Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- For ensuring MSP of Pulses the union govt. has written to all state govts.to start decentralized procurements of commodities including pulses and for which the central govt. will bear the cost. Positive response has been recorded so far.All state govt.s opinion over new mechanism is awaited now. Madhya Pradesh and Haryana are paying differential costs to farmers in case prices fall below the MSP. The Centre had set up a Price Stabilization Fund under the Ministry of Food and Consumer Affairs for maintaining a strategic buffer stock of agriculture commodities.
- Area under pulses rose by 9 per cent to 150.63 lakh hectares in the ongoing rabi (winter-sown) season so far, according to the official data. Area under pulses was 150.63 lakh hectares so far in this rabi season as against 138.34 lakh hectares in the year- ago period. As per preliminary reports received from the states, the total area sown under rabi crops as on December 27, 2017 stands at 565.79 lakh hectares as compared to 571.47 lakh hectare this time in 2016. India produced a record 275.68 million tonnes of foodgrain in the 2016-17 crop year (July-June).
- **Procurement drive, fear of yield loss in Karnataka and Maharashtra (4 & 7** % respectively) and buying support at current level would not allow Tur market to trade lower beyond a certain level despite increasing arrivals in various mandis. New Tur In Maharashtra and Indore is being traded at Rs 4100-4150 and 3900-3950 per qtl. Steady to slightly firm tone may prevail.
- Demand for Moong at higher level got affected from millers end. Arrival is lower. Market participants say that a downward correction by Rs 200 is expected from current level. Fresh demand is expected from mid- January. The short term outlook is weak while medium term outlook remains steady to slightly firm. Moong at Jaipur mandi traded Rs100 down to Rs 5200 per qtl.
- Steady to slightly weak tone prevailed in Urad market due to decreased demand at higher level. Urad in Chennai market traded down by Rs 100 to Rs4350-4450 per qtl. In Mumbai market it is being traded down By Rs 100 to Rs 4200 per qtl. Steady to weak tone may prevail as supply side is higher.
- All India Rabi pulses Area is running ahead by 9.05% to 146.06 lakh ha. From last year so far. Chana area is 13.88 % up to 99.89 lakh ha.,Urad area is up by 2.87 % to 5.77 lakh ha &Moong area is 22.56 % down to 2.31 lakh ha.
- Imposition of 30% import duty on Masur would help cash market to recover at least by 10 to 12 % from current level. Masur market may move up by Rs 300 to Rs 350 per qtl from current level. As new crop is 2 months away, market is expected to recover from Rs 3550 to Rs 3750 in various markets. Import costing would increase and impose flow would be affected in weeks ahead.
- Karnataka govt. had purchased 2.4 lakh tonne Tur last year. This year purchased target has been fixed at 1.65 lakh tonne. State govt. has purposed to give bonus of Rs 500 per qtl. over& above MSP. This means farmers would get Rs 5950 per qtl. for their Tur. Karnataka govt. would procure 20 qtl. from each farmers. It would support market to a certain extent at current level. Tur MSP is Rs 5450 including bonus of Rs 200.It would restrict downward trend despite new arrivals.
- Nafed has procured around 196830.57 lakh tonne moong from kharif 2017 crop at MSP of Rs 5575 till 1st week of Dec. Procurement period in Karnataka ended on 24th N ov-2017 while it has just completed in Telangana. Rajasthan contributed maximum quantity of 166266.08 tonne, Karnataka contributed21902.13 tonne, Maharashtra 4163.04, Telangana -3329.25 and AP- 1170.05 tonne so far. Procurement in Rajasthan, Maharashtra and AP is still on.

