

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- **Kabuli Chana traded weak by Rs100 to Rs150 per qtl. due to liquidity crunch and** stockists' release. Sowing commenced in the region of Rayalseema line in Karnataka. Besides, it would commence from 15th Oct. in Indore, Bhopal line. Despite the beginning of sowing, old stock in market is sufficient to cater the need for domestic market, so any spike is unlikely in the short to medium term despite import decreased by 80% from last year. So steady to slightly firm tone prevail before new crop hits the market.
- **Lemon Tur in Mumbai market is being traded at Rs3375 to 3450 per qtl, depending** on quality of crop. millers are active in buying in Narela, Bawana and Raiee line at Rs3550-3575 per qtl. new buying spree may push up price by Rs100 -150 from current level. Notably, arrival from Jaitua Tur in Katni, Indore line has decreased considerably. There is no supply from Nimuch line. So Agriwatch expects market to move up despite imported stock from Sudan and Mozambique is available. Imported stock is decreasing now. Millers are buying imported Tur and selling it at Rs5500-5600 in Varanasi, Dewaria and Gorakhpur line on delivered basis. As imported stock is decreasing, market is expected to get support at this level. Report of crop loss in Karnataka too seems favorable for cash market.

Previous Update:

- **Chana arrivals in all major markets like Delhi, Nohar, Bhadra, Sawai Madhopur and Bikaner line** has decreased by 70-75% now at this point of time and stock in physical market is said to be lower by 50% from last year. Besides, there is no chance of import due to 70% duty and lower crop size (3.51 lakh tonne) in Australia. Demand from mills started increasing. So fundamental for cash market remains firm in the medium term. Actually, market seems disturbed due to bears game in futures and Nafed selling below MSP. However, it would not last long. Govt. may instruct Nafed to sell near MSP level. Agriwatch expects market to move up from current level. Export incentive might be increased. So stock holders should retain stock till Diwali. By then planting intensification too would be clear and govt. may increase MSP for rabi crop too on the pattern adopted for kharif crop. Cash market may move up to the level of Rs 4500-4600 by end Oct.
- **Lemon Tur in Mumbai market is being traded at Rs3375 to 3450 per qtl, depending on** quality of crop. millers are active in buying in Narela, Bawana and Raiee line at Rs3550-3575 per qtl. new buying spree may push up price by Rs100 -150 from current level. Notably, arrival from Jaitua Tur in Katni, Indore line has decreased considerably. There is no supply from Nimuch line. So Agriwatch expects market to move up despite imported stock from Sudan and Mozambique is available. Imported stock is decreasing now. Millers are buying imported Tur and selling it at Rs5500-5600 in Varanasi, Dewaria and Gorakhpur line on delivered basis. As imported stock is decreasing, market is expected to get support at this level. Report of crop loss in Karnataka too seems favorable for cash market.
- **India imported 29172 MT chickpea from March to Aug-2018 at an average price of \$633.49 per tonne.** In August it imported 14430 MT against nil in July-2018. During the same period India exported 1.98 lakh MT including kabuli chana and dal at an average price of \$1132.98 per MT. For other pulses see table at page no-12. Total import in August was registered at 261005 MT. With 84401 MT Tur scored the highest volume followed by Urad at 68910 MT.
- **All India kharif Pulses area is lagging behind by 1.11 % to 137.93 against 139.49 lakh ha** last year as on 20th Sep-2018. Farmers have covered 45.83 lakh ha against 45.56 last year under Tur till date, higher by 0.58% from last year. Normal area under Tur is 41.90 lakh ha. However, Urad area is lagging behind by 8.97 % to 40.37 against 44.35 lakh ha. Normal area of kharif Urad is 27 lakh ha. Moong area is running up by 7.41 % to 34.36 lakh ha against 31.99 lakh ha last year. Normal area under Moong is 24.93 lakh ha. Other pulses area too is down by 0.45 % than last year. It is 16.46 against 16.53 lakh ha so far against normal of 15.83 lakh ha. Area under Kulthi has decreased by 13.08 % to 0.92 lakh ha against normal of 2.27 lakh ha so far.
- **MP state govt. has extended the date for kharif crops registration for 10 days to 29th Sep-2018.** The decision has been taken on the basis of information received from various farmers association that many farmers could not get themselves registered till 19th Sep. The decision would help farmers who are still unregistered.
- **Lower area coverage by 12.5 to 38.02 lakh ha so far in comparison to last year till 1st week of Sep** and import cap of 1.5 lakh tonne for the year amid report of crop loss in Rajasthan and Maharashtra may lend support to **urad** cash market in coming

weeks. Arrival of old Urad in mandis is almost over now. However, old stock is available in Shivpuri, Katni Agra, Bhopal line in plenty. Lower stock of imported Urad and likely procurement at new MSP may push up price to a certain extent. Demand is weak and may improve from Oct.

