

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- **India has imported 20675.20 MT of Lentil at an average CiF of \$420.77 per tonnes during the month of December -2018.** Of the total quantity around 18457.04 tonnes has been purchased from Canada and the remaining quantity from Unites States and Australia.
- **India has imported 82078.10 MT of yellow pea at an average CiF of \$278.09 per tonnes during the month of December - 2018.** Of the total quantity around 24721.24 tonnes has been purchased from Canada, 13622.71 tonnes from Russia and the remaining quantity from Unites States, Moldova and Ukraine.

Previous Update:

- **Overall rabi area is unlikely to match last year's level as sowing is almost over now for** chana,lentil and pea. Urad and moong sowing would continue. Rabi pulses area decreased by 5.74 % at 153.35 lakh ha against 162.70 lakh ha last year as on 01st Feb-2019.Chana area is lagging by 10.02 % at 96.35 lakh ha against 107.08 last year. Farmers have covered 1.72 % lower area under lentil so far at 16.90 lakh ha against 17.19 lakh ha last year. Pea area is up by 11.36 % at 10.41 lakh ha. Urad area is lagging by 10.83 % at 7.63 lakh ha against 8.56 lakh ha last year. Moong area too is down by 6.12% at 6.81 lakh ha against 7.25 lakh ha so far. See sowing table on page no 3 for details.
- **Recent rains have greatly benefitted chana crop in Rajasthan, MP, and Chattisgarh and** pressure on chana market continues. Recovery in production in these states seems very much in sight. Besides, there is 20 lakh tonne chana in central pool, that would continue to suppress chana price in cash market.in Delhi market chana may come down to Rs 4150-4200. If weather remains wet for a week , production size would go up from 83 to 88-90 lakh tonne under prevailing condition. Overall tone in chana cash market seems bearish. Buyers/stockist's should sell on rise.
- **News regarding ban on pulses import till 31st March-2019 and small grain size of tur in Myanmar encouraged** domestic buyers/millers to buy more tur from mandis and it helped market to move up by Rs200-250 in major cash markets. Besides, procurement on MSP is expected from next week and it would remain supportive for tur market in coming weeks.Currently, millers in Jalgaon are active in Gulberga and Marathwara line.Tur of Amrawati line are being traded at Rs 5100-5250 per qtl. Early crop of Katni line is almost over now. Stock of lemon tur is decreasing , so Market may move further un By Rs 200 more from current level.Overall inner tone remains strong. At MSP level one down ward correction of Rs200 is expected. Besides, lower crop size (36.21 lakh tonne) against 38.67 lakh tonne last year may also help market to trade firm.
- **Indian imported total 2.66 lakh tonne pulses in Dec, slightly higher than Nov(2.60lakh tonne).**Out of total import the largest share was yellow pea,followed by tur and urad.In Dec India imported 82000 MT yellow pea,73744 MT Tur and 42860MT urad. Fig is tentative and may be slightly up.Export figure is being assessed.
- **Lower area coverage and increasing fear of lower grain size of lentil have helped market to improve and trade sentiment has turned strong now.** Lower rainfall in growing region and lack of fog, have affected fruit formation in late sown crop. In some region of UP and MP, plants are drying up. Even MMTC is selling Canadian masoor at Rs 4040-4050. Under prevailing condition masoor market may trade firm in coming weeks.
- **Myanmar offered lemon tur new at \$580,old at \$525 and linkely at \$530 per tonne basis Indian ports.** Urad quoted at \$440 and SQ at \$560 per tonne. Chana Hollan was quoted at \$580 per MT Moong Pakaku was quotes at \$ 690 and Red Rajma at \$925 per tonne. Import demand remains restricted due to new arrival in domestic market and uncertainty over import in first quarter.
- **Moong and Urad procurement activities are likely to commence on 1st Feb in Tamil Nadu and would** continue till 90 days.In Cauvery delta districts it will start on 1st April-2019.The price has been fixed at Rs6975 per qtl for moong and Rs 5600 per qtl for urad . The Tamil Nadu Agricultural Marketing Board will procure pulses from farmers. The Union Ministry

of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare fixed the maximum quantity procurement of green gram at 16,900 tonnes and black gram at 58,425 tonnes.

