

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- New masur crop in Bihar is likely to hit market from 10th March. It is late by 10 days in comparison to last year. Crop condition is good and old crop is being traded at Rs3550-3600 in Barh region of Bihar, the major producing belt after UP and MP. Price of lentil is expected to dip by 300 to 400 per qtl more from current level. Actually, demand is sluggish and major buyers like Bengal is absent from market at this time of the year. Imported lentil is fulfilling demand for Bengal. So price would continue to reel under pressure. Buyers should wait at least 15 days more. Production may cross 12 lakh tonne this year. As of now weather condition in producing belt is normal.
- Pressure on Chana continues and it extended loss by Rs 100 to Rs4000 in Delhi market. The latest feedback from farmers shows that yield in MP and Rajasthan may be lower by 15 and 10 % from last year. It may reduce crop size at least by 4 to 5 lakh tonne. Crop loss in Maharashtra too is very ovious. So overall size of the crop is bound to decline from previous estimate. It would check Chana price to fall further. In current scenario it may trade in the range of Rs3500 to Rs 3900 in various mandis. Govt intend to ban pulses import for a year. Notification expected soon.
- Rabi pulses sowing area is running ahead by 5.29 % to 169.10 lakh ha as on 9th Feb-2018. Chana area was registered at 107.63 against 99.54 lakh ha. Masur area was registered at 17.36 against 17.30 lakh ha, peas area was recorded at 11.92 against 11.97 lakh ha. Even Urad and Moong area was recorded at 9.44 against 9.94 & 8.31 against 7.34 lakh ha. Other pulses area was recorded at 6.28 against 6.53 lakh ha. Sowing is almost over except Urad & Moong so far.
- Tur market traded almost steady in Gulberga despite ongoing procurement drive in producing states. It traded in the range of Rs 4000-4550 per qtl. Steady to slightly firm trend is expected in coming weeks as demand for dal is expected to improve with decreasing availability of green vegetables.
- Steady tone prevailed in Moong market with decreasing arrivals in mandis.It traded at Rs 4900 in Jaipur market. New crop is 3-4 months away from now, so steady tone may prevail .It is likely to trade in the range of Rs 4800-5100 per qtl in Jaipur market.
 - **Urad traded slightly down despite ongoing procurement drive. It is** being traded at Rs 4300 to Rs 4500 per qtl in Chennai market. Steady to slightly weak tone may prevail on selling at higher price by private trades.
- Govt has procured around 5.6 lakh tonne Urad and Moong on MSP during kharif season 2017-18 so far under price support scheme, according to official data. It is worth of Rs 3077 crore. By the end of January-2018 Agri cooperative and state agencies have collectively procured 5,60,335 tonne Urad & Moong. It has been procured in 8 states like Telangana, Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Rajasthan, Maharashtra, Gujarat and Uttar Pradesh. Rajasthan has contributed around 3,93,059 tonne Urad & Moong, while Maharashtra and Karnataka purchased around 64 & 35 thousand tonne so far. State agencies procured only Urad in states like Gujarat & UP.both contributed 19550 tonne & 17434 tonne Urad so far.
- New arrival of kharif Moong crop is 4-5 months away now while rabi crop is smaller and is consumed locally. Besides, restricted import quantity at 1.5 lakh tonne till March-2018 and likely further extension amid increasing intension of retention may support market at current level. Moong at Jaipur market traded at Rs 4900-4950 per qtl.
- Masur crop is in good condition in all major producing states like MP,UP & Bihar. early sown crop in MP started hitting into mandis and almost 25 % harvest is said to be completed so far. As MP and UP contribute 65 to 75 % in total production, new crop from MP would pressurize prices in coming weeks.MP has covered 5.96 lakh ha this year and yield is better than last year, so production size is bound to increase in MP this year.Up has covered 5.97 lakh ha, lower by around 10 % this year
- As 30 % import duty is on place, import flow has come down. However, after March new import deal is
 expected to start at higher rate due to import duty. Consumption is around 20 lakh tonne. With carryout of
 4.84 total availability is expected to be around 18 lakh tonne. If govt.'s start procuring on MSP and export
 starts, lentil price would start moving up in second half of the year. So, buying on dip is good.
- Tur procurement in Maharashtra commences and it may check decreasing prices of Tur in mandis of Maharashtra. It may trade steady in Gulberga and other producing region. Central govt has green signaled to