- **Burma offered Tur Lemon at \$350 per MT basis CNF Indian port. Linkly, Old and new lemon Tur quotes remain same.** FAQ Urad is being offered at \$355 and SQ at \$475 per MT basis CNF Indian port. Kabuli Chana is being offered at 4655 and Hollan at 4690 per MT basis CNF. Moong Pakaku is being offered at \$710 per MT. CNF quotes have improved slightly in past two weeks.
- **Govt has published 4t Adv estimate for 2017-18 Vs 2016-17 on 28th Aug-2018. For Tur it is 4.25/4.87MMT, For Chana it is 11.23/9.38MMT, For Urad it is 3.56/2.83MMT, For Moong it is 2.01/2.17MMT, for Masur it is 1.61/1.21MMT.**

Pulses International Fundamental:

Today's Update:

- **Global chickpea market traded steady during the week under review, Demand remains weak and higher availability of medium and small chana continues to weigh on market fundamental.** Statistics Canada has pegged chickpea production higher by 7% to 282,800 MT against provincial agri dept. estimate of 202,400 MT for 2018-19. Other agency have estimated production at 2.64 lakh tonne against 1.02 lakh tonne in 2018-17-18. Prices are likely to move in the range of \$450 to \$480 per tonne.
- **Chickpeas export from Canada increased by 16% from 108 to 116 thousand MT for 2017-18** due to aggressive buying by Turkey and EU. Despite India being out of global market carryout remained almost unchanged at 1 thousand MT like previous year. The average price decreased slightly from \$1000 to \$950 per MT in 2017-18 due to tight global side. This year (for 2018-19) production is expected to increase sharply due to higher area. Major chickpeas growing states are Saskatchewan and Alberta where maximum chickpeas are produced, almost 90 percent. Total supply is expected to increase from 150 to 273 thousand MT due to higher production estimate in 2018-19. Import is expected to remain at lower level and it may decrease from 47 to 8 thousand MT this year. Average price is expected to decrease considerably as global supply side is ample right now. It may hinge in between \$450 to \$485 per MT. Area in US is expected to increase to 0.66 million acres. Production in US may increase to 0.43 MMT in 2018-19.

Previous Update:

- **Marketing year 2017-18 for chickpeas in US is over now and prevailing prices are ruling higher by 5% from last three years annual average price in local market.** The average price paid for California 9mm Chickpeas was USD \$47.85 per 100 pounds (cwt), compared to an average annual bid of \$41.92 during the latest three year period for farmers. Farmers had received the highest bid (\$55 per cwt) in January while the lowest bid was received in August (\$34 per cwt).
- **With bearish USDA crop report global chickpea market traded under pressure. However,** lower crop size in Australia & Tanzania may support chickpeas a market in coming weeks. Production of chickpea in US may jump to a record level this year. Area under chickpea in US has increased from 623,800 acres to 822,000 acres. The USDA reckons farmers planted 211,200 acres of small chickpeas, up from 179,500 last year; and 608,500 acres of large, compared to last year's 439,300 acres. Higher area in US can make up lower crop size in Australia to some extent. Fundamental for chickpea has started changing into positive now. It may continue to support global chickpea market.
- **Global field pea markets ended weak on the back of likely pressure from the commencement of harvesting** in northern hemisphere countries. Pea harvesting in Canada has been pegged at 21% against 28% last year till 20th August. However, it is higher of recent average of 19%. As condition for harvesting is very congenial due to dry and hot weather condition, pace of harvesting would increase and pressure might be felt on physical market soon in Canada.
- **As per the USDA first production estimate for new crop Chickpea and dry edible bean in US may move up to 16.3 lakh tonne in 2018.** Seeded area is estimated at 2.05 million acres, down 2% from 2017. Harvested area has been pegged at 1.99 million acres, down by 1 percent from last year. It (production) was 16.7 lakh tonne last year.
