

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- **DGFT has re-set pulses import quota at 6.5 lakh MT for 1st April-2019 to 31st March-2020.** As per the latest notification Moong, Urad and pea quota has been fixed at 1.5 lakh MT each for new financial year. Besides, for tur it has been fixed at 2 lakh MT for the whole year. This means import volume would remain restricted and it would support cash market price in coming weeks.
- **Nafed has decided to slower release of chana during procurement time. Lower crop size, procurement drive and restricted selling amid negligible import flow remains supportive to cash chana market.** Cash market is likely to touch MSP level soon. At that level some selling by private trades is expected that may cap rally. Chana market is expected to trade in the range of Rs4450-4550 in Delhi cash market.
- **Urad and moong market too is likely to trade up due to restricted import and decreasing arrivals in cash market.** This week it may move further up by Rs 200-300 from current level. Stock with mills are decreasing and stockists are unwilling to release stock at current price in expectation of higher price. New moong crop from Up is expected from end April/May. Till then market would continue to get support.
- **Chana market with other pulses traded up due to import restriction and decision of restricted selling from central pool stock at the time of procurement.** Buyers were active and they took position in online market. Uptrend in chana market is likely to continue and it may stabilize near MSP. Stake holders should buy chana in futures and cash market and hold stock.

Previous Update:

- **New crop of moong from UP and Bihar is expected to hit market by end April/May.** So, cash moong market may move further up by Rs200-300 as old stock is decreasing and demand from mills have improved. Besides, import too is not possible as there is no parity at current price. Moong in Jaipur market may touch 6400/6500 per qtl before arrival from UP. In the latest development, Nafed would start selling moong from 1st April and it may cap one way upward movement. Procurement too is on in restricted way from rabi crop.
- **Maharashtra govt. has instructed all agriculture marketing boards to ensure selling of chana at MSP.** Notably, MSP of chana is Rs4620 per qtl. It is higher by Rs220 per qtl from MSP of last year. Chana price in mandis is ruling below MSP. Farmers are selling chana to private trades as they receive cash on spot and so they accept even lower price than fixed MSP. As procurement of chana at MSP has picked up, prices in cash market have recovered. Uptrend is likely to continue. How long it will sustain, remains to be seen. In brief, cash chana market may move up by Rs100-150 more from current level. In Delhi market chana moved up by Rs50 to Rs4300-4375.
- **Pulses export up by 37.83 % to 7740 MT in February against 5615.51 in Jan-2019.** Out of total export chana contributed 4902.28MT, followed by moong(1011.41MT), tur(760.73MT), Masur (531.18 MT), Urad- (531.16MT) and moong (509.31MT). The rest were yellow and green pea. Due to disparity, export volume remains at lower ebb. See export –import table.
- **India imported 35.44 % lower pulses less pulses in Feb to 191274.9 MT against Jan-2019.** It includes Kidney bean too. Out of total import the highest volume was registered for yellow pea(50637.42MT) in Feb. Importers imported 35607.5 MT masur, 31915.62 MT urad, 33728.1MT tur, 21044.49 MT chana, 9259.81 MT green pea and 1367.91 MT moong in Feb-2019. Volume of import has declined and it is likely to continue as pulses supply from rabi crop is increasing.
- **Increasing fear of El-Nino and decision of transferring 1.4 million tonne pulses for rebuilding buffer stock amid rough weather condition in major chana growing belts may support chana price at current level..** Arrival of chana in the mandis of MP and Rajasthan is expected to increase due to commencement of procurement at MSP. Chana in Delhi market is being traded at Rs4400-4500 per qtl. Steady to slightly firm tone may prevail in chana market this week. Renewed demand is being seen. Arrivals have decreased in major mandis and farmers /stockists have started holding stock for more improvements. Chana may touch MSP soon.

