

### Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:

#### Today's Update:

- **DGFT has removed the condition of adv. Authorization letter for pulses import.** This means now importers need not to have adv. authorization letter from DGFT for pulses import. DGFT has already increased tur import quota from 2 lakh MT to 4 lakh MT. Importers have to import 2 lakh MT before Oct. It has already impacted tur price in domestic market.
- **Govt. has increased MSP of pulses for kharif season 2019-20.** Increase is considered marginal. Kharif pulses include tur, moong and urad. For arhar, the increase was 2.2 per cent (Rs125 per qtl.) from Rs 5,675 a quintal to Rs 5,800 per quintal. The MSP of moong was increased by 1.07 per cent (Rs 75 per qtl) from Rs 6,975 to Rs 7,050 a quintal while that of urad was increased by 1.78 per cent (Rs100 per qtl) from Rs 5,600 to Rs 5,700 a quintal.
- **Chickpea/chana dal export from India increased from 13031.02 MT in April to 15294 MT in May.** Total export in current MY registered at 28325.03 MT in last two months. Even tur export increased from 265.98 to 917.79 MT in May-2019. Green pea export stay almost steady at 4.03 MT. Lentil export increased from 858.49 Mt to 1759.89 MT in May. Urad export increased slightly to 517.44 MT, pea at 217.51 MT. However, moong export decreased from 1305.12 to 881.36 MT in May.

#### Previous Update:

- **The main govt.'s procurement agency Nafed still has over 4 million tonne pulses stock, it remains to be seen how much quantity is procured in on going kharif season under MSP oppression.** If prices of pulses drops further, govt. may procure pulses under PM-ASHAA program. However, market participants are not sure about quantity. In the 2018-19 rabi procurement season, the government's purchases under PM-ASHAA was less than 10 per cent of the total production. If govt. infuse much fund for this scheme, procurement quantity may increase. However, pressure would increase to release old stock too. It would continue to affect pulses price in local market.
- **Over all kharif pulses area is lagging behind by 61.36 % to 3.42 lakh ha as on 28th June-2019.** Arhar area is down by 77.24 % to 0.84 lakh ha so far while normal as on date is 4.48 lakh ha. Even urad area is down by 40.95 % to 0.62 lakh ha against normal of 1.40 lakh ha till date. Moong area is down by 62.18 % to 1.04 lakh ha against the normal of 3.55 lakh ha till date. Kulthi sowing has just started while other pulses coverage is 30.77 % down to 0.90 lakh ha against normal of 1.78 lakh ha. However, with monsoon advancing in growing regions, sowing activities is likely to pick up in coming weeks.
- **Govt. has allowed peas import for seed purpose and it is not going to make a big difference on other pea price as seed grade pea is imported with different HS code.** As it DGFT has started issuing license to importers. Some applicants have already received it and the rest are in process of getting it soon. There is a condition for importers that they have to import it before Oct-2019. This means supply of Tur, Urad & Moong would increase in Aug, Sept and from October new crop (especially urad and moong) would start hitting the market amid continuous sale by Nafed. So any spike in pulses market is unlikely. Even pulses demand in monsoon season weakens.
- **Haryana government has decided to exempt market fee(2.5%) on pulses/dals used as raw material in food processing industries located within the state by making amendment in Haryana Agri Business and Food Processing Policy-2018.** The Agriculture Department had already approved this exemption in accordance with Rule 30(6) of Haryana Agricultural Produce Markets (General) Rules, 1962.
- **Tur prices could not sustain at higher level taking clue from govt's intention to increase supply in cash market by allowing 2lakh MT additional tur import through private channel and permission for selling 2 lakh MT tur from buffer stock.** Besides, planning of 1.75 lakh MT tur import through Gto G basis. Demand got affected too at higher level. So, some sales by private trades at discounted price kept market down during review week. However, market is well aware of lower stock this year and availability of tur in global market too is at lower ebb. Planting of tur is being delayed, so higher area coverage is unlikely now. It would support cash tur market once again. In Gulberga market tur is being traded at Rs5700-5700. Overall trend remains steady to firm in the medium term.

