

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

Today's Update:

- **Chana arrival in Delhi cash market was reported only 20 motors, lower by 5 motor from previous day** Due to bearish sentiments chana in spot market traded down to Rs 4350-4375. As futures too decreased considerably, buyers preferred to remain quite. Price may get some support from tomorrow as chana settlement for June month futures is today. Maharashtra Nafed has rejected bids due to lower quotes. So, Agriwatch expects chana market to stay steady to slightly up in coming weeks. Arrival has already decreased.
- **Moong sowing in Yadgir region may boost up with good rainfall in Karnataka monsoon** growing belts. It is considered to be beneficial to the new plant. Around 505 sowing of moong in Yadgir region is now over. Hope for revival of monsoon and its advancement towards growing belt have provided much needed respite to the farmers. Moong market traded stable and if rains occur, pressure on moong might be seen in coming weeks. There is a growing fear in South India that farmers may shift 10 to 20 percent moong area to other coarse cereals this kharif season.

Previous Update:

- **Tur market traded lower as trading activities for lemon was seen weak. Sluggish demand in all major mandi is too remains price affecting factors in cash tur market** amid govt.'s decision to allow additional 2 lakh MT import to curb the price. As per latest instruction 4lakh MT tur would hit Indian port till October. Besides, 2 lakh MT would be sold from buffer stock. As supply and availability in global market is lower this year, so 4lakh MT import till October is unlikely. Even new crop in African countries would be available in Sept. Tur scenario for near term is not certain. Even there is a fear of lower acreage due to delayed monsoon. So sentiment in tur market would be clear by the first week of July.
- **Lentil in global market is being traded at higher price and at this price there is disparity for Indian importers**. As local stockiest are unable to hold stock for some more time, supply side has eased to some extent. Demand for lentil dal too is weak at this point of time. So lentil built price decreased by Rs 50 to Rs 75 per qtl. to Rs 4350-4400. As maximum stock in domestic market is in strong hands and demand is likely to come in the weeks ahead, masur price is expected to move up again. Right now demand for malka and Chalani is weak. Mills in Delhi are buying masur from MP and UP at cheaper rate and it would not continue for two weeks. So, masur may move up again from current level.
- **With increased import quota for tur from 2 to 4 lakh MT quotes in Myanmar too moved up to \$795** for new while old was offered at \$685 per MT. Tur red Malawi was offered at \$605 while tur Arusha at \$665 per MT basis Indian ports. Urad FAQ is being offered at \$585 per MT while urad SQ at \$730 per MT. Chana stayed steady at \$680 per MT and moong at \$830. Red Rajma was being offered at \$1040 per MT basis Indian port.
- **As per market source urad stock in Myanmar is said to be around 2lakh MT, while tur stock is around 75000 MT** 7 Moong stock is around 20,000 MT. As per quota for import has been fixed at 1.5 lakh MT each for urad and moong, so supply side seems to be tight from Myanmar in coming months. Even, tur stock is lower than last year. New crop in Myanmar will be available not before Dec, so prices of moong and urad would continue to rule at higher level.
- **Govt has released 3rd adv estimate for pulses and total kharif pulses production estimate has been pegged at 8.52 MMT** while rabi pulses estimate has been pegged at 14.70 MMT for 2018-19. Thus total production has been pegged at 23.22 MMT against the set target of 25.95 MMT. Total pulses production in 2017-18 has been finalized at 25.42 MMT.
- **Govt has released 3rd adv. estimate for chana and pegged it at 10.09 MMT against the set target of 11.50 MMT.** For 2017-18 it has been finalized at 11.38 MMT. However, private trades consider chana production at around 8.8 MMT this year.

