

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- Mostly market traded weak due to sluggish trading activities on Friday.
- Nafed started sale of Tur in AP and Telangana. Response seems positive as bidder's interest were seen increasing in recent weeks. AP and Telangana had procured 55600 & 75300 MT respectively from kharif season -2017-18. Out of total procured quantity, Nafed has been able to sell 47009.60 MT as on 12 Sep-2018 in AP and 45052.30 Mt in Telangana. It has been auctioned at an average price of Rs 3564.23 and 3569.08 per qtl. As prices are ruling lower, average price received by Nafed is lower. The rest available quantity in AP is 8590.40MT and in Telangana, it is30247.70 MT. Nafed continue to offer it in these states until stock exhausts. Average price is likely to increase as in coming weeks as there is a crop damage report in Karnataka, Uttar Pradesh and Maharashtra and it may support price.

Previous Update:

- Giving a major boost to the pro-farmer initiatives of the Government and in keeping with its commitment and dedication for the Annadata, the Union Cabinet chaired by Prime Minister, has approved a new Umbrella Scheme "Pradhan Mantri Annadata Aay SanraksHan Abhiyan' (PM-AASHA). The Scheme is aimed at ensuring remunerative prices to the farmers for their produce as announced in the Union Budget for 2018. It is expected that the increase in MSP will be translated to farmer's income by way of robust procurement mechanism in coordination with the State Governments
- Burma offered Tur Lemon at \$350 per MT basis cNF Indian port. Linkly, Old and new lemon Tur quotes remain same. FAQ Urad is being offered at \$355 and SQ at \$475 per MT basis CNF Indian port. Kabuli Chana is being offered at 4655 and Hollan at 4690 per MT basis CNF. Moong Pakaku is being offered at \$710 per MT.CNF quotes have improved slightly in past two weeks.
- As season for kharif Urad sowing is almost over, any improvement in area is unlikely now. It is 12.5% lower than last year to 38.02 lakh ha so far. Indian farmers had covered 43.44 lakh ha last year till first week of Sep. Area under urad is lower and crop condition to is not satisfactory. Recent rains have badly affected standing crop in some region of Rajasthan. Resultantly, production is likely to decrease this year by 15 to 20%.crop in Maharashtra and Karnatka is almost ready to be harvested. In MP harvesting is delayed by two weeks due to wet weather. Harvesting is likely to commence from 4th week of Sep. Here area under urad has declined by 16.66 % to 14.91 lakh ha. Stock of imported urad is decreasing fast and due to quantitative restriction bulk import is not possible. Imported urad from Burma is being quoted at rs 3750-3800 in Mumbai. Huge burden of carryout too is coming down. As market sees positive sign for uptrend, stockists are active and have started retaining stock.
- Other major states where area has decreased are Maharashtra (23 .155), Rajasthan (12.62%). However, area is up in Uttar Pradesh (15.44%) but it would not compensate overall area loss in other states. So Agriwatch expects improvement in price in coming weeks. Govt agencies would procure urad at higher MSp and it too would support market.
- As per latest update, NAFED has offered 24522.74 tonnes of lentils in five tenders since 13th August-18 until 10th September-18. NAFED will sell lentil at MSP of Rs 4150 per quintal. NAFED has procured 243450.18 MT in MP and UP till 7th July-2018. Quantity sold by NAFED won't make much difference as it will be consumed locally. Furthermore, buyers may be reluctant in participating in lentil tenders offered by NAFED, as domestic price of lentil in open market is ruling below MSP.
- All India kharif Pulses area is lagging behind by 2.2 % to 134.41 against137.45 lakh ha last year as on 7th Sep- 2018.Farmers have covered 45.20 lakh ha against 45.11 last year under Tur till date, slightly higher than last year. Normal area under Tur is 41.90 lakh ha. However, Urad area is lagging behind by 12.5 % to 38.02 against 43.44 lakh ha. Normal area of kharif Urad is 27 lakh ha. Moong area is running up by 7.3 % to34.05 lakh ha against 31.72 lakh ha last year. Normal area under Moong is 24.93 lakh ha. Other pulses area too is down by 0.1 % than last year .It is 16,34 against 16.35 lakh ha so far against normal of 15.83 lakh ha. Area under Kulthi has decreased by 3 % to 0.81 lakh ha against normal of 2.27 lakh ha so far.
- Chana market traded steady despite weak demand from bulk buyers. Recent cancelation of tenders by Nafed due to lower bids has helped market to sustain at current level. If Nafed sticks with its intention not to sell below MSP, cash chana market may stay steady to slightly firm. Total stock with govt and private hands is said to bge around 50 lakh tonne. If consumption continues with 8 lakh tonne per month, market should move up by Rs 200 to 300 from current level. In Delhi market chana is being traded at Rs4100 to Rs4200 per qtl.



