

## Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

### Today's Update:

- **Increasing fear of El-Nino and decision of transferring 1.4 million tonne pulses for rebuilding buffer stock** amid rough weather condition in major chana growing belts may support chana price at current level.. Arrival of chana in the mandis of MP and Rajasthan is expected to increase due to commencement of procurement at MSP. However, any major jump in chana price is unlikely in March. Chana in Delhi market is being traded at Rs4200-4300 per qtl. Steady to slightly firm tone may prevail in chana market this week. Demand is weak. As prices are ruling below MSP, farmers may release chana with slower pace. It may help market to recover.
- **Pressure on tur continues with increasing arrival from old and new stock amid weak demand.** Despite lower crop size tur market may extend its loss further by Rs 100-150. Weak demand, slower pace of procurement and availability of old stock remains unsupportive to cash market. Agriwatch expects demand to improve from mid April, by then maximum old stock is likely to be consumed. So, stake holders should resume buying from mid April, when crop from UP starts coming. Short term out for tur remains weak while medium and long term outlook seems bullish. Myanmar is offering tur at \$600 per MT basis Indian port. Crop damage in Myanmar would help market to move up in the second half of the year as supply side would be tight in Myanmar this year.
- **The government is also considering relaxing quantitative restrictions on import of yellow peas** from 1st April to increase the availability in cash market. According to Nafed managing director Sanjeev Kumar Chadha, Nafed will transfer 1.4 MMT pulses to buffer stock, out of total procured quantity (3.5 MMT).

### Previous Update:

- **Moong cash market traded steady during the week under review.** Weak demand and continuous sale by stockists and Nafed from central pool stock have pressurized market once again despite procurement drive for rabi season. Cash market may extend its loss further by Rs 100-200 in coming weeks. New crop from UP, Bihar and Odisha is expected by end March. So, improvement in the near term is unlikely. Moong is being traded at Rs5500 in Jaipur market. In other major markets it is being traded at Rs 5000 to 5500 per qtl. There is no parity for export while Myanmar is offering moong at \$680 per MT. Supply side seems at ease right now.
- **Pulses stock with FCI, procured on MSP during 2015-16 and 2016-17 MY (July-June) is almost nil now.** It has sold out entire old stock said to be around 2.98 lakh tonne. It has sold out 2.97 lakh tonne pulses stock to various states and bulk consumers. Notably, FCI has tur, urad, masur and moong stock of around 2.98 lakh tonne and it released almost entire stock till Feb-2019. Out of total quantity sold out, bulk consumers brought around 2.36 lakh tonne through electronic auction. The rest was sold to states. Now it has now only 800 MT pulses stock left out.
- **Nafed has procured total 174111.95 MT tur in various states so far. Tur procurement in Telangana** is over and total 70,300 MT has been procured. In Karnataka procurement is smooth and Nafed has procured 89803.66 MT tur so far. In Gujarat 3266.90 MT has been procured by Nafed so far. Tamil Nadu has contributed 236.88 MT while in Maharashtra 10504.52 MT has been procured. Given the current pace of procurement and slower arrival total procurement is expected to be around 6 to 7 lakh tonne by April end. Maharashtra has to procure 2.5 lakh tonne.
- **Tur traded weak with increasing arrivals in major markets amid slower pace of procurement** by various agencies. Total procurement by Nafed, has reached at 1.44 lakh tonne. Arrival pressure is likely to continue amid restricted buying by private trades. There is a common view in the market that tur price may go down by Rs100-150 more from current level as bulk users demand remains sluggish at this point of time. However, any major (??) is unlikely as crop size is lower this year. Agriwatch estimate for tur production is 36.21 lakh tonne for the year while govt.'s 2nd adv estimate released on 28th Feb has put it at 36.8 lakh tonne. As carryout is higher, any major jump from current level is unlikely. Market is awaiting demand. Currently tur market is being traded at Rs 5000-5200 in Gulberga market. This week it may trade slightly lower. Myanmar is offering

tur at \$585 per MT. Total procurement from kharif-2018 has reached 144112.60MT as on 27th Feb-2019. Overall tone remains weak

- **Urad market traded almost steady during the month under review. Slackened demand from mills and higher production** adv estimate amid higher carryout have capped market at current level. Govt has estimated 3.36 million tonne for 2018-19 in the 2nd Adv estimate released on 28th Feb-2019. Private trade, see it at higher side. It includes 2.68 MMT from Kharif and 0.69 from Rabi. Despite lower crop size from kharif, carryout is at higher side and it may restrict uptrend in coming weeks. With opening of weather, demand is likely to improve. With ongoing procurement drive, any major decline is unlikely. Urad may continue to trade at Rs4100-4400 per qtl in various markets. In Chennai market urad is being traded at Rs4200-4250 per qtl. Burma is offering FAQ urad at \$490 & SQ at \$600 per tonne. Imported stock too is capping market to get firmer. Steady tone may prevail in urad cash market in March too. Buying at dip seems good

