

Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:**Today's Update:**

- **Cash chana market traded almost steady despite Nafed's plan to sell chana in MP and UP.** It would be interesting to see the bid price for 2018 crop and acceptance of bid price by Nafed. As quantity of chana in MP is higher, commencement of selling here would affect cash chana markets in other region too. So, the price direction for chana would depend on the level of accepted bid price by Nafed. Overall, there seems no scope for any spike in chana price in the near term despite emerging festive demand. Even futures too remain unsupportive to cash chana market Stakeholders should release stock at every increase of Rs 100. The maximum limit of increase seems near MSP.
- **As per market sources some importers have struck deal of kabuli chana at \$ 400 per MT basis CnF (Nhava Sheva port) from Black Sea region.** The quantity in question is said to be 1000 MT. At Mumbai port Kabuli chana from other origin is quoted at \$695-700 per MT.
- **Despite lower area coverage urad market trades under pressure and it extended its loss further.** In Mumbai market urad is being traded at Rs 4450-4500. Stockiest and importers are releasing old stock while demand for urad dal/urad is weak. New crop would hit market after two months and Nafed would continue to lighten its stock before new crop hits. Under these conditions improvement in urad market is unlikely in the near term. Good rainfall may encourage farmers to cover more area due to higher MSP and it may weaken inner tone further.
- **Prices remained bearish due to weak demand from millers. Although availability of lentil at ports is low however continuous imports in good quantity is keeping prices under pressure.** Stockiest are holding their stock as they expect market to improve in upcoming month. Lentil container and vessel at port are being quoted at Rs 4150 per quintal and Rs 4050 per quintal respectively. Lentil mill quality at Kanpur is moving in around Rs 4400 per quintal.
- **As per trade Sources, India has exported 2099.57 MT of Lentil at an average FoB of \$876.17 per tonne during the month of June-2019.** India has exported around 4717.95 tonnes of lentils during April'19-June'19.
- **At planting front Indian farmers have covered 12.84 lakh ha as on 12, July-2019.** It is lower by 21.73% from last year. Normal area till date is 18.27 lakh ha and normal of the whole season is 43.00 lakh ha. The major growing state like Karnataka & Maharashtra planting is running behind by 32.80 % to 2.96 and 23.64 % to 3.82 lakh ha so far. Normal area in these states are 8.62 and 12.53 lakh ha. In AP normal area for tur is 2.37 lakh ha. However, farmers have covered only 0.06 lakh ha so far against 0.24 lakh ha last year. Against it, farmers in Telangana have covered 2.66 % higher area to 1.73 lakh ha this year so far. In MP area under tur is running behind by 27.23 % to 1.47 lakh ha. Normal area in M.P. is 5.80 lakh ha. Area in UP and Orissa has improved from last year by 28.35 and 32.86 % to 1.14 and 0.37 lakh ha so far. Situation is expected to improve in coming weeks.
- **With better rainfall in growing region pressure on tur market continues and it lost Rs 100 more to Rs 5700 in Gulberga market.** It may decrease to Rs 5600. At this level buyer would be active once again. Lower crop size last year and bleak prospects this year too would not allow market to decrease beyond a certain level. Stockiest are unwilling to sell at current level despite higher import quota of 4 lakh MT and possibility of 1.75 lakh MT more import through G2G basis. Govt. is willing to keep supply side at ease. So, any major spike in tur market in the near term is unlikely.

Previous Update:

- **Govt. has increased MSP of pulses for kharif season 2019-20. Increase is considered marginal.** Kharif pulses include tur, moong and urad. For arhar, the increase was 2.2 per cent (RS125 per qtl.) from Rs 5,675 a quintal to Rs 5,800 per quintal. The MSP of moong was increased by 1.07 per cent (Rs 75 per qtl) from Rs 6,975 to Rs 7,050 a quintal while that of urad was increased by 1.78 per cent (Rs100 per qtl) from Rs 5,600 to Rs 5,700 a quintal.
- **Chickpea/chana dal export from India increased from 13031.02 MT in April to 15294 MT in May.** Total export in current MY registered at 28325.03 MT in last two months. Even tur export increased from 265.98 to 917.79 MT in May-2019. Green pea export stay almost steady at 4.03 MT. Lentil export increased from 858.49 Mt to 1759.89 MT in May. Urad export increased slightly to 517.44 MT, pea at 217.51 MT. However, moong export decreased from 1305.12 to 881.36 MT in May.
- **Govt. has allowed peas import for seed purpose and it is not going to make a big difference on other pea price as seed grade pea is imported with different HS code.** As it DGFT has started issuing license to importers. Some

applicants have already received it and the rest are in process of getting it soon. There is a condition for importers that they have to import it before Oct-2019.

