

## **Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:**

### **Today's Update:**

- **Overall rainfall activity was recorded normal to above normal over Kerala, Karnataka and Maharashtra during 1st week.** During 2nd week, rainfall activity is likely to be above normal over Tamilnadu & Kerala and below normal over Western Himalayan region. However, good post monsoon is required in central and North India for smooth rabi sowing
- **Maharashtra Govt extends Registration deadline for Moong, Urad & Soybean to 15th Nov-2018.** Earlier it was till 24 Oct for Urad & Moong and 31st Oct for soybean. It has provided farmers much space for further registration. This means availability of Moong & Urad would decrease further for trades. Mostly farmers would prefer to sell their produce to Govt.'s agencies. It would help market to recover further.
- **Chana could not extend its loss despite bears activeness in futures and Nafed Selling.** Nafed is continuously selling and it would continue to sale to feed the market needs. However, stock position considered to be 4 to 4.2 MMT including private stock against requirement of 4 MMT till Feb-2019. So, if area decreases this year or new crop faces rough weather from growth to maturity stages, prices would move up towards MSP level. Import is not possible at higher duty. There is a gossip in the market that cash market is unlikely to move down from current level. Demand is improving and uncertainty prevails on area right now. Chana in Delh market is being traded at Rs4150 to 4250. It would move up after Diwali.
- **Tur demand from retail market has started improving and it would continue till Nov.** Old stock is coming down amid fear of lower yield is increasing due to less rainfall in Karnataka, Maharashtra and AP. In other states post monsoon rainfall is required. So next 30 days are very crucial. Govt. would procure new crop at higher MSP and around 30 to 40 % crop is expected to be procured by govt.'s agencies. So any downside movement is unlikely. In Gulberga market tur is being traded at Rs 3700-3900 per qtl. depending on quality.

### **Previous Update:**

- **Farmers are waiting for post monsoon rains as prevailing dry like condition may affect yield of Tur in Maharashtra and south India.** It has started affecting rabi sowing. Farmers have started retaining stock of Moong & Urad in various growing regions. They are preferring to sell their crop to Govt.'s agencies. Arrival in markets have decreased considerably in last one week. Flow of moong from Shekhavati, Kekri, Kishangarh line is decreasing, local traders are buying there and arrival flow would continue to decrease.
- **Moonga arrival from UP too is lower than normal expectation. There is no arrival from Ranchi in Bihar.** Arrival from Kanpur and Allahabad line continues and it is being consumed. However, flow is likely to decrease and would support cash market at current level. Stockists are unwilling to buy. It would drag price up by Rs300-400 in coming weeks.
- **India exported total 224176 MT chickpea from March to Sep-2018.** However, volume of dal and kabuli chana is higher. In Sep, India exported 26195 MT chickpeas/dal at an average FoB price of \$936.41 per MT. In Aug, it has exported 22568 MT chickpea.. If govt. gives higher incentive (10 to 15% likely), volume of export is likely to go up further. Australia has not much stock to offer due to lower crop size this year (3.51 lakh tonne only).
- **India imported total 47501 MT chickpea from Mar to Sep-2018 .Import volume increased from 14430 to 18329 MT in Sep.** Average monthly price of imported chickpea is coming down from \$634.56 in Aug to \$597.45 per MT in Sep. Import volume increased by 27.02 % to 18329 MT while CiF price decreased by 5.84% to \$ 597.45 per MT.
- **White pea, Chana & Masur stock at Mundra port as on 20th Oct-2018 was registered at 196783, 83587 & 67016 MT respectively .** It was 22695 MT, 14038 MT & 13730 MT at Kandla port. White pea and Chana stock at Hazira port was registered at 54991 and 13317 MT. In Mumbai white pea stock was registered at 10000 MT. Total stock of white pea as on 20 Oct was registered 284469 MT, Chana at 97615 MT & Masur at 94064 MT
- **Lentil market is expected to trade steady to firm. As of now, Import demand from Bangladesh is low as** Indian export quotes are high. Nepal is offering lentils around \$800 per tonne for export to Bangladesh. Quality of Indian lentils is better than lentils offered by Nepal. However, there is no short supply in the market. Stake holders should buy on dip. Govt. has accepted the CACP recommendation of hike in Chana & Lentils MSP for Rabi marketing year 2019-20. Chana & Masur MSP has been increased from Rs 4400 & Rs 4250 to Rs 4620 & Rs 4475 per quintal respectively. Furthermore, an analysis of cost of production of Rabi crops shows that farmers will get a maximum return of 75.2 percent for gram and 76.7 percent for lentils.

