

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- No new developments were reported from cash market. Pressure continues as buyers remain sidelined at higher level. Urad, Chana & Masur area is higher and bumper production prospect seems once again on the card. Overall tone remains weak. Urad in Mumbai market traded at Rs 3950/4000.Chana in Delhi market traded at 4250.No trade at current price was reported in Delhi for Chana.
- Moong market traded steady at Rs 5200 in Jaipur market. Buyers are unwilling to buy at higher level. As demand remains affected, downward correction is expected this week.
- With higher arrival Tur market too remains under pressure despite procurement drive and lower crop size. Tur traded at Rs 4000 to Rs 4400 per qtl. in Gulberga market. Overall tone remains weak.
- Chana cash market traded weak at Rs 4250 in Delhi market and is likely to trade under pressure ahead of bumper crop. Around 15 motors arrival in Delhi was reported. Other markets too traded range bound with weak bias likely to continue. Australia offers Chana at \$640/45 per tonne basis Indian port for Jan delivery. No fresh import order was seen this week.
- Rabi pulses sowing area is running ahead by 7.99 % to 154.91 lakh ha as on 05th Jan-2018. Chana area was registered at 103.80 against 92.13 lakh ha. Masur area was registered at 17.04 against 16.56 lakh ha, peas area was recorded at 9.49 against 9.85 lakh ha. Even Urad and Moong area was recorded at 6.93 against 7.29 & 4.20 against 4.15 lakh ha. Other pulses area was recorded at 5.61 against 5.70 lakh ha. Overall sowing progress is running good. Bumper area coverage is on the card once again. See table below:
- Arrival of Tur is about to increase in coming weeks. Pressure on price continues despite procurement drive & lower crop size of crop (around 30 lakh tonne against around 39 lakh tonne last year. It is being traded at Rs 4000 to Rs 4400 per qtl in Gulberga market depending on quality. Burma offers new Tur at \$400 per tonne basis Indian port. Old Tur is being offered at \$360 per tonne.
- Urad market trades range bound. Slack demand from millers end & comfortable supply side remains unsupportive to Urad cash market. It is being offered at Rs 3900/4000 per qtl in Mumbai market while it is being traded at Rs 4350/4400 in Chennai market. Steady to weak tone may prevail. Burma offers FAQ Urad at \$505 per tonne, basis Indian port. SQ is offered at \$625 per tonne.
- Moong market stayed steady at Rs 5200 in Jaipur market. Buyers at higher level remained sidelined. Burma offers Pakako Moong at \$690 per tonne. Govt.'s procurement drive has lent some support to market. However, uptrend is unlikely to continue due to higher retention and old stock.
- In the medium term pressure on chana is likely to continue. New crop size is higher over 95 lakh tonne. Old stock too is at higher side and import flow continues. Under prevailing condition Chana in March April may trade at Rs 3400-3500 per qtl. if govt. does not intervene.
- Demand for Moong at higher level got affected from millers end. Arrival is lower. Market participants say that a downward correction by Rs 200 is expected from current level. Fresh demand is expected from mid- January. The short term outlook is weak while medium term outlook remains steady to slightly firm. Moong at Jaipur mandi traded Rs100 down to Rs 5200 per qtl.
- Steady to slightly weak tone prevailed in Urad market due to decreased demand at higher level. Urad in Chennai market traded down by Rs 100 to Rs4350-4450 per qtl. In Mumbai market it is being traded down By Rs 100 to Rs 4200 per qtl. Steady to weak tone may prevail as supply side is higher.
- Imposition of 30% import duty on Masur would help cash market to recover at least by 10 to 12 % from current level. Masur market may move up by Rs 300 to Rs 350 per qtl from current level. As new crop is 2 months away, market is expected to recover from Rs 3550 to Rs 3750 in various markets. Import costing would increase and impose flow would be affected in weeks ahead.
- Karnataka govt. had purchased 2.4 lakh tonne Tur last year. This year purchased target has been fixed at 1.65 lakh tonne. State govt. has purposed to give bonus of Rs 500 per qtl. over& above MSP. This means farmers would get Rs 5950 per qtl. for their Tur. Karnataka govt. would procure 20 qtl. from each farmers. It would support market to a certain extent at current level. Tur MSP is Rs 5450 including bonus of Rs 200.It would restrict downward trend despite new arrivals.



