

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- **Chana extended its loss due to lack of buying support from millers. Millers have** restricted buying by 50 to 60 % under bearish inner tone. Besides, likely bumper crop (over 95 Lakh tonne) and expected arrivals from Karnataka from mid Jan-2018 have impacted Chana market sentiment adversely. Even at import front a vessel carrying 36902 tonne is expected to hit Mundra port on 16 Dec-2017. Other vessel carrying 31,140 tonne Chana is expected to touch Indian port by 21 Jan-2018. Chana trades at Rs 4325-4400 per qtl. in Delhi market. Weak sentiment is likely to prevail.
- **Procurement drive, lower crop size(31.19 lakh tonne) & Agriwatch revised carryout for 2017-18(4.86 lakh tonne),** much lower than 10.67 lakh tonne in 2016-17 crop year may support cash Tur market in the second half of the new year. As new crop started hitting the market, prices are likely to stay steady to slightly weak in the weeks ahead despite buyers increased buying activities. It is trading at Rs 4400 per qtl. in Gulberga. It will trade in the range of Rs4300 to Rs 4500 in the short term.
- **Demand for Moong at higher level is likely to decrease in coming weeks. At current level** Agriwatch expects a downward correction of Rs 100 to Rs 200 per qtl. in the short term. It is being traded at Rs 5100 in Jaipur market. Burma is offering Moong at Rs 4800-4900 against prevailing price of Rs 5000-5100 in domestic market. As crop size (Rabi) in Tamil Nadu is said to be lower, Moong may get support at current level in January-2018 too.
- **NCDEX has imposed 5% Special margin on chana short side on all running contracts** and yet to be launched contracts in Chana with effect from 13 th Dec-2017. It is likely to support. Market participants say it is not sufficient to discourage bears in futures contract.
- **Nafed has procured around 196830.57 lakh tonne moong from kharif 2017 crop at MSP** of Rs 5575 till 1st week of Dec. Procurement period in Karnataka ended on 24th Nov-2017 while it has just completed in Telangana. Rajasthan contributed maximum quantity of 166266.08 tonne, Karnataka contributed 21902.13 tonne, Maharashtra 4163.04, Telangana -3329.25 and AP- 1170.05 tonne so far. Procurement in Rajasthan, Maharashtra and AP is still on.
- **Over all pulses area is running ahead by 6.59 % to 127.62 lakh ha so far.** Chana is up by 10.25% to 89.58 lakh ha. Despite overall higher area coverage Urad area is down by 12.28 % and Moong by 24.25 % to 3.62 and 1.24 lakh ha respectively.
- **Tur Lemon Moved Up By \$35 To \$350 per T In Myanmar in last 5 days.** As crop size is lower than expectation in Myanmar, forward quotes are likely to move up further in Burma. Govt's stock too is coming down. So in the medium to long term price is expected to move towards MSP level. In short term it may trade steady to slightly weak. New Tur in domestic market is being traded at Rs 4000 to Rs 4100 per qtl. in Gulberga.
- **Urad FAQ moved up By \$20 to \$440 per tonne and SQ moved up by \$10** to \$560 per tonne in Myanmar. However, it traded down in Indian market after slight recovery. With new arrival due from UP, pressure is building up once again. Procurement on MSP may restrict market to have any major fall. Demand is weak and private trade are unwilling to buy bulk quantity due to heavy loss they incurred in recent past months. Steady to weak tone may prevail in the market.
- **Govt. has decided to reduce import of Tur from 3lakh tonne, as agreed** upon two years back from African origin to 1.24 lakh in 2017-18 on G2G basis. It does not include private import restricted to 2 lakh tone. As private import quota is complete, import is not possible till March 2018. As new crop started, steady to weak tone may prevail.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- **As per latest US dry pea and lentil council dry pea export from US declined** around 75% lower than last year in Sept-2016. Indian demand has decreased considerably due to bumper crop size. Even China too has brought less quantity of peas. China has brought 2890 MT followed by India 2005MT and Mexico 1740 MT. Export data for pea from US for Oct is awaited.
