

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- Chana market traded weak as expected and lost Rs 100 more in Delhi market as expected. It may trade below 4000 in Delhi market soon. Indore market may decrease Rs200 more from current level of Rs3700. Arrival pressure in MP is expected from mid-February. Overall tone remains weak.
- Red Tur traded steady to slightly weak at Rs 4100 to Rs 4450 per qtl in Gulberga market. Arrival from
 new crop is likely to increase and it may move down Rs 100 to Rs150 more despite procurement drive,
 increased private participation, lower crop size and import restriction. White Tur in Gulberga is being traded
 at Rs 4400 to Rs 4650 per qtl. Steady to slightly weak tone may prevail in coming days .Lemon tur in Burma
 was quoted at \$370/375 per tonne basis Indian port.
- Urad market traded steady to slightly weak at Rs 3900 to Rs3950 in Mumbai while it is being offered at Rs 4100 to Rs 4200 per qtl in Chennai. As dal demand is likely to improve, range bound movement may prevail in the cash market. Burma offers Urad FAQ at \$460 & SQ at \$590 per tonne basis Indian port.
- Moong market traded weak due to selling pressure and commencement of new crop in Tamil Nadu..lt traded steady atRs4900-5000 in Jaipur market. It may decrease by Rs 100 more from current level. Burma offers Moong at \$745 per tonne against \$780 per tonne in India. Weak tone is expected in the short term.
- New crop of Lentil is round the corner and slightly higher area coverage(0.22 %) to 17.19 lakh ha so far and good growth, flowering of early sown crop till now indicates good crop size this year. Production is estimated around 11.5 to 12 lakh tonne this year, 1 lakh tonne higher than last year. Import continues in spite of 30 % duty. New crop is expected by end February, hardly one month away from now. So improvement in lentil market is unlikely.Govt would procure limited quantity during peak arrival season at Rs 4250 including bonus of Rs 100 per qtl. Current market is ruling below Rs500/600 per qtl from MSP. Likely pressure from new crop would continue to weigh on market fundamentals.
- Canadian Masur in Mumbai is being offered at Rs3400/3550 per qtl.Australian container (lentil is being offered at Rs3600-3700 per qtl at Indian port.So pressure is likeely to continue on lentil market.Opening of export is not much helpful as parity is not in favour od India.Crop condition in UP and MP is good so far.
- South Indian importers imported 411 containers pulses during 15th Dec to 04th January-2018. They had imported 395 containers during fortnight 30th Nov to 14th Dec-2017. Chickpeas import was registered at 219 containers against 109 imported during previous week. Lentil import decreased from143 to 29 containers during the review period. Green Peas & Urad import was registered at 29 against 41 containers while Urad import was registered at 59 against 61 containers. Whole Tur import was reported at 9 against 10 containers during review period. Yellow pea import too decreased from21 to 14 containers.
- Rabi pulses sowing area is running ahead by 4.46 % to 160.91 lakh ha as on 12th Jan-2018. Chana area was registered at 105.62 against 97.90 lakh ha. Masur area was registered at 17.19 against 17.16 lakh ha, peas area was recorded at 11.82 against 11.84 lakh ha. Even Urad and Moong area was recorded at 7.51 against 8.28 & 4.91 against 5.03 lakh ha. Other pulses area was recorded at 5.88 against 5.96 lakh ha. Overall sowing progress is running good. Bumper area coverage is on the card once again. See table below:
- NAFED has procured 98860 toone Urad in Rajasthan till 8th January-2018. Total procurement in various states comes to 203828 tonne. Maharashtra contributed 52,000 tonne, Gujarat contributed 17000 tonne & AP 13600 tonne. It has procured 264916 toone Moong till 8th jan-2018. Rajasthan contributed 231805 tonne. Karnataka procured 21902 tonne. Maharashtra & Telangana contributed 5407 & 3330 tonne respectively. AP procured 2471 tonne. It has procured 16279 tonne Tur also till 8th Jan-2018. Telangana contributed 15508 tonne, Karnataka contributed 770 tonne.
- Karnataka govt. had purchased 2.4 lakh tonne Tur last year. This year purchased target has been fixed at 1.65 lakh tonne. State govt. has purposed to give bonus of Rs 500 per qtl. over& above MSP. This means farmers would get Rs 5950 per qtl. for their Tur. Karnataka govt. would procure 20 qtl. from each farmers. It would support market to a certain extent at current level. Tur MSP is Rs 5450 including bonus of Rs 200.It would restrict downward trend despite new arrivals.



