

### Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- **South Indian millers /importers imported 262 containers pulses from 5th to 29th January-2018** at Chennai and Khrishnapatnam ports. The imported quantity from 15th Dec to 4th Jan-2018 was registered at 401 containers. Import flow has come down in last one month. Out of total import of 262 containers Urad contributed 68 containers, followed by Chana 60 containers. Earlier it was 59 and 219 containers. Green peas import increased from 29 to 42 containers during this period. Lentil import too increased from 29 to 42 containers. Yellow peas import too increased from 14 to 19 containers despite imposition of 50 % duty on peas and 30 % on lentil.
- **Rabi pulses sowing area is running ahead by 5.34 % to 166.47 lakh ha as on 2nd Feb-2018.** Chana area was registered at 107.24 against 99.04 lakh ha. Masur area was registered at 17.34 against 17.25 lakh ha, peas area was recorded at 11.90 against 11.93 lakh ha. Even Urad and Moong area was recorded at 8.47 against 9.21 & 7.15 against 6.31 lakh ha. Other pulses area was recorded at 6.22 against 6.34 lakh ha. Overall sowing progress is running good. Bumper area coverage is on the card once again.
- **Tur procurement in Maharashtra commences and it may check decreasing** prices of Tur in mandis of Maharashtra. It may trade steady in Gulberga and other producing region. Central govt has green signaled to buy 4.46 lakh tonne Tur in the state. Around 1.2 lakh farmers have got registered so far. As crop size is lower, steady to firm tone might be seen once again.
- **Moong market traded under pressure and it may continue due to stockists selling.** They are releasing stock to buy other rabi pulses. New crop from Odisha started coming into mandis. So it may decrease by Rs 100-Rs150 more from current level. In Jaipur mandi it is being traded at Rs 4700-4750 per qtl. Uptrend is unlikely as selling from central pool stock continues.
- **Urad demand in south India has improved and stockists have restricted selling in** open market despite ample stock available from last year's crop. There is a rumour in the market that govt is going to give 10% subsidy on pulses and dal export and import duty on pulses may be increased to 50 % for all pulses. All these developments have lent support to Urad market. It traded at Rs 4400 in Chennai market, up by Rs400 from previous close.
- **Nafed procured 66897.20 tonne Tur at MSP till 23rd Jan-2018 from kharif 2017-18** crop. Karnataka has contributed around 33392.83tonne so far. Telangana has procured 33504.37 tonne so far. Telangana has met its procurement target. However procurement target has been revised up and procurement date extended to 28th Feb-2018, Total Tur by Nafed moved up to 1,33,794.41 tonne till 23rd Jan-2018.
- **Markfed has issued selling tender for Urad & Moong in MP. The quantity in** question is said to be around 1.93 lakh qtl. for Moong & 5647 qtl. for Urad. It is from last season crop. Govt.'s agencies could not sell enough stock before this new tender. Private trades are not much interested
- **New crop of Lentil is round the corner and slightly higher area coverage(0.22 %)** to 17.19 lakh ha so far and good growth,flowering of early sown crop till now indicates good crop size this year. Production is estimated around 11.5 to 12 lakh tonne this year, 1 lakh tonne higher than last year. Import continues in spite of 30 % duty. New crop is expected by end February, hardly one month away from now. So improvement in lentil market is unlikely. Govt would procure limited quantity during peak arrival season at Rs 4250 including bonus of Rs 100 per qtl. Current market is ruling below Rs500/600 per qtl from MSP. Likely pressure from new crop would continue to weigh on market fundamentals.
- **Canadian Masur in Mumbai is being offered at Rs3400/3550 per qtl.** Australian container (lentil is being offered at Rs3600-3700 per qtl at Indian port. So pressure is likely to continue on lentil market. Opening of export is not much helpful as parity is not in favour of India. Crop condition in UP and MP is good so far.
- **Karnataka govt. had purchased 2.4 lakh tonne Tur last year. This year purchased** target has been fixed at 1.65 lakh tonne. State govt. has purposed to give bonus of Rs 500 per qtl. over & above MSP. This means farmers would get Rs 5950 per qtl. for their Tur. Karnataka govt. would procure 20 qtl. from each farmer. It would support market to a certain extent at current level. Tur MSP is Rs 5450 including bonus of Rs 200. It would restrict downward trend despite new arrivals.

