

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- **Overall rabi area is unlikely to match last year's level as sowing is almost over now for chana, lentil and pea.** Urad and moong sowing would continue. Rabi pulses area decreased by 5.74 % at 155.12 lakh ha against 165.12 lakh ha last year **as on 08th Feb-2019**. Chana area is lagging by 10.02 % at 96.50 lakh ha against 107.40 last year. Farmers have covered 1.72 % lower area under lentil so far at 16.91 lakh ha against 17.23 lakh ha last year. Pea area is up by 11.36 % at 10.43 lakh ha. Urad area is lagging by 10.83 % at 8.79 lakh ha against 9.45 lakh ha last year. Moong area too is down by 6.12% at 7.17 lakh ha against 8.36 lakh ha so far.
- **Chana cash market continues to rule under pressure due to continuous release from central pool stock and increasing possibility of higher yield due to recent rains in growing belts of MP and Rajasthan.** These are major producing states and recovery in yield may compensate yield loss in Maharashtra, AP, Karnataka. Crop condition in UP and Chhattisgarh too is good. Arrival from these states are expected from 1st week of March and it may pressurize market once again.
- **Arrival of tur in various market is increasing and it may cap uptrend in cash tur market in coming weeks.** Recent rains have greatly benefitted tur crop in UP, MP and Gujarat. So despite lower crop size and procurement drive tur may continue to trade in the range of Rs 5000 to 5400. However, lower crop size would help market to recover after March-2019 when demand starts to improve. Stake holders should buy on dip.

Previous Update:

- **Despite firm tone tur and urad market may trade lower due to increasing possibility of release of 1200 to 1500 containers imported before 21st Jan.** Some stockists too are willing to release their 20 % stock. Besides, arrival from new crop continues and recent rains have increased prospects of better yield from rabi crops. Some group of importers are planning to move to court against recent decision of DGFT regarding stay. So market may decrease by 150 to 200 again from current level. Rains in larger area and lower temperature is said to be beneficial to standing chana crop and yield in Rajasthan and MP might improve. New crop of chana is expected from mid March in MP and Rajasthan. So chana may move down after slight recovery.
- **Govt. has given approval to buy 34500 MT chana under PSS in Telangana state.** Procurement in this state would continue till March-2019. It has commenced from 1st Feb-2019. For Telangana 159.39 crores have been allocated for chana farmers. Pressure on chana market continues and recovery in production in MP and Rajasthan seems very much in sight due to recent rains, lower temperature in night. Procurement activities in other states too may restrict downward trend. Overall trend in chana cash market is bearish. Pressure from new crop from MP and Raj might be felt from Mid March.
- **Lower crop size (35 to 36 lakh tonne), import restriction till 31st March-2019 and increasing interest of bulk buyers would continue to support tur market and it may cross MSP soon.** Govt has 4.5 lakh tonne stock. Besides, govt may import 2 lakh tonne from Mozambique in addition to 2 lakh tonne same quantity would be allowed for private trade, likely in the second half of the year. However, downward correction might be seen after general election. Govt has option to ease restriction, remove import duty. So price may come down in second half and may trade in the range of Rs 5200-6000.
- **India has imported 20675.20 MT of Lentil at an average CiF of \$420.77 per tonnes during the month of December -2018.** Of the total quantity around 18457.04 tonnes has been purchased from Canada and the remaining quantity from United States and Australia. India has imported 82078.10 MT of yellow pea at an average CiF of \$278.09 per tonnes during the month of December -2018. Of the total quantity around 24721.24 tonnes has been purchased from Canada, 13622.71 tonnes from Russia and the remaining quantity from United States, Moldova and Ukraine.
- **Indian imported total 2.66 lakh tonne pulses in Dec, slightly higher than Nov (2.60 lakh tonne).** Out of total import the largest share was yellow pea, followed by tur and urad. In Dec India imported 82000 MT yellow pea, 73744 MT Tur and 42860 MT urad. Fig is tentative and may be slightly up. Export figure is being assessed.

