

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- Pulses market continued to trade under pressure and bearish tone may prevail in coming weeks. Buyers are out of market. Liquidity crunch too remains disturbing factor for normal trade. Chana extended its loss by Rs75 to Rs3675-3700 in Delhi market. Other pulses too traded weak.
- Govt. has procured 3.46 lakh tonne chana till 20th April-2018 in various states. State agency has procured 1.17 lakh tonne in Karnataka, 62176.25 tonne in Andhra Pradesh, 50,000 tonne in Telangana, 61298.64 tonne in Rajasthan, 33000 tonne in MP & 22371.16 tonne in Maharashtra. Slower pace of procurement could not support bearish movement in the market.
- Burma is offering lemon tur at \$325 and \$330 (new) per tonne basis CnF. Tur market may trade range bound in coming days. In a latest development Maharashtra state govt. has asked union govt to extend date for Tur procurement till 31st May-2018 from earlier approved till 18th April-2018.
- Urad market traded almost flat during the week under review. As per pre-sowing market intension area under kharif urad may decline by 10 to 15 percent on all India basis. Lower price realization remains discouraging for farmers. Steady to slightly weak tone may prevail in cash Urad market this week. Urad at Mumbai market is being traded at Rs 3750 to 3900 per qtl. Market is waiting for demand. Bulk buyers like millers remain sidelined with prevailing weak inner tone. Burma is offering Urad FAQ at \$365 and SQ at \$480 per tonne basis CnF Indian port. At this price possibility of import seems very much in sight.under current norm, importers can import 1.5 lakh tonne Urad.
- In a latest developments central govt has given green signal for procuring 3000 MT Urad in Tamil Nadu and 1lakh MT in Andhra Pradesh from Rabi season 2018 at MSP.It may support Urad price in local market to a certain extent.
- Moong seems under pressure due to lack of demand. However, stockists have restricted selling at decreased price in Delhi Market. Unlike Delhi Moong offtake in Rajasthan was seen improving. It is being traded at Rs 4900 to Rs 5400 in Maharashtra. In Gulberga it is being traded at Rs 4400 to Rs 5300 per qtl. As parity for import seems in sight, traders expect containers from Myanmar may hit India in May.
- Moong import is possible despite quantity restriction at 1.5 lakh tonne for the year. Prices of Moong in domestic market is hovering in the range of Rs 4800-5000, while Mozambique and Burma are offering Moong at \$545 & \$690 per tonne against Indian prevailing price of \$730-740 per tonne. In INR term Mozambique Moong comes to Rs 35360 per tonne while Myanmar Moong comes to 4475 per qtl. New rabi moong is expected from mid May from Bihar and UP. Moong from MP is expected to hit market in June. So supply side is expected to higher and it would cap any move of uptrend in coming weeks.
- Burma is offering lemon tur old at \$325 & new at \$330 per tone basis CnF.If it is imported in India it would cost around\$415 including 30% duty and\$25 per tonne as freight. In INR term it comes to Rs 27275 per tonne. It offers Chana Kabuli at \$630 per tonne. With 60 % duty cost will go up to 65500 per tonne. Urad FAQ is being offered at \$\$65& SQ at 480 per tonne. Moong Pakaku and Pediseva are being offered at \$640 & \$920 per tonne. At current price parity seems in favour of importers except Chana 7 Kabuli Chana.
- Central govt has approved to procure one lakh tonne Urad and 32 thousand tonne Moong in Andhra Pradesh from rabi season 2018 on MSP through govt.'s procurement agencies. Tamil Nadu govt would procure 3000 metric tone Urad from Rabi season.
- Pea Arrival from producing regions is decreasing continuously and there is no import deal right now
 due to 50 % import duty on all peas. As domestic price of matar (peas) is cheaper, importers are waiting for
 parity. Demand for besan and pea are good and there is no import in next two months, it would drive
 domestic price of matar up. The firmness would continue till domestic price come at par with imported pea
 price.
- Nafed will procure 450930MT Chana in Madhya Pradesh during rabi season 2017-18 at MSP from farmers. Chana procurement in Gujarat would commence from 20th April-2018. Odisa govt. has approved Urad, Moong and Tur from farmers on MSP. Markfed will procure pulses in the state.
- Nafed procured 157320.308 MT Chanaas on 4th April from rabi 2017-18 at MSP.Out of total maximum quantity (73399.92 MT) has been purchased from Karnataka, followed by Telangana, which has procured 39779.30 MT so far.AP has procured 24482.75 MT,Rajasthan has purchased 11465,37 Mt & Maharashtra procurement was recorded at 8193.10 MT.Procurement continues.



