

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- ***Karnataka govt. has released 2nd Adv. Est for 2018-19 crops on 22nd Jan-2019. It has decreased tur production estimate from 1st Adv Est. of 7.22 to 5.82 lakh tonne, down by over30%.Chana production estimate too has been decreased by 27.46 %from4th Adv. estimate to 5.23 lakh toone. However, moong production estimate has been increased from1.16 to 1.38 lakh tonne in second Adv estimate.***
- ***Pressure on chana continues with rains in many growing regions. Buyers are not willing to buy in bulk quantity at current level despite lower area coverage. In Delhi market chana is being traded at Rs4450-4475 per qtl. Actually, higher availability of chana in MP in Central pool and continuous selling by Nafed has put a cap on market. Futures too remain unsupportive to cash market. Availability is higher than actual demand. So any spike in chana market is unlikely in the near term. Recent rains have benefitted chana crop in many growing regions. It may continue to trade in the range of Rs4300 to 4600 in the north and central India.***

Previous Update:

- ***Moong procurement from kharif 2018 season is almost over in all states except Gujarat and UP. Nafed has procured 294743.97 MT so far. Rajasthan has contributed the highest quantity 236277.28MT So far. The season is likely to end with 2.95 lakh tonne. Karnataka has contributed 29136.74MT, Telangana-13375.31 MT and Mah-13007.73MT. Stock in central pool is 2.95 lakh tonne. If Nafed decides to sell, it would ease supply side. Besides, new crop from Rabi season would be available from March end. So any big spike in cash moong market is unlikely.***
- ***Rabi pulses area decreased by 5.73 % at 147.91lakh ha against 156.90 lakh ha last year as on 18thJan-2019. Chana area is lagging by 10.14 % at 94.61 lakh ha against 105.28 last year. Farmers have covered 1.89 % lower area under lentil so far at 16.77 lakh ha against 17.10 lakh ha last year. Pea area is up by 11.08% at 10.29 lakh ha. Urad area is lagging by 10.03 % at 6.74 lakh ha against 7.49 lakh ha last year. Moong area too is lower by 0.49 % at 4.86 lakh ha against 4.88lakh ha so far. Overall rabi area is unlikely to match last year's level as sowing has entered the last phase now. See sowing table on page no 3 for details.***
- ***Tur cash market is likely to trade up and it may continue to move up further by Rs200-300 per qtl. from current level. Karnataka govt would buy Tur at Rs6100 per qtl, higher by Rs425 per qtl from MSP. Arrival in major markets is comparatively lower and private buyers are active. Only Telangana govt is procuring tur right now. Procurement in other states would likely by end Jan or mid Feb. Crop size is lower. So Agriwatch expects price to touch MSP level soon. Stockists should start releasing stock at that level. After touching MSP, higher selling might be seen, that may depress price in March & April. Seasonal chart too shows downward move in March April. However, if weather turns rough in Feb-Mar and govt restrict import, any major downfall is unlikely. Tur may trade in between 4900-5700 in the medium term in prevailing market condition.***
- ***Urad Trades Weak On Weak Demand, Firmness Depends On Madras High Court Decision*** Buying for imported Urad in cash Mumbai market was seen weak as traders preferred to wait decision on import restriction pending in Madras High Court. After hearing arguments of both parties the court has reserved decision and it is expected by the end of this week. It is clear that stay will not be given now. Hope for higher supply from Myanmar too remained price limiting factors. There is a news in local market that around 2000 containers of dals are bound to set from Myanmar to Chennai /Kolkatta port from 18 to 23 jan-2019. Demand for dal is weak and new URAD fAQ is being traded at Rs 4450-4500 in Mumbai market. Price impacting factor is court's decision. Govt may impose duty on import to check flow of Urad beyond limit of 1.5lakh tonne.
- ***Out of total 27.24 lakh tonne chana procurement, Nafed has sold 4.69 lakh tonne so far in various states. The highest quantity is available in MP. Out of 15.81 lakh tonne, Nafed has sold only 2.58% so far and it has still 15.41 lakh left in its stock. Nafed has sold 20% stock so far out of 5.80 lakh tonne in Rajasthan and 4.63 lakh tonne still available in its stock. AP, Telangana & Karnataka have sold out 92.74, 86.39 & 68.83% stock so far and have 6669, 6805 & 41834 MT chana available in Nafed stock. There is no selling in UP. In Maharashtra, Nafed has sold out 21.45 % stock so far and 1.42 lakh tonne is still left. Nafed in Gujarat has sold 58 % stock so far and 38138 MT is still left in Nafed godown. Nafed in MP would not sell 4 lakh tonne chana in open market in MP and it would be supplied to PDS. As new crop has started entering in AP and Mah mandis, supply side is expected to remain at comfortable level despite lower crop size in the short to medium term. Recovery might be expected in the second half of the year.***