Pulses International Fundamental:

Today's Update:

- **Recent rains and cold wave in Punjab region of Pakistan have greatly benefitted** standing chana crop and local production of chana in Chana Production In Punjab(Pak) Is Likely To Increase 3 to 5 Lakh Tonne Due To Improved Weather Condition. Punjab (Pak) is expected to increase by 2 lakh tonne from 3 to 5 lakh tonne this year. This means there would be no short supply of chana in Pakistan this year. Experts see chana consumption at 5.5 lakh tonne this year. So with carryout of around 0.6 lakh tonne supply side would remain at ease. Import volume would come down to one lakh tonne this year. Normally Pakistan imports 1.5 lakh tonne chana annually. Lower demand from Pakistan and India would continue to impact chickpea prices in global market.
- **Stock of lentil and field pea is comparatively higher in Canada. At the end of 2018 stock of lentil in Canada was 2.04 MMT and field pea at 2.5 MMT as per statistic Canada data released on 5th Feb-2019 shows that lentil stock in Canada was down slightly from 2.11 MMT for lentil and from 2.82 MMT for Pea compared to 2017. Relatively higher stock for 2019 would continue to pressurize lentil price in world market in absence of big market like India. Trade volume remains thin.**

Previous Update:

- **Global chickpea market traded almost steady as demand from bulk buyers remain restricted.** Analysts expect demand to improve from Feb. Major buyers like Pakistan, B, desh and EU may give some support to cash global market. India is likely to remain out of the market till March-2019. Supreme Court of India has cancelled stay order on import. It would restrict import further.
- **As per latest update by Canadian lentils Agriculture, Canada is expected to produce 2 MMT of lentil from 1.35 million hectares in 2019-20 MY compared to 2.09 MMT from 1.52 million hectares. Domestic consumption is expected at 0.48 MMT. Exports are expected to touch 1.8 MMT in 2019-20 MY compared to 1.53 in 2018-19 MY.**
- **Chickpea export from Russia increased from 9104(Oct) to 19,326 metric tons in Nov. However, it was down by 28% in this calendar year to 78,889 MT from last year till Nov-2018. Pakistan, Turkey and Jordan were major buyers. They brought 61674668 and 2,547 MT so far.**
- **Pea Export from Russia increased from 65,578 MT to 78,295 MT in Oct. This lifted export sales so far during the calendar year to 967,095, up 14% last year. The major importer for the month was Turkey- 17,069 MT. Latvia-15,975 MT and Spain - 15,362 MT.**
- **Supply increased slightly due to large carry-in stocks. Export has been forecast to increase to 18 lakh tonne. To-date Mexico, United Arab Emirates and India are the top export markets. Imports are expected to be lower than the previous year due to the above average grade distribution. Carry-out stocks are expected to fall due to the increase in exports. The overall average price is forecast to fall below the levels achieved in 2017-18 due to weaker world demand, larger domestic carry-out stocks and an above average proportion of grade distribution at the No.1 or 2 grade.**
- **News is circulating in market that tur crop in Myanmar is 40 to 45 % lower than last year and its impact is visible on port where it is being loaded. Import quotes are steady \$525 and is expected to move up soon as India crop too is not good this year. Total crop size may not be more than 35 lakh tonne this year. So, price of tur is bound to move up despite higher carry out stock.**
- **Chickpea production in Australia has been forecast at 330 thousand MT for 2018-19 against 1148 thousand produced in 2017-18. Faba bean production too has been estimated at 214 thousand MT against 330 last year. Field pea production has been pegged at 194 thousand MT against 289 in 2017-18. Lentil production estimate too has been pegged at 343 thousand MT against 485 thousand MT. However, Lupins production estimate has been pegged higher at 710 thousand MT for 2018-19. It was 631 last year**
- **Global Chickpea market remains almost unaffected from final production data in Canada. USDA data is about to be published and market participants are waiting for USDA data. Canada has produced 311,300 metric tons chickpea from 4.43 lakh acres of land. It had produced 118,600 MT last year from 2.09 lakh acres of land. Major increase was reported from**

Saskatchewan where production increased from 95,600 to 276,500 MT. In Alberta production has increased from 23,000 to 34,600 MT. Other states are minor producers and have grown around 200 MT.

- **Lower area coverage in Saskatchewan and Alberta which contributes 96% pea production** in Canada, may reduce pea production by 9 % to 3.7 million tonne for MY 2018-19. In Canada, season starts from 1st August. Yellow pea production has been estimated at 2.9 million tonne while green pea production may increase 0.6 million tonne. Other pea production has been pegged at 1.85 lakh tonne. Weak Indian demand would affect export volume and it may decrease to 2.6 million tonne in 2018-19. From Aug to Sep China, Bangladesh and US has been main buyers for Canadian pea. Carryout stock is expected to increase from 6.6 to 9 lakh tonne for 2018-19. Average price is expected to decrease from \$265 to \$230-60 per MT in current MY.
