

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- **As per the latest update regarding pulses govt. has stated in parliament that** import restriction on tur, urad and moong continues since August 2017 as per set quota of 5 lakh tonne per year. It includes 2 lakh tonne tur and 1.5 lakh tonne urad and moong each. Restriction had been imposed to ensure better price for farmers. Besides, export has been opened for all varieties of pulses without any quantity ceiling with condition to get registered the quantity with DGFT. All of above, export incentives of 7% have been given to chana/chana dal exporter from 20th Mar-2018 to 20 Sep -2018. Consideration on further incentives are under consideration.
- **Chana continues to reel under pressure and extended its loss further. However in futures market** it traded almost steady. New crop in AP started hitting the market. Demand for chana and chana dal is weak right now, However, it is expected to improve in coming weeks. Chana in Delhi market is being traded at Rs 4450-4500. As crop size is expected to be lower by 10 to 12 percent (82 to 84 lakh tonne) from last year, tight supply side may be seen in second half of the year. Procurement at MSP would remain supportive. Buying new chana at 4400-4600 seems good. It may give good return in the third quarter of the year.
- **Burma offers lemon tur, old and likely at \$ 525 per MT basis Indian port. Urad FAQ is being offered** at \$545 and SQ at \$650 per MT. Chana kabuli is being offered at \$590 while Hollar at \$600 per MT basis Indian port. Mung Pakaku is being offered at \$730. Red Rajma is being offered at \$1140 per MT basis Indian port.
- **The restriction on pea import would continue and govt has extended its time from 31st Dec-2018 to Mar-2019.** It has been notified by this week. It would be applicable from 1st Jan-2019 and end on 31st March-2019. As stock is lower at port, prices of pea are likely to improve by Rs100 -150 with this extended time restriction for import. Weak demand and easy availability of chana remain restrictive for pea market in the near to medium term. There is weak demand from besan udhog too as it is using imported chana from Sudan, available at cheaper price.

Previous Update:

- **Rabi pulses area decreased by 6.34 % to 140.67 lakh ha against 150.19 lakh ha last year as on 28 Dec-2018.** Chana area is running behind by 10.63 % to 91.64 lakh ha against 98.40 last year till date. Farmers have covered 2.89 % lower area under lentil so far to 16.40 lakh ha against 16.89 lakh ha last year. Pea area is up by 9.12 % to 9.97 lakh ha. Urad area is running behind by 8.95 % to 5.87 lakh ha against 6.45 lakh ha last year. However, moong area is running up by 5.42 % to 3.08 lakh ha against 2.92 lakh ha so far. As sowing is getting delayed, area under rabi pulses unlikely to touch last year level.. See sowing table on page no 3. Chana area decreased by 10.63 % and it helped chana cash market to recover. However, any spike is unlikely in coming weeks.
- **Weak demand for urad dal discouraged buyers to continue buying. It caused the market** to decrease by Rs 200 to Rs 4500-4600 and SQ at Rs 5500 per qtl. There is no crop in domestic market right now and some importers are willing to buy urad by pressurizing market. So, buying at current price seems good. There is not much stock in mills. However, higher availability of green vegetables have affected urad dal demand. So, Agriwatch expects market to improve once demand starts. Besides, central govt. may decide to ban illegal import completely. Burma is offering urad FAQ and SQ at \$515 and \$645 per MT basis Cif at Indian ports as demand from India has decreased considerably this week.
- **Stock of lemon tur at Mumbai, Chennai, Kolkata port is not up to the mark. Pressure of Kartik crop** is almost over now. Right now supply continues from Karnataka. However, higher price in Karnataka has negated the parity for central and north India. Even mills located in Karnataka are consuming old imported stock. The main region behind it is unwillingness of traders to buy Patka dal above 6100-6200 per qtl. If central and north Indian millers buy it, its costing goes up to the level of 7300-7500. Even in Karnataka it will cost 7000-7100. It has increased lemon tur price in Mumbai at Rs4500 in last two days. Sentiments remain firm.
- **This year pressure of Rajasthan Moong was not seen in any cash market. The main reason** behind it is lower supply from Kekri-Kishan garh line. Normally, supply from this region used to continue till Dec, but this year, it started drying up from Oct end. At this line local mills remain active and brought maximum stock. Supply from Jodhpur line was continued, however, buying by Jalgaon and Jaisalmer's millers has pushed prices up. Even supply from Shekhavati line is higher at Rs5450-5550 per qtl. There is no arrival from Allahabad, Kanpur and Ranchi line now. So Agriwatch expects improvement in price as soon as demand for dal increases.

