

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- **Government is planning to dispose total 5 lakh tonne pulses from buffer stock in current MY ending March-2018.** It would not be sold in open market. It would be mainly for central welfare schemes like mid-day meal, Anganwadis. Annual requirement for both schemes are around 8 lakh tonne. In central pool stock around 16 lakh tonne pulses is available. Government would sell the rest 8 lakh tonne in next fiscal year.
- **Karnataka Government plans to buy new Tur. Higher price for peas in domestic market** would encourage Tur dal demand in coming weeks. Cash market is likely to move up by Rs 100 to Rs 200 from current level in the weeks ahead.
- **There is a rumor in the market that government would either restrict Chana import or open up export with quantity restriction.** Until decision comes, market may trade volatile. Overall outlook for Chana market seems firm in the short term despite higher area coverage so far.
- **Moong market is expected to trade firm. Arrival in Karnataka has declined.** Selling of Moong in Rajasthan has slowed down on improved demand. It traded up by Rs 100 to Rs 4500/4600 per quintal in Indore mandi. Demand improved in Maharashtra mandi too. Delhi market traded stable at Rs 4400/4700 per quintal.
- **Rabi Rabi pulses sowing area is running ahead by 40.26% to 63.79 lakh ha as on 10th November-2017.** It was 45.48 lakh ha last year till date. Chana area was registered at 47.2 against 32.93 lakh ha. Masur area was registered at 6.82 against 3.91 lakh ha, peas area was recorded at 3.76 against 3.25 lakh ha. Even Urad and Moong area was recorded at 1.11 against 1.06 & 0.24 against 0.22 lakh ha. Other pulses area was recorded at 1.37 against 1 lakh ha. Overall sowing progress is running good. Bumper area coverage is on the card once again.
- **Despite higher stock of Tur with govt. Tur stockists/mills have started retaining** stock of Tur due to govt. policy. Govt. is eager to encourage export and may extend quantity restriction after March-2018 onward too. As govt has imposed 50 % duty on peas and its prices have increased By Rs 400/500 in two days, tur dal might trade Rs 100 to Rs 200 higher from current level. As stock is higher and new arrivals have started, current firmness would remain restricted. Govt. has planned to distribute dals for central welfare schemes too.
- **Moong market is likely to improve from current level as dal miller's enquiry has increased** at current level. New arrival from Bihar, Jharkhand & UP would not start before mid-May While MP crop is expected in the beginning of May. Current arrival from Shekhavti, Merta and Kishangarh line has started declining.
- **Urad may trade stable to slightly weak as there is plenty of stock lying in the market.** In UP supply from Chandausi line continues and new crop is almost ready to be harvested. Besides, Black Masur from Kota line is available at lower price. So pressure on Urad may continue.
- **There is a rumour in the market that govt may ban Chana import or impose duty on it.** If it materializes, it would support Chana market to a certain extent. Otherwise, market would trade stable to weak on the back of higher area coverage and import flow.
- **NAFED procures 77083.35 tonnes of Moong in Telangana, Karnataka, Rajasthan & Maharashtra till 5th Nov -2017.** Despite procurement activities cash market continues to reel under pressure due to higher arrival.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- **Global Lentil markets traded lower during past week on fear of duty imposition by Indian Govt in coming weeks.** Prices in western processing plants decreased by 19% to around U.S. \$295 per metric ton (MT), while grower bids for No 2 Canada large green lentils sank 17% to \$575 MT. Govt is unlikely to raise the import duty on lentils or impose quotas as it did with pigeon peas, mung and black matpe beans.
- **As per the latest update by Board of Public Association “Community of Pulse Producers and Customers of Ukraine” (SPPBU), Ukraine is likely to increase pulses area by 30% in 2018.** It was 5.02 lakh ha in 2017. Out of this peas area was 4.01 lakh ha. Ukraine has witnessed 2.5 times area increase under pulses in recent three years. Ukraine had produces 8 lakh tonne in 2016 and 13 lakh tonne in 2017. If area increases by 30 % in 2018, production would touch to 15 /16 lakh tonne under normal condition.
- **Global chickpeas market traded almost unchanged during the week under review despite a tight supply demand side in spot markets.** At current market assessment scenario longer term supply side seems good. India and Turkey are trying to increase its pulses production. So demand from India is bound to decline. Carryout stock in India is at comfortable position. The biggest change will be in desi chickpea output. Australia is now harvesting its crop. The last production estimates were released in September, at which time the crop was pegged at a record 1.18 million metric tons (MT) of desi and 58,500 MT of kabuli chickpeas. Now it is assumed that crop size would be lower than 1 MMT.
- **Lentils area in Canada is bound to decline from 23.72 to 17.43 lakh ha in 2017-18.** It is lower by 23.54 % from last year. yield is expected to improve from 1.45 to 1.55 t per ha. Total production is expected to decline by 16 % from 32.48 to 27.25 lakh ha. As production would decline, total supply would decline by 10.43 % to 30.35 lakh t. Average price in 2017-18 may rule in the range of C\$720 to 750 per T.
- **Chickpeas production in Australia is expected to decrease by 35.92 % to 11.88 lakh tonne in 2017-18** from record 18.54 lakh tonne 2016-17. Despite 4.43 % higher area coverage, production is bound to decrease drastically due to hot and dry weather condition prevalent in the major growing regions. Chickpeas area increased from 1052 to 1099 thousand ha in 2017-18.
- **Lentils production in Australia too is bound to decline from 8.3 to 4.19 lakh tonne in 2017-18.** It is almost 50 % down from last year. Lentils area was reported higher by 16 % at 3.55 lakh ha. Due to rough weather condition Lentils production would decline to 4.19 lakh tonne. Even field peas production is bound to decline by 32.47 % to 2.8 lakh tonne in 2017-18. Australia had produced 4.15 lakh tonne field peas in 2016-17.
- **Canadian Chickpeas Agriculture Canada has updated its production estimate for Chickpeas for marketing year 2017-18.** According to new update Chickpeas production in Canada will improve from 58,000 (old estimate) to 81000 tonne against 82000 tonne produced last year. Export has been pegged at 85,000 tonne in MY 2017-18 against 1.52 lakh tonne during previous MY. Domestic use has been forecast at 6,000 toone against 16,000 tonne last year.
- **AAFC (Canada) has revised down peas production estimated from 42.50 to 41.50 lakh tonne for 2017-18.** In last one month production estimate has been revised down by 1.50 lakh tonne for next season crop due to lower prevailing price and weak demand from India and Pakistan. Canada had produced 48.36 lakh tonne peas in 2016-17.
- **Peas import from Ukraine to India is bound to increase over 50 % to 6.5 lakh tonne in 2017-18** as bumper production seems very much on the card. Ukraine produced 7.45 lakh tonne peas last year.

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade range bound to slightly firm in the near term.
