

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- **Pulses cash market traded almost steady to slightly weak due to weak demand and** increasing availability of green vegetables. First phase of Marriage season too comes to end . So prices are likely to trade range bound this week.
- **Increasing fear of lower crop size big buyers are buying chana with slower pace at** current price and waiting for a clear cut direction as Nafed has ample stock to offer in Rajasthan and MP. Even NCDEX has not much stock for delivery. Futures continued to close higher during the end of last week. It helped market to recover in Delhi cash market. Taking clue from futures,dal market too closed higher. This year importers are importing limited quantity of chana from Tanzania as liquidity is weak. Dal imported in containers last fortnight has been sold out. So, Agriwatch expects market to improve further but not without a correct.
- **Stock of lemon tur at Mumbai, Chennai, Kolkata port is not up to the mark. Pressure of Kartik crop** is almost over now. Right now supply continues from Karnataka. However, higher price in Karnataka has negate the parity for central and north India. Even mills located in Karnataka are consuming old imported stock. The main region behind it is unwillingness of traders to buy Patka dal above 6100-6200 per qtl.If central and north Indian millers buy it,its costing goes up to the level of 7300-7500. Even in Karnataka it will cost-7000-7100.It has increased lemon tur price in Mumbai at Rs4500 in last two days. Sentiments remains firm.
- **This year pressure of Rajasthan Moong was not seen in any cash market. The main reason** behind it is lower supply from Kekri-Kishan garh line. Normally, supply from this region used to continue till Dec, but this year,it started drying up from Oct end.At this line local mills remain active and brought maximum stock. Supply from Jodhpur line was continued, however, buying by Jalgaon and Jaisalmer's millers has pushed prices up. Even supply from Shekhavati line is higher at Rs5450-5550 per qtl. Ther is no arrival from Allahabad, Kanpur and Ranchi line now .So Agriwatch expects improvement in price as soon as demand for dal increases.
- **Recent rains in MP and Chhatisgarh have provided much life support to standing masur crop.**However,lower area coverage would continue to support market as stockof Masur is decreasing continuously in major markets.Import flow too remains restricted and it would cause short supply in masur in coming months.Importers are facing money crunch and are unable to strike forward deal.Stock with MMTC too have drying up. So Agriwatch expects market to move up from current level. New crop is expected from mid Feb.
- **Urad market is likely to trade steady at current level. Market participants are eyeing on Madras** High court decision overimport.Govt is not in favor of importing Urad beyond set target.Next hearing is on 17th Dec.Higher import agianst setquantity (1.5 lakh tonne per year) has impacted market sentiment negatively. Urad cash market is expected to move up once again as stock in north and central India is much lower. SQ are being traded at Rs 5525 per qtl.in Delhi market. However, higher availability of green vegetables in next two months may cap any spike in cash urad market despite lower crop size and likely poor rabi crop.Overall , sentiment remains steady. If court decision of import turns in favour of Commerce ministry, it may move up again.
- **Stock of matar (pea) is not much to take care of emerging needs. However, higher** availability of green vegetables are affecting demand right now. Demand is only for marriage celebration. Besides, pea in green form is available in local market and it is available at Rs30 per kg.Import ban is till December. If it continues or is extended for another three months, pea market may trade stable to slightly weak.If import is opened, it will decrease by 200 o300 per qtl fromcurrent level. Overall tne remains weak.

Previous Update:

- **Rabi pulses area decreased by 9.32 % to 125.40 lakh ha against 138.29 lakh ha last year as on 14 Dec-2018.**Chana area is running behind by 12.82 % to 83.71 lakh ha against 96.02 last year till date. Farmers have covered 4.92 % lower area under lentil so far to15.18 ha against 15.97 lakh ha last year. Pea area is lower by 4.90% to 8.06 lakh ha. Urad area is running behind by 11.17 % to 4.26 lakh ha against 4.79 lakh ha last year. However, moong area is running up by 8.28 % to 1.83 lakh ha against 1.69 lakh ha so far. Overall area may decline further as fields are facing moisture stress and it would impact final rabi crop size. See sowing table on page no 3.

