

## **Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:**

### **Today's Update:**

- **Cash pulses market traded range bound amid sluggish trading activities on the eve of Navratra.** Fresh trading activities are expected to begin from next week. As demand is improving, market is expected to trade slightly firm in the short to medium term.
- **Chickpea export from India increased by 16.1% to 26194.87 MT in Sep-2018.** It was 22567.74 MT in Aug. Even Tur export increased by 193% to 159137 MT in Sep. India had managed to sell 543.18 MT tur in Aug-2018. Even lentil export increased by 40.6 % to 1000.45 MT in Sep-2018 against 711.75 MT in Aug. Black matpe and Moong export increased by 152 & 20 % respectively to 761.82 MT against 301.65 & 1903.88 MT and 1903.88 against 1586.75 MT. India exported total 180838.1 MT chickpea from April to Aug-2018. It exported 6403.78 MT Tur during same period. India exported 5192.35 MT lentil, 4539.34 MT Urad, 10462.8 MT Moong during same period.

### **Previous Update:**

- **Chana prices Cash chana market traded slightly weak in Delhi market and it traded at Rs4300-4350 (Rajasthan line) and Rs 4250-75 (MP line).** Arrival in Delhi market was reported at 15-20 motors. Australian chana in Mumbai was quoted at Rs4100 while it was traded at Rs 4150-4175 at Mundra, Kandla ports. Chana Kanta in Rajkot market was traded at Rs3850-3875 and Desi at Rs 3850-3860. Arrival was registered at 700 bags. Chana cash market is expected to trade steady to slightly firm despite Nafed selling at various states. Festive demand would continue to support chana market at current level. Private stock is said to be lower at 1.5 to 1.8 MMT, lower than 0.5 to 0.6 MMT as per market source. So maximum stock is with Nafed.
- **Urad arrival from kharif crop is lower by 20 % than normal expectation and there is a quality issue too** with rains affected crop. As crop size is lower and procurement under price support scheme, Bhavantar Yojna is about to begin. Besides, demand is expected to improve from current level due to festive season while import volume would be limited at 1.5 lakh tonne. So Agriwatch expects market to move up from current level during the period of procurement. As govt. agencies have stopped auction, it too would support Urad market in coming weeks. Besides, futures in Urad & Tur is likely as concerned authorities seem ready to allow it once again after 2007. Now Sebi has to decide. Overall outlook remains firm for Urad.
- **For supporting cash Tur and Urad market govt. seems ready to start futures in Tur and Urad.** Notably, govt had banned futures in both commodities in 2007 due to unexpected spike in price. Various concerned ministries too seem in favor of re-launching futures and a proposal in this regard may be sent to SEBI and decision is expected by the end of Oct. Higher stock available in domestic market including central pool, average to normal crop crop so far would not allow market to move one way up despite higher MSP. Current festive demand may help market to recover from current lower level by Rs 200-250 in a couple of week. New crop is expected to hit market by Dec and before Dec govt would like to offload as much stock as it can. It would restrict market to a certain level. In arrival season, Tur market would move up as govt would start procurement at MSP. However, Nov would be very crucial month for standing crop. Any aberration in weather condition may affect yield and its impact might be seen on price. In Gulberga market lemon tur is being traded at Rs 3600-3700. Buyers are expected to be active at this level.
- **Old, new and linkely Burma lemon tur was offered at \$340 basis CiF Indian ports .It was down by \$10-15 per tonne** in last two-three days. As prices remain stable in Indian market, demand from Indian importers has come down and pressure is being seen on Myanmar market. Even Urad FAQ and SQ was quoted down by \$10 to \$410 & \$550 per MT. Chana v2 Kabuli and Hollan were offered at \$630 and \$660 per MT at Indian port. Chana CiF price may move up further as domestic market may move up further. Chana stock in private hands is said to be much lower than 2 MMT. Moong Pakaku is being offered at \$765 per MT while rajma at \$1150 per MT.
- **Lentil market is expected to trade steady to firm. As of now, Import demand from Bangladesh is low** as Indian export quotes are high. Nepal is offering lentils around \$800 per tonne for export to Bangladesh. Quality of Indian lentils is better than lentils offered by Nepal. However, there is no short supply in the market. Stake holders should buy on dip. Govt. has accepted the CACP recommendation of hike in Chana & Lentils MSP for Rabi marketing year 2019-20. Chana & Masur MSP has been increased from Rs 4400 & Rs 4250 to Rs 4620 & Rs 4475 per quintal respectively. Furthermore, an analysis of cost of production of Rabi crops shows that farmers will get a maximum return of 75.2 percent for gram and 76.7 percent for lentils.

