

### Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

#### Today's Update:

- **Arrival of chana in cash market was seen improving on one hand, millers and stockiests** were seen restricting its buying on the other. It has pressurized chana cash market and prices decreased by Rs 50 to Rs 4325-4350 in Delhi market. Even futures too traded under pressure. Despite recent downward trend, chana market is likely to recover soon. Bulk buyers may return to market at decreased level. Cash market is expected to improve from current level. Stake holders should buy at decreased price.
- **DGFT has re-set pulses import quota at 6.5 lakh MT for 1st April-2019 to 31st March-2020.** As per the latest notification Moong, Urad and pea quota has been fixed at 1.5 lakh MT each for new financial year. Besides, for tur it has been fixed at 2 lakh MT for the whole year. This means import volume would remain restricted and it would support cash market price in coming weeks.
- **The Madras High Court has upheld the validity of the DGFT order to ban pulses import in the country.** The honorable court has dismissed the writ petitions of importers against the DGFT and held the stand of the latter related to banning of import of pulses. The decision is very crucial and would help pulses market to recover.

#### Previous Update:

- **Concern over upcoming kharif season has started increasing, on uncertainty on monsoon rains** due to emerging El-nino condition. Various agencies have expressed its concerns over emerging El-nino pattern, that may disturb normal rainfall in India this year. Going by various agencies conclusion, there is a possibility of 10% lower rain fall of LPA this year. However, IMD is yet to conclude over monsoon rainfall. As of now, as per IMD, there is lower chances of El-nino. Monsoon rainfall is very important for kharif pulses sowing and lower rainfall, if materialized, may hamper kharif production in upcoming season too. It may push up pulses price further as size of rabi crop has already been affected.
- **Restriction on quantity for tur import at 2.0 lakh MT has been extended for a year, starting from 1st April-2019.** So importers would not be able to import above 2 lakh MT this year. Besides, crop size is lower this year to 35/36 lakh MT against around 40 lakh MT last year. Even in central pool tur stock is decreasing and is around 4 lakh MT. Against its consumption is around 41-42 lakh MT. So, supply side may turn tight in the second half of the year. It may push tur price up and cross MSP (Rs5675) in coming months. New crop is due from UP and MP and arrival, is expected from end April. However, crop is in poor condition and would not build much pressure. Overall inner tone seems bullish. Stake holders should buy on dip and hold it for good gain.
- **Urad cash market is bound to go up due to import cap at 1.5 lakh MT for the whole year, starting from 1st April-2019 to 31st March-2020.** No new crop is due now. Next new arrival (big crop) is expected only in Sep. Before this green urad (smaller crop size) would hit market from MP and Uttar Pradesh but mostly would be consumed in Dhoada. Currently, there is no parity for Delhi from Kota and Chandausi line. So, FAQ moved up by Rs 100 to Rs 4550-4600 and SQ to Rs 5500-5550. After a slight downward correction urad may move further up by Rs 200-300. Stake holders should buy on dip and hold stock.
- **In a latest development DGFT has re-set import quantity for the whole year at 6.5 lakh MT, starting from 1st April-2019 to 31st March-2020.** Out of total tur import quantity has been set at 2 lakh MT, Urad and moong 1.5 lakh MT each and 1.5 lakh MT peas including Green and Kaspa. This means there would be minimum import and it would remain supportive for domestic cash market in coming months. However, it does not include import through govt.'s channel.
- **New crop of moong from UP and Bihar is expected to hit market by end April/May.** So, cash moong market may move further up by Rs200-300 as old stock is decreasing and demand from mills have improved. Besides, import too is not possible as there is no parity at current price. Moong in Jaipur market may touch 6400/6500 per qtl before arrival from UP. In the latest development, Nafed would start selling moong from 1st April and it may cap one way upward movement. Procurement too is on in restricted way from rabi crop.

