

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

- **Chana cash market is likely to trade firm in coming weeks but not without a downward correction.** At improved level sellers may be active. In Delhi chana market traded at Rs4450-4500 per qtl. Australian Chana in Mumbai is being quoted at Rs 4225-4250 per qtl. Buying by stockist/mills continues and they expect market to move further up. Sellers are unwilling to sell. Arrival remains at negligible level. MNC would not sell chana even at improved price while govt may start releasing stock not before August end/Sep.
- **Taking clue from firm chana and commencement of festive season demand for dal is likely to improve.** Pulses like Moong, Masur, Urad, Tur & Peas may trade firm in coming weeks. Right now only Nafed and other state agencies are selling various pulses. So pressure is unlikely to build up in cash market. Tur lemon in Mumbai traded up by Rs 50 to Rs3550/3600 per qtl. Masur(vessel) in Mumbai was traded at Rs3900-4000, while containers was quoted at Rs4000-4200 per qtl. Urad in Mumbai was being traded at Rs3550-3600 per qtl. Overall tone in pulses market remains firm.
- **Burma is quoting Tur Lemon at \$395 while old crop moved up from \$375 to 395 per tonne basis Indian port.** Urad FAQ was quoted at \$325 while SQ was offered up by \$10 to \$470 per tonne basis Indian port. Canadian peas in Mumbai is being quoted at Rs 4150 per qtl. It was traded at Rs 4000 at Mundra port. Russian matar is being traded at Rs 3950. Ukraine peas. Matar from Ukraine is being offered at Rs4000 at Mundra port. Overall trend for peas remains firm.
- **All India kharif Pulses area is lagging behind by 9.56 % to 60.56 against 66.97 lakh ha last year as on 13th July 2018.** Farmers have covered 22.18 lakh ha against 22.64 last year under Tur till date, lower by 2 %. Normal area under Tur is 41.90 lakh ha. However, Urad area is up by 15.17 % to 15.78 against 13.70 lakh ha. Normal area of kharif Urad is 27 lakh ha. Moong area is running behind by 5.47 % to 17.51 lakh ha against 18.52 lakh ha last year. Normal area under Moong is 24.93 lakh ha. Other pulses area too is lower by 61.31% to 4.60 lakh ha than last year. Farmers had covered 11.90 lakh ha under other pulses last year. However, area under Kulthi has increased by 132 % to 0.49 lakh ha against normal of 2.27 lakh ha.
- **Export incentive Of 7 % for pulses and dal has been extended up to 20th Sept-2018.** It has been extended from June to Sept. If prices of chana in global market would move up, export volume for chana may increase. Exporters may be active once again.
- **Tur market is expected to improve from current level by Rs 100 to 200 per qtl in coming weeks.** Higher MSP for new crop, lower all India area coverage by 15 to 20% and increasing intention of retaining stock by stockists amid slower pace of release from central pool stock are likely to support Tur market in weeks ahead. Stock in private hands is said to be decreased by 50 % from normal. It would continue to lend support to cash market. Maximum stock is in central pool and restricted release seems favorable for Tur market. Tur in Gulberga market is up by Rs100 to Rs3700 -Rs4100 per qtl.
- **Urad market moved up by Rs 100 to Rs 4150-4350 per qtl in Chennai.** Good demand amid higher MSP may push market further up by Rs 200/300 from current level. Lower area coverage would remain supportive. As loading is under process in Burma and is expected to hit Indian market by 20 to 24th July, firmness may be contained at higher level. However, in continuation of good demand in domestic market would restrict downward correction. Urad market is expected to stabilize at Rs 4400/4600 per qtl. SQ may trade at Rs 5400 in the near term.
- **Indian importers imported total 114244.86 MT pulses in May-2018, lower by 3.11 % from previous month.** The latest import data shows that green peas import increased by 158 % to 6961.54 MT in May. Even Tur import increased by 280 % from 4958.77 MT to 18821.66 MT in May. Even moong import increased by 9.29% to 829 MT. However, import of other pulses declined in comparison to April. Chana import declined from 2209.55 to 1266.23 MT. Lentil import decreased from 2659.33 to 1703.9 MT during the same period. Urad import declined by 7.35 % from 3931.62 to 3642.52 MT. Even yellow peas import declined by 18.01 % from 87889.81 MT to 72062.99 MT. Kidneybean import declined by 30.15 % from 12823.5 to 8957.42 MT. India had imported 117909.73 MT in April. Import flow is likely to decline further in coming weeks.
- **DES has revised pulses production estimates from 23.95 to 24.51 MMT in the 3rd Adv. Est released on 16th May-2018 for 2017-18 season.** It has finalized last year production at 23.13 MMT.

