

## **Pulses Domestic Fundamentals:**

### **Today's Update:**

- ***Lentil demand from millers is at lower levels. Furthermore, as per trade sources, importers have also entered into forward contracts for importing lentils from Canada. The delivery is expected to be mid to end of August. Therefore, continuous imports and low demand will keep lentil prices steady to weak. Lentil container and vessel at port are being quoted at Rs 4100 per quintal and Rs 4000 per quintal respectively. Lentil mill quality at Kanpur is moving in around Rs 4375 per quintal.***
- ***India has imported 7792.69 MT of green pea at an average CiF of \$394.01 per tonnes during the month of June-2019. Of the total quantity around 5985.57 tonnes has been purchased from Canada and the remaining quantity from United States. The government has fixed import quota of 1.50 LMT for peas (Yellow peas, Green peas, kaspas peas and Dun peas) during April '19-March '20.***
- ***Tur market seems under pressure due to govt.'s strategy and it would continue to trade stable in the near term despite lower crop size last year and slower planting progress this year. Govt has allowed 4 lakh MT import. Besides, additional 1.75 lakh MT would come through G2G channel. This means 5.75 lakh MT import would ease supply side in coming months. It does not include 2 lakh MT sale reserve stock. There are 4 to 5 consumption months remain before the new crop hits the market. So, availability is unlikely to be so tight. If incoming crop gets affected, its impact would be felt next year. Agriwatch expects tur price to move in the range of Rs 5600-6000 in Gulberga market. Right now it is being traded at Rs 5750-5850. CiF quotes in Myanmar have decreased to \$ 740 per MT after touching at \$780 per MT. It is good to release some parts of stock at every hike of Rs100-150.***
- ***Urad cash market continued to reel under pressure due to sluggish demand from bulk buyers and release of higher quantity by punters/importers. As cash market has started adjusting with the higher supply flow, it may stay steady at current level. Improvement in market is expected in August as there is no crop due in next two months. Planting in Maharashtra (Udgir & Latur) has got delayed by 20 days, so new arrivals expected now in Sept. Besides, market is expecting festive demand and it may help market to recover from current level. Urad in Mumbai market is being traded at Rs 4500-4525 while in Chennai market it is being quoted at Rs 4600-4650.***
- ***Moong cash market is expected to recover once again as major parts of stocks are in strong hands and arrival in major markets are decreasing fast. Sowing has been delayed by a fortnight and new arrival would start not before Sep. So steady to slightly firm tone may prevail in cash moong market. In Jaipur market moong is being traded at Rs 6250- 6300 per qtl. Coverage area is lower by 23% so far to 10.58 lakh ha. Recovery in area is expected this week too with current showers of rains in producing regions.***
- ***Cash chana market lacks direction for any upward momentum despite decreasing arrivals in all major markets. In Delhi market chana was traded at previous day level of Rs 4350-4400 amid 15 to 20 motors arrival. However futures traded up during last two days. But due to lack of buying support firm momentum is unlikely to continue. Actually weak demand in cash market and uncertain policy regarding sale by Nafed remain the price affecting factors. Slight improvement might be seen if festive demand emerges. Any major spike in chana market is unlikely in the near term. It may continue to trade in the range of Rs 4300-4550 per qtl. in Delhi market. Nafed is trying to sell chana in MP and UP and it may restrict upward movement in chana market. Besides, import from Black Sea region has started and importers have struck a deal at \$400 per MT basis CnF Navasheva. If the volume increases, it may affect inner tone further. With duty it would cost around \$670-680 per MT.***

### **International Market Update:**

- ***As per the latest update by US dry peas & lentil council mostly standing pulses crops are heading towards maturity stage despite some planting is going on in particular regions. Crop condition is normal to good. As demand from India is weak so farmers have changed planting decision to some extent this year. Inventory of chickpeas and lentil has increased. As per USDA estimate area under chickpeas and lentils have decreased by 31 & 35 % respectively. Montana lentil crops benefitted from good rains across the state. 52% of lentil plants are in bloom. The lentil crop rated 4% poor, 52% fair, 43% good and 1% excellent.***

