

## **Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:**

### **Today's Update:**

- **Lentil market is expected to trade steady to firm. As of now, Import demand from Bangladesh is low as Indian export quotes are high.** Nepal is offering lentils around \$800 per tonne for export to Bangladesh. Quality of Indian lentils is better than lentils offered by Nepal. However, there is no short supply in the market. Stake holders should buy on dip. Govt. has accepted the CACP recommendation of hike in Chana & Lentils MSP for Rabi marketing year 2019-20. Chana & Masur MSP has been increased from Rs 4400 & Rs 4250 to Rs 4620 & Rs 4475 per quintal respectively. Furthermore, an analysis of cost of production of Rabi crops shows that farmers will get a maximum return of 75.2 percent for gram and 76.7 percent for lentils.
- **Lentil market is expected to trade steady to firm. As of now, Import demand from Bangladesh is low as Indian export quotes are high.** Nepal is offering lentils around \$800 per tonne for export to Bangladesh. Quality of Indian lentils is better than lentils offered by Nepal. However, there is no short supply in the market. Stake holders should buy on dip.
- **Nafed had procured 2686475.7 MT chana in Rabi 2018 season in 8 states and out of total procured quantity it has managed to sell only 49474MT so far. It succeeded to sell 25150 MT in Karnataka and 15914MT in Rajasthan as on 8th October-2018.** Now total quantity left for sale is 2637001.7MT. As kharif procurement for 2018-19 is on, sale is likely to continue. Five to six months is left for consumption and monthly requirement is around 7.5 lakh tonne. If Nafed sells 3 to 3.5 lakh tonne per month, it would be able to sell 20-21 lakh tonne until new crop hits the market. The rest required quantity would be supplied by open market. Around 20 lakh tonne chana is said to be available with private trade. So supply demand side seems balanced right now. So any major jump in chana price would depend on planting area this year. If area decreases (likely 10%), export incentive is increased from previous 7 to 15 %, chana price may move up above MSP this year.

### **Previous Update:**

- **Burma is offering lemon tur at \$365 per tonne on cif basis Indian ports. Urad FAQ is being offered at \$410 and SQ at \$575 per tonne.** Chana V2 Kabuli and Hollan are offered at \$ 630 & \$660 per tonne respectively. Moong Pakaku at \$765. Red Rajma is being offered at 41150 per MT basis CiF, Indian port.
- **Indian farmers have planted 34.36 lakh ha under kharif moong, it is higher than last year by 2.37 lakh ha.** Lower rainfall during growth stages and higher rainfall at maturity stages affected the quality of moong. Even grains turned black spotted. So there would be good demand for quality crop at higher rate. Import remains restricted and millers can import only 1.5 lakh tonne moong till March 2019. Arrivals from Karnataka, UP and Bihar have started declining. So Agriwatch expects moong price to move up in coming weeks. Govt agencies would procure moong at Rs 6975 per qtl.
- **MP govt. is ready to buy Urad and Moong through MP Markfed & state civil supply corporation under price support scheme on MSP and procurement is likely soon.** Procurement for tur is expected from March-2019. Around 25 lakh farmers have got themselves registered so far for selling their produce on MSP. It would ensure MSP for them as prevailing price of pulses is still ruling below MSP. Central govt has given approval to AP state govt. for Urad buying during kharif 2018 season. New crop has started hitting the market. Approval has been given for 5324 MT Urad procurement.
- **DES has come out with 1st Adv est. for kharif pulses on 26th Sep-2018.** Tur production for 2017-18 has been finalized at 4.25 MMT. It has estimated 4.05 MMT for 2018-19 against the set target of 4.25 MMT. It has fixed 2.28 MMT kharif Urad production for 2017-18. For 2018-19 it has projected 2.65 MMT against set target of 2.0 MMT. Rabi target has been fixed at 0.8 MMT for 2018-19 against 0.73 MMT in 2017-18. Moong kharif production has been pegged at 1.44 MMT for 2017-18. It has estimated 1.58 MMT for 2018-19 against set target of 1.4 MMT. Last year India had produced 0.57 MMT in rabi season in 2017-18. Total pulses production would decrease from 9.34 to 9.22 MMT in 2018-19 in kharif season.
- **Lemon Tur in Mumbai market is being traded at Rs3375 to 3450 per qtl, depending on quality of crop.** Millers are active in buying in Narela, Bawana and Rahee line at Rs3550-3575 per qtl. New buying spree may push up price by Rs100 -150 from current level. Notably, arrival from Jaitua Tur in Katni, Indore line has decreased considerably. There is no supply from Nimuch line. So Agriwatch expects market to move up despite imported stock from Sudan and Mozambique is available. Imported stock is decreasing now. Millers are buying imported Tur and selling it at Rs5500-5600 in Varanasi, Dewaria and Gorakhpur.

