

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- **Weather remains a major concern in the north-central Indian states and light rains are expected** in coming days. Fear of rains with hailstorm is increasing and it may damage standing crop approaching maturity stages. Pressure continues on chana market. If damage spreads in larger area, sliding chana price may make a pause, otherwise it may decrease further by Rs 100-150 from current level. Chana in Delhi market is being traded at Rs 4200 to 4325. Weather condition in next 15 days would be very crucial for chana price direction. Nafed continues to sell chana through tender.
- **Arrival of new urad and moong commences in producing states. However, crop size of rabi is lower** and if standing crop gets damaged, it may help market to improve slightly. Any major spike at this point of time is unlikely. Demand from bulk buyers remains weak.

Previous Update:

- **India imported 23667.99 MT chickpea in Jan-2019, down by 4.98 % from Dec-2018. Chickpea has been imported** at an average monthly CiF of \$617.39 per MT. India had imported 24908.95 MT in Dec. Total chickpea import from March-18 to Jan -19 was registered at 140664.6 MT. Against it export was registered at 274201.15 MT in last 11 months.
- **Tur import in Jan was registered 66778.8 MT in Jan-2019, down by 9.44 % from Dec-2018** when India had imported 73744.1 MT. In current MY, starting from Dec-2018, India has imported total 140522.9 MT. It has been imported at monthly average CiF price of \$559.45 per tonne. It was imported at \$546.88 per MT in Dec.
- **Urad import in Jan-2019 increased from 42860.81 to 58043.54 MT, up by 35.42 % from Dec-2018. From Aug to Jan-2019** India imported total 339965.28 MT urad at an average monthly CiF of \$634.19 per MT. It has been imported at \$632.06 per MT in Dec. Urad import has already crossed fixed limit of 1.5 lakh tonne. However, the volume is likely to decline now as clearance at port is difficult now.
- **Overall rabi pulses area is unlikely to match last year's level as sowing is almost over now for chana, lentil and pea.** Urad and moong sowing would continue. Rabi pulses area decreased by 5.74 % at 156.30 lakh ha against 166.11 lakh ha last year **as on 15th Feb-2019.** Chana area is lagging by 10.02 % at 96.59 lakh ha against 107.57 last year. Farmers have covered 1.72 % lower area under lentil so far at 16.93 lakh ha against 17.25 lakh ha last year. Pea area is up by 11.36 % at 10.44 lakh ha. Urad area is lagging by 10.83 % at 9.35 lakh ha against 9.77 lakh ha last year. Moong area too is down by 6.12% at 7.63 lakh ha against 8.81 lakh ha so far.
- **Despite firm tone tur and urad market may trade lower due to increasing possibility of release of 1200 to 1500 containers** imported before 21st Jan. Some stockists too are willing to release their 20 % stock. Besides, arrival from new crop continues and recent rains have increased prospects of better yield from rabi crops. Some group of importers are planning to move to court against recent decision of DGFT regarding stay. So market may decrease by 150 to 200 again from current level. Rains in larger area and lower temperature is said to be beneficial to standing chana crop and yield in Rajasthan and MP might improve. New crop of chana is expected from mid March in MP and Rajasthan. So chana may move down after slight recovery.
- **Govt. has given approval to buy 34500 MT chana under PSS in Telangana state.** Procurement in this state would continue till March-2019. It has commenced from 1st Feb-2019. For Telangana 159.39 crores have been allocated for chana farmers. Pressure on chana market continues and recovery in production in MP and Rajasthan seems very much in sight due to recent rains, lower temperature in night. Procurement activities in other states too may restrict downward trend. Overall trend in chana cash market is bearish. Pressure from new crop from MP and Raj might be felt from mid March.
- **Lower crop size (35 to 36 lakh tonne), import restriction till 31st March-2019 and increasing interest of bulk buyers** would continue to support tur market and it may cross MSP soon. Govt has 4.5 lakh tonne stock. Besides, govt may import 2 lakh tonne from Mozambique in addition to 2 lakh tonne same quantity would be allowed for private trade, likely in the second half of the year. However, downward correction might be seen after general election. Govt has option to ease restriction, remove import duty. So price may come down in second half and may trade in the range of Rs 5200-6000.

