas 215 containers, Black Mapte 95 containers, Green Moong 79 containers, Green peas 47 containers, Yellow peas 29 containers and Moth bean 25 containers. The rest were other pulses. As import flow continues, prices of dalhan in domestic market remain under pressure. Confusion over GST too have restricted buying activities in the market.
- Australia offers Desi Chana at \$920 per Tonne on CnF basis for June delivery. It offers Chana for Oct/ Nov delivery from new crop at \$745 and Nov/Dec delivery at \$750 per tonne. Canadian broken lentils are being offered at \$530 at Nhava Shewa port. Mayanmar is offering Back Mapte FAQ at \$714 and SQ at \$888 per tonne for June delivery. Lemon Tur is being offered at \$549 per tonne. Australian red Lentils is being offered at \$610 per tonne.
- Total kharif pulses sowing till 9th June -2017 was registered at 1.64 lakh ha against 1.20 lakh ha last year. Normal area for whole kharif pulses season is 107.59 lakh ha. Normal area under kahrif Tur, Urad and Moong is 40.05,24.39 and 23.59 lakh ha. respectively. Till 9th June Indian farmers have planted 0.10,0.39 and 0.35 lakh ha as against 0.08,0.36 and 0.30 lakh ha last year at this point of time. As there is a good possibility of rains this year, sowing pace would increase in coming weeks with good moisture level in field.
- India imported around 1415 containers of pulses at Krishnapatnam and Chennai port during 16th -31st May'17 compared to 855 during 03rd-15th May'17 at the same ports. Of the total 1415 containers share of Black mapte was recorded at 784 containers, chick peas at 149 containers, Toor whole at 164 containers and lentils at 130 containers. The rest were other pulses like Green Moong, yellow moong, green peas etc.
- Australian Chana in Mumbai was quoted up by Rs 150 to Rs 5600 per qtl.lt was quoted Rs 5650 at Mundra port.Australian Chana from new crop was quoted at Rs 5000 per qtl. for Nov/ Dec delivery.Lemon Tur stayed steady at Rs3650 and 3625 per qtl from old and new crop respectively.Urad FAQ was quotedRs4800 and SQ was quoted at Rs 5800 per qtl. Matar Canada was quoted at Rs 2171 in Mumbai and Rs2211 at Mundra port.Masur(Canadian) was quoted at Rs3500 to 3750 depending on quality of the crop. Green Matar at Mumbai was quoted at Rs2700/2800 per qtl.Australian Masur was quoted at Rs 3700/3850 per qtl.
- Burma offers Lemon Tur at \$539 per tonne on CiF basis.Urad FAQ is being offered at \$738 and SQ at \$918per tonne, MoongPedisheva is being offered at \$885 per tonne While Pakakois at \$695 per tonne. CnF quotes in Burma may stay steady in coming weeks. Demand from India may decrease due to higher availability in domestic market.
- Govt. hints that production of kharif pulses like Tur and Urad may decline this year in comparison to last year due to lower price realization by farmers. Agriculture ministry has revised down production estimate for Tur and Urad for 2017-18. It has been revised down to 42.5 lakh T(Tur) and 26 lakh tonne for Urad including rabi(7.5 lakh tonne) too. Total kharif pulses production estimate has been pegged at 87 lakh tonne. Production in 2016-17 was 46 and 29.30 lakh tonne respectively for Tur and Urad.
- **MSP might be revised up for kharifpulses. Tur MSP may be hiked from Rs 5050** to Rs 5450 Inc. Rs 200 bonus. Moong MSP may be hiked from Rs 5225 to Rs 5575 inc.Rs 200 bonus.Urad MSP may be hiked From Rs 5000 to Rs 5400 per qtl. with a bonus of Rs 200. It remains to be seen whether govt would able to procure next kharif crop at MSP specially when stock are ample and Tur and Moong are available below MSP.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- Despite lower price for lentils in global market and fear of area decline in Canada, the main producer and exporter, area coverage under lentils is bound to increase. The latest USDA update hints 1,055,000 acres could be planted in 2017 against 933,000 acres last year. It might be higher by 13.05 percent. In Canada Laird -3 lentils price has decreased to 24 to 30 cents per pound due to higher stock and decreasing demand from India.