Pulses International Fundamental:

- **Trading activities in global lentil market remains restricted.** Asking price for spot market was seen on line with new crop. Market participants were seen attending Canada Special Crops Association annual meeting in Regina. As summer holiday is on no major activities are expected this week. Higher temperature in growing belt still remains a cause of concern. It may impact yield potential. Despite this concern crop condition is said to be good so far.
- **Global Chickpeas demand-supply scenario seems balanced right now, barring India.** Total marketable surplus is around 6 lakh tonne including Australian new estimated crop size of 4.5 lakh tonne. Against it demand is around 5.25 lakh tonne in next 9 to 12 months including 2 lakh tonne demand from Pakistan. This means availability is only 0.75 lakh tonne higher than projected demand. Situation may be changed if India starts importing from Burma & Tanzania without duty. Marketable surplus in both countries is said to be around 1 lakh tonne. Prices of Chana in India have started firming up and at current prices it comes to around \$510-515 per tonne. If prices move up further, Indian importers can start importing from Burma and Myanmar. It would push up global chickpeas price in coming months.
- **Peas demand from France has increased from European union. It has lent much needed support to pea market in France.** However, import volume from France in May was registered at 17,910 MT, lower by 7% to 19,310 MT loaded in April. France had exported 9,490 MT in May last year. France has exported total 268,720 MT peas so far in the season. Belgium brought around 12,300 MT, Netherlands brought 2015 MT and Spain purchased around 19,250 MT.
- **Global Chickpeas market traded almost mixed while gap between large and medium caliber has started increasing.** Even growers bids have been on decrease from May-2018. US farmers bids decreased by 26% to \$705 MT. In Canada it decreased by 19% to \$490 in last two months. Recovery is expected at current level.
- **Canada lentil area is said to be lower than intended by one million acres to 3.77 MMT.** Agri experts expected it to be 4.05 million acres. Actually, at the time of sowing prices remained subdued and it impacted farmers to reduce area from 4.05 to 3.37 million ha. Canada had planted 4.4 million acres in 2018. Under current prevailing condition production would be only slip from last year's 2.559 million metric ton (MT) harvest to 2.495 million this year.
- **Chickpeas area in Canada & US has been registered higher than previous intention.** US farmers have planted 6.62 lakh acres against intention of 6.65 lakh acres. Farmers have covered 2.05 lakh acres under small chickpeas while Kabuli area increased from 3.46 to 4.57 lakh acres this year. Chickpeas area in Canada increased from 3.46 to 4.68 lakh acres. Unofficial Statistics Canada data suggests Canada planted 13,800 acres of desi, 445,900 acres of kabuli and 9,200 acres of other types such as B-90.
- **The latest release of The Canadian Grain Commission hints that Canada exported around 373,000 MT pea through licensed terminal in May-2018.** Data does not include containers export. The exported volume is higher by 85% from 2.01 lakh MT exported in May-2017. It is almost double from exported volume of 1.77 lakh MT in April-2018. India imported around 30,000 MT from Canada in May-2018.
- **Lentil area is bound to decline 23.51% to 2.70 lakh ha against 3.53 lakh ha last year.** Production is expected to decline by 17.20 lakh tonne to 3.85 lakh tonne against 4.65 lakh tonne last year. Even pea area is expected to decline 2.22 lakh ha to 1.85 lakh ha. Pea production in Australia is expected to decline from 2.89 to 2.13 lakh tonne in 2018-19. Australia Chickpeas area is expected to decrease by 52.69% to 5.28 lakh ha (last year 11.16 lakh ha) in 2018-19. Production is bound to decline by 40.08% to 6.16 lakh tonne against 10.28 lakh tonne last year.
- **Chickpeas area is expected to decrease by 53% to 5.28 lakh ha in 2018-19.** Production is likely to decline 40% to 6.16 lakh tonne this year against last year around 10 lakh tonne. The area planted to chickpeas is forecast to fall by 52 per cent in 2018-19 to around 215,000 hectares. The fall reflects lower expected returns from chickpeas relative to cereal crops.
- **As per Canadian Grain Commission latest report Canada has exported around 1.78 lakh tonne pea in April-2018.** The quantity may be higher as it does not include export in containers. Official data might be slightly higher. Canada had exported 4.18 lakh tonne in April-2017, higher by 57% from export in April-2018. However, it is quite higher from March shipment 57,500 MT. Higher export and improved demand may push pea price up in global market despite weak demand from India at this point of time.
- **Canada exported 36,600 MT lentil in April-2018, it is higher by 3,500 MT shipped in April-2017.** Canada had exported 33,100 MT lentil in April-2017. It is also higher than March shipment (17,900 MT). B, Desh and US were major buyers for

lentil in April-2018. However, total shipped quantity in this My has been registered at 235,200 MT while last year till April it was 700,600 MT.

- **Chickpeas area in Canada is likely to increase considerably from 1.6 lakh acres to 2.79 lakh acres in 2018.** While chickpeas are riskier to grow than lentils, the relative returns were starting to look better for chickpeas in the regions they're grown-says Carl Potts, executive director of the Saskatchewan Pulse Growers. According to him, growing North American demand for human consumption is another factor behind the strength in chickpeas market.

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade firm.
