

## Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

### Today's Update:

- **Slower procurement pace of Rabi crops has affected procurement target of 43.89 Lakh MT** (valued at `19,786 crore) for ongoing rabi harvesting season under PM-Aasha scheme. Till mid- April, procurement agencies have procured only 5% of fixed target for rabi season. rabi procurement season continues till 30th June, so improvement in volume is likely in coming weeks. However, target is unlikely to meet in next two months
- **Nafed, the nodal procuring agency for pulses and oilseeds, has procured about two lakh tonne** of these commodities, comprising gram, sunflower and mustard as of April 11. Actually, problem lies in releasing older crop and there is no defined mechanism for it. NAFED still has 35.6 lakh tonnes of oilseeds and pulses and is required to liquidate these at a fast pace.
- **Gov.t has allowed only millers to import pulses under procurement license. The quota of pulses import** has been fixed at 6.5 lakh tonne annually as last year. Out of total allowed import the share of tur 2lakh MT, of moong & Urad 1.5 lakh MT each and all peas including Kaspas and green 1.5 lakh MT. The no of applicants for import license is likely to increase 8 to 10 times this year as importers booked good profit last year. No of applicants may touch from 300 to 1800-2000.
- **Despite quantitative restriction on pulses import last year, importers imported higher quantity** taking advantage of stay order. Private trade expects 1.5 to 2.0 MMT import last year. However, the same is unlikely to occur this year as DGFT is strict regarding higher import volume.

### Previous Update:

- **Firmness in cash pulses market is likely to depend on monsoon rainfall during the first phase of sowing** starting from June. If India receives good rainfall (likely) as per IMD forecast, better kharif prospects seem on the card and it would cap upward momentum of price. In case of lower rainfall, production prospects may weaken and it would help market to move up. In normal condition cash market is likely to trade steady to slightly weak in the short term. Agriwatch expects market to improve in the second half. However, monsoon progress would remain crucial for pulses price. Right now rains in Rajasthan region have disturbed harvesting activities of chana and if it continues, chana may move up once again
- **India imported 351720.59 MT pulses in March-2019, higher by 83.88% from Feb-2019.** India had imported 191274.9 MT pulses in Feb-2019. Out of total import in March lentil import increased by 283% to 137360.16 MT against 35807.5 MT in Feb. Even chana /dal import increased by 87% to 39353.34 MT in March against 21044.49 MT in Feb. Yellow pea import increased by 157.54 % to 130414.7 MT against 50637.42 MT in Feb-2019. Green pea import increased by 11.35 % to 10310.8 MT against 259.81 MT. However, tur, urad and moong import decreased by 42.95, 80.56 and 22.67 % in March. India imported 19239.6 MT tur, 6202.08 MT urad and 1064.62 MT moong in March. Import flow has increased considerably. For details see weekly import table.
- **Urad cash market is bound to go up due to import cap at 1.5 lakh MT for the whole year, starting from 1st April-2019 to 31st March-2020.** No new crop is due now. Next new arrival (big crop) is expected only in Sep. Before this green urad (smaller crop size) would hit market from MP and Uttar Pradesh but mostly would be consumed in Dhoora dal. Currently, there is no parity for Delhi from Kota and Chandausi line. So, FAQ moved up by Rs 100 to Rs 4550-4600 and SQ to Rs 5500-5550. After a slight downward correction urad may move further up by Rs 200-300. Stake holders should buy on dip and hold stock.
- **New crop of moong from UP and Bihar is expected to hit market by end April/May.** So, cash moong market may move further up by Rs 200-300 as old stock is decreasing and demand from mills has improved. Besides, import too is not possible as there is no parity at current price. Moong in Jaipur market may touch 6400/6500 per qtl before arrival from UP. In the latest development, Nafed would start selling moong from 1st April and it may cap one way upward movement. Procurement too is on in restricted way from rabi crop.

- **India has extended 50% duty on pea import for 12 months and it may impact Australian pea area this year.**Pea import quota has been fixed at 1.5 lakh MT for the whole year with applicable duty of 50%.Under emerging scenario it would be very difficult for exporters to export pea in India.It would affect pea price badly in global market in coming months. Pea production in Australia may drop 45 to 50 % In 2018-19 season.