Pulses International Fundamental:

Today's Update:

- **Chickpea production in Australia has been forecast at 330 thousand MT for 2018-19 against 1148 thousand produced in 2017-18.** Faba bean production too has been estimated at 214 thousand MT against 330 last year. Field pea production has been pegged at 194 thousand MT against 289 in 2017-18. Lentil production estimate too has been pegged at 343 thousand MT against 485 thousand MT. However, Lupins production estimate has been pegged higher at 710 thousand MT for 2018-19. It was 631 last year
- **Global Chickpea market remains almost unaffected from final production data in Canada.** USDA data is about to be published and market participants are waiting for USDA data. Canada has produced 311,300 metric tons chickpea from 4.43 lakh acres of land. It had produced 118,600 MT last year from 2.09 lakh acres of land. Major increase was reported from Saskatchewan where production increased from 95,600 to 276,500 MT. In Alberta production has increased from 23,000 to 34,600 MT. Other states are minor producers and have grown around 200 MT.
- **As per Canadian Grain Commission update Canada has exported 1,82,800 MT field pea in the month of Oct-2018.** It does not include lentil exported in containers from non-reporting terminals. This lifted bulk export loadings for field peas to 592,3 MT so far this marketing year, down 30% from the 845,600 loaded during the same period in the previous marketing year.
- **As per Canadian Grain Commission update Canada has exported 22,700 MT lentils in the month of Oct-2018.** It is higher by 4500 MT exported in Oct-2017. Canada has exported total 1,25,400 MT lentil in current MY. It was 88,000 MT last year till date. Improvement in export sales is likely to continue in Nov & Dec too. However, bulk loading is said to be lower than Sep-2018.

Previous Update:

- **Lentil production in Canada is expected to decrease from 25.59 lakh tonne to 22.30 lakh tonne for MY 2018-19.** Despite lower production total supply is expected to increase from 29.09 to 31.27 lakh tonne due to better yield at 1.48 tonne per ha against 1.44 tonne per ha last year. Despite weak demand from India export is expected to increase from 15.40 to 19 lakh tonne in MY 2018-19. Domestic consumption has been pegged at 4.2 lakh tonne, same as last year. Carryout and stock would decrease from 8.76 to 7.35 lakh tonne. Average price for the year has been projected at \$340-370 per MT against \$475 per tonne last year. Harvested area has been pegged at 1509 thousand ha.
- **Lower area coverage in Saskatchewan and Alberta which contributes 96% pea production in Canada, may reduce pea production by 9% to 3.7 million tonne for MY 2018-19.** In Canada, season starts from 1st August. Yellow pea production has been estimated at 2.9 million tonne while green pea production may increase 0.6 million tonne. Other pea production has been pegged at 1.85 lakh tonne. Weak Indian demand would affect export volume and it may decrease to 2.6 million tonne in 2018-19. From Aug to Sep China, B, desh and US has been main buyers for Canadian pea. Carryout stock is expected to increase from 6.6 to 9 lakh tonne for 2018-19. Average price is expected to decrease from \$265 to \$230-60 per MT in current MY.
- **USDA production estimate for this year's crop is at higher side at 5.71 lakh MT. It is around 80% higher than last year** when chickpea production was registered at 3.16 lakh MT. Yield and area too are higher this year with favorable weather condition. Farmers had planted a total of 853,146 acres of chickpeas this year. Out of total acreage Kabuli share was 632,482 acres, small chickpea 209,338 acres & desi 11,326 acres.
- **Chickpeas export from Canada increased by 16% from 108 to 116 thousand MT for 2017-18** due to aggressive buying by Turkey and EU. Despite India being out of global market carryout remained almost unchanged at 1 thousand MT like previous year. The average price decreased slightly from \$1000 to \$950 per MT in 2017-18 due to tight global side. This year (for 2018-19) production is expected to increase sharply due to higher area. Major chickpeas growing states are Saskatchewan and Alberta where maximum chickpeas are produced, almost 90 percent. Total supply is expected to increase from 150 to 273 thousand MT due to higher production estimate in 2018-19. Import is expected to remain at lower level and it may decrease from 47 to 8 thousand MT this year.