## Pulses International Fundamental:

### Today's Update:

- *As per USDA seeding intension report dry pea area in US is expected to increase by 3% to 8.81 lakh acres. The latest report shows that dry pea area is expected to rise in Idaho, Montana, South Dakota, and Washington. However, area would decline in Nebraska and North Dakota slightly from last season.*
- *Demand for Chickpeas in Canada & US has improved slightly and it may help market to recover from current level. However, India may pose a tough challenge in large and medium caliber markets. India export chickpea from Feb to June as new crop starts hitting the market from mid Feb and there is a plenty of availability in India during this period. Mexico too would pose competition from March end. So, It would not easy to sell chickpeas at good price for any country*

### Previous Update:

- *As per Canada Grain Commission Canada has exported 91,200 MT lentils in Feb-2019 against 99,700 MT in Jan-2019. Canada had exported 51,200 MT in Feb-2018. Despite weak demand from India lentil export from Canada increased to 383,100 MT during the whole marketing year till Feb-2019. It was 180,700 MT last year during same period.*
- *Production of lentil in Canada is expected to decrease by 4.39 % to 20 lakh MT in 2019-20 against 20 lakh tonne in 2018-19. Yield for the year has been pegged slightly up at 1.5 MT per ha against 1.4 MT /ha last year. However total supply is expected to decrease from 29.89 to 28.20 lakh MT due to lower production pegged for 2019-20. Export has been pegged at 18 lakh tonne almost unchanged from 2018-19. Carryout is likely to decline from 7.0 lakh Mt to 5.35 lakh MT in 2019-20. Stock to use ratio is expected to decline from 31 to 23 % in 2019-20. Price is likely to hover in the range of \$ 390 to 420 per MT in 2019-20.*
- *Production of Chickpeas in Canada is expected to decrease by 116.39 % to 1.30 lakh MT in 2019-20 against 3.11 lakh tonne in 2018-19. Yield for the year has been pegged slightly down at 1.76 MT per ha against 1.77 MT /ha last year. However, total supply is expected to increase from 3.37 to 3.48 lakh MT due to higher carryout for 2019-20. Export has been pegged at 1 lakh tonne almost unchanged from 2018-19. Carryout is likely to increase from 1.7 lakh Mt to 1.8 lakh MT in 2019-20. Price is likely to hover in the range of \$ 520 to 550 per MT in 2019-20.*
- *Adverse weather condition at this point of time in Myanmar is likely to affect Tur and urad crop. Despite good area coverage this year production is likely to decline by 15 to 20 percent this year. Lower crop in India this year and weak prospects in Myanmar may push tur market smartly up in the second half of the year. Farmers in Africa too have planted lesser area this year. So, pulses market may find good support in 2nd half of the year.*
- *Lentil production in US is slightly down to 381384 MT against 339381 produced last year. Earlier USDA had projected 398384 MT. Despite lower area coverage by 1.1 million acres, production increased due to better growing condition this year. Average yield increased from 678 pounds per seeded acre to 1,078 pound per acre. US mostly produces green lentil and it is facing challenge due to surplus production in Canada and other parts of the world.*
- *All U.S. chickpea acreage increased from 625,500 acres in 2017 to 859,600 acres in 2018; 636,900 acres in large, and 222,700 in small. Now we know where the lentil and dry pea acreage went; chickpea acreage increased by nearly 38%. As a result of a significant increase in yield, from 1,155 lbs/ac average in 2017 to 1,512 lbs/ac in 2018, production jumped from 320,100 MT in 2017 to 577,967 MT in 2018, an 81% increase in U.S. chickpea production! To break that down, large chickpea production increased by 86%, while small chickpeas increased by 66%.*
- *Chickpea export from Russia increased from 9104 (Oct) to 19,326 metric tons in Nov. However, it was down by 28% in this calendar year to 78,889 MT from last year till Nov-2018. Pakistan, Turkey and Jordan were major buyers. They brought 61674668 and 2,547 MT so far.*
- *Pea Export from Russia increased from 65,578 MT to 78,295 MT in Oct. This lifted export sales so far during the calendar year to 967,095, up 14% last year. The major importer for the month was Turkey- 17,069 MT. Latvia-15,975 MT and Spain - 15,362 MT.*

- *Chickpea production in Australia has been forecast at 330 thousand MT for 2018-19 against 1148 thousand produced in 2017-18. Faba bean production too has been estimated at 214 thousand MT against 330 last year. Field pea production has been pegged at 194 thousand MT against 289 in 2017-18. Lentil production estimate too has been pegged at 343 thousand MT against 485 thousand MT. However, Lupins production estimate has been pegged higher at 710 thousand MT for 2018-19. It was 631 last year.*
