

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- There is a news circulating in the market that govt may take action on pulses import at Chennai port in the name of stay order. Trades community has complained about higher than permitted volume of import. Now commerce ministry is gearing up for tackling excess import at Chennai port. Central govt may challenge stay order of Supreme Court. Fresh action may stop entering of pulses into Indian states imported at Chennai port. The quantity is said to be around 4 to5 lakh tonne. If it comes true. Pulses market may get further support.
- Chana sowing in Guajat decreased to half to 1 lakh ha so far this year against 2 lakh tonne last year. Sowing in AP is almost 35 % lower. There is no good report from Mah, Raj too. Weather too is not favorable. So, crop size this year is expected lower than normal expectation. It may push up chana price in coming weeks.
- Urad cash market is likely to trade up once again as buyers are active amid procurement by govt.'s agencies. Stock of urad at Indian port is down considerably and bulk import is not possible as stock in Burma is said to be lower and quotes are increasing continuously there. Burma is offering urad FAQ and SQ at \$630 and \$770 per MT basis Cif at Indian ports. Urad price in Latur and Udgir line is higher and it is being consumed locally. So supply is tight in other markets too. Even supply from Katni line is lower than normal expectation. It would continue to support cash market in coming weeks.

Previous Update:

- Urad cash market is likely to trade up once again as buyers are active amid procurement by govt.'s agencies. Stock of urad at Indian port is down considerably and bulk import is not possible as stock in Burma is said to be lower and quotes are increasing continuously there. Burma is offering urad FAQ and SQ at \$630 and \$770 per MT basis Cif at Indian ports. Urad price in Latur and Udgir line is higher and it is being consumed locally. So supply is tight in other markets too. Even supply from Katni line is lower than normal expectation. It would continue to support cash market in coming weeks.
- Moong market stayed steady due to lower supply in the cash market. Farmers and stockists are unwilling to sell stock at current price amid ongoing procurement drive in various states. Besides, New crop of moong from rabi season is unlikely to be available before Feb .Cost of moong from China and Uzbekistan is higher at around Rs 7600-7700 and Rs 6600-6700 per qtl respectively. Availability of moong in Myanmar too is lower. So millers are active in local market.. However, Agriwatch expects market to decrease by Rs100-150 from current level as mill may restrict buying for some times. They have fulfilled their immediate requirements. Ranchi line moong is being traded at Rs5200-5250 while Jodhpur line is being traded at5700. Moong in Jaipur market is being traded at Rs 5500. Overall tone in moong market remains firm. Myanmar too has increased CiF quote from \$750 to \$760 in last one week. Availability in Burma is lower too. Overall sentiments remain firm.
- India imported total 19707.72 MT tonne chickpea at an average CiF of \$519.03 per MT in October-2018. It is slightly higher than 18329.3 MT imported in Sep-2018. Importers had imported chickpeas at an average price of \$597.45 MT in Sep. Average imported price declined in Oct from \$597.45 to \$519.03 per MT. Total Chickpea/dal import from March to Oct was registered at 67209 MT. Against it chickpea export was registered at 244745.9 MT from Mar to Oct-2018. India exported 20570 MT chickpea/dal in Oct against 26194.87 MT in Sep. For other pulses see table given below at page no.3.
- **Tur** market traded slightly lower due to selling of lemon tur by importers at lower rate. Besides, millers too restricted buying in bulk that pushed cash market down by Rs100. But overall sentiments remains firm as incoming crop is not good yiel-wise and production is bound to decline to 36-37 lakh tone this year. Nafed and other agencies would try to offload maximum stock at higher level. It would cap any hope for spike in the near term. However, medium term outlook remains firm despite import parity from Myanmar to some extent. India cann't import beyond 3 lakh tone uptoMar-2019. India has already imported over 2 lakh tone tur frommar2018 to Sep-2018. So, importers can import only 1 lakh tone more beyond March-2019. So, Agriwatch expects cash market to move up from current level.
- Burma offers lemon tur at \$520 per MT basis CiF Indian port. Linkly and old too are offered at same price. Situation for standing Tur crop in India is not good and exporters in Myanmar are well aware of the fact. They may increase quotes further for forward delivery. Urad FAQ is being offered at \$600 per MT and SQ at \$730 basis Indian port. It is obvious that availability of quality crop in India is lower and prospects for rabi too is not looking good. So CiF quotes in Myanmar are increasing. Chana Kabuli and Hollan are being offered at \$650 per MT basis Cif Indian port. Moong Pakaku is being offered at \$735 per MT.



