

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- **Govt. imposes 50 % import duty on peas from immediate effects. It would help** peas market to increase considerably as duty impact would be around Rs 1000 per qtl. It will also help Chana market to recover to a certain extent. As there is crunch of money in the market, demand for pulses is unlikely to increase, as expected. Agriwatch sees recovery in market. Chana may move up by Rs 200 to 300 per qtl. Delhi Chana may touch Rs5500 in the near term.
- **Importers in Mumbai have imported around 21,400 MT Chana from Australia and** It is expected to hit port on 11th November-2017. This consignment is a part of over 75,000 MT struck deals for Nov/Dec. One more vessel is expected having same quantity by November end. Almost 3 lakh tonne Chana is expected to hit Indian ports in Nov/Dec & Jan. From Mid February domestic crop from MP & Maharashtra would start hitting the market.
- **NAFED procures 77083.35 tonnes of Moong in Telangana, Karnataka, Rajasthan & Maharashtra till 5th Nov -2017.** Despite procurement activities cash market continues to reel under pressure due to higher arrival.
- **Tur crop condition in Maharashtra, Karnataka and MP is said to be below average. Crop** condition in UP is average to good as of now. Harvesting commences in Maharashtra and yield is lower by 10 to 15% from last year. Cash market is expected to trade in the range of Rs 3700 to Rs 3900 per qtl. in the near term.
- **Rabi pulses area is running ahead by 47 percent to 42.01 lakh ha so far.** Chana, Masur, Matar, Kulthi Urad & Lathyrus area coverage is higher by 47.39, 131.19, 21.87, 15.71 & 6.79 % higher so far. Just opposite to it area under Moong is Moong & Lathyrus lagging behind by 19.66 and 40.15 % so far. Overall sowing progress seems normal to good.
- **Area coverage under Chana is lower in states like Rajasthan, Telangana, AP & Odisha by 44.8, 18.2, 13.5 & 45.3 % so far.** However, higher coverage in MP, Maharashtra, Karnataka and Uttar Pradesh by 301, 134.9, 13.1 & 23.2 % respectively has negated the impact of lower coverage area in some particular states. Overall area coverage is bound to increase by 10 to 15 % this year. After slight recovery Chana is bound to decrease once again.
- **New Tur arrives in Sholapur and around 50 bags were traded at Rs 4500/4600 per qtl.** Reports are circulating in mandis that no of grains are 3 to 4 instead of 5 to 6 this year in Sholapur region. Increasing fear of fungus infestation in other region may support Tur this week to a certain extent. Tur market is likely to move up further by Rs 100 to Rs 150 in the near term before new arrivals increase.
- **Mozambique pigeon pea (red) and white were offered at \$190 and \$210 per tonne basis CnF Nhava Sheva.** Australia quoted chickpeas Jimbour type at \$730 FoB for Nov and Dec delivery. Myanmar Lemon Tur is being offered at \$305 per tone basis Kolkatta. Faq & SQ Urad from same origin is being offered at \$410 & \$555 per tone basis Kolkatta.
- **Australia Desi Chickpeas Jimbour type is being offered at \$735 for Nov delivery.** December and January delivery is being offered at \$725 & \$740 per tonne. Australian Red whole Lentil is being offered at \$480 for Nov/dec delivery, for nipper type it is being offered at \$475 per tone. Australian Kaspa peas is being offered at \$350 per tone for December delivery.
- **Some export deals (around 10,000 tone) have been heard for Moong and if export demand continues, moong** would continue to trade at current level. Arrivals have decreased as farmers have started retaining stock due to lower price realization. Burma offers Mung at \$770 per tonne while it is being traded at Rs 4500 to Rs 4700 in Indian market.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- **As per the latest update by Board of Public Association “Community of Pulse Producers and Customers of Ukraine” (SPPBU),** Ukraine is likely to increase pulses area by 30% in 2018. It was 5.02 lakh ha in 2017. Out of this peas area was 4.01 lakh ha. Ukraine has witnessed 2.5 times area increase under pulses in recent three years. Ukraine had produced 8 lakh tonne in 2016 and 13 lakh tonne in 2017. If area increases by 30 % in 2018, production would touch to 15 /16 lakh tonne under normal condition.
- **Global chickpeas market traded almost unchanged during the week under review despite** a tight supply demand side in spot markets. At current market assessment scenario longer term supply side seems good. India and Turkey are trying to increase its pulses production. So demand from India is bound to decline. Carryout stock in India is at comfortable position. The biggest change will be in desi chickpea output. Australia is now harvesting its crop. The last production estimates were released in September, at which time the crop was pegged at a record 1.18 million metric tons (MT) of desi and 58,500 MT of kabuli chickpeas. Now it is assumed that crop size would be lower than 1 MMT.
- **Lentils area in Canada is bound to decline from 23.72 to 17.43 lakh ha in 2017-18.** It is lower by 23.54 % from last year. yield is expected to improve from 1.45 to 1.55 t per ha. Total production is expected to decline by 16 % from 32.48 to 27.25 lakh ha. As production would decline, total supply would decline by 10.43 % to 30.35 lakh t. Average price in 2017-18 may rule in the range of C\$720 to 750 per T.
- **Chickpeas production in Australia is expected to decrease by 35.92 % to 11.88 lakh tonne in 2017-18** from record 18.54 lakh tonne 2016-17. Despite 4.43 % higher area coverage, production is bound to decrease drastically due to hot and dry weather condition prevalent in the major growing regions. Chickpeas area increased from 1052 to 1099 thousand ha in 2017-18.
- **Lentils production in Australia too is bound to decline from 8.3 to 4.19 lakh tonne in 2017-18.** It is almost 50 % down from last year. Lentils area was reported higher by 16 % at 3.55 lakh ha. Due to rough weather condition Lentils production would decline to 4.19 lakh tonne. Even field peas production is bound to decline by 32.47 % to 2.8 lakh tonne in 2017-18. Australia had produced 4.15 lakh tonne field peas in 2016-17.
- **Canadian Chickpeas Agriculture Canada has updated its production estimate for Chickpeas for marketing year 2017-18.** According to new update Chickpeas production in Canada will improve from 58,000 (old estimate) to 81000 tonne against 82000 tonne produced last year. Export has been pegged at 85,000 tonne in MY 2017-18 against 1.52 lakh tonne during previous MY. Domestic use has been forecast at 6,000 to 16,000 tonne against 16,000 tonne last year.
- **AAFC (Canada) has revised down peas production estimated from 42.50 to 41.50 lakh tonne for 2017-18.** In last one month production estimate has been revised down by 1.50 lakh tonne for next season crop due to lower prevailing price and weak demand from India and Pakistan. Canada had produced 48.36 lakh tonne peas in 2016-17. Local farmers may opt for other lucrative crops if prices continue to hover at lower level.
- **Peas import from Ukraine to India is bound to increase over 50 % to 6.5 lakh tonne in 2017-18** as bumper production seems very much on the card. Ukraine produced 7.45 lakh tonne peas last year.

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade range bound in the near term.