Pulses International Fundamental:

Today's Update:

- *As per Eurostat latest data pea import in Spain decreased by 91% to 635MT in April against 7409 MT in March-2019. In the ongoing MY Spain has imported total 21953 MT against 47045 MT last year till April-2018. France exported 581MT to Spain in April-2019 followed by Canada(48MT) and Belgium (3 MT).*
- *Pea Export from Lithuania in April-2019 declined sharply in comparison to previous month(March). It declined from 28,592 MT(March) to 22,097 MT in April-2019. This MY total export was registered at 94,984 MT, down by 26 % from last year till corresponding months. France brought 13,950 MT, followed by Germany(2,281 MT) & Latvia (2,260 MT)*
- *Dry pea area in Canada is expected to increase by 12% over last year to 1.6 million ha in 2019-20. The reason behind higher area is mainly attributed to higher return and good demand for export over previous year. The major states like Saskatchewan and Alberta contribute 54 and 42 % in total production in Canada. Production is expected to increase by 12% to 4 MMT over previous year due to higher area coverage. Despite higher production supply side would increase marginally as carryout is lower. Demand from China and B, desh is expected to decline in 2019-20. Carry in may increase slightly to 0.4 MMT in 2019-20.*
- *Even in US dry pea area is expected to increase slightly to 9 lakh Acres in 2019-20 due to higher area coverage in Montana. Production of pea in US is likely to decline by 35 to 0.7 MMT in 2019-20. The major buyers of US pea are Canada, the Philippines and Yemen.*
- *Chickpea area is expected to fall in Canada from 176 to 133 thousand Ha in 2019-20 while production is expected to fall from 3.11 to 2.30 lakh MT. Supply is forecast to increase due to higher carry-in stocks, but softened by lower imports and production. The average price is forecast to fall due to larger world supply, with the expectation of an average grade distribution in 2019-20 as per Canada Stats.*
- *US chickpea area for 2019-20 is forecast by the USDA to decrease by 40% to 0.52 million acres from the previous year. This is largely due to an expected fall in area in Idaho, North Dakota and Washington. Assuming normal yields. Production is likely to decline by 43% to 0.33 MT in 2019-20. The major market for US is EU, Pakistan and Canada*
- *Lentil area in Canada is expected to decline 10% to 1.4 million ha in 2019-20 due to the sharp decline in farm gate lentil prices in the second half of the 2018-19 crop year. Saskatchewan is a major lentil producing state accounting for 91% of the lentil area. Production is likely to decline to 2 MMT in 2019-20. Due to lower production and carryout supply side is expected to fall to 2.8 MMT. Export is likely to be stable at 1.8 MMT in 2019-20. Carryout would decrease to 0.5 MMT. So average price for top grade may increase in 2019-20.*
- *Lentil Production In US is expected to decline by 29% to 0.55 million acres in 2019-20. The main reason behind this is lower area coverage in Montana and North Dakota. Production of lentil is expected to decline to 0.3 MMT in 2019-20, sharply lower from 2018-19. The main US export markets for lentils are EU, Canada, India and Mexico.*
- *Chickpeas export from Australia increased sharply by over 90% to 43962 MT in April-2019. It was 23,066MT in March. It has lifted total export in ongoing M to 208,707 MT. However, it is lower by 64% from last year till April 2018. The biggest buyer was B, desh, buying 28,220 MT, followed by UAE buying 8,663 MT & Pakistan at 2,189 MT. Demand is weak right now. Stock in most exporting countries remain at higher levels relative to prospective demand. So Buyers are in no hurry to buy.*
- *In the month of April'19, red lentil exports from Canada decreased by 179% compared to March'19. Canada has exported 63465 MT of lentils in April'19. Top buyers of Canadian lentil were Bangladesh, India and Sri Lanka with 16950 MT, 15909 MT and 8761 MT respectively.*
- *Production of lentil in Canada is expected to decrease by 4.39 % to 20 lakh MT in 2019-20 against 20 lakh tonne in 2018-19. Yield for the year has been pegged slightly up at 1.5 MT per ha against 1.4 MT /ha last year. However total supply is expected to decrease from 29.89 to 28.20 lakh MT due to lower production pegged for 2019-20. Export has been pegged at 18 lakh tonne almost unchanged from 2018-19. Carryout is likely to decline from 7.0*

lakh Mt to 5.35 lakh MT in 2019-20. Stock to use ratio is expected to decline from 31 to 23 % in 2019-20. Price is likely to hover in the range of \$ 390 to 420 per MT in 2019-20.

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade steady to slightly weak.
