

**Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:**

**Today's Update:**

- **Chickpea market continues to be under pressure due to weak buying. Firmness in chickpea market beyond a certain level is highly unlikely due to huge stock position with nafed.** NAFED has a stock of 22 LMT (Old plus New) of chickpea. Lower crop size can be easily covered by stock position. Chickpea is expected to remain weak with small technical recoveries.

**Previous Update:**

- **As per trade Sources, India has imported 50968.45 MT of Lentil at an average CiF of \$416.82 per tonnes** during the month of April-2019. Of the total quantity around 44967.93 tonnes has been purchased from Canada and the remaining quantity from Australia, Turkey and United States.
- **As per trade Sources, India has imported 35714.17 MT of yellow pea at an average CiF of \$268.31 per tonnes** during the month of April-2019. Of the total quantity around 33282.77 tonnes has been purchased from Canada and the remaining quantity from Ukraine, Moldova and Russia.
- **Chana traded slightly weak taking clue from weak futures.** Buyers remain wary of any bulk purchase. Chana in delhi market was traded at Rs 4575(MP chana) while Rajasthan chana was quoted at Rs 4650. There was no trade at this price. Arrival was reported at 25 motors. Firmness in cash market depends on Nafed's selling strategy. Arrival got slowed down from Bikaner line as there is no parity at this level. However, buyers in Kanpur are active in M.P. So any major downward trend is unlikely despite ample stock in private as well as public hands. Total stock of chana with Nafed is 22.45 lakh MT. Out of total old stock share is 16.25 lakh MT while new share is 6.17 lakh MT. It would increase further as govt has allowed to buy till 6th June-2019. As stockist are unwilling to sell, chana is bound to move up again. In June chana in Delhi market may trade in the range of Rs 4600-4950 At this level, stock from cold storage would start coming out. It would restrict uptrend.
- **Moong market traded lower due to new arrival and poor demand for dhoya dal. New moong in MP** was traded at Rs 6300-6400. Arrival was registered at 6 to 7 motors. Moong sourced from Jodhpur is in strong hands. As arrival pressure decreases, moong may trade up Rs 200 from current level.
- **Nafed has purchased total 638799.38 lakh tonne chana till 28th May-2019. Nafed has procured 486781 lakh tonne** in MP, 80320.69 MT in Raj, 34500 MT in Telangana, 18892.71 MT in Maharashtra, 15491.76 in Gujarat, 2594.65 MT in AP, 207.60 MT in Haryana and 10.25 MT in UP so far. Total stock of chana in Nafed custody is 22,41,547 MT right now and it may go up further as procurement is on. Out of total stock old is 1624310 MT while new is 617237 MT. The fig taken is on 27th May-2019.
- **Details of other pulses stock in Nafed custody are as follows:** Tur-838355 MT (old-562969 & old -275386 MT), Urad-334552 MT (Old-320720, new-13832 MT), Moong-177374 MT (old-162868, new-14506 MT), Masur-191444 MT (old-150802, new 40642 MT).
- **DGFT has delayed decision on pea import at least for two months.** The reason behind it is attributed to higher import so far. Importers have already imported 1.75 lakh MT pea against set quantity of 1.5 lakh MT. Govt. is in no hurry to allow pea as it may affect market price and prices of other pulses too. If pea prices increase unexpectedly in coming months then govt may consider import. As there is lower stock in domestic market, so prices of pea are bound to go up.
- **Pressure was seen on cash moong market with the commencement of new arrival. However, lower stock for quality crop and good demand at current level would not allow moong market to decrease beyond a certain level.** Summer crop in Bihar, MP and UP is almost ready to be harvested now. However, demand from Papper industries and dal mills continues. It would help market to sustain at current level. Once the pressure from summer crop decreases, moong would trade firm again. It is being traded at Rs 6500-6900 in Delhi market

