

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- Pulses market continued to reel under pressure, especially Chana. There is no respite for Chana as production size is expected to cross 10 MMT against 9.1 MMT last year. Old stock is ample and new arrival is due in Karnataka from mid Jan-2018. Chana southward journey would continue and it may trade below Rs 4000 in March & April. Delhi chana is trading at Rs 4700 per qtl.
- Rabi pulses sowing area is running ahead by 7.81 % to 117.83 lakh ha as on 1st Dec-2017. Chana area was registered at 84.37 against 78.26 lakh ha. Masur area was registered at 13.55 against 12.62 lakh ha, peas area was recorded at 7.19 against 7.63 lakh ha. Even Urad and Moong area was recorded at 2.54 against 2.45 & 0.89 against 1.02 lakh ha. Other pulses area was recorded at 3.31 against 2.43 lakh ha. Overall sowing progress is running good. Bumper area coverage is on the card once again.
- New Tur strats in Latur and quality is said to be fair to good. Around 45 bags new Tur arrived in Latur
 mandi on Saturday and was trade at Rs 3950 to 4150 per qtl. In Ahmednagar around 1500 bags new Urad
 was reported and it traded in the range of Rs Rs 3000 to Rs 4200 per qtl. depending on quality of crop.As
 new crop has started and pressure is likely to build up in next 20 days ,prices of both commodities might be
 seen under pressure in coming weeks.
- Higher carryout for Urad (8.77 lakh tone) and good crop size expected to be around 24.97 lakh tone would not allow market to retain its current higher level. Total availability is around 35 lakh tonne against AW projected consumption fig. of 25.5 lakh tone for MY 2017-18.
- Tur market improved slightly during the week under review. Buying support from mills at current level has lent support to Cash market. However, market is unlikely to sustain at higher level due to new arrivals from Maharashtra and good incoming crop from UP. Crop in Karnataka too is in good shape, almost ready to be harvested.
- As new Tur arrivals increase, firmness in prices is unlikely. Allocation of nearly 5 lakh tonne from central pool stock to various central welfare schemes would hamper demand from cash markets. Selling continues through weekly auctions by NAFED &FCI. Even MMTC is trying to sell 1 lakh tonne imported old Tur stock.
- Moong market traded steady to slightly firm getting support from mills demand, decreasing arrivals
 and beginning of procurement activities on MSP in Rajasthan. Moong traded at Rs 4700/4750 in Jaipur
 market. It may move up to Rs 4900/5000 per quintal soon. Rajasthan would procure 2.74 lakh tonne Moong
 in the state and for procurement Rs.1527 crore has been allocated. It would support Moong price from
 current level.
- Current Indian stock of chana from indigenous crop stands at 15 to 17 lakh MT. Coupled with imports, this would be sufficient to cater to demands for the one next two and a half months till about 15 Jan 2018. New crop in Karnataka is expected from mid Jan, followed by Maharashtra in Feb, M.P., Rajasthan in March &U.P. & Bihar in April-2018. By that time Karnataka, MP and Maharashtra crops would start arriving in the market. Crop condition is good so far. Weak sentiment might prevail in coming weeks as supply side is higher than actual demand.
- Govt. has decided to reduce import of Tur from 3lakh tonne, as agreed upon two years back from African origin to 1.24 lakh in 2017-18 on G2G basis. It does not include private import restricted to 2 lakh tone. As private import quota is complete, import is not possible till March2018. As new crop started, steady to weak tone may prevail.
- Fresh buying interest and rumor of duty remain supportive to cash Masur market. Stockists too restricted selling. Demand from Nepal too has supported Masur market in Bihar. Imported Masur is being



