

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- No major movement was recorded in pulses cash market on Friday. All pulses traded weak in lack of fundamental support. Buyers are avoiding bulk purchases under weak inner tone. There is a rumor in the market that govt. may give 5% incentive on export. Confirmation is awaited now.
- Chana market traded weak on sellers increased activities. Notification regarding Chana import duty has been delayed. It is still on hold and decision on import duty on lentils too remains undecided. Urad market improved slightly as imported Urad was quoted higher at port. Urad market is expected to trade steady to slightly firm. Carryout is higher so it is unlikely to sustain at higher level in the near term.
- New Tur hits Sholapur market and around 55 bags traded at Rs 4300 per qtl. Old Tur arrival was reported at 800 bags and was traded at Rs 4000 per qtl. Quality of Tur is good and arrival is expected to pick up from mid-December. In Katni, Tur is being traded at Rs 4100/4150 per qtl. Pressure on Tur might be seen with new arrivals. Steady to weak tone may prevail.
- Moong market may trade steady at current level. It is being traded in the range of Rs 4500 to Rs 5000 depending on quality in various market. It is being traded at Rs 4700 in Jaipur market. As arrival remains restricted market may trade steady. Procurement activities may support Moong market to some extent in coming weeks. Tanzania Moong was quoted at Rs 5000 at Mumbai port. Arrivals remain restricted.
- Rajasthan would procure 2.74 lakh tonne Moong in the state and for this Rs 1527 crore has been
 allocated for procurement. It would support Moong price from current level. Arrival pressure is declining in
 major markets. Improvement may continue. Rajasthan government with help of central government would
 procure 60,000 metric tonne Urad in the state. For procurement Rs 324 crore has been allocated to state
 agencies engaged in procurement. It may support market to a certain extent.
- Govt. has decided to reduce import of Tur from 3lakh tonne, as agreed upon two years back from African origin to 1.24 lakh in 2017-18 on G2G basis. It does not include private import restricted to 2 lakh tone. As private import quota is complete, import is not possible till March2018. As new crop started, steady to weak tone may prevail.
- Fresh buying interest and rumor of duty remain supportive to cash Masur market. Stockists too restricted selling. Demand from Nepal too has supported Masur market in Bihar. Imported Masur is being traded at Rs 3700/Rs 3750 while in Delhi market it is being traded at Rs 3800 to 4000 per qtl. prices are likely to stay steady to slightly firm in coming weeks.
- Rabi pulses sowing area is running ahead by 13.96 % to101.43 lakh ha as on 23rd November-2017. Chana area was registered at 72.96 against 62.83 lakh ha. Masur area was registered at 11.73 against 9.72 lakh ha, peas area was recorded at 6.45 against6.39 lakh ha. Even Urad and Moong area was recorded at 1.90 against 2.4 & 0.58 against 0.77 lakh ha. Other pulses area was recorded at 2.56 against 2.33lakh ha. Overall sowing progress is running good. Bumper area coverage is on the card once again.
- Tur including some other pulses import from Mozabique is now on restricted list. Now its restricted quantity will be 1.25 lakh ton for 2017-18.A MoU between both countries has been signed last week(18 Nov-2017).Out of total 1.25 lakh ton around 40,000 has already been imported. The rest 85,000 would be imported further with conditions like requirement of NOC from Mozambique authority and offloading at 5 selected ports like Mumbai Tuticorin, Chennai, Kolkata & Hazira.
- Pulses importers from Mumbai have imported 292 containers of pulses at Nhava Sheva port. M.V
 Northern Prelude having 292 containers is scheduled to arrive on 16th Nov-2017. Out of total 292 containers
 Chana/Chana dal share is 145 containers, followed by Yellow Peas-65 containers, Black Eyebeans-44