### **Pulses International Fundamental:**

#### **Today's Update:**

- **Inclement weather in Ukraine may affect coverage area of pea and it may decrease by 20% to 3.47 Lakh ha.** Due to quantities restriction in India production of pulses in major countries may decline this year. In this case if production decreases in India, prices of pulses may move up in domestic as well as global market too. So monsoon progress and actual rainfall would be major price drivers in weeks to come.
- **Lentil area coverage for the 2019 crop year in US is expected to decrease by 29 % from last year to 555,000 acres.** Area may decline in Montana and North Dakota. Planting intentions in Idaho and Washington are expected to remain unchanged from a year ago. Based on area estimate/intention, it would be the lowest since 2015.
- **US farmers may plant 40% lower area under Chickpeas this year in US.** As per pre sowing intention farmers may plant 5.19 lakh acres in 2019. They may plant 137,000 acres small chickpeas, 382,000 acres large chickpeas around 38 & 40 % lower than last year. It would be the lowest since 2016.
- **Dry peas area in US is expected to increase by 3% to 8.81 lakh acres this year based on pre-sowing intention of the farmer's.** plantings are up in Idaho, Montana, South Dakota, and Washington. However, slightly decrease might be seen in Nebraska and North Dakota.

#### **Previous Update:**

- **As per USDA seeding intension report dry pea area in US is expected to increase by 3% to 8.81 lakh acres.** The latest report shows that dry pea area is expected to rise in Idaho, Montana, South Dakota, and Washington. However, area would decline in Nebraska and North Dakota slightly from last season.
- **Demand for Chickpeas in Canada & US has improved slightly and it may help market to recover from current level.** However, India may pose a tough challenge in large and medium caliber markets. India export chickpea from Feb to June as new crop starts hitting the market from mid Feb and there is a plenty of availability in India during this period. Mexico too would pose competition from March end. So, It would not easy to sell chickpeas at good price for any country
- **As per Canada Grain Commission Canada has exported 91,200 MT lentils in Feb-2019 against 99,700 MT in Jan-2019.** Canada had exported 51,200 MT in Feb-2018. Despite weak demand from India lentil export from Canada increased to 383,100 MT during the whole marketing year till Feb-2019. It was 180,700 MT last year during same period.
- **Production of lentil in Canada is expected to decrease by 4.39 % to 20 lakh MT in 2019-20 against 20 lakh tonne in 2018-19.** Yield for the year has been pegged slightly up at 1.5 MT per ha against 1.4 MT /ha last year. However total supply is expected to decrease from 29.89 to 28.20 lakh MT due to lower production pegged for 2019-20. Export has been pegged at 18 lakh tonne almost unchanged from 2018-19. Carryout is likely to decline from 7.0 lakh Mt to 5.35 lakh MT in 2019-20. Stock to use ratio is expected to decline from 31 to 23 % in 2019-20. Price is likely to hover in the range of \$ 390 to 420 per MT in 2019-20.
- **Production of Chickpeas in Canada is expected to decrease by 116.39 % to 1.30 lakh MT in 2019-20 against 3.11 lakh tonne in 2018-19.** Yield for the year has been pegged slightly down at 1.76 MT per ha against 1.77 MT /ha last year. However, total supply is expected to increase from 3.37 to 3.48 lakh MT due to higher carryout for 2019-20. Export has been pegged at 1 lakh tonne almost unchanged from 2018-19. Carryout is likely to increase from 1.7 lakh Mt to 1.8 lakh MT in 2019-20. Price is likely to hover in the range of \$ 520 to 550 per MT in 2019-20.

- **Lentil production in US is slightly down to 381384 MT against 339381 produced last year.** Earlier USDA had projected 398384 MT. Despite lower area coverage by 1.1 million acres, production increased due to better growing condition this year. Average yield increased from 678 pounds per seeded acre to 1,078 pound per acre. US mostly produces green lentil and it is facing challenge due to surplus production in Canada and other parts of the world.
- **Chickpea production in Australia has been forecast at 330 thousand MT for 2018-19 against 1148 thousand produced in 2017-18.** Faba bean production too has been estimated at 214 thousand MT against 330 last year. Field pea production has been pegged at 194 thousand MT against 289 in 2017-18. Lentil production estimate too has been pegged at 343 thousand MT against 485 thousand MT. However, Lupins production estimate has been pegged higher at 710 thousand MT for 2018-19. It was 631 last year.

**Weekly Outlook:** -Pulses are likely to trade steady to slightly weak.