### Pulses International Fundamental:

#### Today's Update:

- **Global chickpea markets traded almost steady while pressure continues on small and medium calibri chickpea** due to weak demand and higher production estimate for US chickpea. USDA production estimate for this year's crop is at higher side at 5.71 lakh MT. It is around 80 % higher than last year when chickpea production was registered at 3.16 lakh MT. Yield and area too are higher this year with favorable weather condition. Farmers had planted a total of 853,146 acres of chickpeas this year. Out of total acreage Kabuli share was 632,482 acres, small chickpea 209,338 acres & desi 11,326 acres.

#### Previous Update:

- **As per USDA, dry bean production in U.S. is expected to fall by 6 percent to 1.23 MMT even** after 20 percent decrease in sowing as yields are expected to be higher compared to last year. Dry bean exports from U.S. have registered a 12 percent increase during September'17- June'18 compared to September'16- June'17. Top destinations included Mexico, Canada, Italy and UK.
- **Canadian Dry edible bean and chickpea production in US is expected to increase by 6 % to 1.71 MMT** from last year - according to the latest USDA crop production report. Other agencies have projected production in the range of 1.68 to 1.77 MMT this year. Chickpeas production has crossed the production size of pinto bean. However, harvested area is said to be 1 percent lower than last year to 2.01 million acres. Yield estimate has been put at 1884 pounds per acre, higher by 103 pounds per acre from last year. Notably, yield is at record high in Michigan, Minnesota, and Nebraska.
- **According to the latest data released from Eurostat Peas export from France in MY 2018-19** through August has not been up to the mark despite higher by 31 % from August-2018. France exported 22415 MT peas in Sep against 17310MT in August. However, it is 74% lower than shipment in Sep-2017. It was 87310 MT in Sep 2018. Belgium was the most important destination, taking 10,970 MT. Norway was the second most important destination at 6,195 MT, followed by Netherlands at 2,350 and Spain at 1,375 MT.
- **Canadian chickpeas market traded unstable during the week under review as temperature in growing belts** was seen at freezing point at the time of harvesting. Around 25 % crop is yet to be harvested. Quality concern for standing crop is increasing. Market experts say that crop size may be lower than previous expectation. It may decline from 2.83 to 2.58 lakh tonne as per Canada statistics.
- **Global chickpea market traded steady during the week under review, Demand remains weak** and higher availability of medium and small chana continues to weigh on market fundamental. Statistics Canada has pegged chickpea production higher by 7% to 282,800 MT against provincial agri dept. estimate of 202,400MT for 2018-19. Other agency have estimated production at 2.64 lakh tonne against 1.02 lakh tonne in 2018-17-18. Prices are likely to move in the range of \$450 to \$480 per tonne.
- **Chickpeas export from Canada increased by 16% from 108 to 116 thousand MT for 2017-18** due to aggressive buying by turkey and EU. Despite India being out of global market carryout remained almost unchanged at 1 thousand MT like previous year. The average price decreased slightly from \$1000 to \$950 per MT in 2017-18 due to tight global side. This year (for 2018-19) production is expected to increase sharply due to higher area. Major chickpeas growing states are Saskatchewan and Alberta where maximum chickpeas are produced, almost 90 percent. Total supply is expected to increase from 150 to 273 thousand MT due to higher production estimate in 2018-19. Import is expected to remain at lower level and it may decrease from 47 to 8 thousand MT this year. Average price is expected to decrease considerably as global supply side is ample right now. It may hinge in between \$450 to \$485 per MT. Area in US is expected to increase to 0.66 million acres. Production in US may increase to 0.43 MMT in 2018-19.
- **With bearish USDA crop report global chickpea market traded under pressure.** However, lower crop size in Australia & Tanzania may support chickpeas market in coming weeks. Production of chickpea in US may jump to a record level this year. Area under chickpea in US has increased from 623800 acres to 822,000 acres. The USDA reckons farmers planted 211,200 acres of small chickpeas, up from 179,500 last year; and 608,500 acres of large, compared to last year's 439,300 acres. Higher area in US can make up lower crop size in Australia to some extent. Fundamental for chickpea has started changing into positive now. It may continue to support global chickpea market.

**Weekly Outlook:** -Pulses are likely to trade range bound.