### Pulses International Fundamental:

- **B, desh active buying and rumour of Pakistan's likely buying have helped Australian pulses market** to move up smartly last week. Harvesting of Chickpeas is on in India and P akistan would not import Chana from India due to tensed political issues. However, current firmness is unlikely to continue. Australian markeet would decrease once again. Notably, Australian market moved up around \$125 to around \$1000 and lentil moveed up by \$85-90 to \$880 per tonne. Prices moved up by \$50 per tonne in last 10 days.However,it has started decreasing once again. Quotes in Queeensland has decreased from\$600 to \$565 per tonne .
- **Even lentil price has come down from \$500 to \$475-80 per tonne.Major buyers** like India is not going to enter into markeet for any bulk purchasing.So,other countries buying interest would not fulfill the gap.So price is likely to stabilize at current level.
- **Canada Lentil ending stock in 2016-17** was recorded at 4 lakh tonne.it will move up to 7.8 lakh tonne in 2017-18,almost double from last year. Against this stock to use ratio is only36%.
- **Chickpea production is estimated at 97100 tonne in 2017-18 in Canada.**All peas production was estimated at 41.12 lakh tonne.Export has been estimated at 25.20 lakh tonne in 2017-18.
- **Lentils area in Canada is bound to decline from 23.72 to 17.43 lakh ha in 2017-18.** It is lower by 23.54 % from last year. Yield is expected to improve from 1.45 to 1.55 t per ha.Total production is expected to decline by 16 % from 32.48 to 27.25 lakh ha.As production would decline, total supply would decline by 10.43 % to 30.35 lakh t.Average price in 2017-18 may rule in the range of C\$720 to 750 per T.
- **Green Lentils market remains unaffected from USDA 's final production estimate** for 2017 and stock available on 1st December-2017.Available stock on 1st Dec was reported at around 1.9 lakh tonne,lower from 2.38 lakh tonne from Dec last year-2016.Production was estiamted at3.39 lakh tonne in 2017 against5.75 lakh tonne in 2016.However, market participants are not comfortable with this estimate.
- **Chickpeas production estimate for the US has been increased from 2.50 lakh tonne (2016) to 3.15 lakh tonne** in 2017 despite lower area coverage of 6.23 lakh acres.US farmers had covered 3.31 lakh acres in 2016.However,Chickpeas stock on 1st Dec-2017 was recorded at72000 tonne, lower from65000 tonne from Dec-2016.Small Chickpeas stock was recorded at 45750 tonne against32600 tonne last year .Its a tentative fig. Combined stock is higher by around 20,000 tonne from 2016.
- **Chickpeas production in Australia is expected to decrease by 47.85 % to 10.45 lakh tonne** in 2017-18 from record 2004 lakh tonne 2016-17. Despite 4.43 % higher area coverage, production is bound to decrease drastically due to hot and dry weather condition prevalent in the major growing regions. Chickpeas area increased from 1069 to 1144 thousand ha in 2017-18.
- **Imposition of import duty on all peas by 50 % has started impacting export** volume from Canada According to Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada Peas export would decrease from 3.9 MMT(2016-17 to 2.4 MMT in 2017-18.Lower export volume would increase carryout around 5 lakh ton, higher than normal expectation. Yellow peas price sare hovering in the range of C\$5.00 to C\$6.50 a bushel in western Canada.
- **Lentils production in Australia too is bound to decline from 8.3 to 4.19 lakh tonne** in 2017-18. It is almost 50 % down from last year. Lentils area was reported higher by 16 % at 3.55 lakh ha. Due to rough weather condition Lentils production would decline to 4.19 lakh tonne. Even field peas production is bound to decline by 32.47 % to 2.8 lakh tonne in 2017-18. Australia had produced 4.15 lakh tonne field peas in 2016-17.
- **AAFC (Canada) has revised down peas production estimated from 42.50 to 41.12 lakh tonne** for 2017-18. In last one month production estimate has been revised down by 1.70 lakh tonne for next season crop due to lower prevailing price and weak demand from India and Pakistan. Canada had produced 48.36 lakh tonne peas in 2016-17.
- **Peas import from Ukraine to India is bound to increase over 50 % to6.5 lakh tonne** in 2017-18 as bumper production seems very much on the card. Ukraine produced 7.45 lakh tonne peas last year.

**Weekly Outlook:** -Pulses are likely to trade range bound in the near term.