- **A tentative comparison from last year shows that carryover stocks are high for all peas, lentils, and chick-peas.** Dry pea stocks are up 2% to 204,117 MT, lentils are up 81% at 144,242 MT. Large chickpeas are up 310 percent or 113,851 MT, while small chick-peas are up 256 percent, or 43,318 MT. Total chickpeas are up 294% for a total of 157,396 MTas per NASS report.
- **Peas area in Canada is likely to increase by 19.89 % to 1754 khain 2019-20.** Production too may increase by 20% to 43 lakh MT. Export and import are likely to be same in 2019-20. Carryout is likely to increase from 4 to 5 lakh MT this year. Average price might be hover in the range of \$255-285 per MT.
- **Lentil area in Canada is expected to increase by 0.33 % to 1.53 million ha in 2019-20** due to favorable weather condition. Yield is likely to improve from 1.4 to 1.47 tonne per ha. However total supply is likely to decrease by 2.85 % to 28.95 lakh MT in 2019-20. Export and import would increase slightly this year despite weak demand from India. Average price may hover in the range of \$ 430-460 per M
- **As per latest data received from Russian Federal Customs Service chickpeas export from Russia decreased by 16% to 25197 MT in May-2019** in comparison to April when export was registered at 29,858 MT. Russia has exported total 99674 MT in this MY against 19,209 MT during the previous calendar year. Pakistan was the major buyers buying 9,797 MT in May, followed by India-6,789 MT and Turkey at 3,766 MT. Demand remains weak as main buyer like India is almost out of the market due to higher availability in domestic market as well as central pool.
- **Russian export of peas posted slight gain in comparison to March-2019. In April** Russia exported 55930 MT peas, up by 8% to 51836 MT in March. in current MY Russia has exported total 175,643 MT, down from 380,191 in the same period the last calendar year. Pakistan brought 12,004 MT, followed by India 9,655 MT and Bangladesh at 8,701 MT. Demand is likely to improve in coming months.
- **Dry pea area in Canada is expected to increase by 12% over last year to 1.6 million ha in 2019-20.** The reason behind higher area is mainly attributed to higher return and good demand for export over previous year. The major states like Saskatchewan and Alberta contribute 54 and 42 % in total production in Canada. Production is expected to increase by 12% to 4 MMT over previous year due to higher area coverage. Despite higher production supply side would increase marginally as carryout is lower. Demand from China and B, desh is expected to decline in 2019-20. Carry in may increase slightly to 0.4 MMT in 2019-20.

#### **Previous Update:**

- **Even in US dry pea area is expected to increase slightly to 9 lakh Acres in 2019-20** due to higher area coverage in Montana. Production of pea in US is likely to decline by 35 to 0.7 MMT in 2019-20. The major buyers of US pea are Canada, the Philippines and Yemen.
- **Chickpea area is expected to fall in Canada from 176 to 133 thousand Ha in 2019-20** while production is expected to fall from 3.11 to 2.30 lakh MT. Supply is forecast to increase due to higher carry-in stocks, but softened by lower imports and production. The average price is forecast to fall due to larger world supply, with the expectation of an average grade distribution in 2019-20 as per Canada Stats.
- **US chickpea area for 2019-20 is forecast by the USDA to decrease by 40% to 0.52 million acres** from the previous year. This is largely due to an expected fall in area in Idaho, North Dakota and Washington. Assuming normal yields Production is likely to decline by 43% to 0.33 MT in 2019-20. The major market for Us is EU, Pakistan and Canada
- **Lentil area in Canada is expected to decline 10% to 1.4 million ha in 2019-20** due to the sharp decline in farm gate lentil prices in the second half of the 2018-19 crop year. Saskatchewan is a major lentil producing state accounting for 91% of the lentil area. Production is likely to decline to 2 MMT in 2019-20. Due to lower production and carryout supply side is expected to fall to 2.8 MMT. Export is likely to be stable at 1.8 MMT in 2019-20. Carryout would decrease to 0.5 MMT. So average price for top grade may increase -in 2019-20.
- **Lentil Production In US is expected to decline by 29% to 0.55 million acres in 2019-20.** The main reason behind this is lower area coverage in Montana and North Dakota. Production of lentil is expected to decline to 0.3 MMT in 2019-20, sharply lower from 2018-19. The main US export markets for lentils are EU, Canada, India and Mexico.

- *In the month of April'19, red lentil exports from Canada decreased by 179% compared to March'19. Canada has exported 63465 MT of lentils in April'19. Top buyers of Canadian lentil were Bangladesh, India and Sri Lanka with 16950 MT, 15909 MT and 8761 MT respectively.*

**Weekly Outlook:** -Pulses are likely to trade steady to slightly weak.