- Chickpeas area in Australia has been forecast up by 2.99 % from previous year to 1101 thousand ha for 2017-18 crop. It was 1069 thousand ha last year. However, production estimate has been decreased by 23.62 % to 14.16 lakh tonne against 18.54 lakh tonne last year. The main reason behind lower production forecast is mainly attributed to bad weather for planting. Australia had achieved highest yield last year due to favorable weather condition throughout the season.
- Lentils area in Australia is expected to increase by 26 % To 385 Thousand Ha in 2017-18. However, production size has been revised down to 5.30 lakh tonne. Australia had produced 830 lakh tonne Lentils last year. Bad weather is bound to affect lentils yield in Australia in 2017-18. Weather condition is still alarming and reduction in yield seems very much in sight.
- Field Peas Area In Australia has been forecast down by 4.85 % to 219 thousand Ha for 2017-18 crop due to lower price realisation and bad weather condition in producing states. Peas production estimate has been reduced from 415 to 257 thousand T. Australia had realized better yield due to congenial weather throughout the season. Canada's dominance in peas export at cheaper price and ample availability in India have affected global price of peas. So bad weather and weak demand/price encouraged farmers to lower peas area.
- Pulses season (crop year) in Canada starts in August. Before starting the season. Canada has revised down lentils production estimate from 31 lakh tonne to 28 lakh tonne now for 2017-18 season. According to the latest update by AAFC Canada has produced 32.48 lakh tonne Lentils in 2016-17. As production was at higher side, it export figure in current MY is expected to touch at 23 lakh tonne. India as usual emerged as major buyer for Canadian Lentils.
- AAFC (Canada) has revised down peas production estimated from 42.50 to 41.50 lakh tonne for 2017-18. In last one month production estimate has been revised down by 1.50 lakh tonne for next season crop due to lower prevailing price and weak demand from India and Pakistan.Canada had produced 48.36 lakh tonne peas in 2016-17. localfarmers may opt for other lucrative crops if prices continue to hover at lower level.
- Export of Lentils and Peas from Canada continued to perform well during the last week of April.Canada exported76,200tonnes peas and 12,300 tonnes Lentils during the review period.With this volume total peas export from Canada till April was recorded at 30.3 lakh tonne.It is almost higher by 10 lakh tonne during the same period last year.In case of Lentils total export was recorded at 700,600 tonne,higher by 1.1 lakh tonne till date.
- Experts differ on Canadian pulses acreage for the crop year 2017-18.Notably,Canada had produced record Peas and Lentils last year on the back od record area coverage. Survey based estimates of statistics Canada see Lentils area may vary from 3.9 to 6.1 million acres against 5.9 million acres covered last year. In case of Peas area estimate varies from 3.6 to 4.8 million acres against last year coverage of 4.2 Million acres.
- Peas import from Ukraine to India is bound to increase over 50 % to6.5 lakh tonne in 2017-18 as buper production seems very much on the card.Ukraine produced 7.45 lakh tonne peas last year.Area coverage has increased from 2.39 lakh ha to 2.9 lakh ha and with expected 3.16 tonne per ha yield production may touch 9 lakh tonne this year.It has exported around 3 lakh tonne peas in first eight months of 2016-17. Higher acreage would compensate likely acreage loss in Canada.
- As per latest update By Canadian Market experts Chickpeas production in Canada in MY 2017-18 may increase from 82,000 MT to 1.45 lakh tonne in 2017-18. Area coverage under Chickpeas too is likely to increase from 68,000 ha to 75,000 ha.
- Matar production in Canada has been estimated at 48.35 lakh tonne for 2016-17. It had produced 32.01 lakh tonne in 2015-16. the season started with 1.76 lakh tonne as opening stock while it was 6.84 lakh tone in 2015-16. Import too have increased from 16 to 29 thousand tonne in 2016-17. Thus total supply has been



pegged at 50.40 lakh tonne against 39.01 lakh tonne last year. Total demand for this year has been pegged at41.60 lakh tonne against37.24 lakh tonne last year. The season may end with8.8 lakh tonne peas that hints ample supply to continue throughout the year. Prices are ruling at\$260 to 290 per tonne, depending on quality.
