

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- **Myanmar is offering lemon tur (new crop) at \$730, down by \$40 from previous week.** New crop is expected to hit market in June end -July this year. Stock of old crop is not more than one lakh MT. Old crop is being offered at \$675 per MT basis Indian ports. Linkly is being offered at \$700 per MT. Demand from India has weakened due to restriction. Importers have struck some forward deals at \$725-30 for July -Aug delivery. Quantity remains unspecified. As cash market is moving up, stockists have resorted to hold stock sensing uptrend to continue in coming weeks. Crop size is lower at 35/36 lakh tonne this year. If prices continue to move up, planting may increase as there is a normal monsoon forecast. Under emerging scenario tur may cross MSP soon.
- **Nafed has procured 2.70 lakh MT tur, 1.61 lakh MT chana, 4 thousand MT masur and 5 thousand MT moong and 6700MT urad on MSP so far.** It has procured 1.11 lakh tonne tur in Karnataka, 70 thousand tonne in Telangana 53000 MT in Maharashtra, 30,000 Mt in Gujarat and 5000 Mt in AP. Madhya Pradesh and Tamil Nadu have contributed 1800 and 400 MT respectively as on 1st May 2019. Tamil Nadu and Andhra Pradesh have procured 2500 MT moong each so far.
- **As per market sources the import quota for pea may be increased by 50000 tonnes.** The current restriction allows an import of 1.5 LMT of peas (Yellow peas, Green peas, kasper peas and Dun peas) during 01st April 2019 to 31st March 2020. Agriculture ministry expects a production of 240.20 LMT in 2018-19 compared to 252.30 LMT in 2017-18. As a result pea prices have fallen by Rs 100 per quintal in past weeks.

Previous Update:

- **Lower yield (around 20 %) for tur in Bihar and Jharkhand could not pressurize cash market.** Apart from lower arrival demand from Kanpur, Katni and Indore continues to increase. Currently, there is not much stock of tur in mills located in Katni region. As prices of local tur in cash market is higher, there is no parity for dal mills in this region. So, lemon tur is being processed to meet emerging demand. It impacted lemon tur price positively and it moved up by Rs 400 to Rs 5500. However, some correction is expected at this level. As domestic crop size is lower, prices of tur is bound to move up further amid lower crop size in Myanmar this year. Forward deal in Myanmar has been struck at \$720/25 per MT basis Indian port. Supply from Nimuch line is decreasing now. Besides, there is not much stock in Mumbai and Chennai right now. All these development would push tur price up by Rs 400-500 from current level.
- **Improved offtake from millers helped cash urad market to improve by Rs 75 to 125 per qtl.** to Rs 4550 to Rs 4650. Importers have started holding stock and it pushed urad price in Myanmar too by \$10 to 15 per tonne. In south Indian market SQ is being quoted at Rs 5500-5600. As crop size was lower, so arrival in market is decreasing. So there is no chance of coming it down. Demand from bulk buyers may push up market again. Stake holders should buy at correction and hold it.
- **Govt. will import 1.75 lakh MT tur from African countries under G2 G basis. It is over and** above 2 lakh MT allowed for private trades/millers in this financial year starting from 1st April-2019. This means total import would be 3.75 lakh MT this year. Millers in India are now active as arrivals in markets have decreased considerably. New crop in Myanmar is one and a half month away from now. With lower crop size, tur may trade further up in coming weeks.
- **India exported total 254685.19 MT chana in MY 2018-19. It exported 22131.42 MT in March** against 4902.28 MT in February-2019. In March India has exported at an average price of \$649.56 per MT. It includes chana and dal also. In February India had exported chana/dal at an average price of \$825.74 per MT. Due to higher price chana export could not increase despite incentives offered to exporters. Against this India imported 192850.1 MT chana in MY 2018-19. It imported 39353.34 MT in March against 21044.49 MT in February-2019. India imported chana/dal at an average price of \$637.92 per MT. In Feb it had imported chana at an average price of \$603.03 per MT. Higher import duty has impacted import volume considerably in MY 2018-19.

- **India imported 351720.59 MT pulses in March-2019, higher by 83.88% from Feb-2019.** India had imported 191274.9 MT pulses in Feb-2019. Out of total import in March lentil import increased by 283% to 137360.16 MT against 35807.5 MT in Feb. Even chana /dal import increased by 87% to 39353.34 MT in March against 21044.49 MT in Feb. Yellow pea import increased by 157.54 % to 130414.7 MT against 50637.42 MT in Feb-2019. Green pea import increased by 11.35 % to 10310.8 MT against 259.81 MT. However, tur, urad and moong import decreased by 42.95, 80.56 and 22.67 % in March. India imported 19239.6 MT tur, 6202.08 MT urad and 1064.62 MT moong in March. Import flow has increased considerably. For details see weekly import table.

