

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- Chana cash market in Delhi could not sustain its higher level and is likely to decrease by Rs100-150 from current level. Buying at higher level got affected. Even online market traded by Rs 50 per qtl. Profit booking in futures market remains unsupportive for cash chana market. kabuli Sudan at Mumbai was offered at Rs4550. Correction in chana market seems on the card as expected by Agriwatch. Stake holders should release stock and wait for downside before taking fresh position. In Delhi market chana traded at Rs 4700-4750 per qtl.

Previous Update:

- **Cash masur market moved up by Rs 200 in last one week. Supply from major markets** like Mungawali, Ganjbasoda, Sagar, Bhopal and Patna has decreased by 50 %. Even tight supply side was seen in small masur. MMTC masur (moti) too moved up by Rs200 to Rs4300 per qtl. Arrival in KOTA and Bundi too have decreased. Builty price for moti masur was quoted at Rs 4750 .There is no parity from Gonda and Behraich line. Emerging scenario hints market to move up further despite flow of import.
- **There is a short supply of imported peas. Stockiest have brought desi matar in Lalitpur and Jhansi line** at lower rate. However, variety of desi matar are coming in markets of MP and UP. So, selling of imported matar (Canadian) got affected. Imported stock of Canadian and Ukrainean matar is depleting fast. So quotes increased by Rs200-300 at ports. However, buyers remain silent at higher level. As there is no loading for Canadian matar, tight supply side might be seen for imported pea. Any major correction is unlikely at this point of time.
- **Lemon tur in Mumbai market crossed the level of Rs 5750 and was traded at Rs 5800.**Fresh demand by mills and higher quotes in Myanmar amid restricted selling by domestic trades pushed tur market up. In Gulberga market tur traded at Rs 6000-6100 and it may move up further by Rs200. At this level, stake holders should book profit and wait for correction in market.
- **Against the market trend moong traded lower by Rs200-250. However, it is seen** as correction in the market .Moong would move up again as there is shortage of quality moong while next big crop is 3 months away from now. After formation of new govt, it would try to check inflation and may take action to control price of essential commodities. Pulses too would not be out of it. Nafed may start releasing stock. So stake holders should avoid buying at higher level at least for a week or two.
- **Tur market continued to trade firm and may move up further. Lower crop size in India, declining old** stock and lower availability of Tur sourced from African countries have helped market to trade above MSP first time after 2.5 years. Import has been restricted at 2lakh MT while govt would import 1.75 lakh MT. Besides, there is a scope of more import through G2G basis if prices moves beyond 6000 level.in Gulberga market tur is being traded at Rs5550-5750.overall tone remains firm.
- **Nafed. has sold 216174 MT moong through online auction so far in Rajasthan ,MP and Karnataka.** It had procured 261004.7 MT. This means it has still 44830.76 MT moong in stock. It is 82.83 % of procurement. It has sold3180 MT moong during last two weeks at Rs5761 & Rs5826 per qtl. In Chomu it has sold 90 MT at Rs 5800, 310MT at Rs5761 in Kishangarh,260Mt at Rs 5826 in Dooni,700 MT at Rs5790 in Mandalgarh and 1820MT at Rs5802 in Chomu.
- **Procurement agencies have procured total 26195.94 MT chana till 7th May-2019.**Out of total procurement Madhya Pradesh has contributed 165013.46 MT. Rajasthan has contributed 44138.57 MT. Total procurement in Telangana has been registered34500 MT so far. Maharashtra, Gujarat and AP have contributed 9298.37, 8674.44 & 329.10MT respectively so far. Procurement in UP and Karnataka is yet to begin. As procurement pace is about to increase, chana price is expected to move up from current level. However, any spike is unlikely as there is plenty of stock in central pool and cold. Chana in Delhi market is being traded at Rs 4450-4500 per qtl. Current spurt in cash market is mainly attributed to increase pace of procurement and increasing holdings by private trades.