Pulses International Fundamental:

Today's Update:

- **As per USDA seeding intension report dry pea area in US is expected to increase by 3% to 8.81 lakh acres.** The latest report shows that dry pea area is expected to rise in Idaho, Montana, South Dakota, and Washington. However, area would decline in Nebraska and North Dakota slightly from last season.
- **Demand for Chickpeas in Canada & US has improved slightly and it may help market to recover from current level.** However, India may pose a tough challenge in large and medium caliber markets. India export chickpea from Feb to June as new crop starts hitting the market from mid Feb and there is a plenty of availability in India during this period. Mexico too would pose competition from March end. So, It would not easy to sell chickpeas at good price for any country

Previous Update:

- **As per Canada Grain Commission Canada has exported 91,200 MT lentils in Feb-2019 against 99,700 MT in Jan-2019.** Canada had exported 51,200 MT in Feb-2018. Despite weak demand from India lentil export from Canada increased to 383,100 MT during the whole marketing year till Feb-2019. It was 180,700 MT last year during same period.
- **Production of lentil in Canada is expected to decrease by 4.39 % to 20 lakh MT in 2019-20 against 20 lakh tonne in 2018-19.** Yield for the year has been pegged slightly up at 1.5 MT per ha against 1.4 MT /ha last year. However total supply is expected to decrease from 29.89 to 28.20 lakh MT due to lower production pegged for 2019-20. Export has been pegged at 18 lakh tonne almost unchanged from 2018-19. Carryout is likely to decline from 7.0 lakh Mt to 5.35 lakh MT in 2019-20. Stock to use ratio is expected to decline from 31 to 23 % in 2019-20. Price is likely to hover in the range of \$ 390 to 420 per MT in 2019-20.
- **Production of Chickpeas in Canada is expected to decrease by 116.39 % to 1.30 lakh MT in 2019-20 against 3.11 lakh tonne in 2018-19.** Yield for the year has been pegged slightly down at 1.76 MT per ha against 1.77 MT /ha last year. However, total supply is expected to increase from 3.37 to 3.48 lakh MT due to higher carryout for 2019-20. Export has been pegged at 1 lakh tonne almost unchanged from 2018-19. Carryout is likely to increase from 1.7 lakh Mt to 1.8 lakh MT in 2019-20. Price is likely to hover in the range of \$ 520 to 550 per MT in 2019-20.
- **Adverse weather condition at this point of time in Myanmar is likely to affect Tur and urad crop.** Despite good area coverage this year production is likely to decline by 15 to 20 percent this year. Lower crop in India this year and weak prospects in Myanmar may push tur market smartly up in the second half of the year. Farmers in Africa too have planted lesser area this year. So, pulses market may find good support in 2nd half of the year.
- **Lentil production in US is slightly down to 381384 MT against 339381 produced last year.** Earlier USDA had projected 398384 MT. Despite lower area coverage by 1.1 million acres, production increased due to better growing condition this year. Average yield increased from 678 pounds per seeded acre to 1,078 pound per acre. US mostly produces green lentil and it is facing challenge due to surplus production in Canada and other parts of the world.
- **All U.S. chickpea acreage increased from 625,500 acres in 2017 to 859,600 acres in 2018; 636,900 acres in large, and 222,700 in small.** Now we know where the lentil and dry pea acreage went; chickpea acreage increased by nearly 38%. As a result of a significant increase in yield, from 1,155 lbs/ac average in 2017 to 1,512 lbs/ac in 2018, production jumped from 320,100 MT in 2017 to 577,967 MT in 2018, an 81% increase in U.S. chickpea production! To break that down, large chickpea production increased by 86%, while small chickpeas increased by 66%.
- **Chickpea export from Russia increased from 9104 (Oct) to 19,326 metric tons in Nov.** However, it was down by 28% in this calendar year to 78,889 MT from last year till Nov-2018. Pakistan, Turkey and Jordan were major buyers. They brought 61674668 and 2,547 MT so far.
- **Pea Export from Russia increased from 65,578 MT to 78,295 MT in Oct. This lifted export sales so far during the calendar year to 967,095, up 14% last year.** The major importer for the month was Turkey- 17,069 MT. Latvia-15,975 MT and Spain - 15,362 MT.
- **Chickpea production in Australia has been forecast at 330 thousand MT for 2018-19 against 1148 thousand produced in 2017-18.** Faba bean production too has been estimated at 214 thousand MT against 330 last year. Field pea production has

been pegged at 194 thousand MT against 289 in 2017-18. Lentil production estimate too has been pegged at 343 thousand MT against 485 thousand MT. However, Lupins production estimate has been pegged higher at 710 thousand MT for 2018-19. It was 631 last year.
