

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- **Procurement agencies have procured total 261953.94 MT chana till 7th May-2019.** Out of total procurement Madhya Pradesh has contributed 165013.46 MT. Rajasthan has contributed 44138.57 MT. Total procurement in Telangana has been registered 34500 MT so far. Maharashtra, Gujarat and AP have contributed 9298.37, 8674.44 & 329.10 MT respectively so far. Procurement in UP and Karnataka is yet to begin. As procurement pace is about to increase, chana price is expected to move up from current level. However, any spike is unlikely as there is plenty of stock in central pool and cold. Chana in Delhi market is being traded at Rs 4450-4500 per qtl. Current spurt in cash market is mainly attributed to increase pace of procurement and increasing holdings by private trades.
- **Urad market may move up further by 150 to 200 from current level as there is no supply from MP** for northern India right now. Price in MP is higher and there is not much stock. Even in Myanmar there is not much stock of small and bold urad. Even import parity is higher. In near future there is no scope for import. However, any spike is unlikely in the near term as demand for dal remains weak. Market is waiting for demand. Urad FAQ is being traded at Rs 4450-4500 in Mumbai market.
- **DGFT has received 6491 application for pulses import. Out of all applications around 3000 to 3500 application holders** seems to import pulses in higher quantity as they have deposited the amount of Rs 1 lakh. If all applications are accepted, import would not be beneficial. Right now there is no parity for import except peas. It would be interesting to see how the DGFT allocates quantity for applicants.
- **Higher demand from mills and declining arrivals in major markets lend support to tur** market. Stock at port has decreased and there is no hope for shipments under set quota in next two months. Stockiest are unwilling to sell stock at current level sensing uptrend to continue. Increasing fear of delayed monsoon may support tur price to move up. Crop size is lower this year and import remains restricted at 2 lakh MT through private channel. So firm sentiment is likely to prevail in the short to medium term.

Previous Update:

- **As per latest update, normal demand from stockiest and higher arrival from** producing regions led lentil price to become weak by Rs 25-50 per quintal. Fall in price of lentil had a direct impact on lentil dal prices, which fell by Rs 50-100 per quintal and traded around Rs 4900-5000 per quintal. Lentil container and vessel at port are being quoted at Rs 4150-4200 per quintal and Rs 4000-4050 per quintal. Prices are likely to recover from this level in upcoming weeks. NAFED has purchased 3944.57 Metric Tonnes of lentils from Madhya Pradesh.
- **Nafed has procured 2.70 lakh MT tur, 1.61 lakh MT chana, 4 thousand MT masur and 5 thousand MT moong and 6700 MT urad** on MSP so far. It has procured 1.11 lakh tonne tur in Karnataka, 70 thousand tonne in Telangana 53000 MT in Maharashtra, 30,000 Mt in Gujarat and 5000 Mt in AP. Madhya Pradesh and Tamil Nadu have contributed 1800 and 400 MT respectively as on 1st May 2019. Tamil Nadu and Andhra Pradesh have procured 2500 MT moong each so far.
- **As per market sources the import quota for pea may be increased by 50000 tonnes.** The current restriction allows an import of 1.5 LMT of peas (Yellow peas, Green peas, kasper peas and Dun peas) during 01st April 2019 to 31st March 2020. Agriculture ministry expects a production of 240.20 LMT in 2018-19 compared to 252.30 LMT in 2017-18. As a result pea prices have fallen by Rs 100 per quintal in past weeks.
- **Govt. will import 1.75 lakh MT tur from African countries under G2 G basis. It is over and** above 2 lakh MT allowed for private trades/millers in this financial year starting from 1st April-2019. This means total import would be 3.75 lakh MT this year. Millers in India are now active as arrivals in markets have decreased considerably. New crop in Myanmar is one and a half month away from now. With lower crop size, tur may trade further up in coming weeks.

