

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- **Rabi pulses sowing area is running ahead by 6.59 % to 127.62 lakh ha as on 08th Dec-2017.** Chana area was registered at 89.58 against 81.25 lakh ha. Masur area was registered at 14.84 against 13.98 lakh ha, peas area was recorded at 7.90 against 8.36 lakh ha. Even Urad and Moong area was recorded at 3.62 against 4.12 and 1.24 against 1.64 lakh ha respectively. Other pulses area was recorded at 3.64 against 3.97 lakh ha. Overall sowing progress is running good.
- **Chana could not sustain at higher level. It traded Rs 100 down to Rs 4600 per qtl.** in Delhi. Pressure of selling is building up as incoming crop is expected to be bumper, over 95 lakh tonne. Old stock is at higher side and import flow continues. Govt is not taking decision on import duty. Under prevailing condition Chana in March -April may trade at Rs 3400-3500 per qtl.
- **Trades groups are building pressure on govt. to impose duty on Chana just ahead** of bumper incoming crop around 95.56 lakh tonne (Agriwatch 1st Adv. Estimate for 2017-18 crop year). Agriwatch has revised preliminary estimate from 92.12 lakh tonne to 95.56 lakh tonne.
- **As per market participants all India stock is said to be around 18 to 20 lakh tonne.** Besides, in next three months 3.5 to 4.0 lakh tonne import is expected out of 6.5 lakh tonne contracted Oct-2017 onward till 1st week of December-2017. This means around 23 to 24 lakh tonne Chana would be available from old stock. Besides, new crop from Karnataka is expected from mid January-2018. So supply side is expected to be at comfortable level and southward move in Chana market may continue.
- **Tur market improves slightly and stay steady to slightly firm on lower crop size in Burma.** As Indian crop size too is lower by around 1 MMT and procurement is about to begin at MSP from mid - Dec, any major fall from current level is unlikely despite new arrivals. Multinational companies are buying Tur In Myanmar. As of now around 2.5 lakh tonne Tur has been purchased and total quantity may go up to 4 lakh tonne. They are buying for import into India whenever, quantity restriction is removed, possibly in second half of the new year
- **Tur Lemon Moved Up By \$35 To \$350 per T In Myanmar in last 5 days.** As crop size is lower than expectation in Myanmar, forward quotes are likely to move up further in Burma. Govt's stock too is coming down. So in the medium to long term price is expected to move towards MSP level. In short term it may trade steady to slightly weak. New Tur in domestic market is being traded at Rs 4000 to Rs 4100 per qtl. in Gulberga.
- **Higher carryout for Urad (8.77 lakh tone) and good crop size expected to be around 24.97 lakh tone** would not allow market to retain its current higher level. Total availability is around 35 lakh tonne against AW projected consumption fig. of 25.5 lakh tone for MY 2017-18.
- **Urad FAQ moved up By \$20 to \$440 per tonne and SQ moved up by \$10 to \$560 per tonne in Myanmar.** However, it traded down in Indian market after slight recovery. With new arrival due from UP, pressure is building up once again. Procurement on MSP may restrict market to have any major fall. Demand is weak and private trade are unwilling to buy bulk quantity due to heavy loss they incurred in recent past months. Steady to weak tone may prevail in the market.
- **Govt. has decided to reduce import of Tur from 3 lakh tonne, as agreed upon two years back from African origin to 1.24 lakh in 2017-18 on G2G basis.** It does not include private import restricted to 2 lakh tone. As private import quota is complete, import is not possible till March 2018. As new crop started, steady to weak tone may prevail.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- **Likely storm and 300 mm rainfall forecast in parts of eastern Victoria may disturb** harvesting activities in Australia. Chickpeas and lentil harvesting are expected to get affected from this storm and heavy rainfall. In US pulses area is increasing rapidly. Over 80 per cent of pulses grown in the United States come from either North Dakota or Montana.
- **Statistic Canada would release pulses production estimate this week. It had earlier predicted** 3.7 to 4.2 million tonne peas production for 2017-18. Market is awaited new estimates. As demand from India has decreased considerably, farmers and trade community is concerned about price and smooth marketing in new year.
- **After import restriction of pulses from Myanmar by India exporters from Myanmar** have focused their eyes on other countries like Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, Pakistan and Nepal in recent months. Notably, Indian had restricted import volume quota of black matpe, mung beans and pigeon peas from Myanmar in the 2017-18 fiscal year in August-2018.
- **Demand from neighboring countries is increasing now and import volume** from these countries has doubled so far. Current demand from other markets helped Myanmar pulses market to stand once again. Media report says that Myanmar is exporting around 30,000 pulses per month in four countries now. Pigeon pea price declined from Rs 28000 to Rs 18800 per tone in three months in Myanmar. Moong bean price has declined from Rs 29610 to Rs 16200 per tonne.
- **Imposition of import duty on all peas by 50 % has started impacting export** volume from Canada. According to Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada Peas export would decrease from 3.9 MMT (2016-17) to 2.4 MMT in 2017-18. Lower export volume would increase carryout around 5 lakh ton, higher than normal expectation. Yellow peas price are hovering in the range of C\$5.00 to C\$6.50 a bushel in western Canada.
- **Lentils area in Canada is bound to decline from 23.72 to 17.43 lakh ha in 2017-18.** It is lower by 23.54 % from last year. Yield is expected to improve from 1.45 to 1.55 t per ha. Total production is expected to decline by 16 % from 32.48 to 27.25 lakh ha. As production would decline, total supply would decline by 10.43 % to 30.35 lakh t. Average price in 2017-18 may rule in the range of C\$720 to 750 per T.
- **Chickpeas production in Australia is expected to decrease by 35.92 % to 11.88 lakh tonne** in 2017-18 from record 18.54 lakh tonne 2016-17. Despite 4.43 % higher area coverage, production is bound to decrease drastically due to hot and dry weather condition prevalent in the major growing regions. Chickpeas area increased from 1052 to 1099 thousand ha in 2017-18.
- **Lentils production in Australia too is bound to decline from 8.3 to 4.19 lakh tonne** in 2017-18. It is almost 50 % down from last year. Lentils area was reported higher by 16 % at 3.55 lakh ha. Due to rough weather condition Lentils production would decline to 4.19 lakh tonne. Even field peas production is bound to decline by 32.47 % to 2.8 lakh tonne in 2017-18. Australia had produced 4.15 lakh tonne field peas in 2016-17.
- **Canadian Chickpeas Agriculture Canada has updated its production estimate for Chickpeas** for marketing year 2017-18. According to new update Chickpeas production in Canada will improve from 58,000 (old estimate) to 81,000 tonne against 82,000 tonne produced last year. Export has been pegged at 85,000 tonne in MY 2017-18 against 1.52 lakh tonne during previous MY. Domestic use has been forecast at 6,000 tonne against 16,000 tonne last year.
- **AAFC (Canada) has revised down peas production estimated from 42.50 to 41.50 lakh tonne** for 2017-18. In last one month production estimate has been revised down by 1.50 lakh tonne for next season crop due to lower prevailing price and weak demand from India and Pakistan. Canada had produced 48.36 lakh tonne peas in 2016-17.
- **Peas import from Ukraine to India is bound to increase over 50 % to 6.5 lakh tonne** in 2017-18 as bumper production seems very much on the card. Ukraine produced 7.45 lakh tonne peas last year.

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade range bound to slightly firm in the near term except Chana, Urad & Tur.