Pulses International Fundamental:

Today's Update:

- **As per the latest update from Agriculture Canada Chickpeas production may decrease in 2019-20 to 1.30 lakh MT** lower from 3.11 lakh MT from last year. Canada may seed 75,000 ha this year against 1.79 lakh ha last year. Export volume may touch 1 lakh MT in 2019-20 against 90,000 MT this season. In 2017 Canada had exported 1.16 lakh MT. Domestic consumption is expected to increase slightly from 65,000 to 68,000 MT in 2019-20.
- **Inclement weather in Ukraine may affect coverage area of pea and it may decrease by 20% to 3.47 Lakh ha.** Due to quantities restriction in India production of pulses in major countries may decline this year. In this case if production decreases in India, prices of pulses may move up in domestic as well as global market too. So monsoon progress and actual rainfall would be major price drivers in weeks to come.
- **Lentil area coverage for the 2019 crop year in US is expected to decrease by 29 %** from last year to 555,000 acres. Area may decline in Montana and North Dakota. Planting intentions in Idaho and Washington are expected to remain unchanged from a year ago. Based on area estimate/intention, it would be the lowest since 2015.
- **US farmers may plant 40% lower area under Chickpeas this year in US.** As per pre sowing intention farmers may plant 5.19 lakh acres in 2019. They may plant 137,000 acres small chickpeas, 382,000 acres large chickpeas around 38 & 40 % lower than last year. It would be the lowest since 2016.
- **Dry peas area in US is expected to increase by 3% to 8.81 lakh acres this year based on pre-sowing intention of the farmer's.** plantings are up in Idaho, Montana, South Dakota, and Washington. However, slightly decrease might be seen in Nebraska and North Dakota.

Previous Update:

- **As per USDA seeding intension report dry pea area in US is expected to increase by 3% to 8.81 lakh acres.** The latest report shows that dry pea area is expected to rise in Idaho, Montana, South Dakota, and Washington. However, area would decline in Nebraska and North Dakota slightly from last season.
- **Production of lentil in Canada is expected to decrease by 4.39 % to 20 lakh MT in 2019-20** against 20 lakh tonne in 2018-19. Yield for the year has been pegged slightly up at 1.5 MT per ha against 1.4 MT /ha last year. However total supply is expected to decrease from 29.89 to 28.20 lakh MT due to lower production pegged for 2019-20. Export has been pegged at 18 lakh tonne almost unchanged from 2018-19. Carryout is likely to decline from 7.0 lakh Mt to 5.35 lakh MT in 2019-20. Stock to use ratio is expected to decline from 31 to 23 % in 2019-20. Price is likely to hover in the range of \$ 390 to 420 per MT in 2019-20.
- **Production of Chickpeas in Canada is expected to decrease by 116.39 % to 1.30 lakh MT in 2019-20** against 3.11 lakh tonne in 2018-19. Yield for the year has been pegged slightly down at 1.76 MT per ha against 1.77 MT /ha last year. However, total supply is expected to increase from 3.37 to 3.48 lakh MT due to higher carryout for 2019-20. Export has been pegged at 1 lakh tonne almost unchanged from 2018-19. Carryout is likely to increase from 1.7 lakh Mt to 1.8 lakh MT in 2019-20. Price is likely to hover in the range of \$ 520 to 550 per MT in 2019-20.
- **Lentil production in US is slightly down to 381384 MT against 339381 produced last year.** Earlier USDA had projected 398384 MT. Despite lower area coverage by 1.1 million acres, production increased due to better growing

condition this year. Average yield increased from 678 pounds per seeded acre to 1,078 pound per acre. US mostly produces green lentil and it is facing challenge due to surplus production in Canada and other parts of the world.

- **Chickpea production in Australia has been forecast at 330 thousand MT for 2018-19 against 1148 thousand produced in 2017-18.** Faba bean production too has been estimated at 214 thousand MT against 330 last year. Field pea production has been pegged at 194 thousand MT against 289 in 2017-18. Lentil production estimate too has been pegged at 343 thousand MT against 485 thousand MT. However, Lupins production estimate has been pegged higher at 710 thousand MT for 2018-19. It was 631 last year.