- Tur Area in AP is down by 8.33 5 to 1.98 lakh ha, It is down by 3.4 % to 6.24 in MP. However, it up by 12.74 to 9.91 in Karnataka and 11.15 % to 2.77 lakh ha in Telangana. It is down by 4.05% to 12.20 in Maharashtra. Overall Tur area is up slightly from last year. There is report of some damage in MP and Rajasthan. But higher acreage in other states and good rainfall may increase yield too. So there is a good hope for bumper crop once again.more downward trend in Tur is unlikely.steady to slightly firm trend might be seen.
- Govt has published 4t Adv estimate for 2017-18 Vs 2016-17 on 28th Aug-2018. For Tur it is 4.25/4.87MMT, For Chana it is 11.23/9.38MMT, For Urad it is 3.56/2.83MMT, For Moon it is 2.01/2.17MMT, for Masur it is 1.61/1.21MMT.

Pulses International Fundamental:

Today's Update:

- Global Chickpeas market traded almost unchanged last week as trading activities were seen limited in nature. Some stake holders and buyers expects market to move further down from current level and they are waiting for downward correction. Notably, they have to buy for winter season needs. Harvesting in Canada is almost 30 5 over by the first week of Sep. Available chickpeas from new crop is said to be 79000 MT. It is much higher than 37,000 MT last year at this point of time.
- Marketing year 2017-18 for chickpeas in US is over now and prevailing prices are ruling higher by 5% from last three years annual average price in local market. The average price paid for California 9mm Chickpeas was USD\$47.85 per 100 pounds (cwt), compared to an average annual bid of \$41.92 during the latest three year period for farmers. Farmers had received the highest bid(\$55 per cwt) in January while the lowest bid was received in August(\$34 per cwt).
- Farmers in Australia are facing rough winter season and it has prompted Abares(Australian government commodity forecaster) to revise down winter grain production by 12% from last year,s total winter grain production. The latest crop report is tipping winter production including wheat, barley, canola, pulses and oats, among others to yield 33.2 million tonnes. States like Queensland and New South Wales hit hard by drought, production is expected to drop by 38 to 46 per cent in both states. Chickpeas production is expected to drop by 69 % to 3.51 lakh tonne.

Previous Update:

- With bearish USDA crop report global chickpea market traded under pressure. However, lower crop size in Australia & Tanzania may support chickpeas amarket in coming weeks. Production of chickpea in US may jump to a record level this year. Area under chickpea in US has increased from 623800 acres to 822,000 acres. The USDA reckons farmers planted 211,200 acres of small chickpeas, up from 179,500 last year; and 608,500 acres of large, compared to last year's 439,300 acres. Higher area in US can make up lower crop size in Australia to some extent. Fundamental for chickpea has started changing into positive now. It may continue to support global chickpea market.
- Global field pea markets ended weak on the back of likely pressure from the commencement of harvesting in northern hemisphere countries. Pea harvesting in Canada has been pegged at 21 % against 28% last year till 20th August. However, it is higheer of recent average of 19%. As condition for harvesting is very congenial due to dry and hot weather condition, pace of harvesting would increase and pressure might be felt on physical market soon in Canada.
- As per the USDA first production estimate for new crop Chickpea and dry edible bean in US may move up to 16.3 lakh tonne in 2018.Seeded area is estimated at 2.05 million acres, down 2% from 2017.Harvested area has been pegged at 1.99 million acres, down by 1 percent from last year.It(production) was 16.7 lakh tonne last year.
- France Pea marketing season ended with 2.85 lakh tonne, down by 2% from last year. According to data released byEurostat and TerresUnivia export shipments during June totaled 16,775 metric tons, down 6% from the 17,910 MT shipped last month.Belgium was the most important destination, taking 10,560 MT. Netherlands was the second most important destination at 3,120 MT, followed by Italy at 1,535 MT and Spain at 587 MT.
- Lentil Production in Turkey has been pegged down by 12% to 3.8lakh tonne from last year. The reason of lower production is mainly attributed to bad weather condition in parts of south eastern region. Harvesting is over by first week of July. In some particular region farmers have lost 50 % yield due to heavy rains and water lodging. However chickpeas area increased due to govt.'s support and higher return in 2018. The major chickpeas producing regions are Central Anatolia and somewhat in the



Southeastern region. This year chickpeas production has been pegged at 5.5 lakh tonne, up by 15 % from last year. The GOT announced the MY 2018/19 chickpeas procurement price on June 25, 2018 at 3,250 TL/MT (around \$700/MT).

- Canada lentil area is said to be lower than intended by one million acres to 3.77 MMT.Agri experts expected it to be 4.05 million acres. Actually, at the time of sowing prices remained subdued and it impacted farmers to reduce area from 4.05 to 3.37 million ha. Canada had planted 4.4million acres in 2018.Under current prevailing condition production would be only slip from last year's 2.559 million metric ton (MT) harvest to 2.495 million this year.
- Chickpeas area in Canada & US has been registered higher than previous intention. US farmers have planted6.62 lakh acres against intention of 6.65 lakh acres. Farmers have covered 2.05 lakh acres under small chickpeas while Kabuli area increased from 3.46 to 4.57 lakh acres this year. Chickpeas area in Canada increased from3.46 to 4.68 lakh acres. Unofficial Statistics Canada data suggests Canada planted 13,8000 acres of desi, 445,900 acres of kabuli and 9,200 acres of other types such as B-90.

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade range bound.