Pulses International Fundamental:

Today's Update:

- **As per latest update by Canadian lentils Agriculture, Canada is expected to produce 2 MMT** of lentil from 1.35 million hectares in 2019-20 MY compared to 2.09 MMT from 1.52 million hectares. Domestic consumption is expected at 0.48 MMT. Exports are expected to touch 1.8 MMT in 2019-20 MY compared to 1.53 in 2018-19 MY.
- **Global chickpea market traded almost steady as demand from bulk buyers remain restricted.** Analysts expects demand to improve from Feb. Major buyers like Pakistan, B,desh and EU may give some support to cash global market.India is likely to remain out of the market till March-2019. Supreme Court of India has cancelled stay order on import.It would restrict import further.

Previous Update:

- **As per latest update by Canadian lentils Agriculture, Canada is expected to produce 2 MMT of lentil** from 1.35 million hectares in 2019-20 MY compared to 2.09 MMT from 1.52 million hectares. Domestic consumption is expected at 0.48 MMT. Exports are expected to touch 1.8 MMT in 2019-20 MY compared to 1.53 in 2018-19 MY.
- **Global chickpea market traded almost steady and is expected to move slightly up** on increasing buyer's interest and unwillingness to sell by stockiest. Quality issues with Argentina's crops is still there and worries about the pending size of the crop in Mexico remain supportive to the cash market fundamental. However, market participants expect global inventories to remain large relative to prospective demand through at least the end of the calendar year.
- **Chickpea export from Russia increased from 9104(Oct) to 19,326 metric tons in Nov.** However, it was down by 28% in this calendar year to 78,889 MT from last year till Nov-2018.Pakistan, Turkey and Jordan were major buyers. They brought 61674668 and 2,547 MT so far.
- **Pea Export from Russia increased from 65,578 MT to 78,295 MT in Oct. This** lifted export sales so far during the calendar year to 967,095, up 14% last year. The major importer for the month was Turkey- 17,069 MT. Latvia-15,975 MT and Spain - 15,362 MT.
- **Supply increased slightly due to large carry-in stocks. Export has been forecast to increase to 18lakh tonne.** To-date Mexico, United Arab Emirates and India are the top export markets. Imports are expected to be lower than the previous year due to the above average grade distribution. Carry-out stocks are expected to fall due to the increase in exports. The overall average price is forecast to fall below the levels achieved in 2017-18 due to weaker world demand, larger domestic carry-out stocks and an above average proportion of grade distribution at the No.1 or 2 grade.
- **News is circulating in market that tur crop in Myanmar is 40 to 45 % lower than last year** and its impact is visible on port where it is being loaded. Import quotes are steady \$525 and is expected to move up soon as India crop too is not good this year. Total crop size may not be more than 35 lakh tonne this year. So, price of tur is bound to move up despite higher carry out stock.
- **Chickpea production in Australia has been forecast at 330 thousand MT for 2018-19 against 1148 thousand** produced in 2017-18.Faba bean production too has been estimated at 214 thousand MT against 330 last year. Field pea production has been pegged at 194 thousand MT against 289 in 2017-18.Lentil production estimate too has been pegged at 343 thousand MT

against 485 thousand MT. However, Lupins production estimate has been pegged higher at 710 thousand MT for 2018-19. It was 631 last year

- **Global Chickpea market remains almost unaffected from final production data in Canada.** USDA data is about to be published and market participants are waiting for USDA data. Canada has produced 311,300 metric tons chickpea from 4.43 lakh acres of land. It had produced 118,600 MT last year from 2.09 lakh acres of land. Major increase was reported from Saskatchewan where production increased from 95,600 to 276,500 MT. In Alberta production has increased from 23,000 to 34,600 MT. Other states are minor producers and have grown around 200 MT.
- **Lower area coverage in Saskatchewan and Alberta which contributes 96% pea production in Canada,** may reduce pea production by 9 % to 3.7 million tonne for MY 2018-19. In Canada, season starts from 1st August. Yellow pea production has been estimated at 2.9 million tonne while green pea production may increase 0.6 million tonne. Other pea production has been pegged at 1.85 lakh tonne. Weak Indian demand would affect export volume and it may decrease to 2.6 million tonne in 2018-19. From Aug to Sep China, Bangladesh and US has been main buyers for Canadian pea. Carryout stock is expected to increase from 6.6 to 9 lakh tonne for 2018-19. Average price is expected to decrease from \$265 to \$230-60 per MT in current MY.

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade mixed.