Pulses International Fundamental:

Today's Update:

- **As per the latest data updates by Australia Bureau of Statistics chickpeas export** from Australia declined considerably during March-2019. Australia exported 25364 MT chickpeas in March against 46866MT in Feb-2019. Australia has exported total 167043 MT chickpeas during the ongoing MY. It is down by 76 % from last year till March 2018. In March, B, desh purchased 18525MT chana from Australia, followed by UAE 2170MT and Pakistan 2025 MT.
- **As per the latest data received from Federal Customs Service of Russia export volume of chickpeas** decreased by 18% to 24428 MY in the month of Feb-2019. It was 29,903 MT in Jan-2019. Russia had exported 6945MT in Feb-2018. Turkey brought 9,450 MT, followed by Pakistan (6,239 MT) & India (4,309 MT).
- **Lentil export from Australia in April-2019 decreased by 33% to 17777 MT against 26716MT in March.** It is 101798 MT throughout the season till April-2019 against 237305 MT till April-2018. Bangladesh, Egypt and Sri Lanka brought 7,105 , 5,083 & 3,856 MT respectively.
- **As per the latest update from Agriculture Canada Chickpeas production may decrease in 2019-20** to 1.30 lakh MT lower from 3.11 lakh MT from last year. Canada may seed 75,000 ha this year against 1.79 lakh ha last year. Export volume may touch 1 lakh MT in 2019-20 against 90,000 MT this season. In 2017 Canada had exported 1.16 lakh MT. Domestic consumption is expected to increase slightly from 65,000 to 68,000MT in 2019-20.
- **Inclement weather in Ukraine may affect coverage area of pea and it may decrease by 20%** to 3.47 Lakh ha. Due to quantities restriction in India production of pulses in major countries may decline this year. In this case if production decreases in India, prices of pulses may move up in domestic as well as global market too. So monsoon progress and actual rainfall would be major price drivers in weeks to come.
- **Lentil area coverage for the 2019 crop year in US is expected to decrease by 29 %** from last year to 555,000 acres. Area may decline in Montana and North Dakota. Planting intentions in Idaho and Washington are expected to remain unchanged from a year ago. Based on area estimate/intention, it would be the lowest since 2015.
- **US farmers may plant 40% lower area under Chickpeas this year in US. As per pre sowing intention farmers may plant 5.19 lakh acres in 2019.** They may plant 137,000 acres small chickpeas, 382,000 acres large chickpeas around 38 & 40 % lower than last year. It would be the lowest since 2016.

Previous Update:

- **As per USDA seeding intension report dry pea area in US is expected to increase by 3% to 8.81 lakh acres.** The latest report shows that dry pea area is expected to rise in Idaho, Montana, South Dakota, and Washington. However, area would decline in Nebraska and North Dakota slightly from last season.
- **Production of lentil in Canada is expected to decrease by 4.39 % to 20 lakh MT in 2019-20** aginst 20 lakh tonne in 2018-19. Yield for the year has been pegged slightly up at 1.5 MT per ha against 1.4 MT /ha last year. However total supply is expected to decrease from 29.89 to 28.20 lakh MT due to lower production pegged for 2019-20. Export has been pegged at 18 lakh tonne almost unchanged from 2018-19. Carryout is likely to decline from 7.0 lakh Mt to 5.35 lakh MT in 2019-20. Stock to use ratio is expected to decline from 31 to 23 % in 2019-20. Price is likely to hover in the range of \$ 390 to 420 per MT in 2019-20.
- **Production of Chickpeas in Canada is expected to decrease by 116.39 % to 1.30 lakh MT in 2019-20** aginst 3.11 lakh tonne in 2018-19. Yield for the year has been pegged slightly down at 1.76 MT per ha against 1.77 MT /ha last year. However, total supply is expected to increase from 3.37 to 3.48 lakh MT due to higher carryout for 2019-20. Export has been pegged at 1 lakh tonne almost unchanged from 2018-19. Carryout is likely to increase from 1.7 lakh Mt to 1.8 lakh MT in 2019-20. Price is likely to hover in the range of \$ 520 to 550 per MT in 2019-20.
- **Lentil production in US is slightly down to 381384 MT against 339381 produced last year.** Earlier USDA had projected 398384 MT. Despite lower area coverage by 1.1 million acres, production increased due to better growing

condition this year. Average yield increased from 678 pounds per seeded acre to 1,078 pound per acre. US mostly produces green lentil and it is facing challenge due to surplus production in Canada and other parts of the world.

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade steady to slightly firm.