line on delivered basis. As imported stock is decreasing, market is expected to get support at this level. Report of crop loss in Karnataka too seems favorable for cash market.

#### **Pulses International Fundamental:**

##### **Today's Update:**

- **Canadian chickpeas market traded unstable during the week under review as temperature in growing belts** was seen at freezing point at the time of harvesting. Around 25 % crop is yet to be harvested. Quality concern for standing crop is increasing. Market experts say that crop size may be lower than previous expectation. It may decline from 2.83 to 2.58 lakh tonne as per Canada statistics.

##### **Previous Update:**

- **Global chickpea market traded steady during the week under review, Demand remains weak** and higher availability of medium and small chana continues to weigh on market fundamental. Statistics Canada has pegged chickpea production higher by 7% to 282,800 MT against provincial agri dept. estimate of 202,400 MT for 2018-19. Other agency have estimated production at 2.64 lakh tonne against 1.02 lakh tonne in 2018-17-18. Prices are likely to move in the range of \$450 to \$480 per tonne.
- **Chickpeas export from Canada increased by 16% from 108 to 116 thousand MT for 2017-18** due to aggressive buying by Turkey and EU. Despite India being out of global market carryout remained almost unchanged at 1 thousand MT like previous year. The average price decreased slightly from \$1000 to \$950 per MT in 2017-18 due to tight global side. This year (for 2018-19) production is expected to increase sharply due to higher area. Major chickpeas growing states are Saskatchewan and Alberta where maximum chickpeas are produced, almost 90 percent. Total supply is expected to increase from 150 to 273 thousand MT due to higher production estimate in 2018-19. Import is expected to remain at lower level and it may decrease from 47 to 8 thousand MT this year. Average price is expected to decrease considerably as global supply side is ample right now. It may hinge in between \$450 to \$485 per MT. Area in US is expected to increase to 0.66 million acres. Production in US may increase to 0.43 MMT in 2018-19.
- **Marketing year 2017-18 for chickpeas in US is over now and prevailing prices are ruling** higher by 5% from last three years annual average price in local market. The average price paid for California 9mm Chickpeas was USD \$47.85 per 100 pounds (cwt), compared to an average annual bid of \$41.92 during the latest three year period for farmers. Farmers had received the highest bid (\$55 per cwt) in January while the lowest bid was received in August (\$34 per cwt).
- **With bearish USDA crop report global chickpea market traded under pressure. However,** lower crop size in Australia & Tanzania may support chickpeas market in coming weeks. Production of chickpea in US may jump to a record level this year. Area under chickpea in US has increased from 623,800 acres to 822,000 acres. The USDA reckons farmers planted 211,200 acres of small chickpeas, up from 179,500 last year; and 608,500 acres of large, compared to last year's 439,300 acres. Higher area in US can make up lower crop size in Australia to some extent. Fundamental for chickpea has started changing into positive now. It may continue to support global chickpea market.
- **Global field pea markets ended weak on the back of likely pressure from the commencement of harvesting** in northern hemisphere countries. Pea harvesting in Canada has been pegged at 21 % against 28% last year till 20th August. However, it is higher of recent average of 19%. As condition for harvesting is very congenial due to dry and hot weather condition, pace of harvesting would increase and pressure might be felt on physical market soon in Canada.
- **As per the USDA first production estimate for new crop Chickpea and dry edible bean in US** may move up to 16.3 lakh tonne in 2018. Seeded area is estimated at 2.05 million acres, down 2% from 2017. Harvested area has been pegged at 1.99 million acres, down by 1 percent from last year. It (production) was 16.7 lakh tonne last year.

**Weekly Outlook:** -Pulses are likely to trade steady to slightly firm.