Pulses International Fundamental:

- Green Lentils market remains unaffected from USDA 's final production estimate for 2017 and stock available on 1st December-2017. Available stock on 1st Dec was reported at around 1.9 lakh tonne, lower from 2.38 lakh tonne from Dec last year-2016. Production was estiamted at 3.39 lakh tonne in 2017 against 5.75 lakh tonne in 2016. However, market participants are not comfortable with this estimate.
- Chickpeas production estimate for the US has been increased from 2.50 lakh tonne (2016) to 3.15 lakh tonne in 2017 despite lower area coverage of 6.23 lakh acres.US farmers had covered 3.31 lakh acres in 2016.However,Chickpeas stock on 1st Dec-2017 was recorded at72000 tonne, lower from65000 tonne from Dec-2016.Small Chickpeas stock was recorded at 45750 tonne against32600 tonne last year .Its a tentative fig. Combined stock is higher by around 20,000 tonne from 2016.
- Chickpeas production in Australia is expected to decrease by 47.85 % to 10.45 lakhtonne in 2017-18 from record 2004 lakh tonne 2016-17. Despite 4.43 % higher area coverage, production is bound to decrease drastically due to hot and dry weather condition prevalent in the major growing regions. Chickpeas area increased from 1069 to 1144 thousand ha in 2017-18.
- With the beginning of new year & seasonal weak demand as usual remain price affecting factors for peas in the global market. As Indian demand for peas has decreased considerably due to 50 % imposition of import duty, local livestock feed manufacturers in Canada/Australia have increased usage of peas. Pressure on global peas market is likely to continue. Indian govt is not ready to give comforts to exporters on fumigation issue till June-2018. Prices of peas in India has moved up. However, other pulses are ruling weak and there is no short supply of pulses due to two consecutive bumper crop years. New peas crop in India is due in February-2018
- Demand for Canadian yellow peas is set to increase considerably in next few years. China is expanding processing capacity of yellow peas. In many Asian countries plant processing capacities are being increased. One Chinese processing plant capacity is being increased from 4 lakh tonne to 7 lakh tonne annually. It would help Canadian yellow peas export to 30 %.
- Imposition of import duty on all peas by50 % has started impacting export volume from Canada According to Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada Peas export would decrease from 3.9 MMT(2016-17 to 2.4 MMT in 2017-18.Lower export volume would increase carryout around 5 lakh ton, higher than normal expectation. Yellow peas price sare hovering in the range of C\$5.00 to C\$6.50 a bushel in western Canada.
- Lentils area in Canada is bound to decline from 23.72 to 17.43 lakh ha in 2017-18. It is lower by 23.54 % from last year.yield is expected to improve from 1.45 to 1.55 t per ha.Total production is expected to decline by 16 % from 32.48 to 27.25 lakh ha.As production would decline,total supply would decline by 10.43 % to 30.35 lakh t.Average price in 2017-18 may rule in the range of C\$720 to 750 per T.
- Lentils production in Australia too is bound to decline from 8.3 to 4.19 lakh tonne in 2017-18. It is almost 50 % down from last year. Lentils area was reported higher by 16 % at 3.55 lakh ha. Due to rough weather condition Lentils production would decline to 4.19 lakh tonne. Even field peas production is bound to decline by 32.47 % to 2.8 lakh tonne in 2017-18. Australia had produced 4.15 lakh tonne field peas in 2016-17.
- AAFC (Canada) has revised down peas production estimated from 42.50 to 41.50 lakh tonne for 2017-18. In last one month production estimate has been revised down by 1.50 lakh tonne for next season crop due to lower prevailing price and weak demand from India and Pakistan. Canada had produced 48.36 lakh tonne peas in 2016-17.
- Peas import from Ukraine to India is bound to increase over 50 % to6.5 lakh tonne in 2017-18 as bumper production seems very much on the card. Ukraine produced 7.45 lakh tonne peas last year.

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade range bound to slightly weak in the near term.