Pulses International Fundamental:

Today's Update:

- **News is circulating in market that tur crop in Myanmar is 40 to 45 % lower than last year** and its impact is visible on port where it is being loaded. Import quotes are steady \$525 and is expected to move up soon as India crop too is not good this year. Total crop size may not be more than 35 lakh tonne this year. So, price of tur is bound to move up despite higher carry out stock.

Previous Update:

- **Chickpea production in Australia has been forecast at 330 thousand MT for 2018-19 against 1148 thousand produced in 2017-18.** Faba bean production too has been estimated at 214 thousand MT against 330 last year. Field pea production has been pegged at 194 thousand MT against 289 in 2017-18. Lentil production estimate too has been pegged at 343 thousand MT against 485 thousand MT. However, Lupins production estimate has been pegged higher at 710 thousand MT for 2018-19. It was 631 last year
- **Global Chickpea market remains almost unaffected from final production data in Canada.** USDA data is about to be published and market participants are waiting for USDA data. Canada has produced 311,300 metric tons chickpea from 4.43 lakh acres of land. It had produced 118,600 MT last year from 2.09 lakh acres of land. Major increase was reported from Saskatchewan where production increased from 95,600 to 276,500 MT. In Alberta production has increased from 23,000 to 34,600 MT. Other states are minor producers and have grown around 200 MT.
- **As per Canadian Grain Commission update Canada has exported 1,82,800 MT field pea in the month of Oct-2018.** It does not include lentil exported in containers from non-reporting terminals. This lifted bulk export loadings for field peas to 592,3 MT so far this marketing year, down 30% from the 845,600 loaded during the same period in the previous marketing year.
- **As per Canadian Grain Commission update Canada has exported 22,700 MT lentils in the month of Oct-2018.** It is higher by 4500 MT exported in Oct-2017. Canada has exported total 1,25,400 MT lentil in current MY. It was 88,000 MT last year till date. Improvement in export sales is likely to continue in Nov & Dec too. However, bulk loading is said to be lower than Sep-2018.
- **Lentil production in Canada is expected to decrease from 25.59 lakh tonne to 22.30 lakh tonne for MY 2018-19.** Despite lower production total supply is expected to increase from 29.09 to 31.27 lakh tonne due to better yield at 1.48 tonne per ha against 1.44 tonne per ha last year. Despite weak demand from India export is expected to increase from 15.40 to 19 lakh tonne in MY 2018-19. Domestic consumption has been pegged at 4.2 lakh tonne, same as last year. Carryout and stock would decrease from 8.76 to 7.35 lakh tonne. Average price for the year has been projected at \$340-370 per MT against \$475 per tonne last year. Harvested area has been pegged at 1509 thousand ha.
- **Lower area coverage in Saskatchewan and Alberta which contributes 96% pea production in Canada,** may reduce pea production by 9% to 3.7 million tonne for MY 2018-19. In Canada, season starts from 1st August. Yellow pea production has been estimated at 2.9 million tonne while green pea production may increase 0.6 million tonne. Other pea production has been pegged at 1.85 lakh tonne. Weak Indian demand would affect export volume and it may decrease to 2.6 million tonne in 2018-19. From Aug to Sep China, B, desh and US has been main buyers for Canadian pea. Carryout stock is expected to increase from 6.6 to 9 lakh tonne for 2018-19. Average price is expected to decrease from \$265 to \$230-60 per MT in current MY.
- **USDA production estimate for this year's crop is at higher side at 5.71 lakh MT. It is around 80 % higher than last year** when chickpea production was registered at 3.16 lakh MT. Yield and area too are higher this year with favorable weather condition. Farmers had planted a total of 853,146 acres of chickpeas this year. Out of total acreage Kabuli share was 632,482 acres, small chickpea 209,338 acres & desi 11,326 acres.
- **Chickpeas export from Canada increased by 16% from 108 to 116 thousand MT for 2017-18** due to aggressive buying by turkey and EU. Despite India being out of global market carryout remained almost unchanged at 1 thousand MT like previous year. The average price decreased slightly from \$1000 to \$950 per MT in 2017-18 due to tight global side. This year (for 2018-19) production is expected to increase sharply due to higher area. Major chickpeas growing states are Saskatchewan and Alberta where maximum chickpeas are produced, almost 90 percent. Total supply is expected to increase from 150 to 273 thousand MT

due to higher production estimate in 2018-19.Import is expected to remain at lower level and it may decrease from 47 to 8 thousand MT this year.

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade range bound.
