

## Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

### Today's Update:

- **All India kharif Pulses area is lagging behind by 2.92 % to 124.15 against 127.89 lakh ha** last year as on 10<sup>th</sup> Aug 2018. Farmers have covered 42.17 lakh ha against 42.24 last year under Tur till date, down by 0.17 %. Normal area under Tur is 41.90 lakh ha. Even Urad area is lagging behind by 11.99 % to 34.93 against 39.69 lakh ha. Normal area of kharif Urad is 27 lakh ha. Moong area is running up by 6.11 % to 32.13 lakh ha against 30.28 lakh ha last year. Normal area under Moong is 24.93 lakh ha. Other pulses area too is lower by 6.68 % than last year. It is 14.26 against 15.28 lakh ha so far against normal of 15.83 lakh ha. However, area under Kulthi has increased by 67.51 % to 0.66 lakh ha against normal of 2.27 lakh ha. - **In Delhi market chana is being offered at Rs4450-4500. Buyers are active. Besides, buying by Bangladesh** from Maharashtra has lent some support to local market. Bangladesh has brought around 2500 MT chana last week and more sales are expected in August and September. Generally, Bangladesh buys from Australia, but lower crop size (3.5 lakh tonne) in Australia has provided opportunity for Indian exporters to grab this market. Market size of B, desh is 1.25 lakh tonne. Besides, there is opportunity in other neighboring countries too amid support of 7% export incentives.
- **Pulses will not be disposed of immediately as govt has decided to consume pulses stock** through state govt.'s various welfare schemes. It would not be sold for open market through auction. The burden of this stock has been shifted to all states and union territories, which they have to consume over the period of next twelve months under various running welfare programs. So supply of pulses would remain restricted for open market. State govt. has to utilize it. As maximum stock available in central pool is of Chana and Tur. So it would help market to recover from current level.

### Previous Update:

- **Rajasthan state govt has waived the tradition of renewal of license of dal industry having** investment lower than 5 crores regarding air pollution act. Now such pulses industries can get acknowledgement once under air act 1981 & water act 1974 from Rajya mandal. It would help dal industries in Rajasthan from unnecessary delay and documental procedure. All India dal mills association has welcomed this step.
- **Arrival of moong is below expectation in harda, Pipariya and other adjoining markets. Lower arrival** and millers improved interest lent support to moong cash market and it traded up by Rs 100-200 in Auction. MP govt has extended the procurement date to 20<sup>th</sup> Aug now under Bhavantar Yojna. Even farmers are unwilling to sell moong to private traders. As new MSP for moong is much higher than prevailing price, farmers would not sell entire quantity. It may support moong market at current level. There is a common view among farmers that they would sell moong at new MSP when govt would start procurement. All these developments would not allow moong market to dip more from current level. Stake holders should buy on dip
- **Mayanmar offered lemon tur (new & old) at \$ 370 per tonne. Basis Indian port. Linkly too is being offered at** \$370 per tonne, down by \$10, urad FAQ was offered down by \$5 to \$310 and SQ at \$445 basis Indian port. Chana v2 Kabuli was offered at \$620 per tonne and Hollan at \$655 per tonne. Moong Pakaku was offered at \$680 per tonne. Red Rajma was quoted at \$1120 per MT.
- Govt. has assured trades association in a meeting of GST council that 12 & 18 % slab may be replaced in one slab of 14-15% soon.
- **Lentil market may trade steady to slightly weak this week. Domestic demand for dal may support market to a** certain extent. Uptrend in Masur market is unlikely to continue despite lower availability of imported stock in Kolkata and Mumbai. It would not allow market to go unexpectedly down. However, market should not ignore huge stock (243450.18 MT) in central pool procured during the season. Other price limiting factor is lower price for Tur and it is directly affecting Masur dal consumers right now. Tur dal is still available at Rs55-60 per kg against 50 to 55 per kg for Masur. So consumers have option to shift from Masur to Tur. Govt. agencies have around 10 lakh tonne Tur stock and they would start liquidating it before Nov when new crop hits the market. It would pressurize lentil price in the months ahead.