Pulses International Fundamental:

Today's Update:

- **As per latest data received from Russian Federal Customs Service chickpeas export from Russia decreased by 16% to 25197 MT in May-2019 in comparison to April when export was registered at 29,858MT. Russia has exported total 99674 MT in this MY against 19,209 MT during the previous calendar year. Pakistan was the major buyers buying 9,797 MT in May, followed by India-6,789 MT and Turkey at 3,766 MT. Demand remains weak as main buyer like India is almost out of the market due to higher availability in domestic market as well as central pool.**
- **Russian export of peas posted slight gain in comparison to March-2019. In April Russia exported 55930 MT peas, up by 8% to 51836MT in March. In current MY Russia has exported total 175,643 MT, down from 380,191 in the same period the last calendar year. Pakistan brought 12,004 MT, followed by India 9,655 MT and Bangladesh at 8,701 MT. Demand is likely to improve in coming months.**
- **Dry pea area in Canada is expected to increase by 12% over last year to 1.6 million ha in 2019-20. The reason behind higher area is mainly attributed to higher return and good demand for export over previous year. The major states like Saskatchewan and Alberta contribute 54 and 42 % in total production in Canada. Production is expected to increase by 12% to 4 MMT over previous year due to higher area coverage. Despite higher production supply side would increase marginally as carryout is lower. Demand from China and Bangladesh is expected to decline in 2019-20. Carry in may increase slightly to 0.4 MMT in 2019-20.**

Previous Update:

- **Even in US dry pea area is expected to increase slightly to 9 lakh Acres in 2019-20 due to higher area coverage in Montana. Production of pea in US is likely to decline by 35 to 0.7 MMT in 2019-20. The major buyers of US pea are Canada, the Philippines and Yemen.**
- **Chickpea area is expected to fall in Canada from 176 to 133 thousand Ha in 2019-20 while production is expected to fall from 3.11 to 2.30 lakh MT. Supply is forecast to increase due to higher carry-in stocks, but softened by lower imports and production. The average price is forecast to fall due to larger world supply, with the expectation of an average grade distribution in 2019-20 as per Canada Stats.**
- **US chickpea area for 2019-20 is forecast by the USDA to decrease by 40% to 0.52 million acres from the previous year. This is largely due to an expected fall in area in Idaho, North Dakota and Washington. Assuming normal yields Production is likely to decline by 43% to 0.33 MT in 2019-20. The major market for US is EU, Pakistan and Canada**
- **Lentil area in Canada is expected to decline 10% to 1.4 million ha in 2019-20 due to the sharp decline in farm gate lentil prices in the second half of the 2018-19 crop year. Saskatchewan is a major lentil producing state accounting for 91% of the lentil area. Production is likely to decline to 2 MMT in 2019-20. Due to lower production and carryout supply side is expected to fall to 2.8 MMT. Export is likely to be stable at 1.8 MMT in 2019-20. Carryout would decrease to 0.5 MMT. So average price for top grade may increase in 2019-20.**
- **Lentil Production In US is expected to decline by 29% to 0.55 million acres in 2019-20. The main reason behind this is lower area coverage in Montana and North Dakota. Production of lentil is expected to decline to 0.3 MMT in 2019-20, sharply lower from 2018-19. The main US export markets for lentils are EU, Canada, India and Mexico.**
- **In the month of April'19, red lentil exports from Canada decreased by 179% compared to March'19. Canada has exported 63465 MT of lentils in April'19. Top buyers of Canadian lentil were Bangladesh, India and Sri Lanka with 16950 MT, 15909 MT and 8761 MT respectively.**

Weekly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade steady to slightly weak.