Pulses International Fundamental:

Today's Update:

- **Continuous shipments for lentil to Vancouver has helped north American market to trade firmer.** Bulk lentil shipment in Jan-2019 has surpassed the quantity exported during last 5 months. At ports inventory is lower. Inventories in port positions were low as of January 13, but the bulk handling system continues to buy relatively large quantities from farmers, suggesting exporters are accumulating stocks for movement later this month and February.
- **Global chickpea market traded almost steady and is expected to move slightly up** on increasing buyer's interest and unwillingness to sell by stockists. Quality issues with Argentina's crops is still there and worries about the pending size of the crop in Mexico remain supportive to the cash market fundamental. However, market participants expect global inventories to remain large relative to prospective demand through at least the end of the calendar year.
- **Chickpea export from Russia increased from 9104(Oct) to 19,326 metric tons in Nov.** However, it was down by 28% in this calendar year to 78,889 MT from last year till Nov-2018. Pakistan, Turkey and Jordan were major buyers. They brought 6,167,4,668 and 2,547 MT so far.

Previous Update:

- **Lentil production in Canada is expected to decrease by 18% to 20.98 lakh tonne due to lower harvested area and yields.** Large green lentil production is estimated to have risen from last year to 6 lakh tonne while red lentil production fell to about 12 lakh tonne. Production of the other types of lentil is estimated to have risen to 3 lakh tonne for 2018-19.
- **Supply increased slightly due to large carry-in stocks. Export has been forecast to increase to 18 lakh tonne.** To-date Mexico, United Arab Emirates and India are the top export markets. Imports are expected to be lower than the previous year due to the above average grade distribution. Carry-out stocks are expected to fall due to the increase in exports. The overall average price is forecast to fall below the levels achieved in 2017-18 due to weaker world demand, larger domestic carry-out stocks and an above average proportion of grade distribution at the No.1 or 2 grade.
- **News is circulating in market that tur crop in Myanmar is 40 to 45 % lower than last year** and its impact is visible on port where it is being loaded. Import quotes are steady \$525 and is expected to move up soon as India crop too is not good this year. Total crop size may not be more than 35 lakh tonne this year. So, price of tur is bound to move up despite higher carry out stock.
- **Chickpea production in Australia has been forecast at 330 thousand MT for 2018-19 against 1148 thousand produced in 2017-18.** Faba bean production too has been estimated at 214 thousand MT against 330 last year. Field pea production has been pegged at 194 thousand MT against 289 in 2017-18. Lentil production estimate too has been pegged at 343 thousand MT against 485 thousand MT. However, Lupins production estimate has been pegged higher at 710 thousand MT for 2018-19. It was 631 last year
- **Global Chickpea market remains almost unaffected from final production data in Canada.** USDA data is about to be published and market participants are waiting for USDA data. Canada has produced 311,300 metric tons chickpea from 4.43 lakh acres of land. It had produced 118,600 MT last year from 2.09 lakh acres of land. Major increase was reported from Saskatchewan where production increased from 95,600 to 276,500 MT. In Alberta production has increased from 23,000 to 34,600 MT. Other states are minor producers and have grown around 200 MT.
- **Lower area coverage in Saskatchewan and Alberta which contributes 96% pea production in Canada,** may reduce pea production by 9 % to 3.7 million tonne for MY 2018-19. In Canada, season starts from 1st August. Yellow pea production has been estimated at 2.9 million tonne while green pea production may increase 0.6 million tonne. Other pea production has been pegged at 1.85 lakh tonne. Weak Indian demand would affect export volume and it may decrease to 2.6 million tonne in 2018-19. From Aug to Sep China, B, desh and US has been main buyers for Canadian pea. Carryout stock is expected to increase from 6.6 to 9 lakh tonne for 2018-19. Average price is expected to decrease from \$265 to \$230-60 per MT in current MY.
- **USDA production estimate for this year's crop is at higher side at 5.71 lakh MT. It is around 80 % higher than last year** when chickpea production was registered at 3.16 lakh MT. Yield and area too are higher this year with favorable weather condition. Farmers had planted a total of 853,146 acres of chickpeas this year. Out of total acreage Kabuli share was 632,482 acres, small chickpea 209,338 acres & desi 11,326 acres.

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade mixed.