- **Likely storm and 300 mm rainfall forecast in parts of eastern Victoria may disturb** harvesting activities in Australia. Chickpeas and lentil harvesting are expected to get affected from this storm and heavy rainfall. In US pulses area is increasing rapidly. Over 80 per cent of pulses grown in the United States come from either North Dakota or Montana.
- **Statistic Canada would release pulses production estimate this week. It had earlier predicted** 3.7 to 4.2 million tonne peas production for 2017-18. Market is awaited new estimates. As demand from India has decreased considerably, farmers and trade community is concerned about price and smooth marketing in new year.
- **After import restriction of pulses from Myanmar by India exporters from Myanmar** have focused their eyes on other countries like Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, Pakistan and Nepal in recent months. Notably, Indian had restricted import volume quota of black matpe, mung beans and pigeon peas from Myanmar in the 2017-18 fiscal year in August-2018.
- **Demand from neighboring countries is increasing now and import volume** from these countries has doubled so far. Current demand from other markets helped Myanmar pulses market to stand once again. Media report says that Myanmar is exporting around 30,000 pulses per month in four countries now. Pigeon pea price declined from Rs 28000 to Rs 18800 per tone in three months in Myanmar. Moong bean price has declined from Rs 29610 to Rs 16200 per tonne.
- **Imposition of import duty on all peas by 50 % has started impacting export** volume from Canada According to Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada Peas export would decrease from 3.9 MMT (2016-17 to 2.4 MMT in 2017-18. Lower export volume would increase carryout around 5 lakh ton, higher than normal expectation. Yellow peas price are hovering in the range of C\$5.00 to C\$6.50 a bushel in western Canada.
- **Lentils area in Canada is bound to decline from 23.72 to 17.43 lakh ha in 2017-18.** It is lower by 23.54 % from last year. yield is expected to improve from 1.45 to 1.55 t per ha. Total production is expected to decline by 16 % from 32.48 to 27.25 lakh ha. As production would decline, total supply would decline by 10.43 % to 30.35 lakh t. Average price in 2017-18 may rule in the range of C\$720 to 750 per T.
- **Chickpeas production in Australia is expected to decrease by 35.92 % to 11.88 lakh tonne** in 2017-18 from record 18.54 lakh tonne 2016-17. Despite 4.43 % higher area coverage, production is bound to decrease drastically due to hot and dry weather condition prevalent in the major growing regions. Chickpeas area increased from 1052 to 1099 thousand ha in 2017-18.
- **Lentils production in Australia too is bound to decline from 8.3 to 4.19 lakh tonne** in 2017-18. It is almost 50 % down from last year. Lentils area was reported higher by 16 % at 3.55 lakh ha. Due to rough weather condition Lentils production would decline to 4.19 lakh tonne. Even field peas production is bound to decline by 32.47 % to 2.8 lakh tonne in 2017-18. Australia had produced 4.15 lakh tonne field peas in 2016-17.
- **Canadian Chickpeas Agriculture Canada has updated its production estimate for Chickpeas** for marketing year 2017-18. According to new update Chickpeas production in Canada will improve from 58,000 (old estimate) to 81000 tonne against 82000 tonne produced last year. Export has been pegged at 85,000 tonne in MY 2017-18 against 1.52 lakh tonne during previous MY. Domestic use has been forecast at 6,000 to 16,000 tonne against 16,000 tonne last year.
- **AAFC (Canada) has revised down peas production estimated from 42.50 to 41.50 lakh tonne** for 2017-18. In last one month production estimate has been revised down by 1.50 lakh tonne for next season crop due to lower prevailing price and weak demand from India and Pakistan. Canada had produced 48.36 lakh tonne peas in 2016-17.
- **Peas import from Ukraine to India is bound to increase over 50 % to 6.5 lakh tonne** in 2017-18 as bumper production seems very much on the card. Ukraine produced 7.45 lakh tonne peas last year.

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade range bound to slightly firm in the near term except Chana and Urad.