- **DES has revised pulses production estimates from 23.95 to 24.51 MMT in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Adv. Est released on 16th May-2018 for 2017-18 season. It has finalized last year production at 23.13 MMT.**

#### **Pulses International Fundamental:**

- **As per the USDA first production estimate for new crop Chickpea and dry edible bean in US may move up to 16.3 lakh tonne in 2018.** Seeded area is estimated at 2.05 million acres, down 2% from 2017. Harvested area has been pegged at 1.99 million acres, down by 1 percent from last year. It (production) was 16.7 lakh tonne last year.
- **France Pea marketing season ended with 2.85 lakh tonne, down by 2% from last year.** According to data released by Eurostat and Terres Univia export shipments during June totaled 16,775 metric tons, down 6% from the 17,910 MT shipped last month. Belgium was the most important destination, taking 10,560 MT. Netherlands was the second most important destination at 3,120 MT, followed by Italy at 1,535 MT and Spain at 587 MT.
- **Lentil Production in Turkey has been pegged down by 12% to 3.8 lakh tonne from last year.** The reason of lower production is mainly attributed to bad weather condition in parts of south eastern region. Harvesting is over by first week of July. In some particular region farmers have lost 50 % yield due to heavy rains and water lodging. However chickpeas area increased due to govt.'s support and higher return in 2018. The major chickpeas producing regions are Central Anatolia and somewhat in the Southeastern region. This year chickpeas production has been pegged at 5.5 lakh tonne, up by 15 % from last year. The GOT announced the MY 2018/19 chickpeas procurement price on June 25, 2018 at 3,250 TL/MT (around \$700/MT).
- **The Canadian Grain Commission latest update shows that Canada has 29,800 metric tons lentils** through licensed facilities in June against 68,600 MT were shipped the same month last year, while movement is up from the 19,600 MT shipped the previous month. Thus total export for the current marketing year touched to 284,600 MT against 853,100 MT during the same period last season.
- **Canada lentil area is said to be lower than intended by one million acres to 3.77 MMT.** Agri experts expected it to be 4.05 million acres. Actually, at the time of sowing prices remained subdued and it impacted farmers to reduce area from 4.05 to 3.37 million ha. Canada had planted 4.4 million acres in 2018. Under current prevailing condition production would be only slip from last year's 2.559 million metric ton (MT) harvest to 2.495 million this year.
- **Chickpeas area in Canada & US has been registered higher than previous intention.** US farmers have planted 6.62 lakh acres against intention of 6.65 lakh acres. Farmers have covered 2.05 lakh acres under small chickpeas while Kabuli area increased from 3.46 to 4.57 lakh acres this year. Chickpeas area in Canada increased from 3.46 to 4.68 lakh acres. Unofficial Statistics Canada data suggests Canada planted 13,800 acres of desi, 445,900 acres of kabuli and 9,200 acres of other types such as B-90.
- **The latest release of The Canadian Grain Commission hints that Canada exported around 373,000 MT pea** through licensed terminal in May-2018. Data does not include containers export. The exported volume is higher by 85% from 2.01 lakh MT exported in May-2017. It is almost double from exported volume of 1.77 lakh MT in April-2018. India imported around 30,000 MT from Canada in May-2018.
- **Lentil area is bound to decline 23.51 % to 2.70 lakh ha against 3.53 lakh ha last year.** Production is expected to decline by 17.20 lakh tonne to 3.85 lakh tonne against 4.65 lakh tonne last year. Even pea area is expected to decline 2.22 lakh ha to 1.85 lakh ha. Pea production in Australia is expected to decline from 2.89 to 2.13 lakh tonne in 2018-19. Australia Chickpeas area is expected to decrease by 52.69% to 5.28 lakh ha (last year 11.16 lakh ha) in 2018-19. Production is bound to decline by 40.08 % to 6.16 lakh tonne against 10.28 lakh tonne last year.
- **Chickpeas area is expected to decrease by 53% to 5.28 lakh ha in 2018-19. Production is likely to decline 40 % to 6.16 lakh tonne this year against last year around 10 lakh tonne.** The area planted to chickpeas is forecast to fall by 52 per cent in 2018-19 to around 215,000 hectares. The fall reflects lower expected returns from chickpeas relative to cereal crops..
- **Canada exported 36,600 MT lentil in April-2018, it is higher by 3500 MT shipped in April-2017.** Canada had exported 33,100 MT lentil in April-2017. It is also higher than March shipment (17,900 MT). B, desh and US were major buyers for lentil in April-2018. However, total shipped quantity in this My has been registered at 235,200 MT while last year till April it was 700,600 MT.

- **Chickpeas area in Canada is likely to increase considerably from 1.6 lakh acres to 2.79 lakh acres in 2018.** While chickpeas are riskier to grow than lentils, the relative returns were starting to look better for chickpeas in the regions they're grown-says Carl Potts, executive director of the Saskatchewan Pulse Growers. According to him, growing North American demand for human consumption is another factor behind the strength in chickpeas market.

**Weekly Outlook:** -Pulses are likely to trade steady to slightly firm.