Pulses International Fundamental:

- Chickpeas production in Australia is expected to decrease by 47.85 % to 10.45 lakhtonne in 2017-18 from record 2004 lakh tonne 2016-17. Despite 4.43 % higher area coverage, production is bound to decrease drastically due to hot and dry weather condition prevalent in the major growing regions. Chickpeas area increased from 1069 to 1144 thousand ha in 2017-18.
- With the beginning of new year & seasonal weak demand as usual remain price affecting factors for peas in the global market. As Indian demand for peas has decreased considerably due to 50 % imposition of import duty, local livestock feed manufacturers in Canada/Australia have increased usage of peas. Pressure on global peas market is likely to continue. Indian govt is not ready to give comforts to exporters on fumigation issue till June-2018. Prices of peas in India has moved up. However, other pulses are ruling weak and there is no short supply of pulses due to two consecutive bumper crop years. New peas crop in India is due in February-2018
- Demand for Canadian yellow peas is set to increase considerably in next few years. China is expanding processing capacity of yellow peas. In many Asian countries plant processing capacities are being increased. One Chinese processing plant capacity is being increased from 4 lakh tonne to 7 lakh tonne annually. It would help Canadian yellow peas export to 30 %.
- **Production of Yellow pea continue to increase in Nebraska. In 2017/18, 70,000** acres of yellow peas were planted in the state, up from 10,000 acres five years ago.
- Weak demand from India has affected Australian pulses industry negatively. desi chickpeas have fallen by AUD\$330 to AUD\$650 a tonne while nugget lentils are down AUD\$225 to AUD\$465 a tonne. Faba beans and lupins have also softened in price. On the Canadian Prairies, Laird #1 lentils are hanging steady in a range of 31 to 36 cents per pound. Kabuli chickpeas (10mm) were also keeping firm at 74 to 75 cents per pound. The crop is prefered by farmers due to its profit margin and rotaional qualities.
- Pressure on Australian lobby on India to allow a transition period for newly introduced tariffs on imported pulse sto avoid any disruptions to existing contracts. Notably India has imposed 30 % import duty on Chickpeas and Lentil last week & 50 % duty on peas earlier. Australian Trade Minister Steven Ciobo has asked India for a period of transition for the tariffs on chickpeas and red lentils and was seeking a swift resolution. Analysts estimate that India accounts about half of the shipments. Australia exports \$935 million of two pulses (Chana & Lentil) each year.
- Imposition of import duty on all peas by50 % has started impacting export volume from Canada According to Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada Peas export would decrease from 3.9 MMT(2016-17 to 2.4 MMT in 2017-18.Lower export volume would increase carryout around 5 lakh ton, higher than normal expectation. Yellow peas price sare hovering in the range of C\$5.00 to C\$6.50 a bushel in western Canada.
- Lentils area in Canada is bound to decline from 23.72 to 17.43 lakh ha in 2017-18. It is lower by 23.54 % from last year.yield is expected to improve from 1.45 to 1.55 t per ha.Total production is expected to decline by 16 % from 32.48 to 27.25 lakh ha.As production would decline,total supply would decline by 10.43 % to 30.35 lakh t.Average price in 2017-18 may rule in the range of C\$720 to 750 per T.
- Lentils production in Australia too is bound to decline from 8.3 to 4.19 lakh tonne in 2017-18. It is almost 50 % down from last year. Lentils area was reported higher by 16 % at 3.55 lakh ha. Due to rough weather condition Lentils production would decline to 4.19 lakh tonne. Even field peas production is bound to decline by 32.47 % to 2.8 lakh tonne in 2017-18. Australia had produced 4.15 lakh tonne field peas in 2016-17.
- AAFC (Canada) has revised down peas production estimated from 42.50 to 41.50 lakh tonne for 2017-18. In last one month production estimate has been revised down by 1.50 lakh tonne for next season crop due to lower prevailing price and weak demand from India and Pakistan. Canada had produced 48.36 lakh tonne peas in 2016-17.
- Peas import from Ukraine to India is bound to increase over 50 % to6.5 lakh tonne in 2017-18 as bumper production seems very much on the card. Ukraine produced 7.45 lakh tonne peas last year.

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade range bound in the near term.
