

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- **There is news circulating in the market that minister for food and public distribution department, Ramvilas Paswan may increase tur import cap from 2 lakh MT to 4 lakh MT, if prices continues to move above MSP in major producing region. Previously, 2lakh MT import has been allowed on 4th June-2019. Now licence for import is likely to be issued before 20th June for two lakh MT import. Govt. would sell 2 lakh MT tur from buffer stock in open market and it may suppress price. It may pressurize tur price in coming weeks.**
- **As per market source urad stock in Myanmar is said to be around 2lakh MT, while tur stock is around 75000 MT 7 Moong stock is around 20,000 MT. As per quota for import has been fixed at 1.5 lakh MT each for urad and moong, so supply side seems to be tight from Myanmar in coming months. Even, tur stock is lower than last year. New crop in Myanmar will be available not before Dec, so prices of moong and urad would continue to rule at higher level.**
- **If import quota is increased by the govt., import parity would be higher as stock of urad and moong is lower in Myanmar. Even shortfall is unlikely to be met by African countries as production is lower there. Even quality issue remains intact there.**
- **Chana cash market continues to trade lower as fear of release from Nafed stock looms large. In Delhi market chana traded at Rs 4550-4600. It may move down further if Nafed decides to release chana stock in open market in bulk volume.**
- **Chickpea market continues to be under pressure due to weak buying. Firmness in chickpea market beyond a certain level is highly unlikely due to huge stock position with nafed. NAFED has a stock of 22 LMT (Old plus New) of chickpea. Lower crop size can be easily covered by stock position. Chickpea is expected to remain weak with small technical recoveries.**

Previous Update:

- **Govt has just released 3rd adv. estimate of food-grains for 2018-19. It has estimated 3.5 million MT production of tur against the set target of 4.5 MMT. It has finalized production of tur for 2017-18 at 4.29 MMT. Actually, tur production has decreased in 2018-19 due to drought like condition in South Indian states, Maharashtra and Gujarat.**
- **Govt has released 3rd adv. estimate for chana and pegged it at 10.09 MMT against the set target of 11.50 MMT. For 2017-18 it has been finalized at 11.38 MMT. However, private trades consider chana production at around 8.8 MMT this year.**
- **Production of urad has been pegged at 3.21 MMT for 2018-19 in the 3rd Adv estimate against set target of 3.6 MMT. It includes 2.55 MMT in kharif and 0.67 MMT in rabi season. Target for kharif and rabi has been set at 2.8 and 0.8 MMT. Last year total kharif and rabi production has been finalized at 3.49 MMT, including 2.75 MMT in kharif and 0.74 MMT in rabi 2017-18.**
- **Govt 's 3rd adv estimate has pegged moong production at 2.23 MMT in 2018-19 against the set target of 2.25 MMT. It includes 1.55 in kharif and 0.70 MMT in rabi season. For 2017-18 govt has estimated 2.03 MMT moong production. It includes 1.43 MMT in kharif and 0.59 MMT in rabi season.**
- **Govt has released 3rd adv estimate for pulses and total kharif pulses production estimate has been pegged at 8.52 MMT while rabi pulses estimate has been pegged at 14.70 MMT for 2018-19. Thus total production has been pegged at 23.22 MMT against the set target of 25.95 MMT. Total pulses production in 2017-18 has been finalized at 25.42 MMT**

Pulses International Fundamental:
Today's Update:

- **Chickpeas export from Australia increased sharply by over 90% to 43962 MT in April-2019.** It was 23,066 MT in March. It has lifted total export in ongoing M to 208,707 MT. However, it is lower by 64% from last year till April 2018. The biggest buyer was B, desh, buying 28,220 MT, followed by UAE buying 8,663 MT & Pakistan at 2,189 MT. Demand is weak right now. Stock in most exporting countries remain at higher levels relative to prospective demand. So Buyers are in no hurry to buy.
- **As per latest update, until 20th May Saskatchewan has sown 94 percent of peas, 93 percent of lentil and 59 percent of chickpea.** Good seeding condition and very few disruptions in the weather has led to such speedy sowing of various pulses.
- **In the month of April'19, red lentil exports from Canada decreased by 179% compared to March'19.** Canada has exported 63465 MT of lentils in April'19. Top buyers of Canadian lentil were Bangladesh, India and Sri Lanka with 16950 MT, 15909 MT and 8761 MT respectively.
- **As per monthly update of Canadian Chickpeas Agriculture Canada chickpeas production** in Canada is expected to decrease from 3.11 lakh MT to 2.3 lakh MT in 2019-20. This year area under chickpeas is expected to decrease from 1.79 lakh ha to 1.35 lakh ha. Export has been pegged at 1 lakh MT in 2019-20 against 90,000 MT this season. Canada had exported 1.16 lakh MT chickpeas in previous season. Domestic use is expected to decrease slightly from 70,000 MT to 68,000 MT in coming marketing season. Carryout is expected to remain at higher level at 1.75 lakh MT. It was 1.95 in 2018-19. In 2017-18 it was only 13 thousand MT.
- **As per the latest data updates by Australia Bureau of Statistics chickpeas export** from Australia declined considerably during March-2019. Australia exported 25364 MT chickpeas in March against 46866 MT in Feb-2019. Australia has exported total 167043 MT chickpeas during the ongoing MY. It is down by 76 % from last year till March 2018. In March B, desh purchased 18525 MT chana from Australia, followed by UAE 2170 MT and Pakistan 2025 MT.
- **Lentil area coverage for the 2019 crop year in US is expected to decrease by 29 %** from last year to 555,000 acres. Area may decline in Montana and North Dakota. Planting intentions in Idaho and Washington are expected to remain unchanged from a year ago. Based on area estimate/intention, it would be the lowest since 2015.
- **US farmers may plant 40% lower area under Chickpeas this year in US.** As per pre sowing intention farmers may plant 5.19 lakh acres in 2019. They may plant 137,000 acres small chickpeas, 382,000 acres large chickpeas around 38 & 40 % lower than last year. It would be the lowest since 2016.
- **As per USDA seeding intension report dry pea area in US is expected to increase by 3% to 8.81 lakh acres.** The latest report shows that dry pea area is expected to rise in Idaho, Montana, South Dakota, and Washington. However, area would decline in Nebraska and North Dakota slightly from last season.
- **Production of lentil in Canada is expected to decrease by 4.39 % to 20 lakh MT in 2019-20** against 20 lakh tonne in 2018-19. Yield for the year has been pegged slightly up at 1.5 MT per ha against 1.4 MT /ha last year. However total supply is expected to decrease from 29.89 to 28.20 lakh MT due to lower production pegged for 2019-20. Export has been pegged at 18 lakh tonne almost unchanged from 2018-19. Carryout is likely to decline from 7.0 lakh Mt to 5.35 lakh MT in 2019-20. Stock to use ratio is expected to decline from 31 to 23 % in 2019-20. Price is likely to hover in the range of \$ 390 to 420 per MT in 2019-20.

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade steady to slightly weak.