#### Pulses International Fundamental:

#### Today's Update:

- **Adverse weather condition at this point of time in Myanmar is likely to affect Tur and urad crop.** Despite good area coverage this year production is likely to decline by 15 to 20 percent this year. Lower crop in India this year and weak prospects in Myanmar may push tur market smartly up in the second half of the year. Farmers in Africa too have planted lesser area this year. So, pulses market may find good support in 2nd half of the year.
- **Lentil production in US is slightly down to 381384 MT against 339381 produced last year.** Earlier USDA had projected 398384 MT. Despite lower area coverage by 1.1 million acres, production increased due to better growing condition this year. Average yield increased from 678 pounds per seeded acre to 1,078 pound per acre. US mostly produces green lentil and it is facing challenge due to surplus production in Canada and other parts of the world.
- **All U.S. chickpea acreage increased from 625,500 acres in 2017 to 859,600 acres in 2018; 636,900 acres in large, and 222,700 in small.** Now we know where the lentil and dry pea acreage went; chickpea acreage increased by nearly 38%. As a result of a significant increase in yield, from 1,155lbs/ac average in 2017 to 1,512lbs/ac in 2018, production jumped from 320,100 MT in 2017 to 577,967 MT in 2018, an 81% increase in U.S. chickpea production! To break that down, large chickpea production increased by 86%, while small chickpeas increased by 66%.
- **Chickpea export from Argentina increased in Jan-2019 in comparison to Dec-2018 as per latest update by Instituto Nacional de Estadística y Censos.** It has exported 7,559 MT in Jan against 5233 MT in Dec. Thus total sales during the MY reached to 141309 MT. However, it is lower by 15% from last year. UAE brought 1,698 MT, followed by Spain at 1,098 MT. Others countries have brought 1,824 MT.
- **Chickpeas production in Canada is expected to decrease from 311 to 130 thousand tonne in 2019-20.** Area under chickpeas too may decline from 176 to 74 thousand ha in 2019-20. Import is expected to decline from 25 to 18 thousand tonne. Thus total supply would decrease from 350 to 343 thousand tonne. However export volume may increase from 90 to 100 thousand Tonne. Carryout stock is expected to decline from 195 to 175 thousand tonne in 2019-20. Price is expected to hover in the range of \$520 to 550 per MT as per Statistics Canada and Agriculture.

#### Previous Update:

- **Stock of lentil and field pea is comparatively higher in Canada.** At the end of 2018 stock of lentil in Canada was 2.04 MMT and field pea at 2.5 MMT as per statistic Canada. data released on 5th Feb-2019 shows that lentil stock in Canada was down slightly from 2.11 MMT for lentil and from 2.82 MMT for Pea compared to 2017. Relatively higher stock for 2019 would continue to pressurize lentil price in world market in absent of big market like India. trade volume remains thin.
- **As per latest update by Canadian lentils Agriculture, Canada is expected to produce 2 MMT of lentil from 1.35 million hectares in 2019-20 MY compared to 2.09 MMT from 1.52 million hectares.** Domestic consumption is expected at 0.48 MMT. Exports are expected to touch 1.8 MMT in 2019-20 MY compared to 1.53 in 2018-19 MY.

- **Chickpea export from Russia increased from 9104(Oct) to 19,326 metric tons in Nov. However, it was down by 28% in this calendar year to 78,889 MT from last year till Nov-2018.** Pakistan, Turkey and Jordan were major buyers. They brought 61674668 and 2,547 MT so far.
- **Pea Export from Russia increased from 65,578 MT to 78,295 MT in Oct. This lifted export sales so far during the calendar year to 967,095, up 14% last year. The major importer for the month was Turkey- 17,069 MT. Latvia-15,975 MT and Spain - 15,362 MT.**
- **Chickpea production in Australia has been forecast at 330 thousand MT for 2018-19 against 1148 thousand produced in 2017-18.** Faba bean production too has been estimated at 214 thousand MT against 330 last year. Field pea production has been pegged at 194 thousand MT against 289 in 2017-18. Lentil production estimate too has been pegged at 343 thousand MT against 485 thousand MT. However, Lupins production estimate has been pegged higher at 710 thousand MT for 2018-19. It was 631 last year.