Pulses International Fundamental:

Today's Update:

- **Chickpea export from Russia improved from Nov to Dec at 26361 MT against 19,527 MT in Nov.** With this total export quantity reached to 105251 MT so far during the calendar, down by 23% from last year. Turkey was the top consumer, taking 9,797 MT. Pakistan was the second most important destination receiving 6,613 MT, followed by Egypt at 2,383 MT.
- **Price gap between large and smaller kabuli chana has started increasing in global market** as exporters in Mexico have raised its quotes while Indian exporters are unwilling to sell sensing improvement in price in coming weeks. In US production of Kabuli chana has been pegged at 5.79 lakh tonne, up from 3.15 lakh tonne produced last year. USDA previous estimate was 5.41 lakh tonne for 2018.
- **Lentil production in US is slightly down to 381384 MT against 339381 produced last year.** Earlier USDA had projected 398384 MT. Despite lower area coverage by 1.1 million acres, production increased due to better growing condition this year. Average yield increased from 678 pounds per seeded acre to 1,078 pound per acre. US mostly produces green lentil and it is facing challenge due to surplus production in Canada and other parts of the world.
- **Stock of lentil and field pea is comparatively higher in Canada. At the end of 2018 stock of lentil in Canada was 2.04 MMT and field pea at 2.5 MMT as per statistic Canada.** data released on 5th Feb-2019 shows that lentil stock in Canada was down slightly from 2.11 MMT for lentil and from 2.82 MMT for Pea compared to 2017. Relatively higher stock for 2019 would continue to pressurize lentil price in world market in absence of big market like India. trade volume remains thin.

Previous Update:

- **Recent rains and cold wave in Punjab region of Pakistan have greatly benefitted** standing chana crop and local production of chana in Chana Production In Punjab(Pak) Is Likely To Increase 3 to 5 Lakh Tonne Due To Improved Weather Condition. Punjab (Pak) is expected to increase by 2 lakh tonne from 3 to 5 lakh tonne this year. This means there would be no short supply of chana in Pakistan this year. Experts see chana consumption at 5.5 lakh tonne this year. So with carryout of around 0.6 lakh tonne supply side would remain at ease. Import volume would come down to one lakh tonne this year. Normally Pakistan imports 1.5 lakh tonne chana annually. Lower demand from Pakistan and India would continue to impact chickpea prices in global market.
- **Stock of lentil and field pea is comparatively higher in Canada. At the end of 2018 stock of lentil in Canada was 2.04 MMT and field pea at 2.5 MMT as per statistic Canada.** data released on 5th Feb-2019 shows that lentil stock in Canada was down slightly from 2.11 MMT for lentil and from 2.82 MMT for Pea compared to 2017. Relatively higher stock for 2019 would continue to pressurize lentil price in world market in absence of big market like India. trade volume remains thin
- **As per latest update by Canadian lentils Agriculture, Canada is expected to produce 2 MMT of lentil from 1.35 million hectares in 2019-20 MY compared to 2.09 MMT from 1.52 million hectares.** Domestic consumption is expected at 0.48 MMT. Exports are expected to touch 1.8 MMT in 2019-20 MY compared to 1.53 in 2018-19 MY.
- **Chickpea export from Russia increased from 9104(Oct) to 19,326 metric tons in Nov. However,** it was down by 28% in this calendar year to 78,889 MT from last year till Nov-2018. Pakistan, Turkey and Jordan were major buyers. They brought 61674668 and 2,547 MT so far.
- **Pea Export from Russia increased from 65,578 MT to 78,295 MT in Oct. This lifted export sales so far during the calendar year to 967,095, up 14% last year.** The major importer for the month was Turkey- 17,069 MT. Latvia-15,975 MT and Spain - 15,362 MT.
- **Chickpea production in Australia has been forecast at 330 thousand MT for 2018-19 against 1148 thousand produced in 2017-18.** Faba bean production too has been estimated at 214 thousand MT against 330 last year. Field pea production has been pegged at 194 thousand MT against 289 in 2017-18. Lentil production estimate too has been pegged at 343 thousand MT against 485 thousand MT. However, Lupins production estimate has been pegged higher at 710 thousand MT for 2018-19. It was 631 last year.