- **Urad market too could not sustain its upward momentum and decreased by Rs 200-300 per qtl.** Despite slower pace of kharif sowing. Farmers have covered only 32000 ha area under urad due to lower rainfall. As monsoon rains started in major growing region, urad sowing is likely to improve in coming weeks. Urad demand at higher level got affected as dal demand from retail market weakened. As import would remain restricted at 1.5 lakh MT, supply side might be tight till new crop hits the market in Aug end /Sep. So more major decline is unlikely. It may trade up by Rs200 to 300 from current level in coming weeks. In Mumbai tur is being traded at Rs 4700-4750 after touching Rs5000. Overall tone seems steady to slightly firm.

#### **Pulses International Fundamental:**

##### **Today's Update:**

- **As per Eurostat latest data pea import in Spain decreased by 91% to 635MT in April against 7409 MT in March-2019.** In the ongoing MY Spain has imported total 21953 MT against 47045 MT last year till April-2018. France exported 581MT to Spain in April-2019 followed by Canada(48MT) and Belgium (3 MT).
- **Pea Export from Lithuania in April-2019 declined sharply in comparison to previous month(March).** It declined from 28,592 MT(March) to 22,097 MT in April-2019. This MY total export was registered at 94,984 MT, down by 26 % from last year till corresponding months. France brought 13,950 MT, followed by Germany(2,281 MT) & Latvia (2,260 MT)
- **Dry pea area in Canada is expected to increase by 12% over last year to 1.6 million ha in 2019-20.** The reason behind higher area is mainly attributed to higher return and good demand for export over previous year. The major states like Saskatchewan and Alberta contribute 54 and 42 % in total production in Canada. Production is expected to increase by 12% to 4 MMT over previous year due to higher area coverage. Despite higher production supply side would increase marginally as carryout is lower. Demand from China and B, desh is expected to decline in 2019-20. Carry in may increase slightly to 0.4 MMT in 2019-20.

##### **Previous Update:**

- **Even in US dry pea area is expected to increase slightly to 9 lakh Acres in 2019-20** due to higher area coverage in Montana. Production of pea in US is likely to decline by 35 to 0.7 MMT in 2019-20. The major buyers of US pea are Canada, the Philippines and Yemen.
- **Chickpea area is expected to fall in Canada from 176 to 133 thousand Ha in 2019-20** while production is expected to fall from 3.11 to 2.30 lakh MT. Supply is forecast to increase due to higher carry-in stocks, but softened by lower imports and production. The average price is forecast to fall due to larger world supply, with the expectation of an average grade distribution in 2019-20 as per Canada Stats.
- **US chickpea area for 2019-20 is forecast by the USDA to decrease by 40% to 0.52 million acres** from the previous year. This is largely due to an expected fall in area in Idaho, North Dakota and Washington. Assuming normal yields. Production is likely to decline by 43% to 0.33 MT in 2019-20. The major market for Us is EU, Pakistan and Canada
- **Lentil area in Canada is expected to decline 10% to 1.4 million ha in 2019-20** due to the sharp decline in farm gate lentil prices in the second half of the 2018-19 crop year. Saskatchewan is a major lentil producing state accounting for 91% of the lentil area. Production is likely to decline to 2 MMT in 2019-20. Due to lower production and carryout supply side is expected to fall to 2.8 MMT. Export is likely to be stable at 1.8 MMT in 2019-20. Carryout would decrease to 0.5 MMT. So average price for top grade may increase -in 2019-20.
- **Lentil Production In US is expected to decline by 29% to 0.55 million acres in 2019-20.** The main reason behind this is lower area coverage in Montana and North Dakota. Production of lentil is expected to decline to 0.3 MMT in 2019-20, sharply lower from 2018-19. The main US export markets for lentils are EU, Canada, India and Mexico.
- **Chickpeas export from Australia increased sharply by over 90% to 43962 MT in April-2019.** It was 23,066MT in March. It has lifted total export in ongoing M to 208,707 MT. However, it is lower by 64% from last year till April

2018. The biggest buyer was B, desh, buying 28,220 MT, followed by UAE buying 8,663 MT & Pakistan at 2,189 MT. Demand is weak right now. Stock in most exporting countries remain at higher levels relative to prospective demand. So Buyers are in no hurry to buy.

- In the month of April'19, red lentil exports from Canada decreased by 179% compared to March'19. Canada has exported 63465 MT of lentils in April'19. Top buyers of Canadian lentil were Bangladesh, India and Sri Lanka with 16950 MT, 15909 MT and 8761 MT respectively.

**Weekly Outlook:** -Pulses are likely to trade steady to slightly weak.
