

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- **Moong and Urad procurement activities are likely to commence on 1st February in Tamil Nadu and would continue till 90 days.** In Cauvery delta districts it will start on 1st April-2019. The price has been fixed at Rs 6975 per qtl for moong and Rs 5600 per qtl for urad. The Tamil Nadu Agricultural Marketing Board will procure pulses from farmers. The Union Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare fixed the maximum quantity procurement of green gram at 16900 tonnes and black gram at 58425 tonnes.

Previous Update:

- **Lower area coverage and increasing fear of lower grain size of lentil have helped market to improve and trade sentiment has turned strong now.** Lower rainfall in growing region and lack of fog, have affected fruit formation in late sown crop. In some region of UP and MP, plants are drying up. Even MMTC is selling Canadian masoor at Rs 4040-4050. Under prevailing condition masoor market may trade firm in coming weeks.
- **Rabi pulses area decreased by 6.13 % at 151.10 lakh ha against 160.97 lakh ha last year as on 24th Jan-2019.** Chana area is lagging by 9.91 % at 95.99 lakh ha against 106.55 last year. Farmers have covered 1.75 % lower area under lentil so far at 16.88 lakh ha against 17.18 lakh ha last year. Pea area is up by 11.22% at 10.38 lakh ha. Urad area is lagging by 13.58 % at 7.0 lakh ha against 8.10 lakh ha last year. Moong area too is lower by 14.60 % at 5.70 lakh ha against 6.67 lakh ha so far. Overall rabi area is unlikely to match last year's level as sowing has entered the last phase now. See sowing table on page no 3 for details.
- **Pressure on chana continues with rains in many growing regions. Buyers are not willing to buy in bulk quantity at current level despite lower area coverage.** In Delhi market chana is being traded at Rs4450-4475 per qtl. Actually, higher availability of chana in MP in Central pool and continuous selling by Nafed has put a cap on market. Futures too remain unsupportive to cash market. Availability is higher than actual demand. So any spike in chana market is unlikely in the near term. Recent rains have benefitted chana crop in many growing regions. It may continue to trade in the range of Rs4200 to 4400 in the north and central India.
- **Moong and Urad procurement activities are likely to commence on 1st Feb in Tamil Nadu and would continue till 90 days.** In Cauvery delta districts it will start on 1st April-2019. The price has been fixed at Rs6975 per qtl for moong and Rs 5600 per qtl for urad. The Tamil Nadu Agricultural Marketing Board will procure pulses from farmers. The Union Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare fixed the maximum quantity procurement of green gram at 16,900 tonnes and black gram at 58,425 tonnes.
- **Myanmar offered lemon tur new at \$630, old at \$555 and likely at \$570 per tonne basis Indian ports.** Urad quoted at \$500 and SQ at \$625 per tonne. Chana Hollan was quoted at \$580 per MT Moong Pakaku was quoted at \$ 700 and Red Rajma at \$980 per tonne. Import demand remains restricted due to new arrival in domestic market and uncertainty over import in first quarter.
- **Tur cash market is likely to trade up and it may continue to move up further by Rs200-300 per qtl.** from current level. Karnataka govt would buy Tur at Rs6100 per qtl, higher by Rs425 per qtl from MSP. Arrival in major markets is comparatively lower and private buyers are active. Only Telangana govt is procuring tur right now. Procurement in other states would likely by end Jan or mid Feb. Crop size is lower. So Agriwatch expects price to touch MSP level soon. Stockiest should start releasing stock at that level. After touching MSP, higher selling might be seen, that may depress price in March & April. Seasonal chart too shows downward move in March April. However, if weather turns rough in

Feb-Mar and govt restrict import, any major downfall is unlikely. Tur may trade in between 4900-5700 in the medium term in prevailing market condition.

Pulses International Fundamental:

Today's Update:

- **Myanmar offered lemon tur new at \$610, old at \$535 and linkely at \$540 per tonne basis Indian ports.** Urad quoted at \$460 and SQ at \$580 per tonne. Moong Pakaku was quoted at \$ 690 and Red Rajma at \$950 per tonne. Quotes have decreased in past days due to new arrival in domestic market and limits over import in first quarter.

