

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- **Burma is offering Lemon Tur at \$320 per tonne at Indian port.** In INR term it comes to Rs 20,800 per tonne. Urad FAQ from sam origing is being offered at \$425 (Rs 27625/tonne) and SQ at \$540 per tonne (Rs 35100). Moong Pediseva is being offered at \$1200 per tonne while Pakako is being offered at \$780 per tonne (Rs 50700). Australia is offering Chickpeas (New crop) at \$795 per tonne on FoB basis for Nov/Dec delivery. Australia Kabuli chickpeas is being offered at \$1185 per tonne for Dec/Jan delivery. Australian Red whole Lentils (Nipper/Nugget type) is being offered at \$540/tonne for Nov delivery on foB basis. Nugget type Dec delivery is being offered at \$525 /tonne. Canadian broken Red Lentils are being offered at \$500 per tonne on CnF basis at Nhava Sheva for Nov delivery.
- **As import demand from India has decreased considerably due to continuous** decrease in price, forward quotes are unlikely to improve much till Nov/Dec. Stockists may resort strategy to sell when prices improve. It would not allow market to move one way up. Demand is not up to the mark. Procurement agencies are active in limited area while arrivals of Moong and Urad are increasing continuously.
- **Govt. has over 10 lakh tonne Tur in its stock and it will continue to sell** through auction. So uptrend is unlikely. Market participants can expect only improvement in Tur market. Market is waiting for new export policy. Steady to slightly firm trend is expected in the market as demand may come at this lower level.
- **Chana market continued to extend its loss due to selling pressure in futures** and lower forward quotes for Australian Chana. Australia is quoting \$785 per tonne for Oct/Nov shipment (Jimbour Type) and \$780 for Dec/Jan shipment on FoB basis. As stock is available in the domestic market, supply is expected to be sufficient to cover domestic demand. Sellers remain active.
- **Pressure on Lentils market continued due to weak demand and selling by** importers to release accumulated stock. In Mumbai Canadian Lentils is being offered at Rs 3200 per qtl. More dip from current level is unlikely as seed demand and likely export might support market in coming weeks. Australian whole Lentils is being offered at \$505/10 per T at Nhava Sheva port. South Indian importers imported 13 containers during 23 to 28th Sept.
- **Nafed started procuring Moong & Urad in Maharashtra.** The target has been fixed at 70,000 metric tonne. Notably, govt. has fixed MSP for Moong at Rs 5575 and for Urad at Rs 5400 per quintal (including bonus of Rs 200 for each. Procurement in Rajasthan begins in a restricted way, 200 metric tonne per day, likely to increase soon. Procurement agencies in Madhya Pradesh and UP are gearing up for procurement and it will begin from 15th October-2017. It would support market at current level.
- **Kharif pulses sowings are almost over now. Indian farmers have covered** 142.70 lakh ha as on 06.10.2017 against 147.95 lakh ha last year and year's normal of 105.58 lakh ha. Area coverage is 3.55 % lower than last year.
- **UP state govt. has decided to procure Moong and Urad from 15th Oct to 15th Dec-2017.** Beyond this date line farmers would not be able to sell their crops to govt.'s agencies. Tur procurement in UP would start from 15th January-2018. Maharashtra govt. too is gearing up for commencing Moong and Urad Procurement from next week. As prices are ruling lower than MSP, higher procurement is expected this year too.
- **Already over 3 lakh tonne Chana deals have been struck from old and new crop** and its scheduled delivery is due in Oct, Nov & Dec-2017. Mundra port will receive 50,000 tonne imported Chana from Australia by Oct. end. Around 54000 MT in Nov at same port. Besides, one lakh tonne will hit at Mumbai port in Nov. For Dec and Jan delivery almost one lakh tonne is expected on both ports.