buy 4.46 lakh tonne Tur in the state. Around 1.2 lakh farmers have got registered so far. As crop size is lower, steady to firm tone might be seen once again.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- Undertone in global chickpeas market remains subdued due to higher supply in exporting countries
 and lower demand from India. Global Chickpeas production is bound to increase from 115 to 125 lakh tonne
 due to higher area coverage in India. Global Chickpeas production of Kabuli Chana) too would increase from
 20 to 28 lakh tonne this year. Besides global trade would decline as major buyers like India is out of the
 market right now.
- Even lentil price has come down from \$500 to \$475-80 per tonne. Major buyers like India is not going to enter into market for any bulk purchasing. So, other countries buying interest would not fulfill the gap. So price is likely to stabilize at current level.
- Canada Lentil ending stock in 2016-17 was recorded at 4 lakh tonne.it will move up to 7.8 lakh tonne in 2017-18,almost double from last year. Against this stock to use ratio is only36%.
- Chickpea production is estimated at 97100 tonne in 2017-18 in Canada. All peas production was estimated at 41.12 lakh tonne. Export has been estimated at 25.20 lakh tonne in 2017-18.
- Lentils area in Canada is bound to decline from 23.72 to 17.43 lakh ha in 2017-18. It is lower by 23.54 % from last year. Yield is expected to improve from 1.45 to 1.55 t per ha. Total production is expected to decline by 16 % from 32.48 to 27.25 lakh ha. As production would decline, total supply would decline by 10.43 % to 30.35 lakh t. Average price in 2017-18 may rule in the range of C\$720 to 750 per T.
- Green Lentils market remains unaffected from USDA 's final production estimate for 2017 and stock available on 1st December-2017. Available stock on 1st Dec was reported at around 1.9 lakh tonne, lower from 2.38 lakh tonne from Dec last year-2016. Production was estiamted at 3.39 lakh tonne in 2017 against 5.75 lakh tonne in 2016. However, market participants are not comfortable with this estimate.
- Chickpeas production estimate for the US has been increased from 2.50 lakh tonne (2016) to 3.15 lakh tonne in 2017 despite lower area coverage of 6.23 lakh acres.US farmers had covered 3.31 lakh acres in 2016.However, Chickpeas stock on 1st Dec-2017 was recorded at 72000 tonne, lower from 65000 tonne from Dec-2016.Small Chickpeas stock was recorded at 45750 tonne against 32600 tonne last year .Its a tentative fig. Combined stock is higher by around 20,000 tonne from 2016.
- Chickpeas production in Australia is expected to decrease by 47.85 % to 10.45 lakhtonne in 2017-18 from record 2004 lakh tonne 2016-17. Despite 4.43 % higher area coverage, production is bound to decrease drastically due to hot and dry weather condition prevalent in the major growing regions. Chickpeas area increased from 1069 to 1144 thousand ha in 2017-18.
- Imposition of import duty on all peas by50 % has started impacting export volume from Canada According to Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada Peas export would decrease from 3.9 MMT(2016-17 to 2.4 MMT in 2017-18.Lower export volume would increase carryout around 5 lakh ton, higher than normal expectation. Yellow peas price sare hovering in the range of C\$5.00 to C\$6.50 a bushel in western Canada.
- Lentils production in Australia too is bound to decline from 8.3 to 4.19 lakh tonne in 2017-18. It is almost 50 % down from last year. Lentils area was reported higher by 16 % at 3.55 lakh ha. Due to rough weather condition Lentils production would decline to 4.19 lakh tonne. Even field peas production is bound to decline by 32.47 % to 2.8 lakh tonne in 2017-18. Australia had produced 4.15 lakh tonne field peas in 2016-17.
- AAFC (Canada) has revised down peas production estimated from 42.50 to 41.12 lakh tonne for 2017-18. In last one month production estimate has been revised down by 1.70 lakh tonne for next season crop due to lower prevailing price and weak demand from India and Pakistan. Canada had produced 48.36 lakh tonne peas in 2016-17.
- Peas import from Ukraine to India is bound to increase over 50 % to6.5 lakh tonne in 2017-18 as bumper production seems very much on the card. Ukraine produced 7.45 lakh tonne peas last year.

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade range bound in the near term.