Previous Update:

- **As per latest update by Canadian lentils Agriculture, Canada is expected to produce 2 MMT of lentil** from 1.35 million hectares in 2019-20 MY compared to 2.09 MMT from 1.52 million hectares. Domestic consumption is expected at 0.48 MMT. Exports are expected to touch 1.8 MMT in 2019-20 MY compared to 1.53 in 2018-19 MY.
- **Global chickpea market traded almost steady and is expected to move slightly up** on increasing buyer's interest and unwillingness to sell by stockiest. Quality issues with Argentina's crops is still there and worries about the pending size of the crop in Mexico remain supportive to the cash market fundamental. However, market participants expect global inventories to remain large relative to prospective demand through at least the end of the calendar year.
- **Chickpea export from Russia increased from 9104(Oct) to 19,326 metric tons in Nov.** However, it was down by 28% in this calendar year to 78,889 MT from last year till Nov-2018. Pakistan, Turkey and Jordan were major buyers. They brought 61674668 and 2,547 MT so far.
- **Pea Export from Russia increased from 65,578 MT to 78,295 MT in Oct. This** lifted export sales so far during the calendar year to 967,095, up 14% last year. The major importer for the month was Turkey- 17,069 MT. Latvia-15,975 MT and Spain - 15,362 MT.
- **Supply increased slightly due to large carry-in stocks. Export has been forecast to increase to 18lakh tonne.** To-date Mexico, United Arab Emirates and India are the top export markets. Imports are expected to be lower than the previous year due to the above average grade distribution. Carry-out stocks are expected to fall due to the increase in exports. The overall average price is forecast to fall below the levels achieved in 2017-18 due to weaker world demand, larger domestic carry-out stocks and an above average proportion of grade distribution at the No.1 or 2 grade.
- **News is circulating in market that tur crop in Myanmar is 40 to 45 % lower than last year** and its impact is visible on port where it is being loaded. Import quotes are steady \$525 and is expected to move up soon as India crop too is not good this year. Total crop size may not be more than 35 lakh tonne this year. So, price of tur is bound to move up despite higher carry out stock.
- **Chickpea production in Australia has been forecast at 330 thousand MT for 2018-19 against 1148 thousand produced** in 2017-18. Faba bean production too has been estimated at 214 thousand MT against 330 last year. Field pea production has been pegged at 194 thousand MT against 289 in 2017-18. Lentil production estimate too has been pegged at 343 thousand MT against 485 thousand MT. However, Lupins production estimate has been pegged higher at 710 thousand MT for 2018-19. It was 631 last year
- **Global Chickpea market remains almost unaffected from final production data in Canada.** USDA data is about to be published and market participants are waiting for USDA data. Canada has produced 311,300 metric tons chickpea from

4.43 lakh acres of land. It had produced 118,600 MT last year from 2.09 lakh acres of land. Major increase was reported from Saskatchewan where production increased from 95,600 to 276,500 MT. In Alberta production has increased from 23,000 to 34,600 MT. Other states are minor producers and have grown around 200 MT.

- **Lower area coverage in Saskatchewan and Alberta which contributes 96% pea production in Canada**, may reduce pea production by 9 % to 3.7 million tonne for MY 2018-19. In Canada, season starts from 1st August. Yellow pea production has been estimated at 2.9 million tonne while green pea production may increase 0.6 million tonne. Other pea production has been pegged at 1.85 lakh tonne. Weak Indian demand would affect export volume and it may decrease to 2.6 million tonne in 2018-19. From Aug to Sep China, Bangladesh and US has been main buyers for Canadian pea. Carryout stock is expected to increase from 6.6 to 9 lakh tonne for 2018-19. Average price is expected to decrease from \$265 to \$230-60 per MT in current MY.

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade mixed.