containers, Pigeon peas-19 containers and Lentil -14 containers. There is no containers of Moong ,Urad and Moth.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- After import restriction of pulses from Myanmar by India exporters from Myanmar have focused their eyes on other countries like Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, Pakistan and Nepal in recent months. Notably, Indian had restricted import volume quota of black matpe, mung beans and pigeon peas from Myanmar in the 2017-18 fiscal year in August-2018.
- Demand from neighboring countries is increasing now and import volume from these countries has
 doubled so far. Current demand from other markets helped Myanmar pulses market to stand once again.
 Media report says that Myanmar is exporting around 30,000 pulses per month in four countries now. Pigeon
 pea price declined from Rs 28000 to Rs18800 per tone in three months in Myanmar. Moong bean price has
 declined from Rs 29610 to Rs 16200 per tonne.
- Recent rains in Australia have nullified impact of frost on Chickpeas. Notably Australian Chickpeas
 belt was facing frost like condition in early Nov. Recent 80 millimeters rains have given chance of reflowering of Chickpeas. Some improvement in yield is expected now. So Australian Chickpeas production
 may be revised slightly up.
- Imposition of import duty on all peas by50 % has started impacting export volume from Canada According to Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada Peas export would decrease from 3.9 MMT (2016-17 to 2.4 MMT in 2017-18.Lower export volume would increase carryout around 5 lakh ton, higher than normal expectation. Yellow peas price sare hovering in the range of C\$5.00 to C\$6.50 a bushel in western Canada.
- As per the latest update by Board of Public Association "Community of Pulse Producers and Customers of Ukraine" (SPPBU), Ukraine is likely to increase pulses area by 30% in 2018. It was 5.02 lakh ha in 2017. Out of this peas area was 4.01 lakh ha. Ukraine has witnessed 2.5 times area increase under pulses in recent three years. Ukraine had produces 8 lakh tonne in 2016 and 13 lakh tonne in 2017. If area increases by 30 % in 2018, production would touch to 15/16 lakh tonne under normal condition.
- Global chickpeas market traded almost unchanged during the week under review despite a tight supply demand side in spot markets. At current market assessment scenario longer term supply side seems good. India and Turkey are trying to increase its pulses production. So demand from India is bound to decline. Carryout stock in India is at comfortable position. The biggest change will be in desi chickpea output. Australia is now harvesting its crop. The last production estimates were released in September, at which time the crop was pegged at a record 1.18 million metric tons (MT) of desi and 58,500 MT of kabuli chickpeas. Now it is assumed that crop size would be lower than 1 MMT.
- Lentils area in Canada is bound to decline from 23.72 to 17.43 lakh ha in 2017-18. It is lower by 23.54 % from last year.yield is expected to improve from 1.45 to 1.55 t per ha.Total production is expected to decline by 16 % from 32.48 to 27.25 lakh ha.As production would decline,total supply would decline by 10.43 % to 30.35 lakh t.Average price in 2017-18 may rule in the range of C\$720 to 750 per T.
- Chickpeas production in Australia is expected to decrease by 35.92 % to 11.88 lakh tonne in 2017-18 from record 18.54 lakh tonne 2016-17. Despite 4.43 % higher area coverage, production is bound to decrease drastically due to hot and dry weather condition prevalent in the major growing regions. Chickpeas area increased from 1052 to 1099 thousand ha in 2017-18.
- Lentils production in Australia too is bound to decline from 8.3 to 4.19 lakh tonne in 2017-18. It is almost 50 % down from last year. Lentils area was reported higher by 16 % at 3.55 lakh ha. Due to rough weather condition Lentils production would decline to 4.19 lakh tonne. Even field peas production is bound to decline by 32.47 % to 2.8 lakh tonne in 2017-18. Australia had produced 4.15 lakh tonne field peas in 2016-17.
- Canadian Chickpeas Agriculture Canada has updated its production estimate for Chickpeas for marketing year 2017-18. According to new update Chickpeas production in Canada will improve from 58,000(old estimate) to 81000 tonne against 82000 tonne produced last year. Export has been pegged at 85,000 tonne in MY 2017-18 against 1.52 lakh tonne during previous MY. Domestic use has been forecast at6,000 toone against 16,000 tonne last year.



- AAFC (Canada) has revised down peas production estimated from 42.50 to 41.50 lakh tonne for 2017-18. In last one month production estimate has been revised down by 1.50 lakh tonne for next season crop due to lower prevailing price and weak demand from India and Pakistan. Canada had produced 48.36 lakh tonne peas in 2016-17.
- Peas import from Ukraine to India is bound to increase over 50 % to6.5 lakh tonne in 2017-18 as bumper production seems very much on the card. Ukraine produced 7.45 lakh tonne peas last year.

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade range bound to slightly firm in the near term except Chana.