traded at Rs 3700/Rs 3750 while in Delhi market it is being traded at Rs 3800 to 4000 per qtl. prices are likely to stay steady to slightly firm in coming weeks.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- After import restriction of pulses from Myanmar by India exporters from Myanmar have focused their eyes on other countries like Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, Pakistan and Nepal in recent months. Notably, Indian had restricted import volume quota of black matpe, mung beans and pigeon peas from Myanmar in the 2017-18 fiscal year in August-2018.
- Demand from neighboring countries is increasing now and import volume from these countries has
 doubled so far. Current demand from other markets helped Myanmar pulses market to stand once again.
 Media report says that Myanmar is exporting around 30,000 pulses per month in four countries now. Pigeon
 pea price declined from Rs 28000 to Rs18800 per tone in three months in Myanmar. Moong bean price has
 declined from Rs 29610 to Rs 16200 per tonne.
- Recent rains in Australia have nullified impact of frost on Chickpeas. Notably Australian Chickpeas
 belt was facing frost like condition in early Nov. Recent 80 millimeters rains have given chance of reflowering of Chickpeas. Some improvement in yield is expected now. So Australian Chickpeas production
 may be revised slightly up.
- Imposition of import duty on all peas by50 % has started impacting export volume from Canada According to Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada Peas export would decrease from 3.9 MMT (2016-17 to 2.4 MMT in 2017-18.Lower export volume would increase carryout around 5 lakh ton, higher than normal expectation. Yellow peas price sare hovering in the range of C\$5.00 to C\$6.50 a bushel in western Canada.
- As per the latest update by Board of Public Association "Community of Pulse Producers and Customers of Ukraine" (SPPBU), Ukraine is likely to increase pulses area by 30% in 2018. It was 5.02 lakh ha in 2017. Out of this peas area was 4.01 lakh ha. Ukraine has witnessed 2.5 times area increase under pulses in recent three years. Ukraine had produces 8 lakh tonne in 2016 and 13 lakh tonne in 2017. If area increases by 30 % in 2018, production would touch to 15/16 lakh tonne under normal condition.
- Global chickpeas market traded almost unchanged during the week under review despite a tight supply demand side in spot markets. At current market assessment scenario longer term supply side seems good. India and Turkey are trying to increase its pulses production. So demand from India is bound to decline. Carryout stock in India is at comfortable position. The biggest change will be in desi chickpea output. Australia is now harvesting its crop. The last production estimates were released in September, at which time the crop was pegged at a record 1.18 million metric tons (MT) of desi and 58,500 MT of kabuli chickpeas. Now it is assumed that crop size would be lower than 1 MMT.
- Lentils area in Canada is bound to decline from 23.72 to 17.43 lakh ha in 2017-18. It is lower by 23.54 % from last year.yield is expected to improve from 1.45 to 1.55 t per ha.Total production is expected to decline by 16 % from 32.48 to 27.25 lakh ha.As production would decline,total supply would decline by 10.43 % to 30.35 lakh t.Average price in 2017-18 may rule in the range of C\$720 to 750 per T.
- Chickpeas production in Australia is expected to decrease by 35.92 % to 11.88 lakh tonne in 2017-18 from record 18.54 lakh tonne 2016-17. Despite 4.43 % higher area coverage, production is bound to decrease drastically due to hot and dry weather condition prevalent in the major growing regions. Chickpeas area increased from 1052 to 1099 thousand ha in 2017-18.
- Lentils production in Australia too is bound to decline from 8.3 to 4.19 lakh tonne in 2017-18. It is almost 50 % down from last year. Lentils area was reported higher by 16 % at 3.55 lakh ha. Due to rough weather condition Lentils production would decline to 4.19 lakh tonne. Even field peas production is bound to decline by 32.47 % to 2.8 lakh tonne in 2017-18. Australia had produced 4.15 lakh tonne field peas in 2016-17.
- Canadian Chickpeas Agriculture Canada has updated its production estimate for Chickpeas for marketing year 2017-18. According to new update Chickpeas production in Canada will improve from 58,000(old estimate) to 81000 tonne against 82000 tonne produced last year. Export has been pegged at



85,000 tonne in MY 2017-18 against 1.52 lakh tonne during previous MY. Domestic use has been forecast at6,000 tonne against 16,000 tonne last year.

- AAFC (Canada) has revised down peas production estimated from 42.50 to 41.50 lakh tonne for 2017-18. In last one month production estimate has been revised down by 1.50 lakh tonne for next season crop due to lower prevailing price and weak demand from India and Pakistan. Canada had produced 48.36 lakh tonne peas in 2016-17.
- Peas import from Ukraine to India is bound to increase over 50 % to6.5 lakh tonne in 2017-18 as bumper production seems very much on the card. Ukraine produced 7.45 lakh tonne peas last year.

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade range bound to slightly firm in the near term except Chana.