Pulses International Fundamental:

- China field pea demand is likely to increase considerably this year due to expansion of fractionation capacity and unexpected buying by Chinese feed sector. Chinese feed industries have brought around 300000 MT peas so far. In Jan and fen peas import in China was registered at 2.56 and 3 lakh tonne respectively. Weak demand from India affected peas price and Chinese buyers are taking advantage of cheaper pea for making cattle feed. Other grains are comparatively costly.
- Green Peas market traded slightly up due to higher demand through a USDA PL-480 food aid tender last week. The quantity under question is said to be around 20,650 metric tons. Besides, another tender for 8000 MT of green split peas and 1500MT for yellow peas helped market to recover. Canadian peas too improved with hope of higher export demand during May.
- Global lentil market traded almost flat during last week. Under prevailing bearish tone limited trade
 was registered. Loading from new crop too was seen at lower ebb. Despite poor export sales farmers in US
 & Canada received higher price in comparison to previous week. Lower demand from India and weak export
 sales continue to affect global lentil market. Steady to weak tone may prevail in coming weeks.
- Lentil export from Canada has badly affected due to absence of India in global market and imposition of 30 percent duty in India. During the month of March-2018 Canada exported only 23000 MT. During last eight months from August to March-2018 total lentil export recorded only at 2 lakh tonne against 667,400 tonne exported during same time span last year. It seems that season would end with below 4 lakh tonne export. After 2012-13, it would be the lowest one.
- **US** farmers have decreased lenting area due to poor demand and bearish global market. US farmers had planted 1104 thousand acres under lentil in 2017. This year lentil area has decline by 28 % to 791 thousand acres. Area under lentil in all major producing states like Idho, Montana, North Dakota and Washigton has declined by 69, 73, 77 & 82 % respectively this year against last year.
- After two consecutive bumper crop years of pulses in India,prices of pulses decreased below MSP
 level and pressure is still on. So Indian govt is unlikely to increase import quantity in the first half of the
 current MY,starting from April.Farmers in Myanmar may decrease area under Moong and Urad this year and
 may shift to other alternate crops as prices are much below the production cost. Myanmar govt is planning to
 buy Moong to support farmers.
- Global lentil market traded unchanged during the week under review. Weak demand from India and other importing nations has pressurized the Canadian lentil market too.Lentil export from Canada has been decreasing continuously. In the first half of MY 2016-17 only 26% of the opening season supply of lentils was exported .It is downby 51% from last season and 59% during the first half of the 2015-16 marketing year.
- India & Canada have agreed to solve fumigation issue by the end of this year.PM of both the countries
 have announced that India and Canada will work closely together to finalize an arrangement within 2018 to
 enable the export of Canadian pulses to India free from pests of quarantine importance, with mutually
 acceptable technological protocols. However, no statement has been made over import duty ranging from 30
 to 50 % applicable right now.
- Pulse Australia has signed an agreement with Indian Pulse and Grain Association (IPGA) for greater
 exchange of information on Indian pulse crops. IPGA says that better exchange of market information will
 benefit producers and the operation of the supply chain. Insight into pulse crop developments in India is
 especially important, given the global status of India in pulse markets-says Pulse Australia CEO, Nick
 Goddard.
- Canada Lentil ending stock in 2016-17 was recorded at 4 lakh tonne.it will move up to 7.8 lakh tonne in 2017-18, almost double from last year. Against this stock to use ratio is only36%.
- Chickpea production is estimated at 97100 tonne in 2017-18 in Canada. All peas production was estimated at 41.12 lakh tonne. Export has been estimated at 25.20 lakh tonne in 2017-18.
- Lentils area in Canada is bound to decline from 23.72 to 17.43 lakh ha in 2017-18. It is lower by 23.54 % from last year. Yield is expected to improve from 1.45 to 1.55 t per ha. Total production is expected to decline by 16 % from 32.48 to 27.25 lakh ha. As production would decline, total supply would decline by 10.43 % to 30.35 lakh t. Average price in 2017-18 may rule in the range of C\$720 to 750 per T.



- Chickpeas production in Australia is expected to decrease by 47.85 % to 10.45 lakhtonne in 2017-18 from record 2004 lakh tonne 2016-17. Despite 4.43 % higher area coverage, production is bound to decrease drastically due to hot and dry weather condition prevalent in the major growing regions. Chickpeas area increased from 1069 to 1144 thousand ha in 2017-18.
- Lentils production in Australia too is bound to decline from 8.3 to 4.19 lakh tonne in 2017-18. It is almost 50 % down from last year. Lentils area was reported higher by 16 % at 3.55 lakh ha. Due to rough weather condition Lentils production would decline to 4.19 lakh tonne. Even field peas production is bound to decline by 32.47 % to 2.8 lakh tonne in 2017-18. Australia had produced 4.15 lakh tonne field peas in 2016-17.

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade weak.