- **DES (Directorate of Economics & Statistics, Govt of India) has published 1st adv** estimates of food-grains for 2017-18 on 22.09.2017. It has estimated Tur Production at 3.99 MMT against the set target of 4.25 MMT. It was 4.78 MMT (4th Adv .estimate) for 2016-17. DES has fixed target of Chana production at 9.75 MMT.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- **As per latest update by USDA Peas production in USA would decrease by 45%** to 697,043 tonne. Rough weather condition has impacted yield of all pulses. Besides, hot and dry weather lower area coverage (17%) to 1.15 million acres contributed to lower overall crop size. Average yield has decreased by 703 pounds per acres to 1383 pounds per acre. It would be the lowest yield after 1996. harvesting is almost over now in Montana and North Dakota. Crop faced extreme moisture stress from growth/flowering stage to harvesting stages.
- **Chickpeas production in Australia is expected to decrease by 35.92 % to 11.88 lakh tonne** in 2017-18 from record 18.54 lakh tonne 2016-17. Despite 4.43 % higher area coverage production is bound to decrease drastically due to hot and dry weather condition prevalent in the major growing regions. Chickpeas area increased from 1052 to 1099 thousand ha in 2017-18.
- **Lentils production in Australia too is bound to decline from 8.3 to 4.19 lakh tonne** in 2017-18. It is almost 50 % down from last year. Lentils area was reported higher by 16 % 3.55 lakh ha. Due to rough weather condition Lentils production would decline to 4.19 lakh tonne. Even field peas production is bound to decline by 32.47 % to 2.8 lakh tonne in 2017-18. Australia had produced 4.15 lakh tonne field peas in 2016-17.
- **Production of Chickpeas in Queensland in Australia is likely to be lower by** previous estimate of 0.65 Million tonne as weather is not very congenial to the standing crop. Yield is expected to decline by 38 % from previous year. In 2017-18 area covered under Chickpeas was 5% higher than previous year to 5.6 lakh ha. The other major Chickpeas state is New South Wales where 4.78 lakh ha has been covered and production has been estimated 4.78 lakh tonne. It may be reduced further.
- **As per the latest report from Canada Grain Commission Canada has loaded** 94,900 MT field peas for export through licensed terminal and primary elevators in the month of August. Export volume is down by 67 % from 2.92 lakh tonne shipped during same period last year. Demand from India has decreased due to higher availability in domestic market.
- **Canada dry pea area is expected to decline by 3.44 % to 16.56 lakh ha in 2017-18.** Yield is expected to decrease by 14.63 % to 2.45 T per ha. Thus total production is expected to decline from 48 lakh tonne to 40 lakh tonne in 2017-18. As production is bound to decline, export volume too is expected to decrease from 38 to 32 lakh tonne in 2017-18. Total supply in Canada is likely to decrease from 50 lakh t to 41.50 lakh Tonne. Price of pea may rule in the range of \$280 to \$310 per T in 2017-18.
- **Lentils area in Canada is Bound to decline from 23.72 to 17.43 lakh ha in 2017-18.** It is lower by 23.54 % from last year. yield is expected to improve from 1.45 to 1.55 t per ha. Total production is expected to decline by 16 % from 32.48 to 27.25 lakh ha. As production would decline, total supply would decline by 10.43 % to 30.35 lakh t. Average price in 2017-18 may rule in the range of C\$720 to 750 per T.
- **Chickpeas production in Canada would decline slightly from 1.10 to 1.05 lakh tonne** in 2017-18. Average price of Chana is expected to decline from \$1000 to \$960-\$980 per T. Prices would decrease due to higher supply side in global market and bumper crop production in India last year. India is a major buyer of Masur from Canada and it imported around 6 lakh toone masur last year. As availability is higher this year in India import would decline.
- **AAFC (Canada) has revised down peas production estimated from 42.50 to 41.50 lakh tonne** for 2017-18. In last one month production estimate has been revised down by 1.50 lakh tonne for next season crop due to lower prevailing price and weak demand from India and Pakistan. Canada had produced 48.36 lakh

tonne peas in 2016-17. Local farmers may opt for other lucrative crops if prices continue to hover at lower level.

- **Peas import from Ukraine to India is bound to increase over 50 % to 6.5 lakh tonne in 2017-18** as bumper production seems very much on the card. Ukraine produced 7.45 lakh tonne peas last year.

Overall Outlook: - Pulses market may trade steady to weak.
