

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- **All pulses markets except chana traded up on Friday. Chana moved up taking** clue from futures and fear of delayed planting in major state like Rajasthan. Area in Rajasthan is lagging behind by 45 % to 3,09 lakh ha against 5.6 lakh ha last year till 1st Nov-2017.
- **Other pulses like Lentils, Black Mapte, Pigeon peas & green gram too are expected** to find some support due to govt.'s positive move to encourage export. Besides, new import –export policy is on the card and it will come within a month. Besides, buyers are expected to return to market to cover their short position at current lower level. State elections too are round the corner and govt too would favor market to move up from current level. So recovery in pulses market to a certain extent seems a visible possibility.
- **As per The govt. has decided to develop a formula to increase /decrease** import duty on Agriculture commodities. A benchmark price would be fixed under this formula. According to market sources, if prices go down below MSP by 20 %, import will be restricted and export would continue. Just opposite to it, if prices go above MSP by 20 %, export will be restricted and import would continue. This formula would be applicable on all those commodities which prices move (in both directions) higher than fixed benchmark price.
- **Decision on pea, that is affecting Chana price negatively, import duty has been** kept on hold. Decision over it is expected in second fortnight..
- **Australia is offering Chana at \$ 740 for Nov, \$735 for Dec & \$730 for Jan delivery** at Nhava Sheva port. Feb del is being offered at \$720 per tonne. Actually there is no impact of lower crop size in Australia. Stockists in Indian markets are releasing stock as inner tone remains weak. Likely higher acreage in India may put further pressure on Chana market. So selling on slight recovery would be good for stake holders.
- **Australian Red whole Lentils (nipper Type) is being offered at \$505 for tone** for Nov delivery. Nugget type is being offered at \$500 per tone for Dec delivery. Stakeholders should wait for recovery in market.
- **Planting started in Uttar Pradesh and MP. However area coverage is lagging behind** considerably in UP as farmers have decided to shift 20 to 25 % area from Lentils to Chana this year. Overall impact of lower area coverage in UP might reduce all India area by 10 to 15 % this year. If area declines in MP too percentage area coverage may decrease further.
- **Tur market too is waiting for recovery. However, excess stock available in central pool** and continuous selling through auctions has capped market. Demand is weak and standing crop condition is said to be good so far. Import is almost halted due to import limit. Market is waiting for buying support from millers. For short term sentiments remain weak. But recovery from current level might be seen in coming months. Tur traded at Rs 3800 to Rs 3850 in Delhi market. Stockists have preferred to retain stock.
- **Some export deals (10000 tonne) have been held for Moong and if export demand continues, moong** would continue to trade at current level. Arrivals have decreased as farmers have started retaining stock due to lower price realization. Burma offers Mung at \$770 per tonne while it is being traded at Rs 4500 to Rs 4700 in Indian market.
- **Urad market has seen some improvement. But there is no buying support** in market. In Mumbai market Urad is being traded at Rs 4200 to Rs 4400 per qtl. SQ in Chennai is being traded at Rs 5200 per qtl. Overall sentiment remains weak.
- **There is a rumour in the market that govt may trim buffer stock size as central pool is** saddled with huge stock (1.8 million tonne) and procurement for rabi is yet to start. As per market sources 'A committee under Ramesh Chand, member, Niti Ayog, has been set up to review the buffer stock limit. There could be a

downward revision to the existing limit of 20 lakh tonnes. Besides, bilateral agreement with Mozambique, signed during July, 2016 might be reviewed.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- **Canada peas market continued to trade steady to slightly weak due to weak** export demand and increasing possibility of limiting import by Indian govt. There is a talk in markets that govt may take decision to curb import and for this duty may be imposed. A meeting of group of minister regarding decision on duty is scheduled on 1st Nov-2017 and market is waiting for decision now. Imposition of duty or attempts to limit import would support domestic market in coming weeks. Pulses market is in extreme pressure.
- **Global pea markets traded almost steady with weak bias likely to continue due** to reduced export demand for new crop. Importers in India may start buying peas once again because of fear that Indian govt. will end the exemption from import duties or impose import quotas for Chana, Red Lentils and peas. It has already placed it for Moong, Tur and Urad. So importers would increase import despite sufficient stock available in domestic market.
- **Chickpeas production in Australia is expected to decrease by 35.92 % to 11.88 lakh tonne** in 2017-18 from record 18.54 lakh tonne 2016-17. Despite 4.43 % higher area coverage production is bound to decrease drastically due to hot and dry weather condition prevalent in the major growing regions. Chickpeas area increased from 1052 to 1099 thousand ha in 2017-18.
- **Lentils production in Australia too is bound to decline from 8.3 to 4.19 lakh tonne** in 2017-18. It is almost 50 % down from last year. Lentils area was reported higher by 16 % 3.55 lakh ha. Due to rough weather condition Lentils production would decline to 4.19 lakh tonne. Even field peas production is bound to decline by 32.47 % to 2.8 lakh tonne in 2017-18. Australia had produced 4.15 lakh tonne field peas in 2016-17.
- **Canadian Chickpeas Agriculture Canada has updated its production estimate for Chickpeas** for marketing year 2017-18. According to new update Chickpeas production in Canada will improve from 58,000 (old estimate) to 81,000 tonne against 82,000 tonne produced last year. Export has been pegged at 85,000 tonne in MY 2017-18 against 1.52 lakh tonne during previous MY. Domestic use has been forecast at 6,000 tonne against 16,000 tonne last year.
- **Dry bean production in US has been estimated sharply up by 23 % to 1.6 million tonne.** Yield has been estimated at 1737 pound per acre. US farmers have planted 2.11 million acres in 2017.
- **Production of Chickpeas in Queensland in Australia is likely to be lower by** previous estimate of 0.65 Million tonne as weather is not very congenial to the standing crop. Yield is expected to decline by 38 % from previous year. In 2017-18 area covered under Chickpeas was 5% higher than previous year to 5.6 lakh ha. The other major Chickpeas state is New South Wales where 4.78 lakh ha has been covered and production has been estimated 4.78 lakh tonne. It may be reduced further.
- **Lentils area in Canada is Bound to decline from 23.72 to 17.43 lakh ha in 2017-18.** It is lower by 23.54 % from last year. Yield is expected to improve from 1.45 to 1.55 t per ha. Total production is expected to decline by 16 % from 32.48 to 27.25 lakh ha. As production would decline, total supply would decline by 10.43 % to 30.35 lakh t. Average price in 2017-18 may rule in the range of C\$720 to 750 per T.
- **AAFC (Canada) has revised down peas production estimated from 42.50 to 41.50 lakh tonne** for 2017-18. In last one month production estimate has been revised down by 1.50 lakh tonne for next season crop due to lower prevailing price and weak demand from India and Pakistan. Canada had produced 48.36 lakh

tonne peas in 2016-17. Local farmers may opt for other lucrative crops if prices continue to hover at lower level.

Overall Outlook: - Pulses market may trade range bound to firm