Pulses International Fundamental:



- Pressure on Australian lobby on India to allow a transition periodfor newly introduced tariffs on imported pulse sto avoid any disruptions to existing contracts. Notably India has imposed 30 % import duty on Chickpeas and Lentil last week & 50 % duty on peas earlier. Australian Trade Minister Steven Ciobo has asked India for a period of transition for the tariffs on chickpeas and red lentils and was seeking a swift resolution. Analysts estimate that India accounts about half of the shipments. Australia exports \$935 million of two pulses (Chana & Lentil) each year.
- Global lentil markets ended with a mixed tone. Prices of red traded range bound on the week, while the spread between U.S. and Canadian green lentils widened to some extent. There is a concern in global market that India could impose an import duty on the product given the risk that seeded area in India could match or exceed last year. Though the pace of seeding has slowed compared to last year, farmers in that country have sown 1.553 million hectares as of December 15, compared to 1.526 million at this time during the previous rabi season.
- Kabuli chickpea markets finished the week's trading on an uncertain note, with markets for small caliber product destabilized by an increase in the number of Argentine farmers bypassing traditional exporters. Markets for large caliber product were unchanged on the week, with Mexico virtually sold out of product and Indian exporters holding firm on prices for 10mmm and larger caliber kabuli chickpeas.
- As per latest US dry pea and lentil council dry pea export from US declined around 75% lower than last year in Sept-2016.Indian demand has decreased considerably due to bumper crop size. Even China too has brought less quantity of peas.China has brought 2890 MT followed by India 2005MT and Mexico 1740 MT. Export data for pea from US for Oct is awaited.
- Likely storm and 300 mm rainfall forecast in parts of eastern Victoria may disturb harvesting activities in Australia. Chickpeas and lentil harvesting are expected to get affected from this storm and heavy rainfall. In US pulses area is increasing rapidly. Over 80 per cent of pulses grown in the United States come from either North Dakota or Montana.
- Demand from neighboring countries is increasing now and import volume from these countries has doubled so far. Current demand from other markets helped Myanmar pulses market to stand once again.Media report says that Myanmar is exporting around 30,000 pulses per month in four countries now. Pigeon pea price declined from Rs 28000 to Rs18800 per tone in three months in Myanmar.Moong bean price has declined from Rs 29610 to Rs 16200 per tonne.
- Imposition of import duty on all peas by50 % has started impacting export volume from Canada According to Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada Peas export would decrease from 3.9 MMT(2016-17 to 2.4 MMT in 2017-18.Lower export volume would increase carryout around 5 lakh ton, higher than normal expectation. Yellow peas price sare hovering in the range of C\$5.00 to C\$6.50 a bushel in western Canada.
- Lentils area in Canada is bound to decline from 23.72 to 17.43 lakh ha in 2017-18. It is lower by 23.54 % from last year.yield is expected to improve from 1.45 to 1.55 t per ha.Total production is expected to decline by 16 % from 32.48 to 27.25 lakh ha.As production would decline,total supply would decline by 10.43 % to 30.35 lakh t.Average price in 2017-18 may rule in the range of C\$720 to 750 per T.
- Chickpeas production in Australia is expected to decrease by 35.92 % to 11.88 lakhtonne in 2017-18 from record 18.54 lakh tonne 2016-17. Despite 4.43 % higher area coverage, production is bound to decrease drastically due to hot and dry weather condition prevalent in the major growing regions. Chickpeas area increased from 1052 to 1099 thousand ha in 2017-18.
- Lentils production in Australia too is bound to decline from 8.3 to 4.19 lakh tonne in 2017-18. It is almost 50 % down from last year. Lentils area was reported higher by 16 % at 3.55 lakh ha. Due to rough weather condition Lentils production would decline to 4.19 lakh tonne. Even field peas production is bound to decline by 32.47 % to 2.8 lakh tonne in 2017-18. Australia had produced 4.15 lakh tonne field peas in 2016-17.
- AAFC (Canada) has revised down peas production estimated from 42.50 to 41.50 lakh tonne for 2017-18. In last one month production estimate has been revised down by 1.50 lakh tonne for next season crop due to lower prevailing price and weak demand from India and Pakistan. Canada had produced 48.36 lakh tonne peas in 2016-17.



 Peas import from Ukraine to India is bound to increase over 50 % to6.5 lakh tonne in 2017-18 as bumper production seems very much on the card. Ukraine produced 7.45 lakh tonne peas last year.
Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade range bound to slightly weak in the near term.