Pulses International Fundamental:

Today's Update:

- ***As per monthly update of Canadian Chickpeas Agriculture Canada chickpeas production*** in Canada is expected to decrease from 3.11 lakh MT to 2.3 lakh MT in 2019-20. This year area under chickpeas is expected to decrease from 1.79 lakh ha to 1.35 lakh ha. Export has been pegged at 1 lakh MT in 2019-20 against 90,000 MT this season. Canada had exported 1.16 lakh MT chickpeas in previous season. Domestic use is expected to decrease slightly from 70,000 MT to 68,000 MT in coming marketing season. Carryout is expected to remain at higher level at 1.75 lakh MT. It was 1.95 in 2018-19. In 2017-18 it was only 13 thousand MT.
- ***As per the latest data updates by Australia Bureau of Statistics chickpeas export*** from Australia declined considerably during March-2019. Australia exported 25364 MT chickpeas in March against 46866 MT in Feb-2019. Australia has exported total 167043 MT chickpeas during the ongoing MY. It is down by 76 % from last year till March 2018. In March, B, desh purchased 18525 MT chana from Australia, followed by UAE 2170 MT and Pakistan 2025 MT.

Previous Update:

- ***Lentil export from Australia in April-2019 decreased by 33% to 17777 MT against 26716 MT in March.*** It is 101798 MT throughout the season till April-2019 against 237305 MT till April-2018. Bangladesh, Egypt and Sri Lanka brought 7,105, 5,083 & 3,856 MT respectively.
- ***As per the latest update from Agriculture Canada Chickpeas production may decrease in 2019-20 to 1.30 lakh MT*** lower from 3.11 lakh MT from last year. Canada may seed 75,000 ha this year against 1.79 lakh ha last year. Export volume may touch 1 lakh MT in 2019-20 against 90,000 MT this season. In 2017 Canada had exported 1.16 lakh MT. Domestic consumption is expected to increase slightly from 65,000 to 68,000 MT in 2019-20.
- ***Inclement weather in Ukraine may affect coverage area of pea and it may decrease by 20% to 3.47 Lakh ha.*** Due to quantities restriction in India production of pulses in major countries may decline this year. In this case if production decreases in India, prices of pulses may move up in domestic as well as global market too. So monsoon progress and actual rainfall would be major price drivers in weeks to come.
- ***Lentil area coverage for the 2019 crop year in US is expected to decrease by 29 % from last year to 555,000 acres.*** Area may decline in Montana and North Dakota. Planting intentions in Idaho and Washington are expected to remain unchanged from a year ago. Based on area estimate/intention, it would be the lowest since 2015.
- ***US farmers may plant 40% lower area under Chickpeas this year in US.*** As per pre sowing intention farmers may plant 5.19 lakh acres in 2019. They may plant 137,000 acres small chickpeas, 382,000 acres large chickpeas around 38 & 40 % lower than last year. It would be the lowest since 2016.
- ***As per USDA seeding intension report dry pea area in US is expected to increase by 3% to 8.81 lakh acres.*** The latest report shows that dry pea area is expected to rise in Idaho, Montana, South Dakota, and Washington. However, area would decline in Nebraska and North Dakota slightly from last season.
- ***Production of lentil in Canada is expected to decrease by 4.39 % to 20 lakh MT in 2019-20 agisnst 20 lakh tonne in 2018-19.*** Yield for the year has been pegged slightly up at 1.5 MT per ha against 1.4 MT /ha last year. However total supply is expected to decrease from 29.89 to 28.20 lakh MT due to lower production pegged for 2019-20. Export has been pegged at 18 lakh tonne almost unchanged from 2018-19. Carryout is likely to decline from 7.0 lakh Mt to 5.35 lakh MT in 2019-20. Stock to use ratio is expected to decline from 31 to 23 % in 2019-20. Price is likely to hover in the range of \$ 390 to 420 per MT in 2019-20.
- ***Production of Chickpeas in Canada is expected to decrease by 116.39 % to 1.30 lakh MT in 2019-20 agisnst 3.11 lakh tonne in 2018-19.*** Yield for the year has been pegged slightly down at 1.76 MT per ha against 1.77 MT /ha last year. However, total supply is expected to increase from 3.37 to 3.48 lakh MT due to higher carryout for 2019-20. Export has been pegged at 1 lakh tonne almost unchanged from 2018-19. Carryout is likely to increase from 1.7 lakh Mt to 1.8 lakh MT in 2019-20. Price is likely to hover in the range of \$ 520 to 550 per MT in 2019-20.

- **Lentil production in US is slightly down to 381384 MT against 339381 produced last year.** Earlier USDA had projected 398384 MT. Despite lower area coverage by 1.1 million acres, production increased due to better growing condition this year. Average yield increased from 678 pounds per seeded acre to 1,078 pound per acre. US mostly produces green lentil and it is facing challenge due to surplus production in Canada and other parts of the world.

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade steady to slightly firm.