### Pulses International Fundamental:

#### Today's Update:

- **Chickpea market traded steady to slightly lower as supply from farmer's end was seen higher than actual demand.** Demand from North American millers/exporters remained weak. It continued to pressurize chickpea prices. Offering for farmers too. Pulses Daily Report 8 24th Oct-2018 have decreased. Farmers are getting 21% lower price now in comparison to mid Aug-2018. Canadian Farmers too are getting 13 % lower price during the period. As demand remains weak, any spike in global chickpea market is unlikely. Major buyers, India, remains out of the market. Range bound movement might be seen in the short term.
- **USDA production estimate for this year's crop is at higher side at 5.71 lakh MT. It is around 80 % higher than last year when chickpea production was registered at 3.16 lakh MT.** Yield and area too are higher this year with favorable weather condition. Farmers had planted a total of 853,146 acres of chickpeas this year. Out of total acreage Kabuli share was 632,482 acres, small chickpea 209,338 acres & desi 11,326 acres.

#### Previous Update:

- **As per USDA, dry bean production in U.S. is expected to fall by 6 percent to 1.23 MMT even after 20 percent decrease in sowing as yields are expected to be higher compared to last year.** Dry bean exports from U.S. have registered a 12 percent increase during September'17- June'18 compared to September'16- June'17. Top destinations included Mexico, Canada, Italy and UK.
- **Canadian Dry edible bean and chickpea production in US is expected to increase by 6 % to 1.71 MMT from last year - according to the latest USDA crop production report.** Other agencies have projected production in the range of 1.68 to 1.77 MMT this year. Chickpeas production has crossed the production size of pinto bean. However, harvested area is said to be 1 percent lower than last year to 2.01 million acres. Yield estimate has been put at 1884 pounds per acre, higher by 103 pounds per acre from last year. Notably, yield is at record high in Michigan, Minnesota, and Nebraska.
- **According to the latest data released from Eurostat Peas export from France in MY 2018-19 through August has not been up to the mark despite higher by 31 % from August-2018.** France exported 22415 MT peas in Sep against 17310 MT in August. However, it is 74% lower than shipment in Sep-2017. It was 87310 MT in Sep 2018. Belgium was the most important destination, taking 10,970 MT. Norway was the second most important destination at 6,195 MT, followed by Netherlands at 2,350 and Spain at 1,375 MT.
- **Canadian chickpeas market traded unstable during the week under review as temperature in growing belts was seen at freezing point at the time of harvesting.** Around 25 % crop is yet to be harvested. Quality concern for standing crop is increasing. Market experts say that crop size may be lower than previous expectation. It may decline from 2.83 to 2.58 lakh tonne as per Canada statistics.
- **Global chickpea market traded steady during the week under review, Demand remains weak and higher availability of medium and small chana continues to weigh on market fundamental.** Statistics Canada has pegged chickpea production higher by 7% to 282,800 MT against provincial agri dept. estimate of 202,400 MT for 2018-19. Other agency have estimated production at 2.64 lakh tonne against 1.02 lakh tonne in 2018-17-18. Prices are likely to move in the range of \$450 to \$480 per tonne.
- **Chickpeas export from Canada increased by 16% from 108 to 116 thousand MT for 2017-18** due to aggressive buying by Turkey and EU. Despite India being out of global market carryout remained almost unchanged at 1 thousand MT like previous year. The average price decreased slightly from \$1000 to \$950 per MT in 2017-18 due to tight global side. This year (for 2018-19) production is expected to increase sharply due to higher area. Major chickpeas growing states are Saskatchewan and Alberta where maximum chickpeas are produced, almost 90 percent. Total supply is expected to increase from 150 to 273 thousand MT due to higher production estimate in 2018-19. Import is expected to remain at lower level and it may decrease from 47 to 8 thousand MT this year. Average price is expected to decrease considerably as global supply side is ample right now. It may hinge in between \$450 to \$485 per MT. Area in US is expected to increase to 0.66 million acres. Production in US may increase to 0.43 MMT in 2018-19.

- **With bearish USDA crop report global chickpea market traded under pressure. However, lower crop size in Australia & Tanzania may support chickpeas market in coming weeks. Production of chickpea in US may jump to a record level this year. Area under chickpea in US has increased from 623800 acres to 822,000 acres. The USDA reckons farmers planted 211,200 acres of small chickpeas, up from 179,500 last year; and 608,500 acres of large, compared to last year's 439,300 acres. Higher area in US can make up lower crop size in Australia to some extent. Fundamental for chickpea has started changing into positive now. It may continue to support global chickpea market.**

**Weekly Outlook:** -Pulses are likely to trade range bound.