## Pulses International Fundamental:

### Today's Update:

- *As per latest update, until 20th May Saskatchewan has sown 94 percent of peas, 93 percent of lentil and 59 percent of chickpea. Good seeding condition and very few disruptions in the weather has led to such speedy sowing of various pulses.*
- *In the month of April'19, red lentil exports from Canada decreased by 179% compared to March'19. Canada has exported 63465 MT of lentils in April'19. Top buyers of Canadian lentil were Bangladesh, India and Sri Lanka with 16950 MT, 15909 MT and 8761 MT respectively.*
- *Australian pulses growers are finding it difficult to sell their nugget type lentils. However, there are buyers for nipper type lentils right now. There is slight difference of price between nugget and nipper type lentils. Indian importers prefer nugget type while nipper type is preferred by B,desh. In Australian market pulses price has decreased by 17 to 20% since the beginning of the ongoing MY year. The major reason behind this is mainly attributed to Indian import duty (40%) applicable on import from Canada & Australia. Area under pulses in Canada & Australia is bound to decline this year. If India receives less rainfall this year and kharif planting gets affected, govt may consider some relaxation on import duty and quantity restriction on various pulses. Currently, there are ample stocks in central pool and there is no panic at supply front.*
- *As per monthly update of Canadian Chickpeas Agriculture Canada chickpeas production in Canada is expected to decrease from 3.11 lakh MT to 2.3 lakh MT in 2019-20. This year area under chickpeas is expected to decrease from 1.79 lakh ha to 1.35 lakh ha. Export has been pegged at 1 lakh MT in 2019-20 against 90,000 MT this season. Canada had exported 1.16 lakh MT chickpeas in previous season. Domestic use is expected to decrease slightly from 70,000 MT to 68,000 MT in coming marketing season. Carryout is expected to remain at higher level at 1.75 lakh MT. It was 1.95 in 2018-19. In 2017-18 it was only 13 thousand MT.*
- *As per the latest data updates by Australia Bureau of Statistics chickpeas export from Australia declined considerably during March-2019. Australia exported 25364 MT chickpeas in March against 46866 MT in Feb-2019. Australia has exported total 167043 MT chickpeas during the ongoing MY. It is down by 76 % from last year till March 2018. In March B,desh purchased 18525 MT chana from Australia, followed by UAE 2170 MT and Pakistan 2025 MT.*
- *Lentil area coverage for the 2019 crop year in US is expected to decrease by 29 % from last year to 555,000 acres. Area may decline in Montana and North Dakota. Planting intentions in Idaho and Washington are expected to remain unchanged from a year ago. Based on area estimate/intention, it would be the lowest since 2015.*
- *US farmers may plant 40% lower area under Chickpeas this year in US. As per pre sowing intention farmers may plant 5.19 lakh acres in 2019. They may plant 137,000 acres small chickpeas, 382,000 acres large chickpeas around 38 & 40 % lower than last year. It would be the lowest since 2016.*
- *As per USDA seeding intention report dry pea area in US is expected to increase by 3% to 8.81 lakh acres. The latest report shows that dry pea area is expected to rise in Idaho, Montana, South Dakota, and Washington. However, area would decline in Nebraska and North Dakota slightly from last season.*
- *Production of lentil in Canada is expected to decrease by 4.39 % to 20 lakh MT in 2019-20 against 20 lakh tonnes in 2018-19. Yield for the year has been pegged slightly up at 1.5 MT per ha against 1.4 MT /ha last year. However total supply is expected to decrease from 29.89 to 28.20 lakh MT due to lower production pegged for 2019-20. Export has been pegged at 18 lakh tonnes almost unchanged from 2018-19. Carryout is likely to decline from 7.0 lakh MT to 5.35 lakh MT in 2019-20. Stock to use ratio is expected to decline from 31 to 23 % in 2019-20. Price is likely to hover in the range of \$ 390 to 420 per MT in 2019-20.*

**Weekly Outlook:** -Pulses are likely to trade steady to slightly weak.