• Lentil market is expected to trade steady to firm. As of now, Import demand from Bangladesh is low as Indian export quotes are high. Nepal is offering lentils around \$800 per tonne for export to Bangladesh. Quality of Indian lentils is better than lentils offered by Nepal. However, there is no short supply in the market. Stake holders should buy on dip. Govt. has accepted the CACP recommendation of hike in Chana & Lentils MSP for Rabi marketing year 2019-20. Chana & Masur MSP has been increased from Rs 4400 & Rs 4250 to Rs 4620 & Rs 4475 per quintal respectively. Furthermore, an analysis of cost of production of Rabi crops shows that farmers will get a maximum return of 75.2 percent for gram and 76.7 percent for lentils.

Pulses International Fundamental:

Today's Update:

- Lentil production in Canada is expected to decrease from 25.59 lakh tonne to 22.30lakh tonne in For MY 2018-19.Despite lower production total supply is expected to increase from 29.09 to 31.27 lakh tonne due to better yield at 1.48 tonne per ha against 1.44 tonne per ha last year. Despite weak demand from India export is expected to increase from 15.40 to 19lakh tonne in MY2018-19.Domestic consumption has been pegged at 4. 2lakh tonne, same as last year. Carryout and stock would decrease from 8.76 to 7.35 lakh tonne. Average price for the year has been projected at \$340-370 per MT against \$475 per tonne last year. Harvested area has been pegged at 1509 thousand ha.
- Lower area coverage in Saskatchewan and Alberta which contributes 96% pea production in Canada, may reduce pea production by 9 % to 3.7 million tonne for MY 2018-19. In Canada, season starts from 1st August. Yellow pea production has been estimated at 2.9 million tonne while green pea production may increase 0.6 million tonne. Other pea production has been pegged at 1.85 lakh tonne. Weak Indian demand would affect export volume and it may decrease to 2.6 million tonne in 2018-19. from Aug to Sep China, B, desh and US has been main buyres for Canadian pea. Carryout stock is expected to increase from 6.6 to 9 lakh tonne for 2018-19. Average price is expected to decrease from \$265 to \$230-60 per MT in current MY.

Previous Update:

- Global chickpea market continued to trade slightly weak due to ample availability of stock in exporters hand against actual demand from importers. Quality issue with Canadian and some issues related to crop in Argentina could not support medium calibri chana. However, some extra demand emerged from the United States and other origins for better quality. As per Saskatchewan Agriculture estimate 58% of the province's chickpea crop will grade No 1 Canada, 37% No 2 Canada, and 5% No 3 Canada or worse. Last year, roughly 78% chickpeas graded No 1 and 22% No 2 in Canada. This means availability of poor quality crop would be higher.
- USDA production estimate for this year's crop is at higher side at 5.71lakh MT. It is around 80 % higher than last year when chickpea production was registered at 3.16 lakh MT. Yield and area too are higher this year with favorable weather condition. Farmers had planted a total of 853,146 acres of chickpeas this year. Out of total acreage Kabuli share was 632,482 acres, small chickpea 209,338 acres & desi 11,326 acres.
- Agriculture department of Canada has estimated 1% higher yield than Statistics Canada. the major difference has been seen in lentil production fig. Unofficial estimate points 23.7lakh MT production for lentil, which is almost 6% higher than Statistics Canada. Harvesting of all pulses is almost over now. Efforts of more export to other countries than India might be seen in coming weeks. Higher production estimate may cap uptrend in global lentil market in coming weeks
- As per USDA, dry bean production in U.S. is expected to fall by 6 percent to 1.23 MMT even after 20 percent decrease in sowing as yields are expected to be higher compared to last year. Dry bean exports from U.S. have registered a 12 percent increase during September'17- June'18 compared to September'16- June'17. Top destinations included Mexico, Canada, Italy and UK.
- Chickpeas export from Canada increased by 16% from 108 to 116 thousand MT for 2017-18 due to agressive buying by turkey and EU. Despite India being out of global market carryout remained almost unchanged at 1 thousand MT like previous year. The average price decreased slightly from \$1000 to \$950 per MT in 2017-18 due to tight global side side. This year (for 2018-19) production is expected to increase sharply due to higher area. Major chickpeas growing states are Saskatchewan and Alberta where maximum chickpeas are produced, almost 90 percent. Total supply is expected to increase from 150 to 273 thousand MT due to higher production estimate in 2018-19. Import is expected to remain at lower level and it may decrease from 47 to 8 thousand MT this year.



• With bearish USDA crop report global chickpea market traded under pressure. However, lower crop size in Australia &Tanzania may support chickpeas market in coming weeks. Production of chickpea in US may jump to a record level this year. Area under chickpea in US has increased from 623800 acres to 822,000 acres. The USDA reckons farmers planted 211,200 acres of small chickpeas, up from 179,500 last year; and 608,500 acres of large, compared to last year's 439,300 acres. Higher area in US can make up lower crop size in Australia to some extent. Fundamental for chickpea has started changing into positive now. It may continue to support global chickpea market.

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade steady to slightly weak.
